

# SATURDAY, 07/02/26

## C1 - PRIX D'OLARGUES - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 8,000

- JADA MOKO** - Disqualified in class G at this course over 2700m on 31 January. Has disqualification issues but is not out of it
- HAWK SPEED** - Unreliable and finished 10th in class F over this course and distance on 28 January. Remains barefoot but needs to improve to win
- KALLISTEE** - Victorious in Class F over this course and distance on 28 January. Remains barefoot and is improving. Big chance
- JAZZ BUROIS** - Returned to form and was 4th in class G at this track over 2700m on 31 January. Victorious in December and is not out of it
- IBANA DE MONTI** - Disqualified in class E at this track over 2925m on 23 January. Unreliable and has disqualification issues. Others make more appeal
- HOPE COGLAIS** - Disqualified in class F at this course over 2925m on 2 January. Remains barefoot but others are preferred this time
- JIVAGO DE BEYLEV** - Disqualified in a claimer at this track over 2925m on 25 January when barefoot. Not this time and is best watched for now
- JOYAUX DU CHENE** - In good form and was runner up in class F over this track and trip on 28 January. Should be right there at the finish once again
- JUANITO GOBERNA** - Victorious at Modena over 1600m on 10 January. Goes further and tackles stronger this so others are preferred

**Summary:** A small field and only a few of them are likely winners. KALLISTEE (3) looks the right one after a good win over this course and distance last month. She is improving and can follow up. JOYAUX DU CHENE (8) was not too far behind that rival when they met last time out and should be a real threat again. JAZZ BUROIS (4) likes this course and can be closely involved at the business end. JADA MOKO (1) is not one to trust entirely but can make the frame if applied.

**C2 - PRIX DU CROS DE CAGNES (PRIX DE PEZENAS) - 2925m (a2m) -**  
**Class D - Harness - EUR € 21,000**

- 1. NININE DES FLOTS** - Finished 3rd in class C over this course and distance on 16 January. Has shown improvement and is clearly not out without a chance
- 2. NISSA STAR** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class C over this course and distance on 16 January. Could play a minor role at very best
- 3. NOTRE SAXO D'AURE** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in class F over this track and trip on 31 January. Can go one place better
- 4. NILDA LAND** - Runner up in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 31 January. Best at runner up but others are preferred this time
- 5. NEWLIFE DE CAHOT** - Victorious in class F at this track over 2150m on 25 January. Dis qualified on debut before that but can be a threat if smart
- 6. NINA TIME** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in class F at this track over 2150m on 23 December. Can fight out the finish once again
- 7. NOLAN QUESNOT** - Not disgraced when 5th in class C at this course over 2150m on 28 January. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 8. NIMEO FLOWER** - Not reliable and finished 5th in class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 15 January. Capable of doing better and must be respected
- 9. NOMAN'S POINT** - Victorious in Class F at this course over 2150m on 21 January. Has class, tries further this time and can double up
- 10. NEURO BELLA** - Victorious in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over this track and trip on 31 January. In decent form and is clearly not out of it
- 11. NECTAR DES LOYAUX** - Victorious in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 25 October. Has the ability to follow up but is returning from a break

**Summary:** NOMAN'S POINT (9) was an impressive winner over the shorter distance at this track on debut and can follow up. NINA TIME (6) is threatening to win and can contest the finish once again. NEURO BELLA (10) quickened nicely when scoring over this course and distance and is a danger. NECTAR DES LOYAUX (11) is returning from a break but won well at Salon-de-Provence back in October and can get involved with the finish again.

C3 - PX PROMENADE DE LA PLAGE (PRIX D'AVENE) - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR €  
38,000

- 1. IRISH NICE ELGE** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class D over this track and trip on 21 January. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
- 2. HIVER D'AUTHISE** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in class D over this course and distance on 21 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 3. FUCHSIA DU RIB** - Off form and finished 14th in class C at this track over 2700m on 16 January. Others are much preferred
- 4. GRIZMAN** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class D over this track and trip on 21 January. Might play a minor role at very best
- 5. GAI LOGIS** - Victorious in Class D over this track and trip on 21 January. Remains barefoot and is capable of making the frame
- 6. HERAKLION** - Unreliable and was 11th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December when barefoot. Others make more appeal
- 7. HELENCO** - Unreliable and was 7th a claimer over this course and distance on 11 January when barefoot. Can do much better for David Bekaert
- 8. KROONER D'HERIPRE** - Successful in Class D over this track and trip over 2925m on 28 January. Some good recent wins and can complete the hat-trick
- 9. JOY DU CARNOIS** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 December. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 10. HESCORT LOVE** - Disqualified in class D over this track and trip on 21 January. Clearly not reliable but is capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 11. INVISIBLE SAM** - Much improved last run when 3rd in class D over this course and distance on 21 January. Is barefoot and can be a threat again
- 12. GIVE ME CASH** - Disqualified in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 21 January. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 13. HERMES D'ECROVILLE** - Unreliable and finished 3rd in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 January. Remains barefoot and can be competitive once again
- 14. GRANIT DU FRESNE** - In good form and finished 3rd in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January when barefoot. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 15. GALOPIN DES CHAMPS** - Unreliable and was 7th in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Remains barefoot but needs to do a bit more to score

**Summary:** KROONER D'HERIPRE (8) is hat-trick hunting after some good recent wins. His last success was achieved on a very sloppy track, and he gets a narrow vote to score. JOY DU CARNOIS (9) has only been modest of late, but she is capable of a strong finish when in the mood, so she is a threat. HESCORT LOVE (10) is not reliable but is quite capable of getting involved with the finish if in the right mood. HELENCO (7) looks capable of some improvement for David Bekaert.

**C4 - PRIX DES COMMERCANTS (PRIX DU LARZAC) - 2150m (a1m1/4) -**  
**Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000**

- 1. JUST D'HERIPRE** - In good shape and was 3rd in class F at this track over 2925m on 3 February. Is clearly not out of it in this line-up
- 2. JOY FOR EVER** - Consistent and was 3rd in class E at this track over 2925m on 23 January. Should be right there at the finish yet again
- 3. IMPACTDARCHE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in class E at this track over 2925m on 23 January. Victorious back in December and is capable of an upset
- 4. ISLA** - Has struggled of late and was 13th in class E over this track and trip on 21 January. Unreliable and others make more appeal
- 5. ILLUMINATI** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class E at this track over 2925m on 23 January. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 6. JAKADI DE VAUVILLE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at this course over 2925m on 23 January. Capable of making the frame when smart
- 7. INSAISSABLE DUO** - In good form and was 3rd in class F at this course over 2700m on 2 February. Can be a real danger this shorter distance
- 8. JUAN CARLOS GIFONT** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up at Modena over 2080m on 12 January. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 9. JANTALINE** - Unreliable but finished 3rd in class G at this course over 2700m on 31 January. Capable of getting into the mix of things
- 10. IDOLE DE LA TOUQUE** - Disqualified in class E at Nantes over 3000m on 16 January. Not easy to trust and others are much preferred
- 11. JIRENZO** - Disqualified in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 3 February when barefoot. Not reliable but can play a minor role when staying in stride

**Summary:** JOY FOR EVER (2) is usually competitive in this division and looks a solid winning proposition over a shorter distance that suits her ideally. INSAISSABLE DUO (7) is threatening to win and should be right there at the finish once again. JUAN CARLOS GIFONT (8) has got close to winning on his last two starts. This is a tougher task, but he is clearly one to pay attention to. JAKADI DE VAUVILLE (6) has had a couple of disqualifications of late but can contest the finish when staying on the trot.

**C5 - GP VILLE DE CAGNES-SUR-MER (PX BEZIERS) - 2925m (a2m) -**  
**Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000**

- 1. KISS D'EREVAN** - Very consistent of late and was 3rd in class E over this track and trip on 16 January. Should be involved with the finish once again
- 2. KING'S GAME** - Victorious in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 11 January. Victorious in two of last three starts and has claims of winning
- 3. KAPOOR D'OLMEN** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class E over this course and distance on 20 December. Victorious back in August and can be a lively threat
- 4. KIRIO DE REUX** - Holding form and finished fourth in class E at this track over 2100m on 3 February. Successful in November and is not out of it
- 5. KANTOR DU VIVIER** - Disqualified three times in a row, including in class E over this course and distance on 30 December. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 6. KENDO JIEL** - Returned to form and was 3rd in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 18 January. Has shown improvement and is barefoot. Can contest the finish
- 7. KERVELEAN** - Not reliable and was 9th in class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 December. Victorious back in November and can bounce back to score
- 8. KALGARY** - Disqualified in class D over this course and distance on 27 December. Victorious back in November and can earn some more money if smart
- 9. KILIM QUICK** - Unreliable and finished 5th in class D over this course and distance on 27 December. Has a place chance on best form

**Summary:** A very open-looking race. KERVELEAN (7) is not reliable and was well beaten at Vincennes last time out, but he is quite capable of bouncing back to beat these rivals if in the right mood. KAPOOR D'OLMEN (3) could be close to a peak performance after two runs back and is a threat. KIRIO DE REUX (4) has held form nicely and can be competitive yet again. KANTOR DU VIVIER (5) is barefoot for the first time and is another to consider.

**C6 - PRIX DU VAL FLEURI ET DES VESPINS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D -  
Harness - EUR € 26,000**

- 1. LIVINIO FLAC** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 January. Capable of much better and can bounce back to score
- 2. LONDON RECALL** - Only modest of late and finished 10th in class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 23 December. Has a very good record with this shoeing and will be a threat
- 3. LOTHBROCK** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 January. Has room to improve and can contest the finish when smart
- 4. LITTEROK D'EURVAD** - In good form and finished 3rd in class D at this track over 2925m on 11 January. Remains barefoot and can make the frame
- 5. LORD DES FANES** - Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 25 January. Not reliable and has a place chance in this line-up
- 6. LIKALETO DE WALLIS** - Consistent and finished 3rd in class D at this track over 2150m on 3 February. Should be involved with the finish yet again
- 7. LYNX DU SAPTEL** - Not disgraced when 5th in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 25 January. In good shape and can be competitive once again
- 8. LUTIN DE BOISNEY** - In good form and finished 4th in class F at this course over 2925m on 11 January. Could earn some more money
- 9. LUCIFER** - Not reliable and finished 4th in class E at this course over 2150m on 8 January. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 10. LEE ROCK BOND** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in class D at this course over 2925m on 2 January. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role

**Summary:** A competitive-looking race. LIVINIO FLAC (1) ran better than the finishing position shows last time out and can win a race of this nature, so gets the vote to score. LONDON RECALL (2) needed his last two runs and can be a serious challenger for top honours with the fitness on his side now. He has a proud record with this particular shoeing as well. LYNX DU SAPTEL (7) remains in good shape and can get into the mix of things. LIKALETO DE WALLIS (6) is consistent and barefoot, so could also shine brightly.

**C7 - PRIX DES COLLETTES-BREGUIERES - 2925m (a2m) - Class D -  
Harness - EUR € 26,000**

- 1. MELODIE FAVORITE** - Disqualified four times in a row, including last time out over this course and distance on 31 January. Hard to trust and needs major improvement to win
- 2. MILADY SMART** - Yet to win a race and finished 7th in Class E over this track and trip on 31 January. Capable of doing better and could play a minor role
- 3. MONNAIE DE VIETTE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vincennes over 2100m on 18 November. Hard to trust but can contest the finish when staying in stride
- 4. MILADY CASTELETS** - Unreliable and faulted last time out at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 29 January. Probably best over the shorter distance and others make more appeal
- 5. MERVEILLE BOKO** - Unreliable and finished tenth at Duindigt over 2000m on 6 September. Returns from a break but has won over this course and distance and could surprise
- 6. MONA LISA GEDE** - Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2700m on 3 February. Quite capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 7. MAMZELLE D'HERIPRE** - Continues to improve and was runner-up in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 December. Best over shorter but can beat these rivals
- 8. MOSTRA DE CHANLECY** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out over this course and distance on 13 December. In good form before that and can contest the finish.
- 9. MIRABELLE DE LARRE** - Yet to win a race and was barefoot when 9th in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 17 January. Remains without shoes and could be competitive this time around

**Summary:** A competitive lucky last race. MAMZELLE D'HERIPRE (7) has won twice already and both of those victories came over a shorter distance, but she does look the one they all have to beat. She is barefoot and ready to strike. MOSTRA DE CHANLECY (8) faulted last time out over this course and distance but is capable of being a real threat when smart. MIRABELLE DE LARRE (9) has only been modest of late, but improvement can be expected over this track and trip. MONA LISA GEDE (6) has yet to win a race but can make the frame.
