## C1 - PRIX DE SIENNE - 2925m (a2m) - Class A Race - Harness - EUR € 52,000

- **1. JEWELLE OF JANE -** A winner of two of her last four starts but was 8th last time out in Class C over this track and trip on 18 February. Others are preferred
- **2. JUPITER MADRIK -** A winner of two of his last three starts, including last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 4 February. Not out of it
- **3. JITANE VALLEE -** In good shape and was runner-up last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 11 February. Can make the frame
- **4. JOOST D'OLERON -** Holding form and finished fourth in Class B over this track and trip on 26 February. Should be competitive once again
- **5. JAVANAIS DELO -** Victorious in his last three starts, with the latest being in Class C over this track and trip on 4 February. Big chance
- **6. JIGSAW PUZZLE -** On a long losing run and finished 6th last time out in Class C over this track and trip on 18 February. Could play a minor role
- **7. JUDICIOUS WINNER -** Disqualified last time out at Saint Galmier on 17 February. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
- **8. JUST FOR LOVA -** Unreliable and finished 11th last time out in Class B over this course and distance on 26 February. Might earn some minor money

**Summary:** JAVANAIS DELO (5) is on a winning row, having scored in his last three starts. He is from a red-hot yard as well and can make it four on the bounce. JESON BOY (9) ran below-par last time out at this course but runs barefoot here and can make amends. JOOST D'OLERON (4) holds his form well and generally goes well at this course. He should be kept high on the shortlist. JITANE VALLEE (3) is in fine fettle and can make her presence felt once again.

## C2 - PRIX DE SAINT-MALO - 2925m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- **1. JACK DU BARBEY -** Holding form well and was third last time out in Class D over this course and distance on 27 February, Be right there at the finish once again
- 2. HARLEY DES PRES Has struggled for some time now and was 11th in Class E at this course over 2150m on 8 February. Needs major improvement to win
- **3. I AM PHYT'S -** Unreliable and finished tenth last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 21 February. Probably better over the shorter distance and others are preferred
- **4. JOJO LAPIN -** Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up for the third time in a row, in class G at this track over 2950m on 2 March. Has a winning chance
- **5. INNOCENT DU BOURG** On a long losing run but is in good form and was fourth last time out in Class F at this track over 2700m on 18 February. Could play a minor role
- **6. IMBRIN BUROIS -** Unreliable but was third last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 21 February. Can earn some minor money
- **7. HADORABLE MEC -** Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out at this track on 18 February. Needs major improvement to win
- **8. JAURESS DE CANI -** On a long losing run and was 9th in Class C over this track and trip on 18 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race

**Summary:** JACK DU BARBEY (1) has run well at Cagnes sur Mer this winter and should be rewarded with a win sooner rather than later. He gets the vote ahead of ICARE FILE (11) who is on a redemption mission after he blew his chances at the start last time out. ISABEY QUESNOT (14) disappointed last time out but runs barefoot this Friday and is expected to show a different figure. JOJO LAPIN (4) is going through a purple patch and is another who must be given some serious consideration.

- **1. IL PRINCIPINO -** Disqualified last time out at this course on 27 February. Better over further but is capable of making the frame
- **2. IL VILLAGGIO -** Has struggled for some time and was 8th in Class G at this course over 2950m on 2 March. Barefoot this time but others make more appeal
- **3. IVY METAL -** Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at this track on 27 February. Capable of scoring when wise
- **4. IN VIVO -** In good from and was third last time out in Class E at this track over 2700m on 26 February. Remains barefoot and can fight out the finish
- **5. IMPULSE LADY -** Has some fair form of late and was fourth last time out in Class D at Toulouse over this distance on 19 February. Has a winning chance with David Békaert in the sulky
- **6. IESOLO D'HERIPRE -** Has lost the way with some disqualification os late, including last time out at this course on 9 January. Probably best watched for now
- **7. IRON BIRD DEVOL** Disqualified last time out at Cherbourg on 2 March. In good form before that and has a place chance if smart this time

**Summary:** IMPULSE LADY (5) couldn't not find a better entry at 635 Euros from the threshold. Entrusted for the first time to David Békaert and ideally drawn behind the car-start, she looks a solid winning proposition. IN VIVO (4) was barefoot when hebounced back to form at this course on 26 February and should go well again under the same shoeing arrangement. IVY METAL (3) is obviously a better horse than his last three sanctions show and should not be overlooked. ISA MAUVE (8) won her last three starts in the amateur division and can step up in grade successfully.

- **3. GREEN EYES -** Well beaten 8th in a Claimer at this track over 2925m on 2 March. Remains barefoot. Others make more appeal
- **4. GOLDEN VIKING -** Finished 8th in a class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 15 February. A penultimate start runner-up at this level and has every chance again
- **5. GUOPECK DE VIVOIN -** Disqualified in a Claimer at this track over 2925m on 2 March. Remains barefoot. Must be wise to have a say
- **6. FAUX DOLLARS -** Finished 10th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 February. Remains barefoot. Has sufficient means to fight for a place on the podium

**Summary:** HORTENSIA DE LARRE (2) has held his form nicely at this level and does set the standard in a competitive race. GOLDEN VIKING (4) has not won for some time now but was runner-up in this division in his penultimate start and can go one better. FAUX DOLLARS (6) has disappointed of late but should do better in a race of this nature. ENJEU DAIRPET (9) is a danger when in the right frame of mind.

- **3. KASHMIR PRESTANCE -** Finished 7th in a class E at this track over 2150m on 21 February. Ignore the latest, the previous form was good and can bounce back
- **4. KASH D'URZY -** A winner in a class E at this track over 2150m on 21 February. A winner of the last two and can complete the hat-trick. Remains barefoot
