C1 - PRIX PMU "L'ESCALE"-STE-ANNE-SUR-BRIVET - 2800m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- **1. MAMBO ITALIANO -** A good winner on debut in class F at at this track over 2200m on 16 February. Tries further but can double up
- **2. MODESTY -** Yet to win a race and finished fifth last time out in class E at Graignes over 2725m on 13 February. Needs to do a bit more to win
- **3. MAGIC DE BANVILLE -** A good winner last time out in class F at Nantes over 2275m on 21 January. Looked solid that day and can follow up
- **4. MYSTERY QUEEN -** Finished 6th last time out in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 February. Won her debut and can be a real threat this time
- **5. MAESTRO DE CORDAY -** Showed improvement and was a winner last time out in class F at Argentan over 2300m on 16 February. Can contest the finish
- **6. MARILYN MONROE -** Has disqualification issues and finished 8th in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 February. Capable of better but others ar preferred
- **7. MIRABELLE DE LARRE -** Unreliable and finished 8th in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 February. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **8. MISS IS DU CANET -** Showed some improvement and finished third last time out in class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 13 December. Could play a minor role
- **9. MALABAR MAGO -** Holding form and finished fourth last time out in class E at Nantes over 2275m on 26 January. Should fight out the finish again
- **10. MOLINE DE PADD -** Unplaced last time out in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 February. Yet to win a race and others are preferred
- **11. MUSCLE DREAM** Did not show his best when 7th last time out in class C at Enghien over 2150m on 28 September. Returns from a break and could need the run

Summary: MAGIC DE BANVILLE (3) is improving and was a good winner at Nantes in January. The step up in distance should suit and he can double up. MALABAR MAGO (9) has been very consistent over the shorter distances and can be a real threat in this line-up. MAMBO ITALIANO (1) looked good when scoring on debut at this course. This longer distance may not be a problem. MYSTERY QUEEN (4) did not run badly at Vincennes and can also be considered a possible winner.

- **2. LAUVERGNIER -** Has run well in all three of her starts so far and was 4th in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 22 February. Barefoot for the first time and should make a bold bid at scoring
- **3. LOKI DU PONT -** Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a claimer at Les Sables-d'Olonne over this distance on 17 August. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- **4. LADY DE L'ECORCE -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class E at Nantes over 2275m on 14 February. Better over shorter but is also not out of it
- **5. LE CONQUERANT -** Showed what he is capable of with a Class E win at Nantes over 3000m on 14 February. Capable of following up in this line-up
- **6. LILY ROSE D'URFIST -** Disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 13 September. Has the ability but both her wins were at Pornichet-La Baule and she could need this run returning from a break
- **7. LIBERTE CERISE -** Did not show her best when 7th last time out in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 22 February. A winner over this track and trip before that and is not out of it
- **8. LUXOR D'AUVILLIER -** Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Argentan on 16 February. Capable of earning some money if wise this time
- **9. LOMAC GEDE -** Very unreliable and was 8th in Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 22 October. Capable of a surprise but could need this run returning from a break
- **10. LET'S TWIST -** Did not show his best when 8th in Class C at Castéra-Verduzan over 2800m on 19 August. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- **11. LE DUC DE SEVRES -** Continues to improve and was a good third in Class E at Nantes over 2275m on 14 February. Can get involved with the finish yet again
- **12. LESTANCIA BELLA -** Has only lost once in three starts and that was last time out when runner-up in Class E at Angers over 2350m on 29 January. Can go one better this time

Summary: LESTANCIA BELLA (12) won both her starts last year and only found one better on the day in her come back run. She is awkwardly placed in the second row but would not be a surprise winner. LE CONQUERANT (5) was a good winner at Nantes last time out and can follow up. LE DUC DE SEVRES (11) seems better over a shorter distance but that is not guaranteed. - **3. KISS ME JIVE -** Yet to win a race and finished 7th last time out in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 16 February. Can make the frame
- **4. KASH WIT -** Unreliable and finished 8th last time out in class F at Vire over 2800m on 9 February. Better in a harness race and others are preferred
- **5. KERSIGAN -** On a very long losing run and finished 8th last time out in class F at Vire over 2800m on 2 March. Needs major improvement to win
- **6. KINGDOM DE CHENU -** Did not show his best when 6th last time out in class E at Nantes over 3000m on 22 February. In good form before that and has a winning chance

Summary: KING DU RIL (8) has been impressive of late and has rattled off four Mounted race victories in a row. There is no real reason why he cannot extend that to five wins. KINGDOM DE CHENU (6) disappointed last time out in a harness race. He was better under the saddle in two good runs before that will be a lively danger. KIROLETA (7) has struggled with some disqualifications of late but can contest the finish if wise this time. KISS ME JIVE (3) needs to do more to beat those rivals but might make the frame.

- **2. ISMIR DE L'ORMERIE -** Unreliable but was third last time out in class E at Saumur over 3275m on 23 February. Might play a minor role
- **3. HELLO D'URZY -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced last time out in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 18 February. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. IMPERIALE MIVENCE -** On a long losing run but was a good third last time out in class E at Nantes over 3000m on 22 February. Can contest the finish again

- **3. KLEOPATRA BLUE -** On a long losing run but was 6th last time out in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 22 February. Might play a minor role at very best
- **4. KELCANTO BELLO -** Returned to form and finished third last time out in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 22 February. Capable of contesting the finish again
- **5. KENAVO HERBLINAIE -** Needed the last run when 7th in Class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 28 February. Has the ability and could upset fitter this time around

- **4. JURASSIC MOIRE -** Has struggled for some time now and was 7th last time out in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 5 February. Capable of making the frame
- **5. JORPHEA D'ESPOIR -** On a very long losing run and finished 7th last time out in Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 6 September. Likely to need this run returning from a break
