**C1 - PRIX ROQUEPINE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR €
27,000**

1. NELLY DES CHARMES - Victorious in a Class F over this course and distance on 18 January. Looked good on debut and is not out of it

2. NUWA DU PATURAL - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 19 February. Did better before that and could earn some money

3. NOUIC DI PALBA - Holding form and finished 4th in Class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 19 February. Might play a minor role at best

4. NARRETEPAS GIO - Disqualified at Toulouse on 19 February. Not easy to trust and has a tough task to beat these rivals. Others make more appeal

5. NEUVAINE - Successful in a Class F at Nantes over 2275m on 21 February. Has not done much wrong so far and can double up

6. NIKI DU GOUTIER - Showed improvement when runner-up in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2225m on 12 February. Can go one place better

7. NOT ALONE - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 12 February. Has a place chance in this line-up

8. NO RISK FLIGNY - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a Class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 19 February. Should be right there at the finish

9. NATIF DES CAILLONS - Victorious in a Class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 19 February. Still improving and should fight out the finish

Summary: A competitive looking race. NIKI DU GOUTIER (6) is improving and gets a narrow vote to score. He did fluff his lines with a disqualification on debut, though. NATIF DES CAILLONS (9) continues to shine brightly and may have more wins in the tank. NEUVAINE (5) has done well so far so should be very competitive once again. NO RISK FLIGNY (8) has been unlucky not to win recently and should be right there at the finish yet again.

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C2 - PRIX FUSCHIA - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. LEADER CARISAIE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vire on 8 February. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. LYNX DES TOUCHES** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class F at Challans over 2900m on 8 February. Might play a minor role
- 3. LEADER WINNER** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2550m on 22 February. Very hard to trust but can earn some money when smart
- 4. LEGRAND BRILLOUARD** - Has improved this year and was runner-up in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 February. Can earn some more money
- 5. LUCIOLE DES VENTS** - Not reliable but finished 3rd in a Class F at this track over 2550m on 22 February. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 6. LANDEN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Auch on 22 February. Hard to trust and others are much preferred
- 7. LA RIVER D'ECCAM** - Victorious in her last 2 starts, the latest a Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Can complete a hat-trick
- 8. LASTRONAUT DANOVER** - Successful in Class F at Angers over 3125m on 11 January. In very good form and can double up in this line-up
- 9. L'OR DU MELEUC** - Unreliable and finished 10th in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 February. Others make more appeal
- 10. LOOK DES CAILLONS** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class F at Machecoul over 2700m on 1 February. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 11. LITCHI CASTELETS** - Disqualified last time out at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Needed that run and could bounce back to score
- 12. LOUISE D'ERPION** - Unreliable and finished fourth in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 February. Might play a minor role
- 13. LOOK QALI** - Two solid wins of late, the latest in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 6 February. Can complete a hat-trick
- 14. LUCIDE CASTELETS** - In good form and was third last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 February. Can be competitive once again

Summary: A very open looking race and only a very few of them can safely be ruled out from winning. LITCHI CASTELETS (11) will come on from his first run back from a break and can score. LA RIVER D'ECCAM (7) has been good of late with some nice wins and she will not go down easily. LASTRONAUT DANOVER (8) has a good record on right-handed tracks and can be competitive once again. LOOK QALI (13) is hat-trick seeking and clearly not out of it.

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C3 - PRIX KAMOK - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. KADENCE CENSERIE** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 21 September. Should need this run returning from a break
- 2. KATRINA DE MARZY** - Unreliable and finished 4th in Class F at this track over 2550m on 8 February. Has disqualification issues but does also have a place chance
- 3. KANDY VENESI** - A winner of a Class F at Challans over 2900m on 8 February. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring again if in the right mood
- 4. KISS ME DU BOULAY** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class F at Graignes over 22 February. Might earn some minor money
- 5. KOLYTA DU CHENE** - Unreliable and was barefoot and runner-up in a Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 16 February. Not fully barefoot this time but can play a minor role
- 6. KINAYA D'OCCAGNES** - Finished 14th in a Class F at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 31 August. Barefoot returning from a break but others are preferred
- 7. KARINE DE BRETAGNE** - Consistent and was runner-up in Class F at Châteauroux over 2925m on 28 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- 8. KENZA D'ASNOIS** - Did not show her best when 6th in a Class F at this track over 2550m on 22 February. More is needed to win this race
- 9. KARESSE D'EURVAD** - Showed improvement when 3rd in Class F at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. Could play a minor role at best
- 10. KAPTA JELOCA** - Ultra-consistent and was victorious in a Class G over this track and trip on 22 February. Likes this track and can double up
- 11. KISS ME DU LIVET** - Not reliable but did run well when 3rd in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. Has claims in this line-up
- 12. KOSETTE DU LINON** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class E at Saumur over 3250m on 22 February. Can be a lively danger once again

Summary: A tricky race. KISS ME DU LIVET (11) gets the vote to score bated off a good recent performance at Vincennes. KAPTA JELOCA (10) has won her last two starts at this track and remains at the top of her game so must be respected for that. KOSETTE DU LINON (12) usually does well when barefoot and can get into the mix of things. KANDY VENESI (3) is not easy to trust but was successful in her latest start and is not out of it

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C4 - GRAND PRIX BORDEAUX METROPOLE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 35,000

- 1. CLICK STARLIGHT** - Disqualified at Enghien on 9 October. Has disqualification issues and is returning from a break but is quite capable of winning
- 2. INCUDINE** - Successful in a Class D mounted race at Toulouse over 2950m on 22 January. Improving and could follow up
- 3. ILLICO DE LOU** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, the latest at Cordemais on 27 February. Hard to trust but can earn money when smart
- 4. HERACLES DU LAYON** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E mounted race at Cordemais over 2825 on 27 February. Place chance on best form
- 5. IMHOTEP BUROIS** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 February. Could make the frame if at best
- 6. GALIBOT DE L'ISOP** - Only moderate of late and finished 7th in a Class E mounted race over this track and trip on 26 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 7. HA YES MAX** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class E harness at Agen-Le Passage over 2050m on 3 March. Might play a minor role in a mounted race
- 8. JACQUARD** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest at Laval on 26 February. Has the ability to bounce back to score
- 9. IVRE DE TOI** - Disqualified at Amiens on 9 December. Capable of contesting the finish if fit enough returning after a break

Summary: An interesting race. JACQUARD (8) does look the best of them on form but he does come with disqualification issues. CLICK STARLIGHT (1) returns from a break and is hard to trust but should be a threat to these rivals if staying in stride. INCUDINE (2) is improving and won well enough to be considered a possible victor. IMHOTEP BUROIS (5) is unreliable but is also capable of getting into the mix of things if at his best.

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C5 - PRIX D'ASTORG - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. KINGPIN** - Returned from a break and finished 6th in Class F at this course over 2550m on 8 February. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 2. KOGNAC DES TOURS** - Unreliable but finished 4th in a Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 March. Capable of earning some more money
- 3. KWICK DU PASSAGE** - In good shape and finished 3rd in Class F at this track over 2550m on 22 February. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 4. KALIN DEROZES** - Disqualified at Toulouse on 31 October. Returns from a break but is capable of a minor role if fit enough
- 5. KRONOS DES LANDES** - Disqualified at Cherbourg on 1 March. Yet to win a race after 54 starts but is capable of making the frame
- 6. KLAXON DE REVILLE** - Battling to find best form and finished 8th in Class F at this course over 2550m on 22 February. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 7. KING GATE** - Unreliable and finished 10th in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 16 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 8. KRISTAL DU PALAIS** - In good form and was runner-up in Class D at Toulouse over 2750m on 27 February. Can go one place better
- 9. KOUROU LATIN** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Saint-Jean-de-Monts over 2625m on 13 July. Returns from a lengthy break and others are preferred
- 10. KANSAS QUICK** - Has struggled this year and finished 8th in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 26 February. Others make more appeal
- 11. KIKO DU VIGNAC** - Victorious in a Class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 15 January. Tackles tougher this time but is clearly not out of it
- 12. KSAR BLUE BOCAIN** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 19 December. More is needed to score
- 13. KAPORAL CARISAIE** - Successful in his last two starts, the latest in a Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2050m on 9 February. Can complete the hat-trick

Summary: KAPORAL CARISAIE (13) has struck form with some good wins and has every chance of turning that into a hat-trick. KRISTAL DU PALAIS (8) remains in good form and should fight out the finish once again. KRONOS DES LANDES (5) is long overdue for a first success and cannot be ruled out from scoring but is more likely to earn money. KWICK DU PASSAGE (3) is in good form and would not be a surprise winner over this track and trip.

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**C6 - PRIX DE LISIEUX - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR €
27,000**

- 1. MAGNUM DAIRPET** - In good form and was barefoot and runner-up in a Class B at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 14 February. Not barefoot this time but might play a minor role
- 2. MUST DU BELLAY** - Very consistent and was runner-up in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 February. Big chance in this line-up
- 3. MOODY DE VIVE** - Holding form and finished 4th in Class A at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 18 November. Could earn some money returning from a break
- 4. MY LOVE GIO** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 14 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 5. MAURICIEN** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest at Vincennes on 29 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. LORDIUS** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2850m on 30 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 7. L'AMIRAL DIGEO** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 8. LE GRAAL** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 19 February. Not easy to trust but can pop up in a place when in the right mood
- 9. MUSIKO CAUVELLIERE** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 31 December. Capable of better and is not out of it
- 10. MARIE OH FREDLAU** - In good shape and finished 4th in a Class A at Vincennes over 2175m on 21 December. Quite capable of making the frame once again
- 11. MARQUISE DE MAGNY** - Did not show her best when 6th in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 November. Returns from a break but is a threat if smart
- 12. LEZZO FIGHTER** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 February. Can be competitive once again
- 13. LOUSTIC DELAURIERE** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 December. Needs to do more to score

Summary: MUST DU BELLAY (2) is very consistent and should make a bold bid to win this race. LEZZO FIGHTER (12) is not as reliable as his rival but did run well at Vincennes and can be a lively danger in this line-up. MUSIKO CAUVELLIERE (9) is better than the last run would suggest and can challenge for top honours. MARQUISE DE MAGNY (11) returns from a break but can get involved with the finish if fit enough.

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C7 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DE MONFLANQUIN - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. ITONO DE MILLAC** - Much improved last run when runner-up in Class E at Auch over 2800m on 21 February. Could earn some money
- 2. KAISER CHANCE** - Disqualified at this track on 22 February. In good form before that and can be competitive in this line-up if smart
- 3. HOLD UP CRAZY** - Battling to find best form and was tenth in Class G at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 1 February. Others are preferred
- 4. JAVA DE CAPONET** - Not reliable but was 4th in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Quite capable of making the frame
- 5. ICARE D'ASNOIS** - Finished 11th in Class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 10 August. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 6. JUSTIN DE MARCAY** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 26 February. Capable of contesting the finish when in the right frame of mind
- 7. INO DE BRION** - Showed some improvement when 4th in Class E at Auch over 2800m on 21 February. Might play a minor role
- 8. JADE DE PAME** - In good shape and finished 4th in Class E at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 22 February. Has claims at scoring
- 9. INSTANT DU BOIS** - Has struggled and was 9th in Class E at Niort over 3575m on 18 May. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
- 10. KEY TO SUCCESS** - Did not show her best when 13th in Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 10 October. Could need this run returning from a break

Summary: An open race. JADE DE FAME (8) is consistent and is fit and ready for a big performance. JUSTIN DE MARCAY (6) is unreliable but could be a threat to these rivals if showing his best form. KAISER CHANCE (2) was in good form before a last-start disqualification and could bounce back with a victory. JAVA DE CAPONET (4) is unreliable but did not run too badly at Toulouse and could get into the mix of things once again.

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C8 - GRAND PRIX DYNAVENA - GRAND PRIX DES TROTTEURS - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 39,000

- 1. IDOLE DE BEYLEV** - Did not show her best when 8th in a mounted race over this course and distance on 26 December. Better in that discipline and others are preferred
- 2. KIRCIE DE GUEZ** - Not reliable and finished barefoot and 6th in a Group 2 mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 26 January 2025. Should need this run returning from a break
- 3. KASH DES CAILLONS** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 18 January. Can go one better
- 4. ILTON CASH** - Disqualified at Agen-Le Passage on 3 March. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame if smart
- 5. KANO** - Unreliable and finished 4th in Class B at Vincennes over 2100m on 22 January. Can earn some more money
- 6. IALKO JENILAT** - Victorious in a Class D at La Capelle over 2750m on 22 September. Consistent when barefoot but should need this run
- 7. INCROYABLE BLACK** - Has some fair form and finished 4th at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. Might play a minor role at very best
- 8. FILOU DE SITA** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class D at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 9 February. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 9. HOLD UP DU DIGEON** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class B mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m on 14 January. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 10. HELIOS SI** - Has improved of late and finished 3rd in a Group 3 at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 28 January. Should be right there at the finish
- 11. GAZ D'OCCAGNES** - Not reliable and finished 10th in Class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 February. Capable of earning some money when in the right mood
- 12. GALANT DE CAREL** - Off form and finished 11th in Class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 February. Needs to do more to score

Summary: A very competitive lucky last race. KASH DES CAILLONS (3) remains in very good form and has been unlucky not to win recently. He can go one better this time around. HELIOS SI (10) has shown improvement of late and was not disgraced in a Group 3 at Cagnes-sur-Mer in January and should be a real threat. HOLD UP DU DIGEON (9) looks likely to improve and can get involved with the finish. ILTON CASH (4) is unreliable but could make the frame.
