C1 - PRIX DE SIENNE - 2925m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 52,000

- 1. KERNO** - Likes this course and finished fourth in a class B over 2925m on 25 February. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 2. KONRAD DE CORDAY** - Consistent and was third in class B over this track and distance on 25 February. Remains barefoot and can earn more money
- 3. KAPORAL VISAIS** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class C over this course and distance on 3 February. Reverts to barefoot and might play a minor role
- 4. KRIS MARTIN** - Disqualified in a class B over this course and trip on 25 February. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. KOOL AND THE GANG** - Not disgraced when 5th in a class B over this track and trip on 17 February. Remains barefoot and can earn some money
- 6. KOMPANY VINCENT** - Disqualified in a class B over this course and distance on 26 February. Remains barefoot and is not out of it if smart this time
- 7. KINGSLAND DE SIMM** - Victorious in a class B over this track and trip on 25 February. Remains barefoot and can challenge for top honours again
- 8. KALENCIO FLAC** - In good form and was runner-up in a class B over this course and distance on 25 February. Should contest the finish
- 9. KROONER D'HERIPRE** - Has won his last three starts, the latest in a class D over this course and distance on 7 February.. Can add another win to his tally

Summary: KROONER D'HERIPRE (9) has impressed of late and has won his last three starts. They were over this course and distance and he will take some beating in this opening event. KINGSLAND DE SIMM (7) looked good when scoring over this track and trip and can be a lively danger. KALENCIO FLAC (8) remains in good form and should be competitive. KOMPANY VINCENT (6) is capable of making the frame when staying on the trot.

**C2 - PRIX DE SAINT-MALO - 2925m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
29,000**

1. **KAVALE DU CHOQUEL** - Only modest of late and was fifth in a class E over this track and trip on 10 February. On a long losing run and others are preferred
2. **KALAGA DU CADRAN** - Very consistent and was runner-up in a class D over this course and distance on 26 February. Can make the frame
3. **KING D'HERMES** - Disqualified in a class E at Nantes over 3000m on 21 February. Reverts to barefoot and did run well that day. Can make amends
4. **JAIKA DES FANES** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 25 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
5. **KHEOPS TURGOT** - Disqualified in a class D at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 25 January.. Unreliable but might play a minor role
6. **KASH SNIPER** - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2150m on 10 February. Not reliable and needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
7. **JEEK D'ACADIE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class D over this track and trip on 25 February. Could earn some minor money
8. **KIR NORMAND** - Not reliable and finished 9th in class E at this track over 2150m on 10 February. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
9. **KAMOUR** - Victorious in a class C at this track over 2150m on 21 January. Remains barefoot and has a good record without shoes so can follow up
10. **JELGA DU VIVIER** - Disqualified in class G at this track over 2925m on 17 February. Has major disqualification issues but can score when smart
11. **JAKABINO** - Disqualified in a class E at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 1 March. Unreliable and others make more appeal
12. **HAMYOT DE BOMO** - Only moderate of late and finished 7th in a class F over this course and distance on 10 February. Reverts to barefoot but needs to do more to score
13. **JOLI MEC D'AMOUR** - A winner of a class F at this track over 2700m on 17 February. Remains barefoot and has won his last four when barefoot. Consider

Summary: KAMOUR (9) has a good recent record when barefoot and can follow up on a good last win. KING D'HERMES (3) ran better than the disqualification shows last time out at Nantes and could make amends. JELGA DU VIVIER (10) is very hard to trust and has many recent faults. She does, however, have the ability to score when staying in stride. JOLI MEC D'AMOUR (13) has won his last four races when racing without shoes and is barefoot and ready to strike.

C3 - PRIX DE PISE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. JUNIOR DU VIVIER** - Unplaced in class E at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 13 February. Remains barefoot and can be competitive this distance
- 2. JAZZ LINOIS** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class F at this track over 2925m on 28 February. Hard to trust but could be the surprise package of the race
- 3. JEWEL SMILE** - Disqualified in a class D at Toulouse over 2750m on 27 February. Remains barefoot and can make the frame if showing his best form
- 4. JAVA DE ROUAISSE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 19 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. JAZZ BUROIS** - Did not shoe his best when 9th in a class F at this track over 2925m on 26 February. Reverts to barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 6. JAYZI DU BOURG** - Disqualified in class E mounted race at this track over 2925m on 17 February. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
- 7. JOG DE JAVIE** - Disqualified in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 February. Reverts to barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to win
- 8. JALON DU GOUTIER** - Has been struggling at this course and finished 9th in a claimer at this track over 2925m on 11 January. Needs major improvement to win
- 9. JADORE CERIZE** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a class E at Argentan over 2875m on 6 February. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish

Summary: JADORE CERIZE (9) has hit the crossbar a couple of times recently and can go one better this time around. JAZZ BUROIS (5) has an excellent recent strike rate when racing without shoes and can bounce back to score. JEWEL SMILE (3) faulted last time out at Toulouse but that run can safely be ignored and he is not out of it. JUNIOR DU VIVIER (1) is capable of better than his recent runs would suggest and could shine.

C4 - PRIX DES FRENCHY (PRIX DU JASMIN) - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. LAGON DES BROUETS** - Not reliable and finished 9th in class D at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 18 February. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset
- 2. LATINO PURA VIDA** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class E over this course and distance on 20 February. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- 3. LOMAC GEDE** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when fifth in a class E over this track and trip on 20 February. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
- 4. LUCIFER** - Unreliable and finished fourth in a class E over this track and trip on 20 February. Barefoot and capable of earning some money
- 5. L'AMIRAL DARLING** - Disqualified in class D over this course and distance on 3 February. Not easy to trust but can play a minor role
- 6. LEE ROCK BOND** - Disqualified in class D at this track over 2700m on 7 February. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 7. LANNISTER** - Remains in very good shape and was runner-up in a class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 16 February. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
- 8. LEKEVIN DESBOIS** - In good shape and was third in a class E over this track and trip on 20 February. Capable of winning a race of this nature
- 9. LAOS DE BANVILLE** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a class E at this track over 2925m on 26 February. Might play a minor role
- 10. LIVE ON** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Remains barefoot and has a place chance on best form
- 11. LUPIN DOUZOU** - Unreliable and finished fourth in class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 23 November. Returns from a break and others make more appeal

Summary: A very open looking race. LEKEVIN DESBOIS (8) has been consistent of late and gets a narrow vote to score. LANNISTER (7) remains in good form and has good form at this track so is sure to be a threat to these rivals. LATINO PURA VIDA (2) ran well over this course and distance last month but is not reliable. LIVE ON (10) faulted last time out at Marseille-Vivaux but is capable of contesting the finish when smart.

**C5 - PRIX DE LA CAPELLE - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
26,000**

- 1. LADY DRY** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class E over this track and trip on 28 February. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. LADY FLO DE MAX** - Has shown improvement of late and was 4th in class E over this course and distance on 28 February. Barefoot and can contest the finish again
- 3. LADY BLACK ROCHEL** - Victorious in Class E over this track and trip on 28 February. In good form and is quite capable of following up
- 4. LOVELY LA CHENAIE** - Disqualified in class E at this course over 2150m on 20 February. Victorious back in October but is not easy to trust
- 5. LILIBETH SMART** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class E at this course over 2150m on 3 March when barefoot. Not this time and needs to do more to score
- 6. LUXY BLUE** - Victorious in Class E over this course and distance on 12 February when barefoot. Has shown improvement and can contest the finish
- 7. LITTLE WING BLUES** - Disqualified in class D at this track over 2700m on 10 February. Hard to trust and others make much more appeal
- 8. LHOCIEMA** - Likes this track and was 3rd in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 20 February. Victorious in January and should be a real threat
- 9. LIOUBA JAMES** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in class E over this course and distance on 17 February. Victorious back in January and is capable of a surprise
- 10. LESLIE DE VANDEL** - Not reliable and was 6th in class E at this track over 2150m on 20 February. Has a place chance in this line up
- 11. LELLAMIKA** - In good shape and finished 4th in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 14 February. Can be competitive if smart
- 12. LA MOME** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class E at this track over 2150m on 3 March. On a long losing streak and others are preferred

Summary: LADY BLACK ROCHEL (3) seems back to her best and was a good winner over this track and trip last month. She can follow up if in the same mood. LHOCIEMA (8) clearly likes this course and is likely to be concerned with the finish once again. LADY FLO DE MAX (2) is barefoot for the very first time and is clearly not out of it. LELLAMIKA (11) remains in good form and is another that is capable of scoring.

- 1. NOLANN DES AGETS** - Has some fair form and was 3rd in class E over this course and distance on 17 February. Might play a minor role at best
- 2. NARKOS DU CHATAULT** - Not disgraced when 5th in class C over this track and distance on 25 February. Could play a minor role
- 3. NOMAN'S POINT** - Has won both his starts so far, the latest in Class D over this course and distance on 7 February. Can complete a hat-trick
- 4. NORIA DE BERTRANGE** - Only modest of late and was 6th in class C over this course and distance on 25 February. Victorious back in January but others are preferred
- 5. NALA DE SMARVES** - Unreliable but does run well when 3rd in class B over this track and trip on 12 February. Can make the frame
- 6. NASSANDRA** - Unbeaten in three starts, the latest in Class C over this course and distance on 25 February. Can remain undefeated
- 7. NICE TO SEE YOU** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in class B over this course and distance on 12 February. Can contest the finish

Summary: A small field but a very good race. NASSANDRA (6) has won all three of her starts so far and has looked good doing so. She can add that unbeaten run to four. NOMAN'S POINT (3) scored over the short distance on debut and followed up with a course and distance win so is clearly talented and must be respected. NICE TO SEE YOU (7) has improved of late and can contest the finish. NALA DE SMARVES (5) might need to do a bit more to beat those rivals but can make the frame.

**C7 - PRIX DE PADOUE - 2925m (a2m) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR
€ 12,000**

- 1. HEOL LORIETTES** - Off form and finished 11th in Class E over this track and trip on 3 March when barefoot. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. HACKER MESLOIS** - Showed some improvement when 5th in class F over this course and distance on 28 February. Remains barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
- 3. JOJO LAPIN** - Finished 7th in class E at this track over 2700m on 25 February. Victorious back in January and is barefoot. Has claims in this division
- 4. IL PRESIDENTE** - Victorious in this division at Montauban over 2400m on 23 February. Has shown improvement and is barefoot. Not out of it
- 5. HARFAN DES GRANGES** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class D over this track and trip on 28 February. Returns barefoot and can be a threat
- 6. HOMMAGE DE LARRE** - Not disgraced when 5th in class E over this track and trip on 3 March. Should be right there at the finish
- 7. FUN LOVER** - Disqualified in claimer at this course over 2700m on 17 February. Victorious before that and can bounce back to score
- 8. FUCHSIA DU RIB** - Only modest of late and was 7th in class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 February when barefoot. Capable of earning some money
- 9. GRIZMAN** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a claimer at this course over 2700m on 17 February. Capable of an upset on best form
- 10. HELENCIO** - Only modest of late and was 6th in a claimer at this track over 2700m on 17 February. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
- 11. GIVE ME CASH** - Unreliable and finished 8th in class B over this course and distance on 26 February. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 12. GIULIANO** - Disqualified in two of last three starts, including last time out in this division at this course over 2700m on 17 February when barefoot. Not this time and needs to improve to win
- 13. FRANKLIN PARK** - A faller last time out over this course and distance on 20 February. Battling to find best form and others are preferred

Summary: A very open looking claimer. JOJO LAPIN (3) was not disgraced at this track last month and is barefoot and ready to strike trying a claimer. FUN LOVER (7) faulted last time out but did win in this division before that and can bounce back to score. HOMMAGE DE LARRE (6) ran well enough over this course and distance earlier this month to have claims in this line-up. IL PRESIDENTE (4) did win at this level at Montauban and is another to consider.

C8 - PRIX DE VENISE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 8,000

1. FAKIR DE LARRE - Off form and was 9th in class E at this track over 2925m on 20 February. Returns barefoot but is on a long losing streak and others make more appeal

2. HIGH TECH ROC - Not reliable and was 8th in class D at this course over 2925m on 23 January. Remains barefoot and can make the frame

3. HEROIC DES BOSC - In good form and was 3rd in class E at this course over 2925m on 3 March. Better that distance but can beat these rivals

4. GAVROCHE DU GADE - Battling to find best form and was 7th at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. On a long losing streak and others are preferred

5. GAETAN - Consistent and was 3rd in class G at this track over 2925m on 17 February. Should be competitive yet again

6. HARING OKINA - Disqualified in class E at this track over 2925m on 20 February. Hard to trust but can contest the finish when smart

7. HELICE DU TREZON - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class E at this track over 2925m on 3 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

8. FIFTY WINNER - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class F at this course over 2925m on 28 February. Can earn some money when smart

Summary: A small field for this lucky last race and a lot of them have been out of sorts of late. HEROIC DES BOSC (3) is in good form. He is clearly better over further but should also beat these rivals over this track and trip. HARING OKINA (6) has major disqualification issues but can be a danger when staying in stride. GAETAN (5) is consistent and looks likely to fight out the finish once again. HIGH TECH ROC (2) is unreliable but could make the frame.
