

**C1 - PRIX FRANCE BLEU VAUCLUSE - 2525m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR €
6,000**

- 1. JORDANA** - Needed the only run of this year when 9th in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Fitter this time and can earn some money
- 2. IDOCTRO DE HOUELLE** - Finished 6th in a class F at Feurs over 2850m on 4 July. Returns from a lengthy break and could need this run
- 3. HISPANO DU REYNARD** - Returns from a break and finished 10th in a class G at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 25 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. IVANHOE RENKA** - Battling to find best form and finished 9th in a class G at this track over 2600m on 1 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 5. ITYA DE BOSSENS** - Needed the last run when 10th in a class H at Avignon over 2650m on 1 April. Fitter this time and has a place chance
- 6. INTEL** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class H at Paray-le-Monial over 2025m on 22 March. Capable of improvement and is not out of it
- 7. JINA FAST** - A barefoot winner of a class G at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 30 March. Not fully barefoot this time but can contest the finish
- 8. JUAN LES PINS** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 22 March. Remains barefoot and is capable of doing better. Can make the frame
- 9. JOKER DES CHAMPS** - Disqualified in a class G at this track over 2600m on 29 March. In very good form before that and can bounce back to score

Summary: JOKER DES CHAMPS (9) is clearly much better than his last run at this course last month. He can bounce back and win this opening race. INTEL (6) looks likely to improve and should be a threat in a race of this nature. JINA FAST (7) was a barefoot winner last time out and is not barefoot this time, but is not out of it. JUAN LES PINS (8) has not been at his best lately but could challenge for top honours.

C2 - PRIX REMY GONDOIN - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 29,000

- 1. DUBLIN FI** - Probably needed her comeback run when 7th in a class E harness race at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 22 March. Reverts to barefoot and could be a threat under the saddle
- 2. CORNELIA OP** - In good shape and was runner-up in a harness race at Bologne over 1660m on 12 March. Better in that discipline but can play a minor role at best
- 3. INVADER AM** - Successful in a harness claimer at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 15 March. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. JADE GERBEHAYE** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a class E harness race at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
- 5. JINGLE DES BROUETS** - In good form and finished third in a class E mounted race at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 26 February. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 6. IMPERIAL RYLD** - In good shape and was third in a harness race at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. Can earn some more money
- 7. IMPACTDARCHE** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class E harness race at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 25 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. HOLD UP NOCTURNE** - Battling to regain best form and finished 8th in a class E harness race at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 20 March. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 9. IF YOU CAN** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class D harness race at Avignon over 2675m on 1 April. Remains barefoot and has claims trying a mounted race
- 10. JOKER DU HAMEL** - Showed improvement when a runner-up in a class D mounted race at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2700m on 16 March. Reverts to barefoot and could end a long losing run

Summary: IF YOU CAN (9) has some good form in harness races. He looks the type that should be fine in this discipline, so gets the selection to score. DUBLIN FI (1) races without shoes this time, so an improved performance is very likely. JOKER DU HAMEL (10) is looking to end a long losing run and is barefoot and in good form, so must be respected in this line-up. JINGLE DES BROUETS (5) remains in good form and is not out of it either.

C3 - PRIX DE CAVAILLON - 2525m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. NAY MADRIK** - Disqualified on debut in a class F at Feurs over 2225m on 8 March. Highly regarded and should be smarter this time. Respect
- 2. NO LIMIT WELL** - Has not shown much so far and finished 8th in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 3. N'ATTENDS PERSONNE** - Disqualified in a class E at Saint-Galmier over 2025m on 18 March. Best judged on her good penultimate start and could score
- 4. NESMILLE ELEVEN** - Disqualified in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3025m on 13 March. Has only been modest so far and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. NANDY COOL** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Can make the frame
- 6. NABUCCO DES ARRIS** - Finished 7th in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Did win a race before that and has a place chance
- 7. NELSON DU DUDY** - A runner-up on debut in a class G at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 22 March. Capable of going one place better
- 8. NIZONNE** - Finished fth on debut in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Capable of improvement and can earn some money

Summary: A competitive-looking event. N'ATTENDS PERSONNE (3) fluffed her lines with a disqualification at Saint-Galmier last month. She did much better in her penultimate start, and it is on that basis she gets the narrow nod of approval. NELSON DU DUDY (7) showed promise on debut and can be a threat once again. NAY MADRIK (1) is highly regarded, so her disqualification on debut is probably best ignored. NANDY COOL (5) is improving and would not be a surprise winner.

C4 - PRIX DES CARRIERES DODET - 2525m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 19,500

1. **MALICE D'OCCAGNES** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 28 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
2. **MISAKI D'OURVILLE** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in a class E at Lyon La Soie over 2000m on 9 March. Remains barefoot and can go one better
3. **MAGELLAN FOR CLARA** - In good shape and finished third in a class E at Lyon La Soie over 2000m on 9 March. Can be competitive once again
4. **MISS MARGOT** - Yet to win a race but was fourth in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 20 March. Could earn some more minor money
5. **MALIDA** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and third in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 20 March. Remains barefoot and could contest the finish again
6. **MELODIE D'HOULBEC** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 20 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
7. **MUCHO CASH** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 20 March. Capable of making the frame
8. **MOGADOR BLEU** - Successful in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Not reliable but keeps the same shoeing and can double up
9. **MY LOVE PANAME** - Finished 6th in a class E at Lyon La Soie over 2000m on 9 March. Has disqualification issues but is capable of an upset on best form
10. **MAUZIN DE CROUAY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 13 March. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
11. **MUSE DE VANDEL** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 12 March. Needs to do a lot better to beat these rivals
12. **MAMZELLE CARLESS** - Disqualified in a class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 17 February. Yet to win a race but has a place chance o best form
13. **MOLLY DE VISAIS** - Finished 7th in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Not barefoot this time and others are preferred

Summary: MISAKI D'OURVILLE (2) has hit the crossbar a couple of times of late and can go one place better over this track and trip. MALIDA (5) showed some improvement when barefoot last time out and remains barefoot, so is a danger. MOGADOR BLEU (8) is not reliable but will have the same shoeing arrangement as when he won at Marseille-Borély, so must be respected for that. MUCHO CASH (7) is very unreliable but can score when in the right frame of mind.

C5 - PRIX AUGUSTE JOUVE - 2525m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. LEOPOLD** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 25 March. Has place chance in this line-up
- 2. LEI E BELLA** - A barefoot winner of a class D at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 18 February. Remains without shoes and can double up
- 3. LEADER DES RIOULTS** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 25 March. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role at very best
- 4. LAURELINA** - Victorious in her last two starts, the latest in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 25 March. Remains barefoot and can complete her treble
- 5. LE REVE D'OLMEN** - Disqualified in a class D at Caen over 2450m on 19 March. Remains barefoot but is battling to find best form. Others make more appeal
- 6. LIZZY DE JOUDES** - Disqualified in a class D at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 9 March. Remains barefoot but is on a long losing run. Can contest the finish when smart
- 7. LE MAGICIEN** - Much improved this year and was runner-up in a class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 19 February. Should fight out the finish

Summary: LAURELINA (4) has struck a purple patch of form and has two impressive wins in this region. She should complete her hat-trick. LE MAGICIEN (7) has shown improvement this year and looks likely to fight out the finish once again, clearly the main danger. LEI E BELLA (2) was a barefoot winner last time out. She remains racing without shoes, but this is a tougher task for her. LIZZY DE JOUDES (6) is on a long losing run but can make the frame when in form.

C6 - PRIX DU CREDIT MUTUEL DE CAVAILLON - 2525m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 33,000

1. **HYDROMEL** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class C at Toulouse over 2750m on 3 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
2. **GALOPIN DES CHAMPS** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 February. Others make more appeal
3. **JOIE DE LA COTE** - Consistent of late and finished third in a class C mounted race at Enghien over 2250m on 24 March. Remains barefoot and can be a threat once again
4. **INSTRUCTOR** - Showed some improvement when 6th in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and could get into the mix of things
5. **GRIGRI DU BONHEUR** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 8 March. Needs major improvement to score
6. **GAVROCHE DE L'ITON** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class A at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 30 November. Remains barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
7. **FULGURER** - Disqualified in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 13 March. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
8. **GAUDI TIT** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 13 March. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
9. **HIVER D'AUTHISE** - Off form and finished 8th in a class E at this track over 2600m on 29 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
10. **IDYLLE DU PERSIL** - Finished 6th in a class D at Saint-Galmier over 2000m on 18 March. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
11. **JUDOPOCK** - Needed his only run of this year when 8th in a class E at Reims over 2550m on 19 March. Might need another run in two
12. **ILICO DE CASTELLE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at this track over 2600m on 29 March. Others are preferred
13. **HELMA DE BUSSET** - In good form and was runner-up in a class D at Saint-Galmier over 2000m on 18 March. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
14. **HARMONIE DE SITA** - Needed her last run when 8th in a class E at Challans over 2900m on 22 March. Does well with this shoeing and can bounce back to score
15. **JEDI DES BROUETS** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 16 February. More is needed to win this race

Summary: HARMONIE DE SITA (14) starts in a tricky behind-the-cart position but will strip fitter this time around. She also has a good record with this particular shoeing arrangement, so gets the vote to score. HELMA DE BUSSET (13) has been very competitive of late and will not go down easily. JOIE DE LA COTE (3) remains in good shape and would not be a surprise winner. INSTRUCTOR (4) showed improvement last time out and could have more to offer.

C7 - PRIX OURASI LA LEGENDE - 2525m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. KISMET** - Victorious in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Remains barefoot and could double up
- 2. KISS ME** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class G at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 30 March. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
- 3. JONAGOLD** - Has struggled this year and was unplaced in a class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 26 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. JAGUAR DU BOCAGE** - In good form and was runner-up in a class E at this track over 2600m on 29 March. Not fully barefoot this time but can play a minor role
- 5. KHEOPS TURGOT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 March. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. KILGORE** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 24 October. Did win his penultimate start and is not out of it
- 7. ETRANGER JOYEUSE** - Returned to form and finished third in a class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 8 March. Has claims in this line-up
- 8. JEEK D'ACADIE** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class G at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 9. DINGO (ITY)** - A winner at Turin over 2060m on 18 March. Consistent but does need to find a few lengths to beat these rivals over this distance
- 10. KASH D'URZY** - Unplaced in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Unreliable and others make more appeal
- 11. DEVIL OP** - In good shape and was runner-up in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 10 February. Has a place chance on best form
- 12. KHAN D'HERIPRE** - Has improved of late and was third in a class F at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Capable of earning some more money
- 13. ESEDOMANI** - Successful in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 February. In very good form and looks capable of following up
- 14. KOLIBRI** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: A very open-looking race. ETRANGER JOYEUSE (7) returned to form with a good performance at Cagnes-sur-Mer and gets a narrow vote to score. ESEDOMANI (13) has been very good of late and is coming off a solid win at Vincennes, so should be a real threat to these rivals. KISMET (1) remains barefoot and will be competitive over this course and distance. KILGORE (6) is better judged on his penultimate start victory and is another that must be respected.

C8 - PRIX DOMINIQUE ARRIU - 2525m (a1m1/2) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 51,000

- 1. GIBUS** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 21 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
 - 2. INSTRUMENTALISTE** - Needed his last run when 10th in a class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 March. Fitter this time and could be a threat
 - 3. INATO PIERJI** - Usually competitive and was third in a Group 3 at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 October. Returns from a break but has claims if fit enough
 - 4. INDUS VAL** - In good form this year and was runner-up in a class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 8 March. Can go one place better
 - 5. FOSTER WOOD** - Needed his last run when unplaced in a class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 March. Reverts to barefoot and can make the frame
 - 6. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Group 3 at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 25 March. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset
 - 7. HARRY CARISAIE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class A at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
 - 8. FLOREAL** - Disqualified in a Group 3 at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 20 February. Remains barefoot but is battling to find best form and others make more appeal
 - 9. GOLDEN VISAIS** - Much improved when a runner-up in a class C at Lyon La Soie over 2050m on 9 March. Could earn some more money
 - 10. GAZ D'OCCAGNES** - Not reliable and finished fifth in a class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
 - 11. HAMONET DE CHOISEL** - Knocking loudly at the door and was runner-up in a class B mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
 - 12. FEMTO DE VAUVERT** - Disqualified in a class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 8 March. Unreliable but is capable of popping up in a place when in the right mood
 - 13. GALANT DE CAREL** - Off form and finished 8th in a class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- Summary:** A very open-looking lucky last race. INDUS VAL (4) gets a narrow vote to score after a good runner-up performance at Cagnes-sur-Mer. HAMONET DE CHOISEL (11) has hit the crossbar a couple of times of late and can go one place better this time around. INATO PIERJI (3) returns from a break but is consistent and also quite capable of winning. FOSTER WOOD (5) is fitter for this, is barefoot, and ready to strike.
