

C1 - PRIX BAVARIA - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- 1. JOUTEUR D'AUGE** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in a Class E at Laval over 2850m on 28 March. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
- 2. KINO DAB** - Successful in a Class F at Chartres over 2825m on 15 March. Much improved this year and can double up
- 3. ILLICO DES BROUETS** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 16 March. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 4. KOWEIT DE CHENU** - Has won twice in last three starts, including in a Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 March. Can contest the finish once again
- 5. HERMES DU LEARD** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 16 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 6. INCOGNITO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Caen on 19 March. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 7. KLARCK DE VANDEL** - A runner-up in three claimers of late, the latest at Vincennes over 2100m on 27 January. Should contest the finish
- 8. HE STAR DU CALICE** - Disqualified at Rouen -Mauquenchy on 16 March in his only start of this year. Fitter this time and is capable of an upset
- 9. KABALVA** - Unreliable but finished 4th in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 17 March. Remains without shoes and can make the frame
- 10. JAVA DES AUGERIES** - Disqualified at Caen on 25 March. Only fair form this year and needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals

Summary: KINO DAB (2) has improved of late and was a good winner at Chartres last month. She can win this opening event after that confidence-boosting victory. KOWEIT DE CHENU (4) is in very good form and should challenge for top honours once again. KLARCK DE VANDEL (7) clearly likes the runner-up spot and can contest the finish. KABALVA (9) is unreliable but is also clearly not out of it over this course and distance.

C2 - PRIX ALBIREO - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 37,000

- 1. LEADER DE CERISY** - Battling to find best form and finished 6th in a Class F at Bihorel-lès-Rouen over 3575m on 15 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 2. LIFE IS BEAUTIFUL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Meslay-du-Maine on 17 March. Ran better than the disqualification shows that day and can bounce back to score
- 3. LINKIA DES APRES** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E at Laval over 2650m on 5 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 4. LIANE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 24 March. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 5. LOTTA SUEDOISE** - Disqualified at Graignes on 15 March. Does have disqualifications but is also capable of scoring when she is in the right mood
- 6. LEONARDO TURGOT** - In good shape and finished 3rd in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Capable of earning some more money
- 7. LOUKY DE BAULON** - Much improved of late and was runner-up in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Should contest the finish
- 8. LUCIA DE LA CRIERE** - Did not show her best when 8th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 27 February. Consistent before that and can be competitive in this line-up
- 9. LION DU HOULBET** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Saumur on 29 March. He is quite capable of scoring when staying in stride
- 10. LUCKY DE CALVI** - On a long losing run and finished 6th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 21 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 11. LE CHEF** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 2 March. Might need to do more than that to beat these rivals
- 12. LARA VRIE** - Consistent this year and finished 4th in a Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 17 March. Can make the frame yet again
- 13. LUXURY DU DOUAROU** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class F at Saumur over 3250m on 29 March. Can be a threat in this line-up

Summary: LIFE IS BEAUTIFUL (2) is not easy to trust, as she does have disqualification issues. She ran better than her recent disqualification suggests and could bounce back to score. LION DU HOULBET (9) is even harder to trust, having four disqualifications in a row. He can contest the finish if staying on the trot. LOUKY DE BAULON (7) has shown some improvement of late and has claims for victory. LUCIA DE LA CRIERE (8) was consistent before a disappointing last run and is another to consider.

C3 - PRIX AETHRA - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 49,000

1. **KOUSINE MAJYC** - Successful in her last three starts, the latest in a Class F mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 16 March. Can win a fourth time
2. **JUSQUIAME** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a Class E mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. More is needed to score
3. **KHEOPS DORE** - Victorious in his last three starts, the latest in a Class D mounted race at this track over 2700m on 31 December. Returns from a break but is not out of it
4. **KALIMERO JASMA** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E mounted race at this track over 2700m on 21 March. Barefoot this time and could contest the finish
5. **KASBAH PERRINE** - Only moderate of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 16 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
6. **KENNEDY STREET** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a Class E harness race at this track over 2100m on 21 March. Tries a mounted race and others make more appeal
7. **JAZZMAN** - Finished 8th in a Class E at this track over 2100m on 21 March. Capable of improvement trying a mounted race for Eric Raffin
8. **KWARTZ SIBEY** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
9. **KAHIA DE LA CROIX** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track on 21 March. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
10. **KIR NORMAND** - Unreliable and was runner-up in a Class E harness race at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 31 March. Can be a threat back under the saddle

Summary: KOUSINE MAJYC (1) has been solid in all three of her recent victories. She should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. JAZZMAN (7) is unreliable but looks the type that could shine brightly in this discipline, so is a lively danger. KALIMERO JASMA (4) races barefoot this time around and can get into the mix. KIR NORMAND (10) can go one place better back in a mounted race and must be respected.

C4 - PRIX DOROPHEA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

1. **MALVINA MADRIK** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class B at this track over 2175m on 8 November. Could need this run returning from a break
2. **MOON STAR FOR YOU** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class A at this track over 2700m on 17 October. Returns from a break and should need this run
3. **MAHIZ DE GUEZ** - Disqualified at this track on 20 March. Was barefoot and runner-up before that and is barefoot and ready to strike if staying in stride
4. **MY HAPPY STORY** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class C at this track over 2100m on 20 March. Might play a minor role at very best
5. **MANHATTAN FRANCE** - Consistent of late and was runner-up in a Class B at this track over 2700m on 22 February. Keeps that shoeing and is clearly not out of it
6. **MEGAFLECHE** - Successful in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. Remains in good shape and could follow up
7. **MARIE DI LEONE** - Not reliable and finished 12th in a Class A at this track over 2700m on 21 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
8. **MISSLADY DU VICLAU** - Holding form and finished 4th in a Class B at this track over 2850m on 22 February. Can play a minor role
9. **MYSTERY QUEEN** - Has improved of late and finished 3rd in a Class C at this track over 2100m on 20 March. Remains without shoes and can earn some more money
10. **MARVINA BELLA** - Disqualified at this track on 28 February. Not reliable but is quite capable of contesting the finish when smart
11. **MASAI MARA** - Victorious in a Class C at this course over 2100m on 28 February. Continues to improve and can score over this longer distance
12. **MY DARLING DU RIS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class A at this track over 2700m on 21 March. Barefoot this time and should contest the finish

Summary: MASAI MARA (11) has been very good over the shorter distance at this track of late. She has also won over this track and trip and gets a solid vote to score. MY DARLING DU RIS (12) races barefoot, so expect a much better performance from her. MARVINA BELLA (10) has been unreliable and arrives for this after a disqualification but is a threat if staying on the trot. MYSTERY QUEEN (9) has improved of late, is also barefoot, and looks ready to strike.

C5 - PRIX PROSERPINA - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. NEOH DAIRPET** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 23 March. Has disqualification issues and others are much preferred
- 2. NOTEBOOK** - Successful in a Class F at Laval over 2850m on 5 March. Improving and can contest the finish once again
- 3. NEAL DU VIVIER** - Has ability and was runner-up in a Class E at Lisieux over 2725m on 14 March. Can fight out the finish once again
- 4. NEW YORK D'OYSE** - Not reliable and finished 4th in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 5. NIMEO FLOWER** - Has some fair form and finished 3rd in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 3 March. Yet to win but can play a minor role
- 6. NEVERS** - Unbeaten in two starts, the latest in a Class E at Lisieux over 2725m on 14 March, Looks capable of completing a hat-trick
- 7. NEMO DE BEYLEV** - Victorious in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2225m on 16 March. Disqualified before that but can be a threat if staying in stride

Summary: A small field but a very interesting race. NEVERS (6) has won both starts so far and has every chance of completing the hat-trick. NEAL DU VIVIER (3) chased home that rival last time out at Lisieux and could do so again. NOTEBOOK (2) is improving and picked up a win at Laval, so must be respected for that. NEMO DE BEYLEV (7) put a disqualification behind him when scoring last time out and can also be a threat if in the right mood.

C6 - PRIX COELESTINA - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MICHIGAN** - Successful in a Class E mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 26 February. Remains barefoot and can double up
- 2. MISTRAL DE CERISY** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class E harness race at Caen over 2450m on 25 March. Does better under the saddle and has claims in this line-up
- 3. MID DANCER** - Yet to win a race but finished 5th in a Class C mounted race at this track over 2175m on 25 February. Capable of earning some money
- 4. MAXOU DIGEO** - Disqualified at this track on 27 March. Barefoot this time around and should fight out the finish if smart
- 5. MAGUEN DAIRPET** - Not reliable and finished 12th in a Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 2 April. Does better in mounted races and has a place chance
- 6. MAGYC BERRY** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a Class C mounted race at this course over 2175m on 25 February. More is needed to score
- 7. MITCH DE GRANOU** - Disqualified at this track on 27 March. Yet to win a race but is capable of contesting the finish when staying in stride
- 8. MAURICIO DU DERBY** - Needed the last run when 7th in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 24 March. Could be the surprise package of the race, fitter this time
- 9. MYTIC RENARDIER** - Disqualified at Enghien on 24 March. In good form before that and can make the frame if staying in stride

Summary: MITCH DE GRANOU (7) is coming off a disqualification at this course and has yet to win a race, but can win a race of this nature. MAXOU DIGEO (4) also faulted last time out at this track but is barefoot and capable of striking. MICHIGAN (1) won nicely at Laval and is capable of following up with further success. MISTRAL DE CERISY (2) does better in mounted races but can still get involved in the finish.

C7 - PRIX PALMA - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

1. **NEBULA DANICA** - Has improved this year and finished fourth in a Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 30 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
2. **NONOLETA** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class D over this course and distance on 20 March. Might play a minor role at very best
3. **NIKITA DES ARRIS** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class D over this course and distance on 20 March. Capable of making the frame
4. **NOUMEA D'AMOUR** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a Class D at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 25 March. Might play a minor role
5. **NOBLESSE** - Victorious in a Class F at Caen over 2450m on 19 March. Has disqualification issues but keeps that shoeing and is not out of it
6. **NEW YORK CITY** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class E at Laval over 2850m on 28 March. Can contest the finish once again
7. **NOUNASSIMA** - Has run well in both her starts and finished 3rd in a Class D over this track and trip on 20 March. Clearly not out of it
8. **NIKKI BEACH JISCE** - Returned from a break and was a winner of a Class F at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. Keeps that shoeing and can double up
9. **NOUMEA COCONUT** - Returned to form and finished 4th in a Class D at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 25 March. Could earn some more money
10. **NUIT D'IVRESSE JAF** - Returned from a break and finished 5th in a Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 10 March. Fitter this time and has a place chance
11. **NEUILLY** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Group 3 race at this track over 2700m on 21 March. Capable of an upset
12. **NUBA DE PERVENCHE** - Victorious in a Class D at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 25 March. Improving and is capable of doubling up
13. **NANCY DE GOUYE** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a claimer at Bihorel-lès-Rouen over 2500m on 8 March. Tougher task this time around

Summary: NIKKI BEACH JISCE (8) was a good winner at Laval when returning from a break. She should be fitter this time and can double up while keeping the same shoes. NOBLESSE (5) is not easy to trust but arrives here after a victory at Caen and is a danger when in the right mood. NEW YORK CITY (6) remains in good shape and is clearly not out of it. NIKITA DES ARRIS (3) has not been reliable but is capable of getting into the mix.

C8 - PRIX ADRIA - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- 1. NAME IS DAIRPET** - A three-year-old colt by Feliciano out of Eragonne Maybe wh is making his debut. His mother won once in 34 starts. Could need this experience
- 2. NORTH OF GOLD** - Disqualified on debut in a harness race at Le Croisé-Laroche on 23 March. Tries a mounted race and could improve
- 3. NOBI BAROSSO** - Disqualified twice in three starts, including last time out at Caen on 30 March. Can earn some money when staying in stride
- 4. NIRVANA SPIRIT** - Victorious on debut in a Class F mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 19 March. Was a solid winner and can follow up
- 5. NINO VERO** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2250m on 6 March. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 6. NIKOS** - Victorious on debut in a Class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 30 March. Looked good that day and could double up
- 7. NEMO DU VARLET** - Finished 10th in a Class C harness race at this track over 2700m on 31 March. Capable of improvement first time under the saddle but others make more appeal
- 8. NOCARIO JEEP** - Finished 6th in a Class C mounted race at this track over 2700m on 31 March. Did better on debut and can contest the finish

Summary: NIKOS (6) showed promise when winning on debut at Caen, and his time was much quicker than that of his rival in this race, NIRVANA SPIRIT (4), who won on the same day. NIKOS (6) sets a decent standard for this lucky last race and should score. NOCARIO JEEP (8) is best judged on his good debut and could be a threat. NIRVANA SPIRIT (4) did all that was asked on debut and can contest the finish. NINO VERO (5) has been unreliable so far but can make the frame.
