C1 - PRIX DE HYERES - 3000m (a2m) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- **1. L'AMERICAIN -** Disqualified in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. In poor form and is on a long losing streak
- **2. LIGNE BLANCHE -** Finished 6th in class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 18 April. In good form before that and has a place chance
- **3. LE REVE D'OLMEN -** Victorious in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 28 March. In good form and is capable of following up
- **4. LUEGO CONTIGO -** Victorious in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 March. Improving and should fight out the finish
- **5. LE CARAT D'AS -** Finished 5th in class C at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 20 April. Remains barefoot but is on a long losing streak. Others preferred
- **6. LILY ROSE -** Disqualified in class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 18 April. Unreliable and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **7. LET ME SIXTY ONE -** Finished 5th in class C at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 25 April. Probably needs to find a few lengths to win
- **8. LUPIN D'OLMEN -** Victorious in Class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 10 August. On a impressive winning streak and has a chance if fit from a break
- **9. LIZZY DE JOUDES -** Very consistent of late and was third in class C at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 25 April. Can be competitive yet again
- **10. LEVRETTE** Disqualified in class C at Feurs over 2850m on 7 April. Has disqualification issues but is capable of contesting the finish when wise
- **11. LUCIFERMORNINGSTAR** Yet to win a race but was third in a Group 3 at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 13 February. Capable of an upset returning from a short break

Summary: LE REVE D'OLMEN (3) has won two of his four starts, including last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer. He remains barefoot returning from a break and can win again. LUEGO CONTIGO (4) is improving and won well over this track and trip in March. LUPIN D'OLMEN (8) is clearly talented but has not been seen since August last year. LEVRETTE (10) has disqualification issues, but she is also capable of contesting the finish when she is in the right mood.

- **2. JAZZISSIME -** Has struck form with two solid wins of late, the latest in a Class E mounted race at this track over 2400m on 18 April. Can complete the hat-trick
- **3. JUST PAT -** On a very long losing run and finished 5th in a Class E mounted race at this track over 2400m on 18 April. Has a place chance in this line-up.
- **4. IVAN D'URZY -** Kept to harness races and was 5th in Class F over this track and trip on 18 April. Could be the surprise package of the race trying a mounted race
- **5. GIOS DAIRPET -** Has struggled of late and finished 11th in a Class D harness race at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 20 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. FOREVER STONE -** Has struggled of late and was 8th in a Class F harness race at this track over 2300m on 30 April. Unreliable but can pop up in a place when in the mood.
- **7. JUMANJI SIBEY -** In very good shape and was runner-up last time out in a Class F harness race at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Tries a mounted race but can score.

Summary: JAZZISSIME (2) has struck a purple patch of form and was good in his last two wins. He remains barefoot and is likely to complete the hat-trick. JUMANJI SIBEY (7) has been very competitive of late in harness races and can go one better when trying a mounted race. JAGERSRO (1) returned to form with a good run just the other day and is usually very competitive, so deserves respect. IVAN D'URZY (4) has won a harness race over this track and trip, so could be a threat when trying this discipline.

- **2. JOIE DE LA COTE -** Victorious in Class C at Castillonnes over 2450m on 20 April. Unreliable but is capable of following up if in the same mood
- **3. HOLD UP NOCTURNE** In good shape and was fouth in class F at this track over 3000m on 18 April. Could play a minor role at best
- **4. HASPARREN -** Finished 15th in class F at this track3000m on 18 April. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. JOCONDE TURGOT -** Victorious in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Remains barefoot and can complete a hat-trick
- **6. GIZMOGOLD -** Victorious in Class E at over this track and trip on 16 April. Unreliable but is clearly not out of it in this line-up
- **7. MAGGIORE (SWE) -** Much improved of late and was third in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 11 April. Remains barefoot and can make the frame

IDEAL GREEN (1) is in good form and can be competitive yet again. JOIE DE LA COTE (2) is not reliable but won over a similar distance last time out and is not out of it. GIZMOGOLD (6) won over this track and trip last time out and would not be a surprise winner.

- **2. GARDON -** In good form of late and was runner-up in Class B at Vincennes over 2850m on 30 January. Remains barefoot and has a winning chance
- **3. FALCO FUN -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 19 April. Fitter and barefoot this time so can contest the finish if wise
- **4. GOLIATH DU CAUX -** Disqualified last time out at Hyeres on 1 May. Clearly unreliable but is capable of an upset on best form
- **5. GIVE ME -** Showed improvement when 5th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 April. Can be very competitive in this line-up
- **6. FRONSAC -** Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class B at Cavaillon over 2525m on 8 April. Needs major improvement to win
- **7. FANFARONNEUR -** Showed vast improvement when 5th in Class C at Toulouse over 2950m on 4 April. Might play a minor role
- **8. ILAYA -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 19 April. Clearly capable of getting in to the mix of things when in the mood
- **9. GORDON FLASH -** Has shown improvement of late and was runner-up in a claimer at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 10 April. Might play a minor role
- **10. FINGER DES BORDES -** Has really struggled of late and finished 11th in a claimer at Vincennes on 29 April. Needs major improvement to win
- **11. EVAN PAULO -** Very unreliable and was 7th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 April. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- **12. GEGE BAROQUE -** Has struggled this year and was tenth in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 20 April. Capable of better but others are preferred

Summary: HARMONY DU RABUTIN (1) remains at the top of her game and only found one better on the day last time out at Vincennes. She should make a bold bid to beat these rivals. - **2. KERCHAK -** Finished 9th in class E at Feurs over 2100m on 7 April. Unreliable and is on a long losing streak. Others are preferred
- **3. KAICHA -** Finished 6th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 8 April. Probably needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **4. KASH D'URZY -** Disappointing last run when 9th in class E at Nimes over 2750m on 27 April. Victorious on two occasions in February and can bounce back to score
- **5. KARTA KING -** Disqualified in class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 20 April. In good form before that and is not out of it if wise
- **6. KERNEL DE NUIT -** Victorious in Class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May when barefoot. Remains in good form and can contest the finish
- **7. KISS THE MOON -** Has some fair form and was 5th in class D at this course over 3000m on 30 April. Victorious back in January and is capable of an upset
- **8. KEBBIE -** Victorious in Class E over this track and trip on 21 March when barefoot. Has shown improvement and is not out of it
- **9. KLEPPER DU LOIR -** Disqualified in class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- **10. KASIMODO** Disqualified in class F at Oraison over 2650m on 6 April. Has disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- **11. KATMAI -** Finishd fourth in class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 4 April. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- **12. KRISTAL VICTORY -** Only modest of late and was 6th in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 20 April. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- **13. KAPOOR D'OLMEN -** Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 3 September. Won twice in a row before that and can be a real threat if wise

- **2. HIBERNATO -** Unreliable and finished 15th last time out in Class E at this track over 3000m on 13 April. Capable of a surprise over this shorter distance
- **3. IL MIO -** Has struggled of late and was 12th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 8 February. Returns from a short break and could need this run
- **4. JOYEUSE MAB -** Very consistent this year and was runner-up last time out in Class E at this track over 2400m on 25 April. Should be right there at the finish again
- **5. GREAT KOOL** A winner of two of his last three starts, including last time out in Class G over this course and distance on 7 September. Returns from a break but is not out of it
- **6. JEEP DES CHARRONS -** Only fair of late and finished 5th in Class F over this track and trip on 16 April. Can play a minor role in this line-up
- **7. HEY YOU -** Showed some improvement and was 5th in Class E at Nîmes over 2750m on 27 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race
- **8. ISA MAUVE -** Returned to form with a Class F win over this track and trip on 16 April. Knows how to win and can follow up.
- **9. JOE TEJY -** Returned to form and was runner-up in Class F at Hyères over 2650m on 1 May. Capable of getting involved in the finish once again
- **10. HANNIBAL CARNOIS -** Finished 10th last time out in Class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 6 April. Capable of earning some minor money when wise

Summary: A very open-looking event. ISA MAUVE (8) has had a very good year so far, winning four times including last time over this course and distance. She will not go down easily. JOE TEJY (9) bounced back to form at Hyères and may well go one better this time. JOYEUSE MAB (4) has not won for some time but is very consistent and should fight out the finish. She showed some improvement last time out and could make the frame.

- **2. MOON TURGOT -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 25 April. Better over this distance and can bounce back to score if smart this time around
- **3. MADISON DE NIMES -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at this track over 2400m on 25 April. Won on debut and is capable of making the frame
- **4. MACLAREN D'ALESA -** Won nicely on debut at this track last year but has been disqualified in both starts this year, the latest at this course on 25 April. Can surprise if wise
- **5. MALAGA D'ATOUT** Disqualified last time out at this course on 25 April. Did very well over shorter distances in her first two starts and would not be a surprise winner trying further.
- **6. MAEVA DE COQUERIE -** Won nicely on debut at this track last year but has been disqualified in both starts this year, the latest at this course on 25 April. Can surprise if wise
- **7. MEMPHIS ROCK -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class D over this course and distance on 18 April. Should be very competitive in this line-up
- **8. MACARENA D'HOULBEC -** Unreliable and finished 10th last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 30 April. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **9. MAFALA -** Disqualified in both her starts so far, the latest being at Hyères. Probably best watched until improvement is shown

Summary: MACLAREN D'ALESA (4) looked good when scoring on debut last year. He has had some disqualifications this year but could be ready to put that behind him with David Bekaert driving. MALAGA D'ATOUT (5) let her supporters down when faulting last time at this track but had been threatening to win and is not out of it. MOON TURGOT (2) also fluffed her lines at this track and is capable of being a threat if wise. MINOS DE BERLES (1) is unreliable but can also get involved in the finish.

- **2. INO DE BREVOL -** Battling to find his best form and was unplaced last time out in a claimer at Saint-Galmier over 2675m on 24 November. Likely to need this run returning from a break.
- **3. ILE DE FADA -** Very consistent this year and finished third in Class G at Cavaillon over 2575m on 8 April. Big chance in this line-up
- **4. GRANDIOSO -** Disqualified last time out at Cavaillon on 26 April. Has been struggling for some time now and needs major improvement to win
- **5. HATOUT DE CONNEE -** Disappointing in his last two runs and was 10th last time out in Class F at Hyères over 2650m on 1 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. HARMONICA -** Finished 6th last time out in a Class E mounted race at Cavaillon over 2600m on 8 April. Can do better back in a harness race and is not out of it
- **7. GAETAN -** Has been consistent of late and finished fourth last time out in Class F at this track over 2300m on 16 April. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **8. FEELING MESLOIS -** Did not show his best when 8th in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 21 April. Was in good form before that and has a winning chance
