C1 - PRIX ASSOCIATION CASSANDRA - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LEADER STREET** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a Class F mounted race at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 25 May. Might play a minor role
- 2. LEDA SAINT LATUIN** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class F mounted race at Rambouillet over 2800m on 14 May. Can complete the treble
- 3. LATINO ELDE** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class F mounted race at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 30 April. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- 4. L'AMI PRODIGIEUX** - Successful in a Class F mounted race at Tours over 2825m on 10 May. Very unreliable but has a place chance at very best
- 5. KAMOVA DU RILER** - Unplaced in a Class G at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 November. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 6. LOVE ET CASH RENKA** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class F at Caen over 2450m on 27 May. Can be competitive once again
- 7. LAGON D'ORIENT** - Victorious in a Class F mounted race at Amiens over 2400m on 16 May. Not easy to trust but is capable of doubling up
- 8. KEILA DU PERCHE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a claimer at Bernay over 2800m on 18 May. Others are much preferred
- 9. LUCAS DE TOURNAI** - Disqualified at Dozule over on 14 May. Not easy to trust and needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 10. LEON DU CLOS** - Disqualified last time out at Vire over 2800m on 18 May. In good form before that and can contest the finish if smart
- 11. LEONARD DU CLOS** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 24 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 12. LAURO FLIGNY** - Did not show his best when 6th in a Class E at Vire over 2825m on 18 May. Capable of better and can make the frame
- 13. LOU DES COUPERIES** - A winner of a Class E at Argentan over 2900m on 11 May. Has improved of late and could follow up if in the same mood

Summary: LOU DES COUPERIES (13) impressed when scoring in style last month and has been kept fresh for this assignment. A repeat of that effort could see her follow up. LAURO FLIGNY (12) commands respect after winning on his sole start with H el ene Godey. LOVE ET CASH RENKA (6) shaped well when third on his mounted debut and remains open to improvement. Entrusted to Mathieu Mottier, LEON DU CLOS (10) is another one to consider.

**C2 - PRIX DEMENAGEMENT AUGUSTE PONT L'EVEQUE - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR
€ 26,000**

- 1. NENA NINETY NINE** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class D at Caen over 2450m on 30 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 2. NORMANDY DANCER** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class F at over this track and trip on 17 May. Tougher task this time but might earn some money
- 3. NOBLE SUPREME** - Disqualified last time out at at Enghien over 2875m on 18 April. Has ability and could fight out the finish if smart
- 4. NEPTUNE DES ARRIS** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 13 February. Unreliable and is likely to neEd thls run returning from a break
- 5. NELSON DU RIB** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 23 May. Had some fair form before that and could play a minor role
- 6. NOUBA DU CABARET** - Successful in a Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Improving and is not out of it in this line-up
- 7. NINJA DU PLESSIS** - Disqualified twice in just four starts, including last time out at Vincennes on 22 May. Can be a threat if staying in stride
- 8. NASH DU CAMPUS** - Unbeaten in two starts, the latest in a Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Capable of completing the hat-trick

Summary: NASH DU CAMPUS (8) has made a highly promising start to his career and remains unbeaten after two outings. Well regarded by connections, he can complete the hat-trick. The chief threat may come from NOBLE SUPREME (3), who still has plenty of scope for improvement and returns to the scene of his sole victory with the benefit of a freshening break. NINJA DU PLESSIS (7) has shown ability in his early starts and looks capable of making the frame. NOUBA DU CABARET (6) continues to progress and also warrants consideration.

**C3 - PRIX LA CIVETTE SAINT MARTIN DE LA LIEUE - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR €
23,000**

- 1. MINDIE DES PRES** - Disqualified at Chatelaillon-La Rochelle on 10 May. Has major disqualification issues and is probably best watched for now
- 2. MINYA KONKA** - Showed some improvement and was runner-up in a Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 3. MAYA DE KACY** - Unreliable and finished 3rd in a Class E at Vire over 2700m on 18 May. Has done well with this shoeing and is capable of making the frame
- 4. MANILLE D'ERABLE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. MA JOLIE PRINCESS** - Holding form and finished 4th in a Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Capable of earning some minor money
- 6. MISS GRAIGNES** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class E at Vire over 2700m on 18 May. Can be competitive once again
- 7. MAVINA DES ETANGS** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out at Bernay on 3 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 8. MARQUISE DES ARRIS** - Victorious last time out in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 3 May. Not reliable but is also clearly not out of it
- 9. MASTERCLASS D'EARL** - Disqualified at Caen over 2450m on 3 May. Battling to find best form and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 10. MAGIC MAGGIE** - Much improved last run when 3rd in a Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Unreliable but has a place chance
- 11. MUSIC DE BERTRANGE** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in a Class E at Caen over 2450m on 16 May. Looks capable of completing the treble
- 12. MALAGA DU DIGEON** - Disqualified at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 April. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame when staying on the trot
- 13. MADEIRA** - Successful twice in her last three starts, including last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Can score again
- 14. MISS DU PERCHE** - Improving and has won twice in a row, the latest in a Class E at Vire over 2700m on 18 May. Should fight out the finish

Summary: A competitive-looking contest, but preference is for the wealthier and more proven runners, headed by MUSIC DE BERTRANGE (11), who was dominant in both starts during May and arrives in top form. MISS DU PERCHE (14) also bids for a hat-trick after back-to-back victories and rates a serious threat. Unbeaten racing right-handed, MADEIRA (13) boasts an excellent profile and her consistency makes her hard to oppose. Provided she keeps her manners in check, MALAGA DU DIGEON (12) has the ability to play a prominent role.

C4 - PRIX MULTIPIERRES - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 26,000

1. **LUCA BAROSSO** - Has some fair form and finished 4th at Orebro over 2100m on 7 May. Can earn some minor money if at best
2. **AMERICA DREAM** - Disqualified at Le Croise-Laroche on 20 May. Unreliable in Sweden but is capable of an upset on best form
3. **CASSIUS CLAY D.E.** - With Mathieu Mottier in the saddle, he will have supporters for his first steps in France. Can be a threat to these rivals
4. **JUST PACHA** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Has disqualification issues but is capable of scoring
5. **BATTUTA FACE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 16 November. Returns from a break but can earn some money if fit enough
6. **ILIEN DE VRIE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a Class E at Caen over 2450m on 27 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
7. **CAMERON** - Unreliable and was upplaced in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 23 May. Not easy to trust but might play a minor role
8. **COMES WITH AGE** - Disqualified at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 May. Kept to harness races but can be a threat if staying in stride
9. **NATURAL MINE** - A winner of a Class D harness race at Vichy over 2950m on 11 May. Just as good under the saddle and can follow up

Summary: NATURAL MINE (9) has switched between disciplines with credit and looks well placed to add another victory under these conditions. COMES WITH AGE (8) made a favourable impression on his French debut and can be given another chance after disappointing at the Parisian tracks. His first start under saddle adds further intrigue. CASSIUS CLAY D.E. (3) is not easy to assess but warrants respect on his French debut. The in-form JUST PACHA (4) has enough recent form to suggest he can be competitive.

C5 - PRIX MG MOTOR LISIEUX - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LA RAGNA** - Returned from a break and was unplaced in Class F at Durtal over 2825m on 25 May. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 2. LHASA DU SCION** - Unreliable but did finish fourth in Class F at Jullouville-Les-Pins over 2700m on 17 May. Has disqualification issues but is capable of making the frame when smart
- 3. LOMBARDIE GIRL** - Disqualified last time out at Royan-Atlantique over 2475m on 24 May. Yet to win a race but does pop up in a place every now and then
- 4. LOVELY BRUYERE** - Disqualified last time out at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race
- 5. L'AGATHE VAUCEENNE** - Remains in good form and was runner-up in Class F at Granville over 3125m on 24 May. Can go one place better
- 6. LILIONALLY** - Battling to find best form and faulted last time out at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 May. Others make much more appeal
- 7. LILI D'EVAILLES** - Faulted last time out in Class F at Jullouville-Les-Pins over 2700m on 17 May. Did win her penultimate start and is a threat when staying in stride
- 8. LOLITA CHARMEUSE** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Vire over 2700m on 18 May. Can complete a hat-trick
- 9. LEVIOSA** - Disqualified last time out at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. In good form before that and can bounce back to score if smart
- 10. LAGUNA SECA** - Did not show her best when unplaced in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 26 May. In good form before that and can contest the finish

Summary: LOLITA CHARMEUSE (8) has taken her form to a new level in recent weeks and looks a leading contender as she bids for a hat-trick. LAGUNA SECA (10) was given too much to do at Vincennes and that effort is best overlooked. A return to her previous form would put her firmly in the picture. From the front row, L'AGATHE VAUCEENNE (5) has been in excellent heart since the spring and deserves respect, while LILI D'EVAILLES (7) is worth noting, having recorded her sole victory of the season in partnership with Yoann Lebourgeois.

C6 - PRIX #RACE AND CARE - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **LIBERION D'ARJEANC** - Yet to win a race and was unplaced last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 12 April. Needs major improvement to score
2. **LENNON ELLIS** - Has struggled this year and finished 8th in Class F at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Yet to win and others are preferred
3. **LIKE DAD** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a mounted race at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 25 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
4. **LORD DU GRAIS** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 23 May. Hard to trust and needs to improve to score
5. **L'AS DU PERCHE** - Bounced back with a victory in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 May. Capable of following up if smart
6. **LAMPARO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 25 May. Hard to trust but can make the frame when smart
7. **LULU QUICK** - Has only been modest and finished 6th in Class H at Mamers over 3175m on 25 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
8. **LOGAN DES PRES** - Not reliable and was unplaced in Class F at Jullouville-Les-Pins over 2700m on 17 May. Might play a minor role at best
9. **LOYAL** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 2 May. Victorious in his penultimate start and is not out of it
10. **LEADER DE L'AUMOY** - In good shape and finished fourth in Class E at Argentan over 2800m on 11 May. Capable of making the frame
11. **LOUSTIC VERT** - Unreliable but was successful last time out in a Class E at Ecommoy over 2775m on 3 May. Not easy to trust but might follow up
12. **L'ARNACOEUR** - Completed a hat-trick when scoring in Class E at Bernay over 2825m on 3 May. Can add another win to his tally
13. **L'AS DES CARAIBES** - - In good shape and finished third in Class E at Argentan over 2900m on 19 May. Should be competitive once again
14. **LET'S GO MAURICIEN** - Has shown improvement of late and finished runner-up in Class E at Argentan over 2900m on 19 May. Can contest the finish

Summary: The answer may lie among the second-row starters, headed by L'ARNACOEUR (12), who remains open to further progress and whose current limits are yet to be established. LOUSTIC VERT (11) returned to form with an encouraging effort on the grass at Ecommoy and is respected, while LET'S GO MAURICIEN (14) is a notable contender when racing with a lighter shoeing configuration. L'AS DES CARAIBES (13) looks competitive at this level and is another to consider seriously.

C7 - PRIX PMU + - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **MONSEIGNEUR MADRIK** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
 2. **MYSTERE DES ARRIS** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class E at Caen over 2450m on 21 May. Can get involved with the finish yet again
 3. **MAGNUS DE FLEUR** - A winner of a Class F at Angers over 3125m on 12 May. Fit and should make a bold bid at another victory
 4. **MAESTRO BILOU** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class E at Vire over 2700m on 18 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
 5. **MAESTRO ECUS** - Unreliable but finished 4th in a Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Capable of being in the mix of things when in the right mood
 6. **MAMBO DE LA VALLEE** - Disqualified 8 times in a row, the latest at Le Mans on 21 May. Very hard to trust but can score when staying in stride
 7. **MADE IN MARETTES** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
 8. **MISSILE DE TAGOR** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 6 February. Not easy to trust and could need this run returning from a break
 9. **MILLESIME GWEN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Hard to trust but does have claims if smart
 10. **MISTER FRIPOUILLE** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 29 May. Clearly not reliable but is capable of making the frame when staying in stride
 11. **MAKAO DE REVE D'OR** - Four wins in his last five starts, including last time out in a Class E at Caen over 2450m on 27 May. Can score again
- Summary:** An intriguing clash is in store between MAGNUS DE FLEUR (3), who arrives on the back of a recent success at Angers, and MAKAO DE REVE D'OR (11), who bounced back to form in impressive fashion at the end of May. MISTER FRIPOUILLE (10) merits respect on a return to a track that suits him well, while MILLESIME GWEN (9) is capable of better than his last two runs suggest.

C8 - PRIX DELAUNAY PRODUCTIONS - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. JAB KISS** - Not reliable and finished 11th in Class D at Caen over 2200m on 27 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. JO DIBAH** - Unreliable but did finish fourth in Class F over this track and trip on 17 May. Might play a minor role
- 3. JOCASTE DAIRPET** - Did not show his best when 9th in Class F over this course and distance on 17 May. Has a place chance on best form
- 4. JUMBO JACK** - Off form and finished 9th in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2850m on 23 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. JEEP DE DALINE** - Unreliable and finished 15th in Class D a Caen over 2200m on 27 May. Capable of a surprise when in the right mood
- 6. JAMSHIR** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at La Capelle over 2800m o 24 May. Needs to do more to score
- 7. JAINA D'ESSARTS** - Successful last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 17 May. Not reliable but can double up
- 8. JEWELKIM** - Much improved last run when runner-up in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2850m on 23 May. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 9. JACARTO DE HOUELLE** - Victorious last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 23 February. Returns from a break but is a danger if fit enough
- 10. JOKER DU MATCH** - Did not show his best when 9th in Class D at Vire over 2800m on 18 May. Quite capable of making the frame
- 11. JOKER DU PONT** - At the top of his game with two wins in his last three starts, including last time out in Class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 19 May. Clearly not out of it
- 12. JOYAU DU GRESSY** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class E at Vitre over 3225m on 25 May. Needs major improvement to win
- 13. JALICO DU FRUITIER** - In good shape and finished third in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 14. JOYEUX DU VIVIEN** - Successful last time out in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2850m on 23 May. In good form and could follow up
- 15. JERZINO VICI** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out at Vitre over 3225m on 25 May. Not easy to trust but can earn some money when smart

Summary: A competitive affair in which JAINA D'ESSARTS (7) is fancied to follow up her recent course-and-distance success. She produced a commanding display and a repeat of that effort would make her the one to beat. The task is far from straightforward, however, with JACARTO DE HOUELLE (9) returning from a break after being specifically prepared for this reappearance. JALICO DU FRUITIER (13) also warrants serious consideration. Blessed with a powerful finishing burst, he is capable of producing a late challenge. Consistency has not always been the strong suit of JOKER DU PONT (11), who remains capable of both brilliant and disappointing performances.
