#### C1 - PRIX DE MAUQUENCHY - 2850m (a1 3/4m) - Apprentices-Conditional-Jockeys - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 19.000

- **1. IMPREVU MAJYC -** Has yet to win a race after 28 starts and he has been moderate in most of his runs this year. Tries a Mounted race but others are preferred
- **2. INTERVAL TRAINING -** Remains barefoot. Both his wins have been in harness races and he has only been fair in Mounted races. Could contest the finish
- **3. INNA CEMA -** Remains barefoot. Disappointing form this year and is on a long losing streak. Tries a Mounted race and can improve but others are preferred
- **4. INDICE DE MALOUY -** Disappointing form this year including three disqualifications. Did run well over this course an distance last year and could be the surprise package
- **5. ILLUSTRATION ECLAT -** Remains barefoot. 36 starts now without winning and has disqualification issues but has run some fair races in this discipline. Has a winning chance
- **6. IDALIUM MAGIC -** Only eighth last time out in a Mounted race. Capable of improving but is probably best watched this time
- **7. IMPACT DU CAUX -** Unreliable and has major disqualification issues including three times at this course this year. Capable of an upset if smart
- **8. IDEAL D'ARTONGES -** Much improved last run when fourth. Keeps that shoeing arrangement and can do a lot better this time. Big winning chance

**Summary**: IDEAL D'ARTONGES (8) showed improvement when fourth last time out and could be the pick of this weak race. IMPACT DU CAUX (7) has major disqualification issues but is capable of winning this race if smart. ILLUSTRATION ECLAT (5) can break a 36 run winless record if showing his best form and deserves the utmost respect this time. INTERVAL TRAINING (2) has only been fair in Mounted races this year but is also not out of it.

# C2 - PRIX DE BEAUMONT DE LOMAGNE - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - National - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18.000

- **1. KOTESIT -** A three-year0old gelding by Captain Sparrow out of Terre de Sienne who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- **2. KIM D'AVIGNERE -** Fifth over this course and distance on debut and did even better when runner-up over further last time out. Has a winning chance
- **3. KID DE CHANLECY -** Has only been modest in his last two starts but will prefer this shorter distance and could be capable of an upset
- **4. KIARA UTINGEOISE -** Well beaten in her latest start and she needs to find a few lengths to win this race. Others are much preferred
- **5. KAPRISUN BRIAIRES -** Mostly moderate form so far. His best run was at this course when third in a claimer back in April but he will need to do more to win this race
- **6. KATIA DE ROMAZ -** Has been fair in all three of her starts. She probably prefers it further than this but she is capable of earning some money
- **7. KOETANE D'AVRIL -** Disqualified in her first two starts but has been fair of late and is capable of earning some more money
- **8. KYOSHIRO -** Disqualified last time out. Good first two runs including when runner-up over this distance and can contest the finish
- **9. KASH KING -** Unreliable and has been disqualified twice in his seven starts. Hard to trust but is capable of earning some money
- **10. KAPORAL DU JOUR -** Good debut win over 2700m last month. Drops in distance this time but he is clearly capable of following up
- **11. KOEA SPORT** A good winner of her penultimate start but she has been disqualified in her other three starts. Capable of winning if smart
- **12. KINGSWOOD -** Disappointing last run when sixth. Capable of better this shorter distance and is not out of it

**Summary**: KAPORAL DU JOUR (10) looked good when winning one his debut last month. He drops in distance this time but can double up. KYOSHIRO (8) was disqualified last time out but showed promise in his first two starts and can bounce back to score. KOEA SPORT (11) is hard to trust with three disqualifications and a win to her name but she is capable of winning if smart. KINGSWOOD (12) is better this short distance and is not out of it.

# C3 - PRIX DU CROISE LAROCHE - 2850m (a1 3/4m) - National - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23.000

- **1. JAZZY TOUCH -** On a long losing streak and has disqualification issues. Barefoot this time but others are preferred
- 2. JIPSY ROYALE Remains barefoot. Disappointing five runs since last win and needs major improvement to win
- **3. JENNY D'EURVAD -** Remains barefoot. On a long losing streak since only win and she needs to find a few lengths to win this race
- **4. JADE MAJOR -** Has yet to win a race but she has been fair of late and she could be capable of contesting the finish this time
- **5. JAGGERA BOMB -** Probably at very best over a shorter distance but has not been too bad of late and could earn some money
- **6. JOLIE DES RACQUES -** Remains barefoot. Clearly unreliable so her last two runs are not much of a surprise. Capable of winning when in the mood
- **7. JIROLATA -** Has major disqualification issues and is coming off a pair of them Capable of running well when smart and has a place chance
- **8. JABELONE -** Remains barefoot. Clearly unreliable but has run her best races when barefoot and is capable of an upset if in the mood
- **9. JOYCE PIPOL -** Unreliable and was well beaten last time out but is barefoot this time and is capable of earning some minor money
- **10. JORADE DAIRPET -** Has major disqualification issues but she has been at her best of late with two nice wins. Not easy to trust but she can complete the hat-trick
- **11. JOCONDE TURGOT -** Won her first three starts but lost her way for awhile after that but she bounced back to her best to win her latest start and she can follow up

**Summary**: JOCONDE TURGOT (11) looked good at the beginning of her career with three nice wins. She lost her way a bit after that but bounced back to her best with a solid win last time out and can win again. JORADE DAIRPET (10) is hard to trust with her disqualification issues but is hat-trick seeking after some nice wins and deserves respect. JOLIE DES RACQUES (6) is unreliable but not out of it. JOLIE DES RACQUES (6) needs to do a bit more to win but could contest the finish.

# C4 - PRIX DE CARPENTRAS - 2850m (a1 3/4m) - National - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23.000

- **1. JOYAU DE MAX -** Remains barefoot. Showed some promise with the two wins this year but has lost his way of late with two disqualifications. Can win if smart
- **2. JEFF BOLERO -** Disappointing last run when only ninth when barefoot. Seems to prefer it a bit shorter than this distance. Might place
- **3. JAKABINO -** Fit but has only been fair in three starts since winning in July. More needed to win but could play a minor role
- **4. JASMIN D'ENOGAT -** Remains barefoot. Knocking hard on the door with two runner-up runs but does seem to be stretched this distance. Not out of it
- **5. JUST A MAN -** Clearly unreliable and has disqualification issues but bounced back to win his latest start and deserves respect for that win
- **6. JOKER DU RABUTIN -** Fluffed his lines last time out but he has already won three times this year and has a winning chance
- **7. JOYAU DU CHATELET -** Remains barefoot. Has a good record since going barefoot with two wins in four barefoot runs plus a runner-up position. Can go close once again
- **8. JEEK D'ACADIE -** In good form of late with this shoeing arrangement and is distance suited. Has disqualification issues but can contest the finish once again
- **9. JOAO DE VANDEL -** Remains barefoot but has mostly been disappointing since winning early this year. Others are preferred
- **10. JESON BOY -** Remains barefoot. Versatile distance-wise and is coming off two solid wins. Capable of completing the treble
- **11. JOKER DU HAMEL -** Has some disqualification issues and has been well tried this year without winning but is barefoot this time. Prefers Mounted races but might place
- **12. JOYAU DE MORTREE -** Remains barefoot. Has major disqualifications and his last win was ina claimer. Others are preferred
- **13. JOB DES LOUANGES -** Disappointing last run when sixth. Not barefoot this time but has won like this before and he could be the surprise package of the race

**Summary**: JESON BOY (10) is having a good year and comes her after two good wins. He can complete the hat-trick. JOYAU DU CHATELET (7) has won twice in four starts when barefoot of late and could be a threat. JEEK D'ACADIE (8) has disqualification issues but can contest the finish if smart. JUST A MAN (5) is unreliable but is also coming off a nice win and can follow up if in the same mood.

- **1. ILLA VILLA -** More than a year since her last win. Has struggled in three starts this year and needs major improvement to win
- **2. ILE DU SABLIER -** Remains barefoot. Has yet to win a race after 37 starts but did run well when third last time out and is capable of finishing in the money
- **3. ISIS DE REYNALD -** Has yet to win a race after 28 starts and is coming off two moderate runs but is distance suited and could play a minor role
- **4. INFLUENCE JULRY -** Very unreliable and has major disqualification issues but she ran well when runner-up last time out and is barefoot and ready to strike
- **5. IBIZA DE L'ETANG -** Remains barefoot. Unreliable since only win but ran well when runner-up in her penultimate start and could earn some money
- **6. ISCHIA SAINT CLAIR -** Has yet to win a race after 36 starts and she has been disappointing of late. Best watched for now
- **7. INAYA DE MONGOCHY -** Holding her form with some nice runs of late. Barefoot this time and is capable of contesting the finish
- **8. IN LOVE METIS -** Remains barefoot. Has mostly been a disappointment this year. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- **9. IAKA -** Unreliable and has been a disappointment of late. Distance suited and could play a minor role if at her best
- **10. ICEHOUSE -** Remains barefoot. On a long losing streak and is unreliable but she is also capable of contesting the finish when in the mood

IBIZA DE BOURGOGNE (12) has three disqualifications in arow but is capable of bouncing back to score if smart. ICEHOUSE (10) is unreliable and on a long losing streak but could run well this course and distance. IVORY DE FAEL (11) is another that is hard to trust but could win.

- **1. ILCOURT DU RENARD -** Unreliable again this year and has been disqualified in two of four starts this year. Has run well in the other two starts and is capable of earning some money
- **2. IKE DES CHAMPS -** Remains barefoot. Has completely lost the way since winning in January and has major disqualification issues. Others are preferred
- **3. IPSILON ATOUT -** Well tried this year and has been mostly a disappointment. Did better last year but is best watched for now
- **4. INSTALL OAKS -** Remains barefoot. Last win was a claimer in 2022 but he was not disgraced when third last time out and could finish in the money once again
- **5. ICE SCOTT -** On a very long losing streak. Did well enough early this year with a couple of runner-up runs but has lost his way since then and is best watched for now
- **6. IMPACT FIX -** Won a race in 2021 and again in 2022. Can win in 2023 as he is in good form and will be barefoot and ready to strike
- **7. INSTINCT DE VETRE -** Has yet to win a race after 31 attempts. Unreliable of late and has been disqualified twice in his last three starts. Others are preferred
- **8. IDEAL WIC -** On a long losing streak and was a bit of a disappointment when only sixth last time out. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- **9. IVORY PAT -** Remaisn abrefoot. Only fair of late but did win twice earlier this year and is capable of winning again. Can upset
- **10. INDY VET -** Disappointing last run when seventh. Was in good form before that and is capable of bouncing back to score
- **11. ISCO JYL -** Disappointing last three runs but was in good form earlier this year and he has a winning chance
- **12. IGLON DAIRPET -** Remaisn barefoot. Unreliable since winning in February but he is always capable of earning some money
- **13. ISIDORE BONHEUR -** On a very long losing streak since only win but is knocking hard on the door and can fight out the finish once again

**Summary**: INDY VET (10) fluffed his lines when only seventh last time out but was in good form before that and gets a narrow vote to score. ISCO JYL (11) is capable of better than what he has been showing of late and is capable of bouncing back to score. ISIDORE BONHEUR (13) is knocking hard on the door and has a winning chance. IMPACT FIX (6) is barefoot and ready to score in 2023.

- **1. HOCA JENILOU -** Major disqualification issues of late although convinced many with his victory last run. Can contest the finish if smart
- **2. HORTANCE FOLLE -** Has major disqualification issues but bounced back to form and won well in his last run. Can contest the finish
- **3. HORIZON DU GERS -** Has disqualifiction issues but did well in his last run. Unreliable but is distance suited and has a winning chance
- **4. HOLLINS -** Good form of late around this distance. His trainer is confident in the move up category. Not out of it
- **5. HELLINE SERVINOISE -** Yet to win this year although 6th on this course last year. Unreliable but is capable of earning money
- **6. HYPOLIT DE BEL AIR -** Won well back in April but unreliable as of late. Has disqualification issues and is best lwatched this time
- **7. HAIE DES GENIEVRES -** Has disqualification issues but did well on this course finishing at 3rd place earlier this year. Should not be overlooked for the places
- **8. HASTIFER -** Won well back in January around this distance. Has had disqualification issues of late but remains barefoot. Others are preferred
- **9. HENZO DE CARSI -** Has disqualification issues, remains barefoot. Applying himself right will provide himself with a winning chance in an open looking race
- **10. HOLLY GREEN -** Attractive in the end of her last run. Remains barefoot and is capable of fighting out the finish again

**Summary**: Many will agree with HENZO DE CARSI (9), when at his best he can win in this line-up. Likely to lead his opposition HOLLY GREEN (10), who looked great at the finish last run as well as HORIZON DU GERS (3) who returned to her form. HOLLINS (4) continues to distinguish himself and confidently moves up the category where as HORTANCE FOLLE (2) is able to shine on a good day and is capable of an upset.

- **1. GRANIT PACO -** Tet to be victorious this year. Disappointing last four runs. A big ask against this lot, others are preferred
- **2. GAWANI DU BOCAGE -** On a long losing streak and has struggled on this course. Struggling this year so far and others are much preferred
- **3. GRANTCHESTER -** Won well back in May over 2300m. Remains barefoot but has only been modest of late and others are preferred
- **4. GOLDIE DRY -** Yet to win this year. Has disqualification issues but has run well when barefoot. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- **5. FAX DE L'AUMOY -** Won well back in April although he has disqualification issues. Remains bareforot and he has been in consistent form of late. Not out of it
- **6. FORREST GEDE -** Won well back in February although he has had disqualification issues of late. Remains barefoot and can upset if at very best
- **7. DOMINO DREAM -** Major disqualification issues of late but won well at this course last year. Capable of winning but is best watched for this time
- **8. EDEN JULRY -** Podium potential but has yet to attain a breakthrough victory this year. Has placed well against good competition. Can contest the finish
- **9. ELIXIR DU RABUTIN -** Unreliable this year and his last win was in a claimer last year. Likes this course and could play a minor role
- **10. FORMI -** Won well back in April around this distance when barefoot. Disappointing since then but is barefoot and could upset
- **11. GAOTCHO JIEL -** In excellent form and impressive when barefoot winning 7 out of 7 this year. Remains barefoot and clearly the one to beat
- **12. FUNKY D'ALB -** Won well back in August when barefoot. Remains barefoot and has won two of last three starts. Be right there at the finish
- **13. GOLD RIVER -** Fair fifth in his penultimate start but has struggled in his other runs this year. Did much better last year but is best watched for now
- **14. FLICKA JULRY -** Victorious on this course back in 2021. Her last victory was at this distance in 2022. Third run back and is barefoot and ready to strike

**Summary:** Impressive when barefoot is GAOTCHO JIEL (11), who remains barefoot and he has won his last seven races when barefoot. FLICKA JULRY (14) won at this course back in 2021 and is prepared for the challenge at hand. FUNKY D'ALB (12) returns with real ambitions coming off an impressive win back in August. GOLDIE DRY (4) remains barefoot and can contest the finish.
