Watch out for THE SCARLET CAT who runs for a stable in good form. She showed pace on soft ground in her last start and has drawn well again. CHIMES AT MIDNIGHT, SHE'S A TRACKSTAR and TIME IN PARIS have shown enough to warrant respect in this event. DEE DAY had her saddle slip last time - watch out.

She could be looking for this surface. REJUVENATE needs to time her run right. MISS DANON ran a better race in her last start. She has drawn well and could be one for Trifectas and Quartets.

She is best weighted and has good form on the Poly but is returning from a break. There may not be much to choose between DAWN TILL DUSK and TIRPITZ with both holding form and drawn well. He could come on in leaps and bounds. IBHELE has been a bit costly but has run some decent races and must notch up a win sooner or later. BLESS ME FRED should be in the firing line on current form too.
