C1 - PRIX OHIO - 2175m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Mounted - EUR € 40.000

- **1. JET DES MALBERAUX -** Was well on his way to victory at Enghien last time but broke stride in the concluding stages. Capable of making amends
- **2. JAMES OF CARLY -** Has found form and consistency of late. Acquitted himself well at Enghien last time (3rd) and should again be in the shake-up
- **3. JUVENTUS -** Has not been seen since 19 April but represents a formidable training outfit and will be fully unshod on her reappearance. Keep safe
- **4. JODANNE DIESCHOOT -** Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on her best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **5. JEUNE DEMOISELLE -** Undeniably capable but has been off the boil in both disciplines this year, so must reaffirm. Others preferred
- **6. JOY FOR US -** Seldom finishes far off the mark and could get into the picture here but has no more than a place chance
- 7. JAZZY THOURJAN Not entirely devoid of resources but is seldom far from faulting, so is best watched for now. Outsider
- **8. JUST ONE NIGHT** Didn't go unnoticed on her return when finishing 7th and would've improved condition since so will have more to give. Respected
- **9. JEAN DES GLENAN -** Took advantage of JET DES MALBERAUX's (1) disqualification to win at Enghien last time out and is likely to play another leading role
- **10. JAD DE CALIX -** Has struggled to regain form or show the signs of improvement needed to be competitive here, so is unlikely to trouble the judge
- 11. JOLIE NANA Inconsistent though seldom far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **12. JAGUAR DE VILLETOT -** Has been a model of consistency for several weeks and, having regained freshness, is likely to remain competitive
- **13. JAVA DAIRPET -** Has done well when avoiding disqualification and has caught the eye on occasion. Not easily discounted
- **14. JUST A WINNER -** Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on his best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **15. JASMIN BLANC -** Undeniably capable but has been off the boil in both disciplines this year, so must reaffirm. Others preferred

Summary: JET DES MALBERAUX (1) has been disqualified in consecutive outings recently having won twice and finish 2nd in three previous starts, and he need only demonstrate better application to reconnect with success. JEAN DES GLENAN (9) took advantage of that rival's faux pas to win at Enghien last time and will again fight for victory, as could consistent last-start winner JUVENTUS (3), who races barefoot returning from a break. Stablemates JUST ONE NIGHT (8) and JAMES OF CARLY (2) have the means to pose a threat. JAGUAR DE VILLETOT (12) completes the shortlist.

C2 - PRIX AURORA - 2175m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 35.000

- **1. KOVES DU PONT -** Undeniably capable but appears to have gone off the boil, on the evidence of his last 2 starts. Must reaffirm
- **2. KRONOS MADRIK -** Has undeniable means but is yet to show his full potential and will need to bounce back from a recent disqualification. Dark horse
- **3. KING GEORGES -** Won on debut and finished 2nd in his next start but showed his limits when only 7th last time at Enghien. Needs to improve but has the scope to do so
- **4. KIYOUNI -** Undefeated in two starts, winning on debut in March and at Cordemais in April. One to note on his reappearance
- **5. KRONOS DE TROIS -** Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on her best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **6. KALEO DE BANVILLE -** Did not go unnoticed when finishing 6th at Cabourg last time, which showed both his form and well-being. Will have more to offer, so has a winning chance
- **7. KING DE CHANLECY -** Was still going strong when breaking stride at Enghien last time but has the means to bounce back here. Keep safe
- **8. KARNAK DAIRPET -** Usually does well when avoiding disqualification and has caught the eye on occasion. Not to be underestimated
- **9. KRONOS DU GITE -** Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **10. KAKOU CAYENNAIS** Would've refined his condition with the outing at Enghien last time and is likely to pose more of a threat here
- **11. KAMARO DU DONJON -** Showed sufficient quality in the provinces this summer to warrant respect here, especially with Eric Raffin engaged
- **12. KAN DURAN -** Didn't have to exert his talent to win at Nantes last time and is capable of following up here. Will be a factor
- **13. KATKO DES CHAMPS -** He will be tackled again and will try to take advantage of this good commitment to restore his image.
- **14. KOOL DU PORHOET -** Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on her best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out

Summary: KALEO DE BANVILLE (6), despite finishing 6th, caught the eye at Cabourg last time and that race ought to have teed him up nicely for this engagement. He is worth chancing here and gets the nod ahead of last-start Nantes winner KAN DURAN (12) and KAMARO DU DONJON (11) with Eric Raffin engaged. KING OF CHANLECY (7) should not be condemned for his recent disqualification and is also capable of staking a claim. KAKOU CAYENNAIS (10) and KRONOS MADRIK (2) appeal most of the remainder.

C3 - PRIX DU CHER - 2175m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Mounted - EUR € 36.000

- **1. IRIS LORILLIERE -** Has, for some time now, nothing noteworthy to his name to warrant any consideration here. Can be ruled out
- **2. IBISSA PRIOR -** Unreliable but bounced back to form with a reassuring (4th) last start at Angers, which gives her a good chance here
- **3. ISLENA -** Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on her best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **4. IROISE JISCE -** Consistent for the most part in harness races recently so cannot be taken lightly switching to the mounted code
- **5. IMPULSE** Versatile performer who seldom finished far off the mark in both disciplines. Not incapable of getting into the picture
- **6. ISIS DU DANCING -** Versatile performer and last-start winner in the harness category at Châlons-en-Champagne. Not taken lightly
- **7. IRELAND TEAM -** Faulted early on in her only outing under the saddle at Mauquenchy in June but would have gained from that experience. Could do better
- **8. IDYLLE DES BERTHES -** Has already performed well in harness races with Florian Desmigneux, so warrants respect reverting to this code with that partner retained
- **9. IZORA BARZAT -** Has been in good form recently in the harness category, finishing 2nd at Graignes last time. Could well make an impact in her first start under the saddle
- **10. INDIANA DE BEAUM -** Has, for the most part, demonstrated great consistency and is likely to right the wrong of her recent disqualification. Keep safe

Summary: A small field assembled for this mounted race and it could pay to take a chance on IZORA BARZAT (9) in her first start under the saddle, having regained momentum in the harness category recently. INDIANA DE BEAUM (10) has already proven herself in the specialty and is more than capable of fighting for victory, so she shouldn't be condemned for her recent faux pas. IBISSA PRIOR (2) and IDYLLE DES BERTHES (8), judged on their recent form in the harness category, also have the means to pose a threat.

C4 - PRIX WALPURGA - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 36.000

- **1. ISKA BERRY -** Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on her best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **2. IVORY PERRINE -** Has been struggling to recapture her form or remain consistent for some time so is unlikely to trouble the judge
- **3. IRENE FLASH -** Proven performer at this venue and races fully unshod here with Matthieu Abrivard engaged. Has a lot in her favour
- **4. IBANA DE MONTI -** Enigmatic and hard to catch right although not incapable of staking a claim in a race like this. Beware
- **5. INES TURGOT -** Has lost her way and looked rather ordinary for some time now, so her chances even at this level can be ruled out
- **6. IPSIE DE LA LUNE -** Has struggled to remain consistent or make the improvement needed to be competitive in a race of this nature. Overlook
- **7. INTUITION SOYER -** Had been hopelessly out of sorts prior to her shock last-start success. Unreliable so best just to watch for confirmation
- **8. IDOLE DE LA TOUQUE -** Last-start winner at the top of her game recently, winning twice and finishing 2nd in her last three outings. Should continue her momentum here
- **9. IGANA D'ALB -** Won consecutive outings before finishing 4th in her hat-trick bid last time. Ought to remain competitive despite her tricky spot behind the autostart
- **10. IRINA DU LUPIN -** Honest hard-knocker with consistent form credentials in stronger races/company. Eric Raffin engaged bodes well for her chances
- **11. IALLA IALLA -** Unreliable at the best of times but, judged on her best references, certainly has the means to win a race of this nature. All or nothing
- **12. ISAKA -** Disqualified after blowing the start at Amiens last time but is undeniably capable of making amends in race of this nature. Keep safe
- **13. ISSAMBRES -** Delicate but is not entirely devoid of ability. Needs to demonstrate better application to get a look in here
- **14. ICALINE DIESCHOOT -** Pops up on occasion (finished 3rd two starts back) but has, for the most part, been distinctly underwhelming. Others preferred
- **15. IDOLE HAUFOR -** Versatile mare who showed her form and well-being at Graignes last time out, despite being disqualified. Redemption could be on the cards

Summary : IRENE FLASH (3) has not raced fully unshod since way back in February when finishing 2nd at this venue. She's been inconsistent of late but is likely to appreciate the conditions so, with Matthieu Abrivard engaged, is worth chancing here. IDOLE HAUFOR (15) is complicated but versatile too, and has remained consistent alternating between the two disciplines. Judged on her best references, she has the means to win a race of this nature and needs only to avoid disqualification to fight for victory. IRINA DU LUPIN (10) acquitted herself well in a stronger race at Les Sables-d'Olonne recently and is likely to play a leading role here with a repeat of that performance. ISAKA (12), IDOLE DE LA TOUQUE (8) and IGANA D'ALB (9) complete the shortlist.

C5 - PRIX MEDUSA - 2850m (a1 3/4m) - Apprentices - Harness - EUR € 54.000

- **1. DASSERO -** Acquitted himself very well in the Prix Isara (finished 5th) and will be very competitive here on that form
- **2. FIGOLU FRAZEEN -** Has looked rather ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore
- **3. GUIDE MOI FORGAN -** Lines up here in good form and physical condition. Yet to win in the harness category but has every chance of doing so here
- **4. EOLIEN DE CHENU -** Unplaced in the Prix Isara recently but performed better than his finishing position (8th) may suggest. Dark horse
- **5. ESPOIR DU NOYER -** Has been struggling to spark the improvement needed to be competitive here, so unlikely to trouble the judge
- **6. EVITA PERON -** Finished 2nd four starts back but has, for the most, looked rather ordinary to this point. Best watched for now
- **7. ECLAIR GOLD -** Struggled to make an impact in Quinté+ races recently but ought to fare better at this level. Not taken lightly
- **8. HAVE A DREAM -** Consistent for the most part with sound form references in this category, though better when racing unshod. Watch for now
- **9. FASHION TOUCH -** Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on her best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **10. FRAGONARD DELO -** Acquitted himself well in a GNT stage at Reims last time in his first start for new connections. Winning chance from the outside of the front line
- **11. DIEGO SAUTONNE -** Has looked rather ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore
- **12. EDY DU POMMEREUX -** Has been struggling to spark the improvement needed to be competitive here, so unlikely to trouble the judge
- **13. FARAH DES CAUX -** Finished behind EOLIEN DE CHENU (4) in the Prix Isara recently. Should fare more to offer in this grade/company
- **14. FAIRPLAY D'URZY -** Has struggled to recapture any form or spark the necessary improvement to be competitive. Others preferred
- **15. DELFINO -** Capable veteran with sound form credentials. Should have a say in the finish despite his 25m handicap
- **16. DIMO D'OCCAGNES -** More effective under the saddle with no references in this category to make note of, so easily overlooked

Summary: Several with chances here but no more so than GUIDE MOI FORGAN (3) who should belatedly open his account in the harness category. There are, however, a number of potential dangers, headed by FRAGONARD DELO (10), excellent in the GNT at Reims recently. DELFINO (15), sparingly raced this year, has sufficient means to fight for victory but needs to bounce back to consecutive unplaced starts. DASSERO (1), EOLIEN DE CHENU (4) and even FARAH DES CAUX (13) should all fare better in this grade having finished in that order behind Izoard Védaquais in the Prix Isara.

C6 - PRIX D'ANGERS - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Class - Mounted - EUR € 35.000

- **1. KONDRIEU DEHOUELLE -** Quif De Villeneuve newcomer trained and owned by Franck Leblanc, who has booked Adrien Lamy
- **2. KA FACTOR -** Complicated sort disqualified four times in his last five starts. Finished 6th last time but must confirm that improvement watch for now
- **3. KINGSTON D'ERI -** Finished 6th under the saddle four starts back but has been sanctioned in three consecutive outings since. Others preferred
- **4. KINGSTON DU MINON -** Has nothing noteworthy to his name to warrant inclusion/consideration here so can be ruled out. Overlook
- **5. KOLOSSE RHODES -** Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on her best references. Place chance
- **6. KING DE COSSIO -** Caught the eye with an impressive last 1000m at Enghien on debut, finishing 3rd in this code. Dark horse
- **7. KENTUCKY DANICA -** Was fighting for victory at Meslay-du-Maine until hos fault 200m from the finish. Redemption not out of the question
- **8. KING KONG BOY -** Would certainly have won were it not for his fault at the entrance to the straight last time out at Machecoul. Bred to succeed in this code, so could make a splash on debut in this category
- **9. KING TEJY -** Seldom finishes far off the mark and could get into the picture here but has no more than a place chance
- **10. KINGALO DU CHENE -** Demonstrated better application to score at Cabourg recently. Will play a leading role here if confirming that improvement
- **11. KENTUCKY DU CAIEU -** Runner-up to KINGALO DU CHENE (10) at Cabourg recently, so has claims here on that form. Could improve trying this shoeing arrangement
- **12. KING DEL PHEDO -** Finished a reassuring 2nd back under the saddle last time. Could have a role to play here if confirming that improvement
- **13. KAP ORNE -** Has come to hand in the mounted code. Won two starts ago and proved his competitiveness by finishing last time, so warrants respect here
- **14. KILT -** Consistent for the most part and has sound references in this code. Can get into the picture, though has more of a place chance than a winning one

Summary: Well-bred KING KONG BOY (8) has shown considerable ability in the harness category but should, on pedigree, be even more effective in this code, so it could pay to side with him in his first start under the saddle. KINGALO DU CHENE (10) got back on track by winning last time and needs only to remain wise to fight for victory again, which could also be said of KENTUCKY DANICA (7). Both KAP ORNE (13), who has found his niche in mounted races, and KENTUCKY DU CAIEU (11), with this shoeing configuration adopted for the first time, are capable of giving cheek to those aforementioned principals. Unexposed likely improver KING DE COSSIO (6) isn't out of it either.

C7 - PRIX GYPTIS - 2200m (a1 3/8m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 43.000

- **1. LARA CROFT -** Sanctioned on debut but would have gained plenty from that experience so could have more to offer. Outsider
- **2. LIBELLA DU HOULBET -** Has finished 5th in consecutive outings following her debut victory. Won't be far off the mark but has no more than a place chance
- **3. LUNGA DES BROUSSES -** Consistent sort with sound form references. Has the means to get into the picture but has no more than a place chance
- **4. LISSANDRA JIEL -** Twice 2nd in her last three starts (finished 3rd in the other), including to a smart prospect last time. Will be competitive once more
- **5. LET ME SHINE GIO -** Stretched out in good style to open her account at Caen last time and will be a factor here if confirming that improvement
- **6. LILAS CASTELLE -** Has done well when avoiding disqualification and boasts sound form references, including a good 3rd in the Group II Prix Marcel Dejean. Beware
- **7. LOTTA BOURBON** Well-related sort (half-sister to Face Time Bourbon) with exciting untapped potential. Winner of her starts and looks the type capable of remaining undefeated
- **8. LA VIE EST BELLE -** Consistent for the most part and has respectable references. Can get into the picture but has only a minor role to play
- **9. LINADA BELLA -** Seldom finishes far off the mark so does have earning potential here, although no more than a minor role
- **10. LAYLA** Opened her account in good style at Enghien last time, confirming the improvement shown in her previous outing. Can have a say here
- **11. LOURGA** Complicated sort who finished 3rd in consecutive outings before losing her way. Sanctioned in her last three starts and is best watched until showing better application
- **12. LUMIZIANA -** Finished 2nd on debut and confirmed that promise by winning subsequently. Is open to any amount of improvement
- **13. LONG LIFE -** Talented filly with considerable means, judged on the strength and consistency of her form. Will pose a threat to LOTTA BOURBON (7)

Summary: Well-related LOTTA BOURBON (7), Prodigious half-sister to Face Time Bourbon, has made a bright start to her career by winning twice from as many starts. She was impressive in winning at Vincennes recently and, on that evidence, is good value to preserve her unbeaten status. She will, however, have to be wary of LONG LIFE (13), who has revealed considerable means and also looks to have a bright future. LET ME SHINE GIO (5) got back on track with a victory at Caen last time and she ought to remain competitive. LISSANDRA JIEL (4), LAYLA (10) and LILAS CASTELLE (6) come next.

C8 - PRIX GEMINUS - 2200m (a1 3/8m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 43.000

- **1. LIBRE PENSEUR MEEK -** Confirmed the promise of his debut 3rd by winning his next outing. Disqualified at Vincennes last time but remains unexposed so cannot be written off
- 2. LUCAS D'AVRIL Not devoid of resources but was disappointing last time (8th) and will need to bounce back. Best watched for now
- **3. LE JIBAY -** Was unable to go with LEONARDO ROC (8) last time, but that 2nd is good enough to warrant respect here. Keep safe
- **4. LARGO DE CASTELLE -** Opened his account in impressive fashion at Caen last time and has the scope to improve, so cannot be taken lightly
- **5. LUNIK DU CHOQUEL -** Consistent sort with sound form references. Has the means to have a say in the outcome but no more than a place chance
- **6. LOVER DES BROUSSES -** Twice 3rd and did finish 2nd as well in the three outings prior to his last-start 7th. Not taken lightly
- **7. LITTLE KING -** Does well when avoiding disqualification and has caught the eye on occasion. Needs only to remain wise to stake a claim
- **8. LEONARDO ROC -** Progressive colt who won in good style at Enghien in his first start on French soil. Looks more than capable of following up
- **9. L'AMERICAIN -** Returned to back to form with a good 2nd last time behind an exciting prospect. Should have a role to play
- **10. LUTTEUR DES GLENAN -** Consistent sort with sound form references. Has the means to have a say in the outcome but no more than a place chance

Summary: Progressive LEONARDO ROC (8) confirmed the form and improvement of his previous start (victory) by winning again at Enghien last time and is good value to complete the hat-trick here. L'AMERICAIN (9), again entrusted to Yoann Lebourgeois, heads the list of potential dangers that also includes last-start 2nd LE JIBAY (3), and LARGO DE CASTELLE (4) after an impressive winning comeback at Caen. The shortlist is completed by FREETHINKER MEEK (1) and LUTTEUR DES GLENAN (10).
