### **R4 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]**

## C1 - PRIX DE LA COTE SAINT ANDRE - 2150m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 24.000

- **1. LA COMTESSE MADRIK -** Unreliable and was only fair when fifth over this track and trip last time out. More needed to win but could play a minor role
- **2. LA BELLE SURPRISE -** Disappointing last two starts around this distance and is probably better over further. Others are preferred
- 3. LE GRAND FLAC Much improved last run when runner-up over this track and trip last time out. Not out of it
- **4. LET'S TWIST -** Consistent so far around this distance. Not disgraced when fourth last time out and can contest the finish again
- **5. LOU D'ECROVILLE -** Ran well on debut but was disqualified over this course and distance last time out. Can bounce back to score
- **6. LAPS GEDE -** Runner up on debut over this course and distance on debut last month. Should fight out the finish once again
- **7. LET ME SIXTY ONE -** A good winner on debut but struggled twice at Vincennes. Could be the surprise package of the race
- **8. LYRIKO BELLO -** A good debut winner over this track and trip on debut. Looks promising and can follow up
- **9. LANCELOT BUROIS -** A three-year-old gelding by Niky out of Fatale Buroise who is making his debut. Watch the betting
- 10. LEADER DES RIOULTS Disqualified twice and is capable of improvement but is best watched for now

**Summary:** LYRIKO BELLO (8) looked good on her debut course and distance win and is capable of following up in this line-up. LAPS GEDE (6) was not disgraced when runner-up on debut and should be right there at the finish yet again. LET'S TWIST (4) has been consistent and is clearly not out of it. LE GRAND FLAC (3) showed improvement last time out when only finding one better on the day and has a winning chance.

## C2 - PRIX DE LA COTE D'AMOUR - 2150m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 22.000

- **1. JOLIE DES RACQUES -** Won over this course and distance in August but has struggled since and has disqualification issues. Others are preferred
- **2. JUVENILE CUP -** Remains barefoot. Unreliable and has major disqualification issues but is capable of scoring when she is the mood
- **3. JOY FOR EVER -** Probably needed both return runs and is barefoot this time. Unreliable but is capable of contesting the finish
- **4. JOSEPHA MESLOISE -** Has major disqualification races but returned to form with a good win at this course last time out. Can double up over a much shorter distance
- **5. JADA MOKO -** Has yet to win after 26 starts and has been struggling of late. Barefoot this time and could improve but others are much preferred
- **6. JADORE JULRY -** Remains barefoot. Disappointing last two runs but is probably better this distance and has a place chance
- **7. JOKER ATOUT -** Both wins were in 2022. Has struggled throughout 2023 and major improvement is needed to win this race
- **8. JUNIOR D'ETE -** Remains barefoot. Unreliable but returned to form with a solid win at this course last time out. Can follow up
- **9. JOY MARGOT -** Disappointing last two runs but has been consistent at this course and is capable of earning some money
- **10. JADORE DES RACQUES -** Very unreliable and has been disqualified twice since winning in September. Capable of winning but hard to trust
- **11. JUPITER DU GOUTIER -** Unreliable but has been in good form of late. Distance suited and is capable of contesting the finish again
- **12. JUAN D'OCCAGNES -** Unreliable and won once in 2022 and once in 2034. Returns from a lengthy break and is likely to need this run
- **13. JAZZISSIME** Showed improvement when fifth last time out. Has not won for some time and more is needed to win this race
- **14. JETROVNA DU VIVIER -** All three wins were in 2022 and was disappointing in 2023. Not disgraced when fourth last time out and could play a minor role
- **15. JOIE DU GUELIER -** On a very long losing streak and has only been modest of late. Might play a minor role
- **16. JAMES DE BASSIERE -** Not disgraced when third last time out but has not won in 23 attempts and is very unreliable. Others are much preferred

**Summary**: A very competitive race. JOSEPHA MESLOISE (4) looked good when scoring at this course last time out but this distance will test him. JUNIOR D'ETE (8) returned to form with a solid win last time out and is proven this shorter distance so will be a major threat. JUVENILE CUP (2) is unreliable but is capable of winning when she is in the mood. JOY FOR EVER (3) is barefoot this time and not out of it.

## C3 - PRIX FANDANGO - 2150m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 38.000

- **1. ESPOIR FLYMP -** Remains barefoot. Very consistent last year and won three times. Better over further but can win this race
- 2. GENERAL DU NORD Last win was over a lot further but is versatile distance-wise and capable of earning some money
- **3. EDJO DU MONT -** Unreliable and has disqualifications issues. Fourth at this course last time out but is probably better over further
- **4. EPERON DE FRECA -** Remains barefoot. Disappointing form since last win in March. Probably better over further but could play a minor role
- **5. FERLAINE -** On a very long losing run and has been modest of late. Drop in distance could spark improvement but others are preferred
- **6. GIRL PETTEVINIERE -** Versatile distance-wise and ran well when fourth last time out. Remains barefoot and can do even better this time
- **7. FEEL GOOD DESBOIS -** Remains barefoot. Has struggled in most of his runs since winning at this course a year ago. Might place
- **8. GIVE ME CASH -** May have needed last run. Won with this shoe arrangement in August over this course and distance. Could be the surprise package of the race
- **9. ETIENOS DE CHENOU -** Remains barefoot. On a very long losing run and has struggled of late. Others are much preferred
- **10. GIMME SHELTER -** Remains barefoot. Unreliable but ran well when runner-up last time out and has won at this course before. Go close
- **11. GOLD D'ECROVILLE -** Fourth at course last time out but has been unreliable since winning in July. Not out of it though
- **12. GEGE BAROQUE -** Likes this course and returned to his best when scoring over this course and distance last time out. Can double up
- **13. EDITEUR LA RAVELLE -** Remains unshod. Well beaten in latest start which was at this course. Last win was a claimer and others are preferred
- **14. GUEPARD DE TILLARD -** Remains barefoot. Well beaten in recent runs and is better over further so is best watched this time
- **15. FRANCE D'OCCAGNES -** Remains barefoot. On a long losing streak and is unreliable but quite capable of an upset if in the mood
- **16. GEOFFREY D'AM -** Remains barefoot. Last win was 1800m but has run well over this course and distance before. Place chance

**Summary**: GEGE BAROQUE (12) won well over this course and distance last time out and is capable of following up in an open looking race. GIRL PETTEVINIERE (6) indicated she may be ready to score with a good fourth last time out and deserves respect. GIMME SHELTER (10) is unreliable but has run well over this track and trip before so could be a threat. GOLD D'ECROVILLE (11) is better over further but is not out of it.

## C4 - PRIX DES COTES D'ARMOR - 2925m (a1 13/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 33.000

- **1. KELLY GEDE -** Not disgraced when sixth last time out when returning from a break. Barefoot this time and could be the surprise package of the race
- **2. KILLER MESLOIS -** Disqualified last time out for a total of three disqualifications. Has also won three times in nice starts and is capable of contesting the finish
- **3. JIQUEL -** Remains unshod. Disqualified last time out but has run well over this track and trip. Place chance
- **4. JUSTIN WOOD -** Remains barefoot and was runner-up over this course and distance last time out. Loves this course and should fight out the finish
- **5. JUSSEO -** A bit unreliable of late but is distance suited and won seven times last year. The one to beat
- **6. JAVANAISE TURGOT -** Remains unshod. Very unreliable and has disqualification issues but did win penultimate start. Can upset
- **7. JUMANJI SIBEY -** Remains barefoot. Holding form well and was third over this course and distance last time out. Not out of it
- **8. KEEP GOING -** In good form and likes this course and distance. Should be right there at the finish again
- 9. JALIMEDE Remains barefoot. Modest form of late and needs to find a few lengths to win this race

**Summary**: A small field but a good race. JUSSEO (5) is good when in the mood and won seven times this year. Clearly the one to beat. JUSTIN WOOD (4) likes this course and distance and is an obvious threat. KILLER MESLOIS (2) is a mixed bag of trucks with three wins and three disqualifications in nine starts but can score again. JUMANJI SIBEY (7) is holding form and can contest the finish.

## C5 - PRIX DE LA COTE D'OR - 2925m (a1 13/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 29.000

- **1. GHALAL DE VANDEL -** Heavily raced last year and has struggled of late. Disqualified three times in last four starts and others are much preferred
- 2. HAUBAGNE Not disgraced when third at this course last time out. Has won over this course and distance and is not out of it
- **3. HERMES DU DON -** At best around this distance so the last run over a short distance is best ignored. Can bounce back to score
- **4. HUNMEC SOMOLLI -** Unreliable and was only eighth last time out. Barefoot this time but does seem best over a shorter distance
- **5. HOLD UP MESLOIS -** Unreliable and has disqualification issues. Needed the last run and is capable of an upset on best form
- **6. HAYASTAN DE ROSAN -** Remains unshod. Disqualified last time out and has disqualification issues. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **7. GAMINE DES LANDES -** On a very long losing run and has only been modest last year. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race
- **8. HARING OKINA -** Remains unshod. Has major disqualification issues but is capable of running well when wise. Might place
- **9. HIGHWAY NARCY -** Remains unshod. Runner-up in penultimate start but has been unreliable of late and others are preferred
- **10. HOLD BLUE -** Tenth last time out at this course but is clearly capable of better and deserves some respect in this line-up. Can upset
- **11. HOKIO** Unreliable of late and has been disqualified twice in last three starts. Better over shorter but is not out of it.
- **12. GIGA DES PLAINES -** On a long losing run and was a disappointment when seventh last time out. Did better when fourth at this course before that. Might place
- **13. HOOPER DES CHASSES -** Has his disqualification issues but has won three times in last five starts. Barefoot and capable of winning this longer distance
- **14. FAST D'AVEZE -** Disappointing last run when ninth. Did better before that but is returning from a break and others are preferred
- **15. GENTLEMAN DE LARRE -** In good form with two recent wins over a short distance. Better over shorter but does have a winning chance

**Summary**: HOOPER DES CHASSES (13) won well last time out at this course and is capable of scoring again. GENTLEMAN DE LARRE (15) has been at very best over shorter these days but is capable of winning this longer distance. HOKIO (11) is better over shorter and has been disqualified twice recently but is capable of running well when smart. HOLD UP MESLOIS (5) needed the last run and is capable of an upset on best form.

# C6 - PRIX DE LA COTE D'EMERAUDE - 2925m (a1 13/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 26.000

- **1. IZZIA HIGHLAND -** Not disgraced when third at this course last time out but is unreliable and has not won for some time. Might place
- **2. IDYLLE DU NORD -** On a very long losing run but has been in good form of late. Runner-up over this course and distance last time out and has a winning chance
- **3. IZORA BARZAT -** Heavy raced of late and is coming off a disqualification. Needs major improvement to win this race
- **4. ISA MAUVE -** Showed improvement when fifth over this track and trip last time out but is on a long losing streak. Might play a minor role
- **5. INITIALE BLEUE -** Not disgraced when seventh las time out. Won penultimate start when barefoot and is barefoot again. Can upset
- **6. IZAROSANGELA -** Won over this course and distance in 2022 but struggled in most of her runs last year. Barefoot and could play a minor role
- **7. INSOLITE -** Remains barefoot. In good form and is capable of contesting the finish once again. Go close
- **8. IBERIQUE TURGOT -** Unreliable and is coming off two disqualifications. Won three times last year and is capable of winning when in the mood
- **9. ISLA DE BANVILLE -** Not disgraced when fourth over this course and distance last time out but is unreliable and has disqualification issues. Might place
- **10. INDIGOTE** Remains barefoot. Won three times last year and is versatile distance-wise. Disappointing last two runs but can bounce back to score
- **11. IMPULSE JULRY -** Very unreliable but did win four times last year and is capable of an upset. Has been disappointing of late though
- **12. IDEE NOIRE -** Remains barefoot. Disqualified last time out and has her issues but is capable of winning when in the mood. Respect
- **13. ISOTTA BAR -** Remains barefoot. Has disqualification issues and last win was in 2022. Others are preferred
- **14. IVILLA BLUE -** Unreliable and has been a disappointment since winning in August. Barefoot and can improve but others are preferred

**Summary**: INDIGOTE (10) is better than the last two runs would suggest and can bounce back to score in a very open looking race. INSOLITE (7) is in good form and sure to be a lively runner once again. IBERIQUE TURGOT (8) is coming off two disqualifications but is capable of winning when in the mood. IDYLLE DU NORD (2) is in good form and it would not be a surprise if she goes one better this time.

# C7 - PRIX DE LA COTE VERMEILLE - 2925m (a1 13/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 26.000

- **1. KINGSTON -** Holding form well but is returning from a break and tries this longer distance. Place chance
- **2. KAMI DU BOURG -** Versatile distance-wise and is coming off a nice runner-up performances at this course. Barefoot and not out of it
- **3. KOOL CRISTAL -** Unreliable but showed his best form when scoring last time out. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- **4. KOTO DE PIENCOURT -** Unreliable and has major disqualification issues but was not disgraced when runner-up last time out at this course. Place chance
- **5. KILL THE BLUES -** Much improved of late with some nice wins. Versatile distance-wise and could complete the hat-trick
- **6. KIF DE L'UNE** Disappointing recent form but has run well over this course and distance a few times. Place chance
- **7. KRISTO STAR -** Much improved of late and has won two of last five starts. Barefoot for the first time and should fight it out
- **8. KEEP TIME -** Not disgraced when fourth last time out and is at best around this distance. Not out of it
- **9. KING HEUVELLAND -** Consistent so far without winning and was runner-up over this course and distance last time out. Go close
- **10. KAISER GIBUS -** Won his first three starts in 2022 but has lost his way since then. Only sixth at this course last time out but has more to do this time
- **11. KLIMT MERITE** Improving and has won twice in his last three starts. Distance suited and is capable of fighting out the finish again
- **12. KASSIUS BERRY -** Disqualified last time out. Good debut win and has been runner-up twice since then. Can upset
- **13. KING MOKO -** Disappointing last run when ninth at Vincennes. Capable of better and was in good form before that. Might place
- **14. KINGDOM DU LIAMONE -** On a long losing run since only win. Unreliable of late and needs to do more to win. Might play a minor role

**Summary:** KILL THE BLUES (5) has struck form nicely and is hat-trick seeking. This is a tougher task this time but he may well be up to it. KING HEUVELLAND (9) is consistent and was runner-up over this track and trip last time out so could be a threat. KRISTO STAR (7) is barefoot for the very first time out has been good of late so deserves respect. KEEP TIME (8) is distance suited and not out of it.

- **1. KORONA DIKA -** Fifth over this course and distance last time out and could do even better this time. Respect
- **2. KELLE CLASS -** Showed some improvement when seventh last time out but was disqualified twice before that. Battling to regain form and others are preferred
- **3. KALIFA MESLOISE -** Has been at very best at Caen but does have a winning chance in this line-up and will be a threat
- **4. KELLY CHARLY ERA -** Only win was at this course but is clearly hard to trust with four disqualifications in last six starts. Can upset
- **5. KAVALE DU CHOQUEL -** Has yet to win a race and has been struggling in some claimers of late. Others are much preferred
- **6. KARMINA DU BREUCQ -** Has major disqualification issues and is on a long losing run but does run when smart and is not out of it
- **7. KAIRA DU DAMIER -** Disqualified twice in last four starts but did run well when fifth last time out. Should do a lot better this time
- **8. KANGALA DE FAEL -** Disqualified in four of her ten starts but does run well when smart and should make a bold bid at winning this race

**Summary:** KANGALA DE FAEL (8) is hard to trust with four disqualifications behind her but she does ability and is quite capable of beating these rivals. KALIFA MESLOISE (3) has done best at Caen and over shorter but also has run well around this distance and is not out of it. KAIRA DU DAMIER (7) showed some improvement last time out and could do even better this time. KARMINA DU BREUCQ (6) is hard to trust and is also hard to ignore.
