- **2. EVER FASTER -** 5th last time, 3rd over 3600m in a claiming hurdle in November before that. Chase debut and warrants respect
- **3. JACK TOP -** Nice 2nd on chase debut last time over 3600m in December. Showed enough to score in this
- **4. SAINT NONANTAIS -** 6th on chase debut last time in early December in a claiming event. Needs to show a good bit more to be involved
