TIPS: 1 TRIPPING THUNDER 5 IMOKELLY 2 CHASINGTHERAINBOW 12 GIMMEATHRILL

PREVIEW: TRIPPING THUNDER has improved with each start and finished 2nd over track and trip last time with blinkers fitted (retained). With further progress, he can go one better and confirm his superiority over CHASINGTHERAINBOW and IMOKELLY, who fit similar profiles and ought to be competitive. Both GIMMEATHRILL and KINGSBOY are open to improvement returning from respective absences, during which they were gelded. Newcomers SHOW OFF and JET FORCE are worth a market check on debut, while WAVE OF GLORY has shown enough to make his presence felt too. Watch the betting.

TIPS: 8 HAT'S PRIDE 5 FUTURE TURN 7 RULE OF THUMB 3 INNAMORARE

PREVIEW: FUTURE TURN and HAT'S PRIDE are closely matched on the form of a recent course-and-distance clash so there shouldn't be much separating the pair again on identical weight terms. SOLAR POWER has a bit to find on those rivals but is capable of getting into the mix. Consistent RULE OF THUMB and versatile stablemates INNAMORARE and PREVALENCE have the form and experience to be competitive too. Class-dropper FRENCH FLAME shouldn't be underestimated off a 5-point lower mark.

TIPS: 1 RICH FOLKS HOAX 3 OKAVANGO 4 ICONIC DESTINATION 7 KEBONALESEDI

PREVIEW: RICH FOLKS HOAX took his medicine from a wide draw last time but made eye-catching late headway to finish a close-up 4th over track and trip, and a repeat of that performance from gate No 1 and off an unchanged mark should suffice. Improving OKAVANGO, rejuvenated AZZURRI and hard-knocker KEBONALESEDI are recent course-and-distance scorers with the means to play leading roles despite their increased ratings. However, ICONIC DESTINATION, OZARK, MASTER OF PARIS and BOUNCEBACK fit similar profiles so shouldn't be taken lightly.

TIPS: 3 KWITE A KING 9 GROOVEJET 5 LA PULGA 7 GENTLEMAN JOE

PREVIEW: GROOVEJET defied a 3-point penalty when winning over 2000m last time under the same weight, so a further 3-point hike isn't likely to prevent another forward showing. Stablemate KWITE A KING is 2kg better off and should turn the tables from a favourable inside stall. Both TOTHEMOONANDBACK and ALADDIN'S LAMP are 2.5kg better off so are weighted to be competitive on these revised terms. LA PULGA is open to improvement stretching out to this distance for the first time, so he's best kept safe. HAPPY DAYS and GENTLEMAN JOE complete the shortlist.

PREVIEW: INDUSTRIALSTRENGTH was all dressed up but had nowhere to go when finishing an unlucky close-up 5th over 1600m in his last start. He put more than 3 lengths between himself and subsequent winner NOON DAY GUN, so it could pay to follow the progress of the lightly raced former from his tidy No 2 gate. The latter is weighted to confirm his superiority over re-opposing rivals WHAT A FORTUNE and HANG OUT THE STARS. A bigger threat to the selection will likely come from promising SWIATEK and in-form FAMILY POWER, with LADY LOOK ALIKE another capable of getting into the picture from her wide berth.

PREVIEW: Hard-knockers BLUFF ON BLUFF and BARNEY MCGREW weren't winning out of turn last time and they should remain competitive, despite resultant penalties. However, it is worth noting that Ashton Arries partnered both to victory and his decision to stick with the former speaks volumes. Lightly raced 3yo gelding UN BEL DI and 3yo filly SWEETIE DARLING are dangerous to discount off their reduced ratings and are best kept aside. Veteran ALL ABOUT AL, consistent RAFA BOY and unexposed DAME OF TRIX, who didn't go unnoticed (wasn't knocked about) on her return from a long layoff, complete the shortlist.

PREVIEW: GOLDEN DESTINY displayed a smart turn of foot when quickening from the rear of the field to get up on the line in a similar course-and-distance event on Met Day. He'll need things to go his way again, given his hold-up running style but a 3-point penalty seems unlikely to halt his momentum. TOUGH TERRAIN is closely matched on that form and 1kg better off so he should be in the thick of it again. SOOTY, ELSINORE and FORT RED are capable of making their presence felt but a bigger threat should come from thriving best-weighted filly CAPTAIN'S DESTINY who ought to play a leading role on these terms.

PREVIEW: OLIVER, NORDIC CHIEF and returning (recently gelded) WE HAVE TOUCHDOWN are better than their last starts suggest so shouldn't be underestimated. CAPTAIN WEST fits a similar profile and he ought to have tightened up after a pleasing comeback run. Given the likelihood of improvement, he should be competitive. DUMBLEDORE and ARCTIC WIZARD also have the form and experience to play leading roles at the finish. However, it should pay to follow the progress of TENANGO. He has thrived after a wind-up and is held in high regard by connections who believe their charge has the ability to win a feature.
