- CLEOD'OR Has dropped to a rating that makes a strong case here. Looks very competitive on best form
- **2. MYBELLE -** Unplaced last two outings. A 3rd place over course and distance prior to them. Others rate higher
- **3. FRENCH PEGASUS -** Has been out of form over various trips. Needs to show a lot more and happy to avoid
- 4. THE CHOSEN ONE Seems to be out of form of late. Will need to a lot more to be involved
- **5. LEJENDARIO -** 3rd at this venue over 2150m in March and won in January over 2150 at this track. Good run anticipated
- **6. ITALO -** Unplaced last twice. A winner three outings ago at Pau over 1600m in January. Outside place claims
- 7. AUTUMN TWILIGHT 4th at Chantilly over 1600m only 9 days ago. Expected to put in a bold show
- **8. HADEWIN -** A winner at Pornichet when last seen in February over 1700m. Will be fit and ought to be in the shake-up
- **9. ALMANZONE** Unplaced on the latest run, but a good 2nd at Cagnes-Sur-Mer over 2000m prior to that. Leading contender
- **10. MAKE GOLD -** 6th at this venue in late March over 2150m, a prior 2nd over course and distance also in March was encouraging. Can play a role
- **11. ULTIME NONANTAISE -** Three below-par runs at this course over 1800m have seen a bit of respite by the handicapper. Needs to bounce back to form
- **12. MARITOT -** Four average runs of late. Was 2nd on the all-weather in December over 2000m. Hard to fancy

Summary: CLEOD'OR (1) has dropped to a very reasonable rating and his run at Deauville three back was a good effort, he has a good chance to get his head in front. AUTUMN TWILIGHT (7) ran well at Chantilly and poses the main threat, in a difficult race for the punters. BOCCIATORE (13) has to be in the mix and has been threatening to win a race for a while, he should be respected. LEJENDARIO (5) enters calculations after a recent third-place finish at this track.

- 3. PARCHEMIN Won at Chantilly in February over 1900m. Needs a personal best to win
- **4. CHARLESQUINT** Had a fairly easy time in front when winning last time over 1800m at Chantilly. Can be involved if similar tactics play out. Can have a say at the business end
- **5. NATIONAL SERVICE -** Won at Marseille Borely (turf) over 1700m in mid-March. Looks competitive on form
- **6. GLAER -** 2nd in a Listed Race at Cagnes-Sur-Mer over 2000m in February. Can be involved at the finish
- 7. BOSIOH Unplaced at La Teste-Bassin Arcechon over 2000m 13 days ago. Looks out of his depth

Summary: YOOZUNA (1) is top-rated and has winning form on an artificial surface. He can show his quality and is the selection. NATIONAL SERVICE (5) won on grass when last seen, he is adaptable and can pose a danger. CHARLESQUINT (4) seemed to thrive for different tactics and a new jockey last time, a player if in the same mood. GLAER (6) is at home on this type of surface, and has to be respected.

- BLACK WALL Out of form in his latest outings. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- **4. SPEED CHOP -** Three below-par runs of late. 2nd in January over 1500m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer was a good run. Needs more
- **5. CURARO LIGHT -** A 2nd place finish in Italy when last seen. Form prior to that was below par. Hard to fancy

CALAS QUEEN (13) who got collared close to the finish when last seen at this venue, was a good effort and she looks like the biggest danger. KARRY BRADSHAW (6) looks the obvious each way selection, she has good course form. FRENCHY (7) is also a winner at this racecourse and can make her presence felt.

- **10. ALLEZ LULU -** Unraced son of ECTOT out of a 6-time winning Dam. Betting market best to expected performance
- 11. TOP OF MIND Filly by NEW APPROACH, unraced, and the market guide will prove best

Summary: LADY REGENT (9) took a nice step forward when last seen at Chantilly in what is likely a good maiden. She can progress further and be hard to beat. LE TREPORT (1) was green on debut last year, and given a kind introduction by his rider that day. He can play a role in the finish. AQUILON (2) is a horse with plenty of ability, and if relaxing, he can be a threat to the rest of the runners. SALT FLAKE (8) ran a promising race when last seen, and has strong place claims.

- **5. MAGIC TUNIS -** She is improving with racing experience and has strong claims. A must for all bets
- 6. BELLES FEUILLES She is seldom too far off the winners but more is required for the win
- 7. GERMINAL Has earned three from four starts and should get even closer now
- **8. SALSA DU DEMON -** Is course and distance suited and has a good chance. Would be no surprise if were to win
- 9. CRACK CITY Improving but might find this a bit tough. Place chance at best

- **3. ABHA -** Won well at her second start and could be absolutely anything. Respect and include in all bets
- 4. BRISBANE Makes her track debut, takes on winners and might find this a bit tough.
- 5. JAGDA Has had quite a few runs but shown some ability, however others are preferred
- **6. MADAME DE SAXE -** Won last time and despite being one of the longer shots in the field, could place
- 7. BELLE ET GRISE Makes her track debut and drops slightly is distance but can still win

ILES ET AILES (2) is owned by Godolphin and comes from the Fabre yard. He won at Deauville on debut and could remain unbeaten after this. The Aga Khan owned ALASHAR (1) has put up some fair efforts and rates a chance.

- 3. MISS MUIR Has not shone in three starts thus far and would be a shock winner
- 4. DOLCESHAL She can improve to get much closer and cannot be ignored
- 5. STELLAR JAY Was disappointing last time and needs to build on that to threaten here
- 6. ROSEL Her last victory was at this track, she ran well last time and is the horse to beat
- 7. KWIPPER Never shone in moderate debut effort and will need serious improvement

Summary: The daughter of Amaron, ROSEL (6) from the Caullery stable is the first choice. Her last run was encouraging and her last victory was recorded at this very track which makes her at home here. She is the one they all have to fear the most. NEVADO (1) is yet to record his maiden win but judging by his good last run, should get it all right very soon. He gets the services of Jockey Lemaitre and can fight out the finish. GRATULACE (2) caught the eye when making an encouraging local debut finishing fourth over this track and trip. She is a huge runner and DOLCESHAL (4) can improve to get much closer.

- 4. CAPABLE Has shown her capabilities having won seven races and could make it eight after this
- 5. SEIRY Has a good record over this track and trip and can give plenty of cheek again
- 6. SADARAK Is taking time to return to winning form and cannot be selected on recent efforts
- 7. EMBAJADORES Ignore his last run, chance based on fair penultimate and overall form
- 8. MIRISSA Stays the marathon distance and rates the one they all have to beat

SEIRY (5) stays all day and was a winner over the course and distance last month. She should be right there again and EMBAJADORES (7) can be forgiven for his last run.
