# C1 - PRIX FRANCE BLEU VAUCLUSE - 2525m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- **1. ILE DE FADA -** Much improve of late and was victorious last time out in Class G at this track over 2600m on 23 March. Can complete the hat-trick
- **2. IMPERATOR DE CARSI -** Needed the last run when 6th in Class G at Cholet over 2800m on 2 March. Fitter this time and has a winning chance
- **3. GALAXY VAUCEENNE -** Only modest this year but was not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 28 March. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **4. IDA DES MONTS -** Disqualified last time out at Marseille-Vivaux on 28 March. Has struggled this year and others make more appeal
- **5. GALOPIN FONTAINE -** Disappointing form this year and was 8th last time out in Class H at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2275m on 16 March. Barefoot this time and could contest the finish
- **6. GENESALIA -** On a long losing run and finished 6th last time out in Class G at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 28 March. Might play a minor role
- **7. ISLA -** Has disqualification issues and finished 11th last time out in Class G at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 21 March. Hard to trust but could earn some money of wise

**Summary:** ILE DE FADA (1) has been in very good form this year. Her two recent wins suggest a hat-trick is very possible over a course and distance that clearly suit. IMPERATOR DE CARSI (2) is better over further but will strip fitter from the last run and is capable of contesting the finish. GALOPIN FONTAINE (5) is barefoot this time, so look for an improved performance. GALAXY VAUCEENNE (3) needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals but could make the frame.

# C2 - PRIX DE CAVAILLON - 2525m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- **1. MAASAI -** Did all that was asked of him when winning well on debut in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 27 February. Can follow up
- **2. MUSE DE VANDEL -** Disqualified last time out at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 17 February. Did win her penultimate start but others are preferred
- **3. MARIE CURIE -** Disappointing last run when 7th in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 28 March. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- **4. MELODIE DU VIROIS -** A good recent debut winner, in Class G at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 22 March. Has ability and can double up
- **5. MAGNUM DE BLARY -** Did not run too badly when 5th in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 14 March. Can contest the finish
- **6. MON ENIGME -** Finished third on her recent debut, in Class G at Carpentras over 2650m on 30 March. Tougher task this time but can earn some money
- **7. MILOU DE CAZOULENE -** A winner on debut but was only 8th last time out in Class F at Marseille-Borely over 3025m on 14 March. Capable of an upset this shorter distance
- **8. MACUMBA DESBOIS -** Has improved with each start and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Hyeres over 2050m on 27 March. Capable of making the frame
- **9. MACHTWO DU MORTIER -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Carpentras on 30 March. Needs major improvement to win
- **10. MIRAGE D'ARDENNES -** Finished fourth on debut in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 23 March. Can contest the finish again with improvement expected

**Summary:** MAASAI (1) produced an impressive debut display at Lyon-La Soie in February. He can certainly follow up if in the same mood. MELODIE DU VIROIS (4) was a good debut winner at Paray-le-Monial and could be anything, so deserves respect in this line-up. MIRAGE D'ARDENNES (10) looks likely to be smarter second time out and can contest the finish. MACUMBA DESBOIS (8) is fit and improving and can also get into the mix of things.

# C3 - PRIX REMY GONDOIN - 2600m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Mounted - EUR € 29,000

- **1. CORNELIA OP -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when third in a Class G Mounted race at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 14 March. Could play a minor role
- 2. INOUIE DOMPIERRE Has major disqualification issues and was 5th last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 March. More is needed to win
- 3. ITALIANO DREAM Holding form and was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class F Mounted race at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 17 February. Has a winning chance
- **4. ILLUSION DU VAL -** Disqualified last time out at Lyon-La Soie on 27 February. Unreliable but is quite capable of getting into the thick of things again
- **5. IDOLE DE LA COTE -** Holding form and finished fourth in a Class F Mounted race at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 23 March. Not out of it in this line-up
- **6. IDEAL DU GAZON -** In good form and finished third last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 23 March. Should fight out the finish
- **7. HERCULE DU LEVANT -** Has been struggling for some time now and was 9th in Class F Mounted race at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 27 February. Barefoot and capable of improvement but others are preferred

GAMIN DU SABLIER (10) struggled in some harness races last year and is returning from a break, but he has won under the saddle over this particular track and trip. He gets a narrow vote to score. IDEAL DU GAZON (6) is fit and in very good form, so would not be a surprise winner. IMPERIAL KEY (9) is better in this discipline and can be a lively danger. ITALIANO DREAM (3) is usually competitive and clearly not out of it.

- LHASSA DE VANDEL Has disqualification issues but was runner-up last time out in Class F at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 March. Can go one better this time
- **2. LINAS -** Not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 21 March. Has a winning chance
- **3. LETS GO DE MONCHEL -** Returned from a break and finished 9th last time out in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 18 March. Barefoot this time and could surprise fitter this time
- **4. LOYAL FRIEND -** In good form and was victorious last time out in Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 18 January. Can complete the hat-trick
- **5. LORINA LOULOU -** Has some fair form of late and was not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 10 March. Has a place chance
- **6. LOUNA CHIC** Yet to win a race but was runner-up in a Class E Mounted race at Feurs over 2225m on 23 March. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
- **7. LIBERTY DU MORTIER -** Yet to win a race and was 5th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 21 March. Needs find a few lengths to win
- **8. LA PRIMAVERA -** In good form of late and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 30 January. Has a winning chance
- **9. LYNX DES BROUETS -** Bounced back to his best when victorious in Class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 5 March. Can follow up
- **10. L'AMIRAL D'EURVAD -** Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Salon-de-Provence on 26 March. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **11. LIMBOURGOIS -** Disqualified last time out at Lisieux on 27 March. In good form before that and can fight out the finish if wise

**Summary:** LINAS (2) ran a bit better than his finishing position indicates at Marseille-Borely last month. He should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. LIMBOURGOIS (11) has disqualification issues but is quite capable of winning a race like this when wise. LOYAL FRIEND (4) is improving and can follow up on a barefoot win at Toulouse. LETS GO DE MONCHEL (3) is unshod this time so could be a threat.

- **1. HOLD OF COMTAL -** Finished 7th in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 14 March. Christophe Martens gets along well and is not out of it
- **2. EOLE DU PRIEURE -** Finished 6th in a Mounted class D at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 March. Remains barefoot. Probably best watched for now
- **3. FASHIONABLE QUICK -** Unplaced in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 6 January. Reverts to barefoot.
- **4. HEROS D'YVEL -** Finished 9th in a class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 1 December. Reverts to barefoot and returning from a break. Deserves to be respected
- **5. FILOU DE SITA -** Disqualified in a class A at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Unreliable sort, but if in the mood can make the frame
- **6. GALION DES THIRONS -** Disappointed when unplaced in a class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 27 February. Reverts to barefoot. David Bekaert will give every assistance from the sulky and has a good chance

- **2. KANEA DE L'ABBAYE -** Fourth in a class E at this track over 2600m on 23 March. Remains barefoot. A good effort on this track and is not out of it
- **3. KANGALA DE FAEL -** Fourth in a class C at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 26 March. Remains barefoot. Can play a minor role
- **4. KASH SNIPER -** Third in a class C at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 26 March. Holding form and has every chance again

KANEA DE L'ABBAYE (2) ran well at this track last time out and could make the frame.

- **3. CONDOR PASA GAR -** A winner at Naples over 1600m on 14 March. Returning to our soil and deserves to be respected in this line-up
- **4. I AM PHYT'S -** Finished 6th in a class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 27 March. Remains barefoot. Unreliable, but if in the mood can be competitive

- **2. GINO VIVA -** Fifth in a class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 9 March. Tackled but remains competitive and can contest the finish again
- **3. FORBACH -** Finished 10th in a Group 3 at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 26 March. Reverts to barefoot. Others make more appeal
- **4. HUDO DU RUEL -** A runner-up in a class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 9 March. Remains barefoot. In solid form and should make a bold bid for victory

FOSTER WOOD (8) is unshod and sure to improve on some disappointing recent performances. HEROS DES MOTTES (13) is fit and very consistent, so would not be a surprise winner in this line-up.
