Track rises 12m from 1600m to 800m marks, making it most testing circuit in SA. **TOP JOCKEYS AT TRACK:** G Lerena 261-76 (29.12%)-114, C Zackey 146-27 (18.49%)-56, M Yeni 189-26 (13.76%)-88, K Matsunyane 217-23 (10.60%)-74 **TOP TRAINERS AT TRACK:** S G Tarry 292-40 (13.70%)-106, A P Peter 230-34 (14.78%)-80, J J van Vuuren 150-24 (16.00%)-59, P F Matchett 235-16 (6.81%)-93 **DRAW:** Low-number draws favoured over 1400m and to a lesser extent 1600m. **APPRENTICES (ALLOWANCES):** G Dookhit (4.0), K J Lihaba.

He would have benefitted from that experience and with any improvement should open his account. SIMBINE and BINGO have shown enough to pose a threat to the selection. Debutantes BRIGITTE ANNE and GIMMEFORSURE are respected, especially in receipt of a 2.5kg sex allowance.

QUEEN'S PACT has greater experience and remains open to improvement but a bigger threat will likely come from one of the newcomers. Watch the betting on ON THE RUN, RHUM DE VIE and WAR TALK.

PREVIEW: Good race. WHITE PEARL ran on from a long way back (wide draw) to finish a close-up 4th in a similar contest over track and trip last time. She is closely matched with RADICCHIO on the form of that race but need only repeat that performance to resume winning ways. GIMMEANOTHERCHANCE is better off at the weights with both familiar foes but engaged to run at an earlier meeting. TEXAS RED could fare better in this company than he did in a KZN Grade 2 last time. Consistent BUSSTOPINHOUNSLOW has a money chance too.

They're all open to any amount of improvement, though preference is for the latter who obliterated older rivals with a wide-margin win over 1200m and could be better suited to this extended trip. Fellow debut scorer MISS NOVAX and last-start winner BACK FROM WAR also have legitimate each-way chances.

Course-and-distance debut winner TAKE NO PRISONERS is open to any amount of improvement with that experience under his belt. Recently gelded stablemate READ ALL ABOUT IT is 3kg better off with last-start conqueror RED PENNY who holds TIN PAN ALLEY on their recent 1160m meeting.

PREVIEW: Last-start Grade 2 winner LET'S GO NOW is weighted to follow up and get the better of her male rivals again. However, younger 3yo filly OLIVIA'S WAY is also weighted to be competitive after her recent Grade 2 success. Progressive 3yo geldings MUSICAL SCORE and IMMEDIATE EDGE have a bit to find but are probably better than rated. ATTICUS FINCH, SON OF RAJ and TAMARISK TREE have the form and experience to make their presence felt too. Watch the betting on Durban July entry THE EQUATOR on his local debut, especially with Richard Fourie a noteworthy jockey engagement.

PREVIEW: A cracking concluding contest in which Grade 1 winners CONFEDERATE and LEGEND OF ARTHUR set a lofty standard. The former holds the edge over his familiar foe and there is little reason he should not confirm his superiority. Improving KAMENSKY is unbeaten over this course and distance so cannot be taken lightly. Exciting PUMPKIN PIE impressed with a last-to-first victory over track and trip last time. He is probably better than rated and dangerous to discount under a handy galloping weight. Last-start scorer CHOISAANADA is another with legitimate earning potential.
