- 1. **ECLIPSE D'ORIENT** 1.25L fifth in a class D mobile event at Vincennes prior to a DQ at Vire on Saturday. Tackles this sprint trip for the first time.
- 2. **CESAR MADJI** 5.25L fourth in a class C autostart at Enghien in April. Not discounted dropping in distance on stable debut.
- 3. **CHANTACO** Running fairly from behind the mobile on his last two starts. Each way claims racing barefoot.
- 4. **DUC DU VIVIER** Midfield finishes in recent outings and has a poor record from behind the mobile. Others hold stronger claims.
- 5. **DARWIN STAR** Held on both starts since resuming. Opposed.
- 6. **CARLITA GIRL** 6L success in a class A walk up on grass at Arras eighteen days ago. Unexposed in autostarts. Key player.
- 7. **D'ARTAGNAN FRANCE** Yet to score in 21 starts from behind the mobile but has found the frame on both track visits. Each way claims without shoes.
- 8. **DISCO D'OCCAGNES** 2.25L fifth in a class D mobile event at Salon-de-Provence seventeen days ago. One to note with this sprint trip a possible positive.
- 9. **DREAM DU CHATAULT** 1.75L fifth in a class D mobile event at Caen sixteen days back. Run well on both course starts. Not ruled out.

Summary

The first qualifying round of the Speed Cup Final. CARLITA GIRL (6) ran out a ready 6L winner of a class A walk up on grass at Arras. Unexposed in autostarts and is a leading contender if replicating on this surface. DISCO D'OCCAGNES (8) showed good early speed when 2.25L fifth in a class D mobile event at Salon-de-Provence. Tackles this sprint trip for the first time. Respected. ECLIPSE D'ORIENT (1) ran well when fifth two starts ago and may have more to offer over this journey. DREAM DU CHATAULT (9) holds each way claims.

- 2. **EMILIANO** Showed plenty of early speed when 0.25L second in a class C walk up at Cavaillon prior to a solid mobile third at Salon-de-Provence. Respected.
- 3. **EMPEREUR DU CEBE** Made all for a 0.75L success in a class D mobile event at Bordeaux 23 days ago. Excellent record at this venue and racing barefoot. Top chance.
- 4. **DITHA DJEN** Capable of running well in this grade from behind the mobile and would hold each way claims on best form. Races barefoot.
- 5. **DIVA BEAUREGARD** Safely accounted for in recent starts and more needed on stable debut reverting to an autostart.
- 6. **EMENCOURT BLEQUIN** Mixed form in three walk ups since resuming but has a good placed record from behind the mobile. Each way player back in an autostart.
- 7. **COCKTAIL D'HERMES** Narrow second behind a subsequent winner at Angers two outings back. Below par on grass since but dangerous returning to this surface.
- 8. **CAID DE CAPONET** Excused two disappointing walk up efforts after a 1.25L third in a class D mobile race at Marseille Borely prior. Not discounted.
- 9. **EDDY DU LOISIR** Scored in a low grade turf walk up at a country track eleven days ago. More needed upped in standard.

Summary

The second qualifying round of the Speed Cup with the Final being race seven today. EMPEREUR DU CEBE (3) made all for a 0.75L victory in a class D mobile event at Bordeaux. Excellent record at this venue and racing barefoot. May prove tough to beat. ELAN DE DOMPIERRE (1) outran a trio of subsequent winners by 1.75L from behind the mobile at Vincennes two back. Good effort since and can prove the main danger. EMILIANO (2) showed plenty of early speed when a 0.25L second in a class C walk up at Cavaillon prior to a solid mobile third at Salon-de-Provence. In the mix. EMENCOURT BLEQUIN (6) could find the frame.

- 3. **FANTASTIC CHARM** DQ on four of his last five starts but is capable of running well at this level. Market check needed.
- 4. **FAARRON DE VIETTE** Running well when DQ at the 200m stage at Caen on reappearance. Back in a preferred shoeing combination and is one from one over this track and trip. Respected.
- 5. **FARCEUR DE L'INAM** Held in recent starts and trio of third placed finishes came in claiming events. Best watched.
- 6. **FALKO DE NOUVILLE** 4L third in this grade from behind the mobile here a week ago. First start without front shoes. In the mix.
- 7. **FARO DU BONANT** 1.25L fourth in a class E mobile event at Caen two starts ago. Key player for an in-form driver. Runs barefoot.
- 8. **FALMACO DES ANGLES** Arrives in poor form but needs a market check in this first-time shoeing combination.
- 9. **FULL BLOOD RANAIS** Poor overall record but has the ability to find the frame in this grade. Runs barefoot.
- 10. **FORGEAS DU GITE** Recent starts have come in mounted events but remains unexposed from behind the mobile. May have more to offer. Runs barefoot.

Summary

FARO DU BONANT (7) produced a 1.25L fourth in a class E mobile event at Caen two starts ago. Leading contender for an in-form driver. FALKO DE NOUVILLE (6) shaped well when 4L third in this grade from behind the mobile here a week ago. Open to progress in this first-time shoeing combination. Strong claims. FAARRON DE VIETTE (4) returns to a preferred shoe setting and is one from one over this track and trip. Dangerous to dismiss. FORGEAS DU GITE (10) cannot be ruled out back in a driven contest.

- 1. **GEANT D'AMOUR** 4L fourth in a class E walk up at a country track on Saturday. Each way claims running barefoot.
- 2. **GARRY GRIFF** Three moderate walk up runs recently but remains unexposed from behind the mobile. May show more back in an autostart.
- 3. **GRINGO DU NOYER** Run well in two class F walk ups since racing barefoot. Unexposed without shoes. Key player.
- 4. **GINO DU DERBY** Capable of running well in this grade and dangerous to dismiss for a driver in-form. Races barefoot.
- 5. **GASTOUNET** Recent starts have come in claiming company and yet to find the frame in five mobile attempts. Others preferred.
- 6. **GAMIN DU SABLIER** 8.5L sixth in a class F walk up at this venue last week but may take a step forward with shoes removed.
- 7. **GARDIEN DU QUESNE** Two fair runs in class E company of late and has a 50% placed strike rate from behind the mobile. Each way player without shoes.

- 13. **GALOPIN DE BIANCA** Well beaten in last three outings at this venue. Others preferred.
- 14. **GRAND RIVAL** Unplaced in eight starts behind the mobile and shown little form racing barefoot. Others preferred.

GRINGO DU NOYER (3) has run well in two class F walk ups since racing barefoot. Unexposed without shoes. Leading player. GINO DU DERBY (4) is capable of going well in this grade and looks dangerous to dismiss for a driver in-form. GLAIEUL DE JOUX (8) produced a 5.5L fifth in a class E at Feurs. May have more to offer in autostarts. In the mix. GARDIEN DU QUESNE (7) holds three places from six attempts behind the mobile. Place claims.

- 3. **HETRE DU JOUR** Narrow defeat when sixth in this grade on grass eleven days ago. Firmly in the mix.
- 4. **HAPPY COGLAIS** Two placings from 26 career starts. Could grab a place after showing more on grass in this class eighteen days ago.
- 5. **HOLIDAY ELEVEN** Unplaced in previous three mounted starts. Unlikely to feature back in driven company.
- 6. **HINDEN** Improved 2.5L fourth over this track and trip in better company a fortnight ago. Thereabouts without rear shoes.

- 9. **HIRTAL** 20 race maiden who finished ninth in a stronger Lyon-Parilly walk up last month. Others make more appeal.
- 10. **HECTAR SEVEN** 16L fifth in a much stronger walk up here eight days ago. Attractive chance.
- 11. **HENRY DE CORDAY** 11L defeat in a stronger course autostart 44 days ago. May show more eased in grade.
- 12. **HOLD DREAM TURBO** Five placings from seven outings. Key player barefoot for the first time in a winnable contest.
- 13. **HASHTAG D'EMOTION** Improved 3L runner up in this shoeing combination at Lyon-Parilly three weeks back. Strong claims.

HOLD DREAM TURBO (12) has made an excellent start to his career with five placings from seven driven outings. Should feature without shoes for the first time. HELLO BOY DU PIC (8) rates highly after completing a placed double over this track and trip in a higher grade. Key player. HO MY GOD ONE (7) displayed significant improvement to hit the frame at Paray-le-Monial. Each way claims. HASHTAG D'EMOTION (13) is another who could find the frame.

- 1. **HARLEY D'ORGERES** 8.25L sixth in a stronger Le Mans walk up eighteen days ago. Could improve down in grade.
- 2. **HAVANA JOLIE** Held sixth first up on grass at a higher level. May progress eased in class.
- 3. **HEIDI** Three placings from eleven starts. Hopes pinned on a new shoeing combination.
- 4. **HARMONIE DE SITA** No worthwhile form since resuming. Could find a placing if producing best but improvement needed.
- 5. **HANA DE PHYT'S** 7L fifth in a stronger walk up following a success in weaker company. Inconsistent but has ability.
- 6. **HANSONIA** Improved 5.5L fourth in a similar level walk up here last week. Not ruled out.
- 7. **HUNE DE CONDE** One placing from 26 starts. Opposed.
- 8. **HOUPPETTE D'AMBRI** Three straight DQs since landing a first win at Agen. Overall profile suggests a modest run.
- 9. **HOLY D'AIMTE** Showed more with a fifth in stronger company second up last week. Could go well without rear shoes for the first time.
- 10. **HYPOLINE DES LUCAS** Hard to recommend after three consecutive DQs. Prefer to watch.
- 11. **HORTANCE FOLLE** Two placings in ten driven outings thus far. Likely to find a few too good.
- 12. **HELICE DES MARAIS** Yet to place in twelve starts. Readily opposed.
- 13. **HANA DE FAVEROL** Failed to complete in a weaker grass walk up four days ago. May improve with a top driver taking over.
- 14. **HARMONIE DU NORD** 6L seventh in a better grade Laon autostart eleven days ago. Frame chance.
- 15. **HULOTTE DE FORGES** Five straight failures to complete tempers any enthusiasm.
- 16. **HAPPY FROMENTRO** Yet to finish a race in two starts. Best watched.

HANA DE FAVEROL (13) is expected to improve with a top driver taking over after a grass DQ. Strong claims. HARMONIE DU NORD (14) rates an each way chance. Managed to improve finishing 6L seventh at a higher level. Consider HAVANA JOLIE (2) easing in standard. Ran sixth on reappearance and might strip fitter. HOLY D'AIMTE (9) could have more to offer without rear shoes for the first time. Include.

- 4. **INCUDINE** Yet to reach the placings in three weaker driven events. Others preferred.
- 5. **ICONE DES FORGES** DQ in a similar course autostart third up a month ago. Progress needed.
- 6. **INDONESIA** DQ on second outing after a promising grass debut at Durtal. Key player for a top trainer.
- 7. **IDEE ROSE DE CHENU** Improved runner up in a weaker grass walk up four days ago. Contender if replicating.
- 8. **ILARITA MAG** Second in this company on grass after a late DQ on debut here. Solid claims.
- 9. **IT'S GIRL DE SAGA** Failed to complete over this track and trip in this grade 22 days ago. Others make more appeal.
- 10. **ISTRIA** Dramatic improvement with a second in a similar level Laon walk up eleven days ago. In the mix with front pads on.
- 11. **IRESINE** Improved 1.5L runner up at this level 68 days ago. Key chance on third start.
- 12. **ICONE TURGOT** Two placings from five career starts. Others preferred.
- 13. **ICONE PLANCHETTE** Midfield in previous three grass walk ups. Hard to enthuse.
- 14. **IKA DE BANOMME** 13L defeat on autostart debut here 53 days ago. Place claims.

INDONESIA (6) made a promising debut effort prior to a DQ subsequently. Leading claims for a top trainer. IDEE ROSE DE CHENU (7) managed a runner up effort on grass four days ago. Key contender if able to replicate back on this surface. Among the chances is ILARITA MAG (8) who can build on a fine second in latest. ISTRIA (10) is another to note after progressing at Laon. Front pads could provide further improvement.
