# C1 - PRIX DES CEDRES - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- **1. ICONE PLANCHETTE -** 6th of 16 in a 2800m Vichy Class F on 1 July and would be preferred in the amateur division
- **2. JOYEUX DU LANDRET -** In the frame in 2 of last 3, latterly 2nd of 16 in a 2850m Carentan Class E 3 weeks ago. Seen more often than not racing left-handed but has previously won going clockwise and must be considered a serious player
- **3. JUVAMINE RENARDIER -** 8th of 10 finishers, on return from a break, in a 2900m Amiens Class E last week. Could not have asked for a better draw and her finishing speed will only work to her advantage
- **4. JACK L'EVENTREUR** Returns to Cabourg for first time since 2021 after finishing 8th of 11 finishers in a 2900m Guerlesquin Class H last week and, reconfigured from the 4-spot, can get a look in
- **5. JAVA DES CAILLONS -** Good class of mare that put any doubts to bed when comfortably winning a 2150m Enghien Class F on 26 July. Is barefoot again and with form maintained will take all the beating
- **6. JACINTHE DES ULMES -** Missed out by little on the 4-timer when just headed in a 2875m Enghien Class D a month ago. Has never failed to deliver at Cabourg and looks main threat to JAVA DES CAILLONS (5)
- **7. JOPLIN DES CROUAS -** Eliminated in 5 of last 6 starts, most recently a 2875m Enghien Class D last Saturday and even though useful when applied, others still easier to trust
- **8. JACOB LUDOIS -** Returns to racing clockwise after failing to deliver in last 2, latterly coming last of 9 in a 3150m Class E at La Roche-Posay on 20 July. Is new to the venue but is still not to be written off
- **9. JIDEO STREET -** 7th of 13 in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 12 July. Has nothing to prove at this level though and, barefoot this time, it will not be long before he gets back in the game
- **10. JOIE DE VIVRE -** 2nd of 11 in a monte Class G over 2750m here 2 weeks ago and is unlikely to make much of an impact
- **11. JACK DES MALBERAUX -** Complicated sort that ran better in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 12 July than his 10th of 13 behind JIDEO STREET (9) would suggest. Breaks from the rear here and despite his capricious nature should not be ruled out

**Summary:** She may have taken some time to come to hand this season but JAVA DES CAILLONS (5) stormed up in Paris late last month, is undefeated when barefoot at Cabourg, starts in front, and looks a marginally better bet than JACINTHE DES ULMES (6) who has been simply dynamic lately. Handed an excellent number behind the car, and reconfigured for the occasion, JOYEUX DU LANDRET (2) has twice shown his form lately and will be dangerous if applied. JUVAMINE RENARDIER (3) enjoys a better spot on the front line and will be barefoot for her first objective of the summer.

- **4. KANDAR JIEL -** Eliminated in a 2700m Vittel Class F 12 days ago. Disappointing over recent months and with front pads fitted is not going to influence the result
- **5. KILOU -** Looked rather ordinary when 6th in 11 July race of reference. Has references here but still needs to find more
- **6. KING OF DAY -** Not the luckiest 5th of 14 finishers behind KASHMIRE TONIC (11) in a Class E over course and distance on 11 July. Obviously in decent shape and should not be far from the action if James Lebouteiller keeps him out of harm's way
- **7. KEOPS DU BUHOT -** 6th of 16 in a 2875m Class E at Meslay-du-Maine 10 days ago. Is proven here and despite the hike in category can still play a role
- **8. KERIDO D'ALOUETTE -** Unable to confirm Reims victory when eliminated early in a Class E over course and distance on 11 July. New driver at the helm and will be a serious proposition if he can keep his charge focused. Claim
- **9. KELAS -** Ran 2nd to KENTUCKY PIYA (3) here before dominating a 2600m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel mid-July. Goes notably well for David Thomain and looks a major player once more

- **3. LADY QUEEN -** Back under harness after faulting in a 2875m Enghien monte Class D last Saturday. Barefoot this time but still has too much to do
- **4. KOMINA -** Won a brace at Amiens prior to coming 3rd of 11 in a 2775m Lingnieres Class E on 13 July. Enjoys a terrific draw and can challenge for the win
- **5. LOBSTER DU BELLAY -** Got back in the game on 22 July when close 3rd of 13 in a 2725m Class D here. Starts on front row and David Thomain has maintained faith. Chance
- **6. LA DIVA SUPREME -** Eliminated on re-entry in a 2850m Laval Class C in early-June. Has evident ability but is too frequently unsure of stride to be considered a contender

- **3. LE GRAND AMOUR -** Won on re-entry before running 4th of 8 finishers in a 2150m Biarritz class E 3 weeks ago. Takes on a better bunch here but must still be respected
- **4. LORENZACCIO** Debuts at Cabourg after winning last 2, latterly a 2800m Bernay Class F on 13 July. Has a lot going for him here and is ideally-positioned to complete the 3-timer

- **9. MAECO DELADOU** Eliminated when preparing for this in a 2400m Domfront Class F 12 days ago. Has placed just once under the saddle though and cannot be considered a player
- **10. MANU DU GASSEL** Winner of a 2000m harness Class F at La Clayette on 20 July and debuts in the discipline with a good hand to play

**Summary:** After a brace of unproductive harness runs, MOJITO D'HERFRAIE (8) showed a different side to himself on his ridden debut here 10 days ago and is our timid favourite ahead of the complicated but plainly in-form MAX MESLOIS (7) who lost his action when going well here a week earlier. Although eliminated in all 4 starts to date, MAMBO DE LA VALLEE (1) has nevertheless shown considerable potential and will be no soft touch if Tamara Mathias-Maisonnette keeps him focused. Winner on turf under harness recently, MANU DU GASSEL (10) switches code for the first time and must be respected.
