PREVIEW: Trainer Clinton Binda does well when he brings down a few. Both MARIACHI MADNESS and CHAPBOOK have drawn well and look to have lively chances. The former's last form line is working out well but the latter is a promising youngster that could be headed for stronger contests. GALLIC FORGE has done little wrong to date and could prefer the drop in distance. He looks a big threat. SUN DAZED is capable of a big finish and a wide draw may not spoil his chances too much.
