- 2. KANELLE BUROISE Ran 5th in a Class F over 2800m at Vire Normandie on 16 November. Looks out of her league in this line-up
- 3. KELLY BRIDGE Moderate 6th in a Class E over 2700m at Graignes on 30 November. She will run with shoes in front but that looks unlikely to result in enough improvement
