# C1 - PRIX DES MICOCOULIERS - 1500m (a7f1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- 1. SEVERAC Has only been modest so far and was fifth in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1350m on 31 May. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 2. VALIENTE Finished 8th on debut in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 18 November. Others make more appeal
- 3. WALWOOD Not disgraced when fourth on debut at Pise over 1300m on 20 November. Capable of improvementt and can make the frame
- **4. SAINT LAURENT -** Finished 7th on debut in a Conditions race at Pau over 1600m on 28 November. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- 5. POSSENHOFEN In good form and finished third in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 18 November. Big chance
- **6. NOCTURNE BLOU -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a claimer at Salon-de-Provence over 1100m on 13 September. Might play a minor role
- **7. SAHIMAA** Finished 10th on debut in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1600m on 22 October. Capable of improvement and is not out of it
- **8. BENVENUTI -** Much improved last run when runner-up in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 18 November. Be right there at the finish
- **9. ILIANNABELLA -** Showed some improvement and was fourth in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 18 November. Can contest the finish
- **10. IRY -** A two-year-old colt by Hello Youmzain out ofSound of the Sea who is making his debut. His Dam was unraced. Watch the betting

**Summary:** An interesting race. POSSENHOFEN (5) did not get the run of the race last time out over this course and distance. He can score and turn the tables on rival BENVENUTI (8) with better luck in running. BENVENUTI (8) is fit and will not go down easily so deserves the utmost respect. WALWOOD (3) was disgraced on debut in Italy and can have more to show. SAHIMAA (7) should improve on debut and can be a threat.

- 2. BEAU GARS In good shape and was runner-up in a handicap at Toulouse over 1200m on 16 November. Has claims in this line-up
- 3. PASAND Not reliable but did finish fourth in a claimer at Toulouse over 1600m on 16 November. Can make the frame
- **4. HEKLA COLT** Did not show his best when 8th at Rome Capannelle over 1600m on 15 November. Can get involved with the finish
- **5. L'ARLEQUIN -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1200m on 20 November. Yet to win a race and others make more appeal
- **6. COTE D'OR** Only modest of late and finished 8th in a claimer at this track over 2000m on 5 November. Others make more appeal
- **7. ROMANISSIMA** Not disgraced when fifth in a Conditions race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1600m on 25 October. Can be competitive at this level
- **8. MERI SHARMA -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in a claimer at this track over 1500m on 24 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. AMORE MIA -** Did not show her best when 10th in a claimer at this track over 1500m on 18 November. More is needed to win this race

**Summary:** MIKEY (1) is best weighted for this claimer. He has won at this course and sets the standard for the race. BEAU GARS (2) is in good form and should fight out the finish yet again. HEKLA COLT (4) was a disappointment last time out in Italy but has some fair form and can contest the finish at this low level. PASAND (3) did not run too badly in this division at Toulouse and is another that can get into the mix of things.

- 2. WILD CITY A winner of his last two starts, the latest in a handicap over this track and trip on 12 November. Can complete the hat-trick
- **3. WAZIERS -** Returned to form and was runner-up in a handicap at Compiegne over 1400m on 24 September. Can make the frame
- **4. SPORT COUPE -** Showed some improvement when fourth in a handicap over this course and distance on 12 November. Might play a minor role
- **5. TASHANKA** Disappointing last run when 7th in a handicap at this track over 1500m on 12 November. In good form before that and has a place chance
- **6. BELINSKOV** Not disgraced when fourth in a claimer at Deauville over 1400m on 1 November. Has won two of last four starts and is not out of it
- **7. ZASYMOKA -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1350m on 7 November. Capable of earning some money

**Summary:** A very open race. WILD CITY (2) has struck a purple patch of form and was a convincing winner over this track and trip last time out. He needs to overcome a penalty to beat these rivals and gets a narrow vote to score. ABSOLUTE (10) is well drawn and gets a lot of weight from that rival and is also a course and distance winner. WE RIDE THE WORLD (1) carries top weight but is also in good shape and must be respected for that. BELINSKOV (6) also has some claims.

- 2. FOLLOW YOU A winner of a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 27 November. Carries a penalty but is not out of it
- 3. BEN DE DIANE In good form and was third in a handicap at this track over 2000m on 24 November. Should contest the finish
- **4. KALIFE ALAPLACE -** In good form and was runner-up at Ajaccio over 2400m on 9 November. Tougher task in this line-up
- **5. POP LIFE** Returned to form and was third in a handicap over this course and distance on 12 November. Can do even better this time
- **6. AL HABISSET -** Not reliable and finished 6th in a claimer over this track and trip on 24 November. Can bounce back to score

- **3. PATZESTEVE -** Only modest of late and finished fifth in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 27 November. Needs to do more to win this race
- **4. NOUSDEUX -** Showed some improvement when third in a handicap at Deauville over 2500m on 25 November. Can win a race of this nature
- **5. ASPEN -** Showed some improvement when fourth in a handicap at Toulouse over 2400m on 23 November. Can be competitive in this line-up

- 3. BOSQUET Has struggled of late and was 10th in a handicap over this track and trip on 24 November.. Yet to win a race and others are preferred
- **4. SPIRIT GREY -** Has some fair form and finished fifth in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 2150m on 17 November. Capable of an upset
- 5. PARVA SCURRA Finished 9th in a claimer at this track over 2600m on 24 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win

- **4. SENONNIAN -** Only modest of late and finished 6th in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 1800m on 27 November. Has a place chance
