

# R3 AGEN LA GARENNE [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE SAINT-SIXTE - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000**

- 1. HAMPTON AMERICA** - Disqualified in class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 22 January. Remains barefoot but does need improvement to win major
- 2. IMPERIAL RYLD** - Disqualified in class E at Montauban over 2400m on 28 December. Not reliable but is capable of earning some money
- 3. IBIS D'OR** - Did not show his best when 7th in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Capable of better and can contest the finish
- 4. JOIE DE BERTRANGE** - Showed some improvement and was third in class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 22 January. Remains barefoot and has claims at scoring
- 5. JONAGOLD** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 10 December. Has won at this track before and could make the frame
- 6. ILLUSION DE CHENU** - Unreliable and was unplaced in class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 December. Capable of improvement in this category and is not out of it
- 7. GOLD DE BAULON** - Off form and finished 9th in a class G at this track over 2625m on 11 January. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of improvement. Has a place chance
- 8. HERMAU DE SUZON** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in class G at this track over 2625m on 1 February. Remains barefoot and can go one better
- 9. JOY DES CHAMPS** - Battling to find best form and finished 8th in class G at this track over 2625m on 1 February. Needs to do more to score

**Summary:** A tricky opening event with a lot of out-of-form rivals. JOIE DE BERTRANGE (4) showed improvement a couple of weeks ago and can beat these rivals if repeating that level of form. IBIS D'OR (3) is better than her last run would suggest and can be a lively danger this time around. JONAGOLD (5) has won at this course in November but is not easy to trust and has two recent disqualifications to overcome. ILLUSION DE CHENU (6) looks capable of improvement in this division and is another to consider.

**C2 - PRIX DE SAINT-PIERRE-DE-CLAIRAC - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR €  
21,000**

- 1. LATINA PENEME** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in a class F harness race over this course and distance on 1 February. Races without shoes but does need major improvement to win
- 2. LADY GODIVA** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a class F mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 30 January. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- 3. LOAIME JIJI** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and fourth in a class F harness race over this track and trip on 1 February. Not fully barefoot but can score back under the saddle
- 4. LUCKY DE FLEUR** - Disqualified in a class E harness race at Toulouse over 2950m on 9 January. Capable of improvement first time in a mounted race. Place chance
- 5. LANDEN** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class E harness race at Toulouse over 2750m on 30 January. Remains barefoot and could make the frame
- 6. LATINO BOY** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class F mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 30 January. Has won two mounted races and is not out of it
- 7. LILI** - Showed some improvement when fourth in class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 30 January. Reverts to barefoot and can be a lively danger
- 8. LANCELOT DE BEYLEV** - Finished 9th in class F mounted race at Auch over 2800m on 25 August. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 9. LINOS DU GOUTIER** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class F mounted race at Toulouse over 2325m on 30 January. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 10. LIBERTINE DE CHENU** - Victorious in a class E mounted race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 February. Remains barefoot and in good form. Can follow up

**Summary:** An interesting race. LOAIME JIJI (3) is at his very best when fully barefoot and is not this time around, but he did show improvement in a harness race over this course and distance. He is better under the saddle and could score. LIBERTINE DE CHENU (10) has struck form with some solid wins of late and should be right there at the finish. LILI (7) showed improvement and is barefoot this time, so could be a threat. LANDEN (5) is unreliable but is also not out of it.

### C3 - PRIX DE SAINT-ROMAIN-LE-NOBLE - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **MISSION DU GILET** - In good shape and finished third in class E over this course and distance on 17 January. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
2. **MAYA DES BAUX** - Has some fair form and was fourth in class E over this track and trip on 17 January. Might play a minor role
3. **MILLENIUM BOND** - Victorious in a class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 30 January. Impressed that day and is capable of doubling up
4. **MY DREAM DES MONTs** - Only modest of late and was fifth in class E over this track and trip on 17 January. Tries barefoot and has a place chance
5. **MIKADO PIEMONT** - Not reliable and finished 7th in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 9 January. Did win his penultimate start and is not out of it
6. **MISTRAL DE LOISEL** - Has some fair form of late and was fourth in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 January. Can make the frame
7. **MONEY AIMEF** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class E at this track over 2575m on 17 January. Could have won her latest start and can be a threat of smart
8. **MELODISYVA** - Showed some improvement when third in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 15 January. Tries barefoot and can be competitive again
9. **MARPA D'IROISE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 15 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
10. **MAC DUEM** - Holding form and finished fourth in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 15 January. Could play a minor role

**Summary:** MILLENIUM BOND (3) showed some ability when winning over a shorter distance at Toulouse last month and is quite capable of following up. MELODISYVA (8) put in an improved performance last time out and will be barefoot for the very first time, so could score. MONEY AIMEF (7) has a string of recent faults, but she was an unlucky loser in her latest start and could be a threat if she stays in stride. MISTRAL DE LOISEL (6) has some fair recent form and is another to consider.

## C4 - PRIX DE SAINT-MAURIN - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. KINGSTON DU GOSIER** - In good shape and was third in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Has a place chance
- 2. KURLING ATOUT** - Off form and was unplaced in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Capable of an upset on best form
- 3. KAPEO** - Much improved of late and was victorious in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Remains barefoot and can be successful again
- 4. KOSAK DU FER** - Not disgraced when fifth in a claimer at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 25 January. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 5. KATAVIA PRESS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 27 January. Can do a lot better at this track and is not out of it
- 6. KAPTA JELOCA** - In very good shape and has won her last two starts, the latest in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Should be right there at the finish
- 7. KIFILL CHOISI** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Might play a minor role at very best
- 8. KALINEO PENEME** - A winner of a class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 30 January. Reverts to barefoot and can follow up but is not reliable
- 9. KALIMERO** - Much improved last run and was runner-up in class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 30 January. Can go one place better
- 10. KRYPTON D'EPONA** - Consistent and finished fourth in a class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 30 January. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
- 11. KENTUCKY TUILERIE** - Finished fifth in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 12. KLANT D'OLIVERIE** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Reverts to barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
- 13. KITALPHAR** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 14. KARL SPEED** - Disqualified in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal

**Summary:** A very competitive race with several rivals in strong form. KAPEO (3) gets a narrow vote to score after a good recent win at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat. KAPTA JELOCA (6) has won her last two starts and will not go down easily. KALINEO PENEME (8) has not been as reliable as these two runners but won well enough last time out and is barefoot, making him capable of following up. KATAVIA PRESS (5) has been modest of late at Vincennes but can also be involved in the finish.

## C5 - PRIX DE LAPLUME - 2050m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **JAVA DU GILET** - Showed some improvement and was runner-up in a class G at Toulouse over 2750m on 22 January. Reverts to barefoot and can earn some more money
2. **KRISTOBAL** - Victorious in a class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Has improved of late and can double up
3. **KEOPS TILLAYE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Needs to do a bit more to score
4. **KAPORAL CARISAIE** - Successful in a class F at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 23 January. Not reliable but is capable of following up
5. **KASSAV DE FRECA** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Remains barefoot and is capable of doing better. Has claims
6. **KEYS** - Much improved last run when third in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Can be competitive once again
7. **JASPER'S WAY** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class G at Toulouse over 2750m on 22 January. Reverts to barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
8. **JAVERT** - Did not show his best when 9th in class F at Graignes over 2725m on 30 December. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset on best form
9. **JIRELLA DU LOISIR** - Off form and finished 9th in class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 14 November. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
10. **JOYAU DE LA COTE** - A winner of a class D mounted race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 30 March. Returns from a break and should need this run
11. **JOURNEE A LA GRAVE** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in class F at this track over 2575m on 17 January. Might play a minor role at very best
12. **KOUSINE CARISAIE** - Not reliable and was fifth in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Might play a minor role at very best
13. **KROONER D'ORION** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Can go one better

**Summary:** A very open race, and not too many of these can be ruled out. KAPORAL CARISAIE (4) has had some good recent wins, so it is interesting that he has dropped in distance. He is capable of following up on his win at Saint-Brieuc. KASSAV DE FRECA (5) is not reliable but can be a lively danger if in the right mood. KRISTOBAL (2) is in good shape and is clearly not out of it. KEYS (6) is also hinting that a winning turn may not be far away.

**C6 - PRIX DE LA SAUVETAT-DE-SAVERES - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
21,000**

- 1. LOUNA DU CHERISAY** - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 29 November. Remains barefoot but could need this run returning from a short break
- 2. LENA ZEN** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class F over this course and distance on 1 February. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 3. LADY PURPLE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 8 December. Remains barefoot and could be a threat for Theo Briand
- 4. L'ETOILE MASCAR** - Unreliable but was third in class F over this track and trip on 1 February. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
- 5. LA VOICI DU PERCHE** - Off form and finished 8th in class F over this course and distance on 1 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. LUISA** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 3 January. Others make more appeal
- 7. LOLITA ROLAU** - Non runner
- 8. LILAS METIS** - Finished 9th in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 5 September. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 9. LA MOME BEAUFOUR** - A winner of two of her last three starts, the latest in class F over this track and trip on 11 January. Reverts to barefoot and can score again
- 10. LILAS DU MELEUC** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Capable of making the frame
- 11. LOUBIANA DU BOURG** - Returned to form and was runner-up in class E at Angers over 3125m on 28 January. Big chance in this line-up

**Summary:** LOUBIANA DU BOURG (11) has earned by far the most money in the race and only found one better at Angers last time out. She could prove to be the right one. LADY PURPLE (3) has three recent disqualifications to overcome but can be a threat under Theo Briand. L'ETOILE MASCAR (4) is not reliable but ran well over this course and distance earlier this month and has a winning chance. LILAS DU MELEUC (10) is also capable of getting involved in the finish.

**C7 - PRIX DU CONSEIL DEPARTEMENTAL DE LOT-ET-GARONNE - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class E**  
**- Harness - EUR € 21,000**

- 1. LUCKY DU CHALONGE** - In good form and finished fourth in class F over this course and distance on 1 February. Capable of making the frame
- 2. LOUJYO VITA** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F over this track and trip on 1 February. Capable of an upset on best form
- 3. LABUAN BAJO** - Off form and was unplaced in a class F at this track over 2625m on 1 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. LITTLE DREAM D'ERI** - Off form and finished 9th in class F over this course and distance on 1 February. Needs major improvement to win
- 5. LUCKY DAY** - In good shape and was a runner-up in a claimer at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 25 January. May need to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. LEXO JELOCA** - Knocking loudly at the door and was runner-up in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 18 January. Should be right there at the finish
- 7. LEADER WINNER** - Successful last time out in a class F over this track and trip on 11 January. Remains barefoot and can double up
- 8. LEVYLAND** - A winner of a class F over this track and trip on 1 February. Likes this track and can follow up in this line-up
- 9. L'ARTISTE D'AVENIR** - Finished fifth in class D over this track and trip 6 on 17 January. Remains barefoot and can earn some money
- 10. LUPIN DE BEAUFOUR** - Only fair of late and finished fifth in class D at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Remains barefoot and could earn some minor money
- 11. LOUISDOR DECHAMBOU** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Might play a minor role at very best
- 12. LOCKWOOD EFJI** - In good shape and was third in class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Can get involved with the finish once again

**Summary:** LEVYLAND (8) clearly likes this course and won in a decent time over this particular track and trip. He remains barefoot and looks the one to be with. Trainer Charles Bouview likes both his runners, LEXO JELOCA (6) and LEADER WINNER (7), so both must be respected for that. Both are in good form and can get involved in the finish. LOCKWOOD EFJI (12) is in good shape and would not be a surprise winner either.

**C8 - PRIX DE L'AGGLOMERATION D'AGEN - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR €  
35,000**

- 1. DUNA DI GIRIFALCO** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class E at this track over 2575m on 31 May. Returns from a break and should need this run
- 2. JUBII VANG** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 29 January. Capable of an upset on best form
- 3. MASERATI HALL** - Finished 10th in class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 29 January. Remains barefoot and could bounce back to score for Alexis Collette
- 4. HAYRTON MAGIC** - In good form and finished fourth in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 21 January. Remains barefoot and can make the frame
- 5. HASPARNE DUEM** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 22 January. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 6. IDEAL DE RIVRAY** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class E mounted race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 January. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 7. JOYCE DELTO** - Did not show her best when 7th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 8 November. Returns from a break but could play a minor role
- 8. INSTANT GRAVE** - Off form and finished 8th in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m on 13 December. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 9. BEAT GENERATION** - Disqualified in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Remains barefoot but others are much preferred
- 10. FILOU DE SITA** - Unreliable and was unplaced in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 11. L.A.BOKO** - Disqualified in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Not easy to trust but can contest the finish when smart
- 12. FREEDOM (NOR)** - Victorious in a class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Remains barefoot and in good form. Should be right there at the finish

**Summary:** A tricky lucky last race. MASERATI HALL (3) did not show his best form twice at Vincennes but can bounce back to win a race of this nature if taking to going right-handed this time. FREEDOM (NOR) (12) remains barefoot and in good form, so should challenge for top honours. L.A.BOKO (11) has disqualification issues but is also not out of it when staying on the trot. HASPARNE DUEM (5) is unreliable but can shine brightly when in the right mood.
