**C1 - PRIX ANABAA - 1300m (a6f1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 1 Race - Flat
- EUR € 38,000**

1. DARLINGHURST - Needed the last when 7th last time out in a Conditions race at Cagnes-Sur-Mer over 1400m on 25 January. Fitter this time and can contest the finish

2. SAJIR - Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a Group 3 at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 15 September. Returns from a break and has a winning chance

3. VICIOUS HARRY - A winner last time out at Madrid over 1200m on 20 October. Returns from a break but takes on stronger this time

4. LUCKY WINE - In very good form and was third last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1400m on 16 January. Should contest the finish

5. NATIONAL SERVICE - Finished fifth last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1300m on 7 February. Fit and is capable of making the frame

6. CIAO PA' - Winner last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 1300m on 19 December. Carries a 3.50kg penalty but is not out of it

Summary: SAJIR (2) was fourth in Prix Jean Prat (Gr. 1) and is returning from a break. If fit and well he will prove hard to oppose. LUCKY WINE (4) has held his form well of late and get into the finish yet again. DARLINGHURST (1) clearly needed the last run and will strip fitter this time. Expect a much better run from him this time around. CIAO PA' (6) was impressive in a handicap last time out but does take on stronger this time.

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**C2 - PRIX BERING - 2700m (a1m1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 1 Race - Flat
- EUR € 38,000**

1. DOUBLE MAJOR - Class stayer and was a winner of a Group 1 last time out at Saint-Cloud over 3100m on 27 October. Deserves the utmost respect returning from a break

2. GOYA SENORA - Finished fourth last time out in a Group 3 at Meydan over 2810m on 21 February. Has won on this surface and is not out of it

3. CASSIUS - Holding form and was a winner last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 2500m on 23 December. Tougher task but can earn some money

4. THE GOOD MAN - Finished 5th last time out in a Conditions race at Deauville over 2500m on 19 February. Could play a minor role

5. AFF UN ZO - Holding form and finished fourth last time out in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 14 February. Might play a minor role

6. KOSAKENZIPFEL - Did not show his best when 9th in a handicap at Deauville over 2500m on 17 January. Needs major improvement to win

7. CANDELARI - Undefeated in two starts, with both those wins being in Conditions races over this track and trip. Can complete the hat-trick

Summary: CANDELARI (7) takes on his toughest test yet but he has won both his starts and they were both over this course and distance. He can complete the treble. DOUBLE MAJOR (1) is a double Group 1 winner already but is using this as a preparation run for Dubai later this month. GOYA SENORA (2) did not run badly at Meydan last month and should fight out the finish. THE GOOD MAN (4) tackles stronger but might make the frame.

C3 - PRIX DU CARREFOUR SAINT-REMY - 1400m (a7f) - ALL WEATHER - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 23,000

- 1. GAVRUS** - Showed improvement when runner-up at Dortmund over 1700m on 16 February. Could play a minor role in this line-up
- 2. DRUMROY GIRL** - Showed what she is capable of with a claimer win at this course over 1600m on 27 February. Capable of scoring again
- 3. EYWA** - Usually gives of her best and was 5th in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1600m on 27 February. Capable of an upset
- 4. SPICHOPE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1600m on 19 February. Capable of improvement and can contest the finish
- 5. REUX** - Did not show his best when tenth in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1300m on 22 February. Did better in claimers before that. Has a winning chance
- 6. KEY TO VICTORY** - Holding her form and was fourth in a handicap at this track over 1400m on 21 February. Should contest the finish again
- 7. BUFFALO WOMAN** - Did not show her best when 8th in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 1200m on 17 November. Might earn some minor money
- 8. MRS BOHEMIAN** - Showed vast improvement when third in a handicap at Deauville in a handicap over 1400m on 13 December. Can make the frame
- 9. LARMES D'OR** - Did not show her best when 8th in a handicap at Deauville over 1300m on 31 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 10. ESHQUIA** - Non runner

Summary: DRUMROY GIRL (2) was a good winner in this division last time out at this track and she sets the standard for the race. She should follow up. REUX (5) is at his best at this level and should be involved with the finish. KEY TO VICTORY (6) is consistent and would not be a surprise winner of this race. SPICHOPE (4) is not reliable but is also quite capable of contesting the finish.

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C4 - PRIX MAURICE CAILLAULT - 1800m (a1m1/8) - ALL WEATHER - Listed Race - Flat - EUR € 55,000

- 1. GHAWAR** - Victorious in two of four starts, including last time out in a Conditions race at Pau over 2000m on 11 February. Not out of it
- 2. STORMY DONALD** - Improving and is hat-trick-seeking after some nice wins, with the latest being in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 14 February.
- 3. AL AALI** - Has improved on the PSF and was runner-up last time out in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 14 February. Could earn some money
- 4. FLY HALF** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Conditions race over this track and trip on 14 February. Might play a minor role at best
- 5. HOHENSCHWANGAU** - Unbeaten in two starts on the PSF, including last time out in a Conditions race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1600m on 16 February. Has a place chance
- 6. CURRAGH CAMP** - A good winner on debut in a Conditions race at this course over 1600m on 7 February. Can follow up
- 7. EXTRAPOL** - Looked solid enough when scoring on a debut in a Conditions race at this track over 1900m on 7 February. Be right there at the finish
- 8. TITO MO CEN** - Did all that was asked of him on debut when winning a Conditions race at this course over 1900m on 14 February. Can double up

Summary: A competitive looking-race. CURRAGH CAMP (6) gets a narrow vote to score after an impressive debut win at this track. He can follow up. TITO MO CEN (8) also looked good with his debut win also at this course. GHAWAR (1) has won two of his four starts and can be competitive in this line-up. EXTRAPOL (7) could also prove to be a threat as he also did well to win on debut.

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C5 - PRIX MONTENICA - 1300m (a6f1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Listed Race - Flat - EUR € 55,000

- 1. WOODSHAUNA** - Excellent efforts thus far, finished 2nd over 1300m at Deauville on the 8th of last month and has serious claims on that basis
- 2. ROSAPENNA** - Has won his last two and is tipped to reel off the hat trick. Last win was over 1500m at Deauville. Strong winning chance
- 3. TROUBLE MAN** - Makes French debut but has shown some talent in Great Britain. Has won last two, once at Kempton Park and the other at Wolverhampton. Do not ignore
- 4. ZAWAN** - Finished 3rd at Deauville on the 24th of January over 1500m but will need to do more for the win here. Prefer others
- 5. MOTU PROPRIO** - She impressed last time when victorious at the second start which was over 1300m at Deauville and she could be anything. Big danger
- 6. KAADI** - Made a bold effort in a Listed race at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on the 23rd of February and has good earlier form. Good chance
- 7. VALMACCA** - Placed 3rd over 1200m at Marseille Borely on the 17th of last month and boasts consistent form before that. Strong place chance
- 8. ARCTIC SUMMER** - She can build on last run when 6th at Deauville in a Listed race and could be the place value. Respect and include
- 9. IMPARABLE** - Ignore her last run in a Group 3 race, she finished an attractive 2nd before that at La Teste in a Listed event. Huge claims

Summary: ROSAPENNA (2) is clearly a good horse having won his last two starts in impressive fashion. His last win was at Deauville in late January over 1500m and he should be hard to beat. MOTU PROPRIO (5) is a daughter of Earthlight that won at only the second time of asking. She could be absolutely anything. Big chance. WOODSHAUNA (1) has strong each way claims and KAADI (6) is a must for all betting permutations.

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C6 - PRIX MONTJEU - 1600m (a1m) - ALL WEATHER - Class 1 Race - Flat - EUR € 38,000

- 1. TRIBALIST** - Ignore last run, was a winner of penultimate start over 1600m at Parislongchamp in the highest Group 1 class. Huge winning chance if fit on return
- 2. GLAER** - Ignore last effort, was victorious the race before that over 1900m in Listed company at Deauville and is one for the shortsit
- 3. FAST RAAJ** - Holding form, is talented, placed 2nd over 1600m in a Listed field last time. Strong each way chance
- 4. NO LUNCH** - Has won last two with most recent being a Listed race over 1600m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer and is confidently selected to follow up
- 5. BULLACE** - Only managed 7th position last time when racing over 1600m at Deauville in a Group 3. Others preferred for this race
- 6. APAX** - Was a winner at Chantilly over 1600m on the 14th of February and over 1600m at same course before that. Place chance in this field at best
- 7. FERRARI FEVER** - Might find this opposition way too strong and is therefore hard to fancy and select. Happy to ignore until races against a tad weaker
- 8. QUASAR** - Takes a step up in company and grade and might find it very tough. Finished 2nd at this track over 1600m last time but prefer others
- 9. MATURLO** - Finished 5th at Chantilly over 1600m and is hard to make a case for today. Pass by

Summary: NO LUNCH (4) comes into the race fresh off an impressive victory in a Listed feature over 1600m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer and looks set and ready for race to race feature wins. Group 1 winner TRIBALIST (1) is a class act and has run well fresh before. He has solid claims too. FAST RAAJ (3) has ultra-consistent form in features races and can be given serious each way claims. GLAER (2) has a first four chance and deserves all the respect.

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C7 - PRIX ESSO - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 15,000

- 1. MORHIB** - Has struggled of late and finished last time out in a Conditions race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1600m on 19 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. SEA WINGS** - Disappointing recent form and finished 16th last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 20 February. Distance suited and can bounce back to score
- 3. RUBIS GOLD** - A runner-up twice in his last three starts, with the latest being in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 21 February. Be right there at the finish
- 4. SYMBOLE** - Disappointing recent form and finished 13th last time out in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 21 February. Could be a threat off this handicap mark
- 5. LA DOLOISE** - Very unreliable but was not disgraced when third last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 14 February. Has a winning chance
- 6. EARLY LIGHT** - Has lost his way and was tenth last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 20 February. Others make more appeal
- 7. PRINCEDESCHAMPS** - Unreliable and finished 9th last time out in a handicap at Deauville over this distance on 1 February. Capable of a surprise when in the right mood
- 8. ALLURES DE REINE** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a handicap over this track and trip on 20 February. Has a place chance
- 9. BAYLAGAN** - Has struggled of late and finished 17th last time out in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 19 November. Others are preferred
- 10. MYMAP** - Battling to regain best form and finished 6th last time out in a handicap at Pornichet-La Baule over 1700m on 6 February. Others are preferred
- 11. PLATINE** - Yet to win a race and finished 11th last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 14 February. Needs major improvement to win
- 12. OSER** - On a very long losing run and finished 7th last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 20 February. Has a place chance on best form
- 13. BOW LANE** - Unreliable and finished 15th last time out in a handicap at this track over 1800m on 20 December. Capable of an upset on best form
- 14. A STOLEN KISS** - A runner-up three times in her last four starts, including last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 20 February. Can go one better
- 15. HOT SUMMER** - On a long losing run and finished 6th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 21 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 16. CALA MOLI** - On a long losing run and finished 16th last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 7 September. Could need this run returning from a break

Summary: RUBIS GOLD (3) is in good form and deserves a winning turn after some recent runner-up performances. SYMBOLE (4) has really struggled of late but could surprise off this reduced handicap mark. SEA WINGS (2) is distance suited and should do better than some recent efforts. LA DOLOISE (5) ran well over this track and trip last month and can do even better this time.

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C8 - PRIX DARSHAAN - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 1 Race - Flat - EUR € 38,000

- 1. GRECIAN STORM** - In good form and was third last time out in a Conditions race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 2 February. Capable of making the frame
- 2. MON FLAMANT** - Continues to improve and was victorious last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1800m on 30 December. Can get into the mix of things again
- 3. WAKABURN** - Returned to form with a Conditions race win over this track and trip on 13 February. Has a place chance
- 4. WALLY** - Ultra-consistent and was runner-up last time out in a Conditions race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1600m on 25 January. Can contest the finish again
- 5. DOLLAR INDEX** - Did not show his best when 6th last time out in a Group 2 at ParilLongchamp over 3000m on 5 October. Might need this run returning from a break
- 6. BIRR CASTLE** - Has the ability and was not disgraced when runner-up last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 2400m on 8 November. Big chance in this line-up
- 7. HORIZON DORE** - Has not won since 2023 and returns from a break but did finish third last time out in a Group 1 at Ascot over 2000m on 19 June. Can win if fit
- 8. ROCK BLANC** - Just needed the last run when 5th in a Conditions race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2000m on 25 January. Can upset this track and trip
- 9. STERN MARKKA** - Did not show his best when 8th at Saint-Moritz over 2000m on 16 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 10. MERKUR** - In good shape and was runner-up last time out in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1900m on 14 December. Clearly not out of it

Summary: Some decent runners go to the post for this race. BIRR CASTLE (6) returns from a break but should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. HORIZON DORE (7) is clearly the class animal in the field but does return from a lengthy break and may have other races in mind. WALLY (4) is always in for the fight and can contest the finish again. GRECIAN STORM (1) remains in good shape and can also shine in this line-up,

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C9 - PRIX OTTO - 1900m (a1m1/4) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 18,000

- 1. LETTYT FIGHT** - Finished 5th last time out in a claimer at Deauville over 1900m on 31 January. Needs a few lengths to win
- 2. MAITRE D'ARMES** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 18 December. Might need to find a few lengths to win
- 3. LHOMMAIZE** - Did not show his best when 7th in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 24 January. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 4. ROI DE FLANDRE** - Did not show his best when 7th last time out in a Conditions race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1600m on 19 February. Better in handicaps and has a winning chance
- 5. AHATIS** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a handicap over this course and distance on 20 February. Could earn some money
- 6. ROAD TO ESCONDIDO** - Yet to win a race and finished 9th in a Conditions race at Lyon-La-Soie over 1800m on 18 November. Others are preferred
- 7. ESKANDANI** - Remains in very good form and was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Pornichet-La Baule over 2100m on 20 February. Can go one better this time
- 8. INKIOSTRO** - Showed vast improvement when runner-up last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 13 February. Not out of it
- 9. MARKSWOMAN** - Disappointing form of late and finished 7th in a handicap over this course and distance on 13 February.
- 10. LEJENDARIO** - Not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2000m on 23 February. Capable of an upset
- 11. ANTINEA** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie. Others are much preferred
- 12. LIDISBARN** - On a long losing run and finished 5th last time out in a handicap over this track and trip on 13 February. Capable of making the frame
- 13. ROYAL MONARCH** - Broke a long losing run when a winner of a handicap over this course and distance on 20 February. Can follow up if in the same mood
- 14. COLD PLAY** - Has some fair form of late and finished 5th in a handicap at Deauville over this distance on 1 February. Has a place chance
- 15. DEVIL'SPEAK** - Has really struggled of late and was 8th in a handicap at Pau over 1400m on 19 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 16. LOVE THE STARS** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a handicap over this course and distance on 20 February. Not out of it

Summary: ESKANDANI (7) is very consistent and does have a decent enough shot at taking out this lucky last race. INKIOSTRO (8) bounced back to form with a good last runner-up effort and can go one better this time around. ROI DE FLANDRE (4) will do better back in a handicap and has a winning chance. COLD PLAY (14) is distance suited and is one of many mare in with a hope of scoring.
