R3 MESLAY-DU-M. [R-H]

C1 - PRIX FRAGONARD - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LEDA SAINT LATUIN** - Useful mare that ran 3rd of 12 in a 2850m Laval monte Class F on 5 March, her first appearance in the code. Will be more comfortable this time and should prove good enough to make the frame once again
- 2. L'APPASSIONATO** - Dominant winner of a Caen Class F on 16 March before losing his action on turf a fortnight later. Sports 4 pads for the first time and others easier to back
- 3. KERGRIST** - Backs up after running 5th of 14 in a Fougères Class E last Sunday. Is reunited with Benjamin Rochard and can be assured a competitive ride
- 4. LAUREL LA RAVELLE** - Consistently in the thick of things when barefoot and focused. Goes well for Romain Marty and is easy to fancy for a first-5 cheque
- 5. KIMY SIMARDIERE** - Still chasing that elusive first win, but did encourage in a Class F over course and distance last month. Takes on a better lot this time though and chances appear limited
- 6. LEON DU CLOS** - Showed promise at 3 but has since lost his way and latest run over course and distance left a lot to be desired
- 7. LUCIOLA DE LOU** - Courageous 4th on re-entry at Vire 3 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the race and can apply the pressure on KAKOU ALDO (12)
- 8. LUCIA DU CHATELET** - Delicate sort that has twice failed to replicate her Cabourg performance, and is unlikely to have many friends
- 9. LEDORIKA** - Should not be too hastily-judged for failing to deliver at Caen on 12 March. Is confirmed under these conditions and it would be no surprise to see her competitive for a place in the picture
- 10. KELLY CHALEONNAISE** - Never far from faulting in this branch of the business, but gave a good account at Pontchâteau mid-February, and barefoot this time will be dangerous if applied
- 11. LOUISIANE KERYVON** - Has yet to get that maiden monkey off her back, and is unlikely to this time either, but reassured at Mauquenchy a week ago and will have her supporters
- 12. KAKOU ALDO** - Has been out of competition for 15 months but is plainly in race-mode for comeback, and Mathieu Mottier will be expecting to win this
- 13. KOKTAIL LUDOIS** - Returns to a code for which he has shown little aptitude and recent harness conditioners have done nothing to inspire confidence

Summary: With hardly a blot on his copybook, KAKOU ALDO (12) progressed for every run...in 2024. He is back in action though, with his faithful partner in the irons, and will be well-backed to win this. As dependably competitive as she is, LUCIOLA DE LOU (7) has yet to lose her maiden tag but still represents the principal danger. The good LEDA SAINT LATUIN (1) did not disappoint on last month's monte debut and will not be sent out at 24-1 this time. Oddly below-par last time, LEDORIKA (9) has otherwise been in cracking form and ran 2nd on her sole start here.

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C2 - PRIX RENOIR - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. NUMBER ONE DU BOIS** - Put on a good show first time out when runner-up in a Challans Class F. Is competitively-shod this time and has the capability to contest the finish
- 2. NABAD DU ROCHER** - Has just the one race under his belt since the layoff. Is confirmed under these conditions, sports front pads for the first time, but still has too much to do
- 3. NELSON FAFA** - Moderate element making first appearance since October and is not about to influence the outcome
- 4. NEED YOU AGAIN** - Unexceptional filly that was well-beaten at Enghien a month ago. Mathieu Mottier reining this time but still not an obvious choice
- 5. NEVADA PIERJI** - Lost his action early before subsequently comporting himself well in a Caen Class E a fortnight ago. Should appreciate the Meslay profile and cannot be ruled out
- 6. NORTHWOOD** - Oddly below-par 5th, a place behind NOTTINGHAM FIRST (9), in a Lisieux Class E mid-March. Is not about to set off any fireworks but can get a look in if he manages to keep a line
- 7. NICE BOY BOURBON** - Won on debut before being denied a run at Caen. Gave a fine account nevertheless and will not be far from the action if kept out of trouble
- 8. NOTA PRIMO** - 2nd at Saint-Brieuc on debut before romping at Toulouse. Faces a tougher test this time but in current form is easy to fancy for a spot in first 5
- 9. NOTTINGHAM FIRST** - Has yet to get off the mark but has shown decent aptitude. Gets to race with pads this time and, given the stable's form, is worth monitoring
- 10. NEGOCIABLE** - Imposed on re-entry 2.5 weeks ago in a 2700m Graignes Class F. Theo Duvaldestin in the bike this time and is clearly a candidate for success
- 11. NIKY WAY** - Most convincing winner of a 2825m Cordemais Class E on 27 February. Top pilot at the helm this time and has every chance of doubling his money

Summary: Runner-up on his debut behind the excellent Nice Speed, the well-bred NIKY WAY (11) imposed with authority next time. Alain Chavatte has abdicated in favour of Eric Raffin and will be justifiably anticipating a repeat performance. NEGOCIABLE (10) has done everything right so far, looks a good future prospect, and with front pads fitted this time will be no easy touch. Good 2nd at Challans first time out, NUMBER ONE DU BOIS (1) will sport 4 pads for the occasion and will be partnered by Matthieu Abrivard this time. NICE BOY BOURBON (7) has been learning his trade in good order and is unlikely to disappoint.

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C3 - PRIX VAN GOGH - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. MA DOUCE DE DALINE** - 4th of 14 in a 2100m Lisieux Class E 2 weeks ago, at 34-1. In this field, though, will struggle to make her mark
- 2. MEARAS PAULOIS** - Winner of last 2, latterly a 2850m Laval Class F in early-February. Is barefoot for comeback and looks main threat to MIDEN DE FONTAINE (3)
- 3. MIDEN DE FONTAINE** - Exciting prospect that has shown very good aptitude for the game. Has buckets of untapped potential and can get straight down to business
- 4. MAESTRO BLANC** - Faithful for the most part, and presents solid clockwise credentials. Is better than his recent run would suggest, and sports a fresh configuration, but nevertheless faces a tougher test here
- 5. MAESTRO D'IDEF** - Gave a fine, but surprising, account on re-entry at Caen in early-March. Was unable to confirm at Lisieux however, and is unlikely to spice things up
- 6. MILLESIME GWEN** - Can prove a handful but has otherwise been acquitting himself honourably of late. Returns to a hard surface, and to racing right-handed, but looks a minor place chance at best
- 7. MILADY DREAM** - Useful filly that went into her break after failing to deliver at Caen last October. Stays shod and will not be troubling the judge
- 8. MESANGE DU RIB** - Won 2 at Vire then ran 2nd in a Lisieux Class F mid-March. Thrives going barefoot and although unlikely to get her nose in front, can nevertheless contest a place on the podium
- 9. MARKUS DES AGETS** - Not the worst horse here, and will be reconfigured for the occasion, but latest results do little to inspire confidence
- 10. MY LOVE JULMA** - Serious type switching to racing clockwise following a pair of Laval eliminations. Is clearly in form though and the engagement of Eric Raffin's services may be just the ticket to redemption
- 11. MAYBE DAIRPET** - No slouch on a good day but has not been seen out since December and is going to need the run
- 12. MISTRAL DU REGENCY** - Quality element that made quite an impression when 2nd in a Caen Class E on comeback 3 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the race and is unlikely to be going home empty-handed
- 13. MAESTRO BILOU** - Showed early promise but has subsequently failed to come good and would be preferred at a lower level
- 14. MUST DE BANVILLE** - Quality element making his return to racing after winning 2 last autumn. Is clearly being conditioned and best to keep one's powder dry
- 15. MAESTRO KADESH** - Talented sort that was given an easy re-entry at Laval late last month. Goes barefoot for the first time and, with application, should not be far off the mark
- 16. MILLION DREAMS** - Like a horse reborn since starting to race barefoot. By no means disgraced when 3rd in a Lisieux Class E 2 weeks ago and, considering the engagement, will be expected to put on a good show. Place chance

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Summary: MIDEN DE FONTAINE (3) may not have seen competition until October 2025 but he has shown significant promise. He makes his first appearance since early-December but will be first-time barefoot and can get his new season off to a victorious start. Sent for a spell after imposing at Laval in February, MEARAS PAULOIS (2) returns to racing right-handed and will also be barefoot for the occasion. A different horse since starting to race barefoot, MILLION DREAMS (16) benefits from a golden entry and Laurent-Michel David will be keen to take advantage of the opportunity. Similarly reinvigorated after having been relieved of his shoes, MESANGE DU RIB (8) is unlikely to be far off the mark.

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C4 - PRIX MANET - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LA DIVINE ECUS** - Is not devoid of talent but does have a temperament. Has little liking for Meslay-du-Maine and even with pads fitted will have nothing to contribute
- 2. LEGENDE DEL PHEDO** - Serious mare presenting fine credentials but is shod for re-entry and best to hold off
- 3. LAURIANE DU RIED** - Sprang quite the surprise when 2nd in a Class F over course and distance, at 59-1, 3.5 weeks ago, however a repeat seems improbable
- 4. LISBETH DE BANNES** - Complicated sort returning to the harness code after being eliminated under the saddle at Challans early last month, but at this level will have little to offer
- 5. LA RIVER D'ECCAM** - Unlucky 5th behind LAZURA PRIOR (11) in a Caen Class F last week. Is reunited with Eric Raffin who will be eager to set the record straight. Place prospect
- 6. LUDMILLA HAUFOR** - In the frame in 2 of last 3, latterly 2nd in a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche 2.5 weeks ago. Has never failed to deliver when racing clockwise, but may nevertheless be taking on too much
- 7. LAST CHANCE** - Has twice failed to confirm her Loudeac victory, being eliminated in both runs. Can trot when applied though and could pleasantly surprise if she gets off on the right foot
- 8. LIBERTA DE MARZY** - Quality mare with a brace of conditioners under her belt following her layoff. Goes barefoot for first objective of the season and, winner of her only start with Mathieu Mottier, can confirm
- 9. LAEKEN DE LA MOTTE** - Rarely far from the action when focused. Beat LA RIVER D'ECCAM (5) when victorious in a Lisieux Class F on 14 March. In better company this time but can still play a role if she deigns to stay in stride
- 10. LIGNE BLANCHE** - Useful mare making first start for her new handler. Is competitively-shod for comeback and, although not a priority, is still worth keeping an eye on
- 11. LAZURA PRIOR** - Made up for Maure-de-Bretagne effort when 3rd in a Caen Class F on 30 March. Is quite evidently close to winning for the first time since August 2023, and must not be underestimated
- 12. LALY DE JADE** - Honest mare with decent references at this level. Will have come on for her comeback and, barefoot as she likes, can pick up a first-5 payout
- 13. LADY DE JANEIRO** - Has clearly been showing her form this term, gets to race first-time barefoot, and with Guillaume Martin reining, must be considered a player

Summary: Seldom disappointing when racing barefoot, LIBERTA DE MARZY (8) will be fit following a pair of conditioners and, provided she turns, can open her right-handed account. That said, LAZURA PRIOR (11) has form at Meslay and is due a win one of these days. Ideally-engaged at the limit of earnings, LADY DE JANEIRO (13) is first-time barefoot and hard to ignore. LA RIVER D'ECCAM (5) ran 3rd on her sole Meslay start and benefits from an Eric Raffin drive for the occasion.

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C5 - PRIX DEGAS - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LALDO LOUZEEN** - Comfortably won a 2800m Vire Class E 3 weeks ago. Will be partnered by the champion driver for the first time and is very easy to recommend
- 2. LOTUS DU RIB** - Starts for the first time since early-February. Stays shod for the occasion and will have few takers
- 3. LARABELLO DE LOU** - Reverts to a previous formula after pleasing on re-entry at Chartres mid-March. Has been re-shod but is still out of his depth
- 4. LUNDU DE LOU** - Has failed to make the frame in any of 5 starts this year. Mathieu Mottier in the bike this time but others still easier to support
- 5. LORD DE L'ITON** - Won 2 on the trot before coming 3rd in a Caen Class F 2 weeks ago. Has thrived since moving to Pascal Lelièvre's yard and should again prove competitive for a place on the podium
- 6. LEADER** - Outclassed the opposition in a 2725m Lisieux Class E a fortnight ago and even though new to the venue still looks the horse to beat
- 7. LEAD ME ON** - Ran 3rd, some way off LESS TIME (11), in a 2500m Reims Class F 3 weeks ago. Is being aimed too high this time and is unlikely to cause an upset
- 8. LUCKY DU DONJON** - Should not be too hastily-judged for failing to fire at Laval. Has had time to recalibrate and can finish closer
- 9. LEADER DE L'AUMOY** - Kicked the year off well but out of the picture in last 2. Hind pads fitted this time and will have nothing to contribute
- 10. L'AS DES ISLES** - Made up for Chartres effort when 2nd in a Maure-de-Bretagne Class F, when being conditioned, 12 days ago. Is unlikely to counter LEADER (6) but still looks the main threat
- 11. LESS TIME** - Went close at Reims before faulting at Nancy. Entrusted to Benjamin Rochard who will be expected to put things right. First 5
- 12. LUDO PAROYO** - Enjoys a fine entry here but has made little impact for some time and, even though competitively-shod, still has too much to do

Summary: Consistently-performant and most recently commanding at Lisieux on just his 2nd start back, LEADER (6) takes to Meslay for the first time and, if he takes to the new conditions, can confirm. Leading the opposition, L'AS DES ISLES (10) sports a fresh configuration after having surprised at Maure-de-Bretagne, while LORD DE L'ITON (5) comes to the venue after having won 2 of his last 3. LALDO LOUZEEN (1) stayed on well at Vire last month and Eric Raffin gets the nod this time.

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C6 - PRIX UTRILLO - 2875m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 26,000

- 1. KOALA DES ARCS** - Placed twice going left-handed last month before being eliminated at Ecommoy last Monday. Has demonstrated decent aptitude but looks a minor place chance at best
- 2. KENTUCKY DANICA** - Has not been seen out since November but is a serious campaigner in the monte code and boasts a particularly strong record with his driver
- 3. KOPRIORO** - Has won 3 of 5 this year, most recently a Caen Class F in style mid-March. Is here in earnest, even though shod, and is still in the running for the spoils
- 4. KABIR BEDI** - Starts for first time under the saddle following a pair of poor harness conditioners. Barefoot this time but still has no realistic chance
- 5. JOLIKOVA D'ARIANE** - Blows hot and cold and failed to make the grade at Angers last week. Benefits from a front-row start but will nevertheless struggle to make her mark
- 6. KORRIGAN OLIVERIE** - Is not without merit but reliability not his strong suit. Has just the one race under his belt since the layoff and others preferred this time
- 7. JUST BIRD** - Disqualified after running close 3rd in a Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne on 24 March. Benjamin Rochard in the saddle this time and will endeavour to put things right
- 8. HERACLES DU LAYON** - Always gives his best but has nothing to offer at this level and can be disregarded
- 9. JACK DES MALBERAUX** - Like a horse reborn over past 2 weeks. Is reunited with Eric Raffin and will be expected to finish close once more
- 10. IQUEM NARCY** - Unexceptional 5th of 9 on re-entry last month in a 2450m Caen Class E. Has a lot of ground to make up and is unlikely to spring any surprises
- 11. JAZZMAN IDEF** - Showed improvement on Vincennes effort when 3rd in a Cordemais Class D in late-February. Is unbeaten at the venue and is unlikely to be far off the mark
- 12. JIRI PACHA** - Won a Caen Class F before giving a good account at Agen 2.5 weeks ago. Is not about to create an upset but can nevertheless finish in the money

Summary: Wonderfully-performant when competitively-shod and focused, KOPRIORO (3) runs shod this time, but goes well for Victor Saussaye and can complement his Caen success. He will still feel the heat from the returning, but classy, KENTUCKY DANICA (2) who is confirmed in the day's configuration, and 2nd-row starter JACK DES MALBERAUX (9) who appears to be back at the top of his game. JAZZMAN IDEF (11) has placed in 2 of 3 this year, won his only Meslay-du-Maine start, and must be taken seriously.

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C7 - PRIX CEZANNE - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **KING ELVIS** - Makes first start since last November. Has no chance in this company, even from front row, and can be ruled out
2. **LETS GO DE MONCHEL** - Unremarkable type with just the one race under his belt since the winter break. Shoes on and no danger
3. **LUCKY DES GAUDINES** - Moderate sort that failed to impress at Loudeac mid-March. Shoes back on and is not a concern
4. **LITTLE BOY** - No champion but can trot. Will be partnered by Matthieu Abrivard for the first time, starts in front, and will be afforded every chance
5. **LEWISIA DE LATOM** - Makes just 2nd appearance since her layoff, and will be reconfigured for the occasion, but would be preferred barefoot
6. **KADIX DEL PHEDO** - Failed to confirm Vincennes performance when trounced at Caen a month ago. Has never excelled at Meslay and is unlikely to begin now
7. **KOPA VRIE** - Handy element that showed improvement at Challans 2.5 weeks ago. Is unlikely to create an upset but still has the wherewithal to get a look in
8. **LINO GUILLERVILLE** - Consistently in the thick of things and is as comfortable going left-handed as right-. Is new to the venue but in current condition is very hard to ignore. Place chance
9. **LOOK AT ME LULU** - Respectable mare with decent barefoot form but is plainly not in race-mode and can be ruled out
10. **KNOCKANDO** - Has not been seen out since running 4th in a Laval Class F on 4 February. Has form at the venue, will have come on for the race, and will not be far from the action
11. **LUMIERE BLUE** - Has not finished out of first 3 since September. Has won 3 of last 4 starts, should take well to the new conditions, and will again be expected to contest the finish
12. **LUCKY LOVE** - Returned to winning ways 11 days ago when dominating a Rambouillet Class E and will not be available at 27-1 this time
13. **LACIENDA FLASH** - Can prove a handful but has ample ability. Pleased on sole start here and, if applied, can finish in the mix
14. **LICAR SOMOLLI** - Complicated trotter but is not devoid of ability. Imposed at Enghien on sole start in the day's configuration, but cannot be considered a priority this time around
15. **LOVE DANCER** - Justifiably well-regarded individual making first appearance since October. Has no Meslay references but is quite evidently being conditioned
16. **KALIPETTE JELOCA** - Useful mare making just 2nd start following her winter break. Is still being conditioned though and others preferred
17. **KERIDO D'ALOUETTE** - Enjoys a fine entry and has nothing to prove at this level, but has not been seen out since October and will not be over-extended
18. **LUCIANO VREDEBEST** - Serious sort making first start for a yard in rude health. Is confirmed racing right-handed and has a lot going for him. Claim

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Summary: A fine servant making his debut for the Chavatte stable, LUCIANO VREDEBEST (18) benefits from a terrific entry, has been entrusted to Eric Raffin for the first time, sports a fresh configuration, and is easy to like for the win. LUMIERE BLUE (11) has not put a foot wrong since the autumn and Mathieu Maignan can be confident of another big performance. LINO GUILLERVILLE (8) has been knocking at the door and is unlikely to let the side down. LUCKY LOVE (12) got off the mark late last month, at 26th time of asking, and is back on a hard surface with a decent chance of making the frame once more. In fine form, and 2nd last time here, KNOCKANDO (10) will race shod and will be justifiably well-supported.

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C8 - PRIX DALI - 2875m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **JOB DU CEBE** - Hardy element but has not been seen out since October, and with shoes fitted will have nothing to offer
2. **ISIDORO DIDAN** - Recently returned to competition following his spell. Sports a fresh configuration this time but still appears to be out of his depth
3. **JIOSCO DES OMBRES** - Modest element with better form at a much lower level and has nothing to offer on first start since last September
4. **KRYSTAL DU RUEL** - Put in a fine showing on comeback at Caen 2 weeks ago, running 4th in a 2450m Class F. Is new to Meslay but will have come on for the race, and from the front row can give this a good go
5. **KARLA JALLERIE** - Fine servant making first appearance since winning a Cordemais Class E in mid-January. Shoes fitted for return though and is not a priority
6. **KEOPS DE JUMILLY** - In the frame in last 2, latterly beaten only by a very good horse at Enghien last month. Enjoys a front-line break and Eric raffin is unlikely to let the opportunity pass him by
7. **JOYCE PILE** - Honest mare that was not disgraced in a Lisieux Class F on 14 March, but in this company will need to find considerably more
8. **JULIANO** - Good, consistent campaigner making first appearance since late-October. Will be barefoot for the occasion, benefits from a fine entry on the front row, and should be capable of getting in on the action
9. **KRAFEN** - Blows hot and cold, has just one run in him since the winter break, and would have better chances at a lower level
10. **JUSTICIA GLAM** - Defied her 18-1 to come 3rd in a 2100m Vincennes Class E a fortnight back. Has been reconfigured for the occasion and makes her Meslay debut with a decent chance of making first 5
11. **KIPHYLE DESBOIS** - Ran 7th, on re-entry, behind KOMERE DE CORDAY (14) in a 2875m Enghien Class E on 6 March. Has had a month to come on and even from the 2nd row can play a prominent part
12. **KINGSMAN D'EOLE** - Not as sharp as he was during the autumn but did run 5th in 6 March race of reference. Runs shod on this occasion however, and can be passed over
13. **KIVALA RENARDIER** - Has not won for over a year but left quite the impression in a Vire Quinté 3 weeks ago and, with form maintained, can challenge for the win this time
14. **KOMERE DE CORDAY** - Fine individual that has placed in 4 of last 5 in a superior category. Is short on clockwise credentials but nevertheless has the quality to win a race of this nature
15. **IDOLE ELDE** - Capable mare that goes either direction, but races for first time in 9 months and best to hold off
16. **KORONA DELADOU** - Held her own in a Vincennes Class B prior to losing her action at Vire 3 weeks ago. Is competitively-engaged but looks a minor place prospect at best

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17. IMPERIALE DU MONT - Starts for first time since running 4th in an Angers Class F in late-January. Matthieu Abrivard in the bike this time but others still easier to back

18. INDIAN PACIFIC - Wonderfully-engaged here but has just the one race under his belt following a lengthy period on the sidelines, and is going to need the run

Summary: Winless since imposing at Vincennes last October, KOMERE DE CORDAY (14) has nonetheless been knocking at the door lately and makes her right-handed harness debut with a decent chance of getting her nose in front. Arnaud Desmottes will still be wary of KIVALA RENARDIER (13) who ran 3rd to a very good horse at Vire recently, and a resurgent KEOPS DE JUMILLY (6) who breaks with a 25m head-start. KIPHYLE DESBOIS (11) has a race under her belt since the layoff and, confirmed at a superior level, will be no pushover. On the front row, and convincing on re-entry at Caen a fortnight back, KRYSTAL DU RUEL (4) is not one to be overlooked.
