**C1 - PRIX DU JOURNAL PARIS-TURF - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Harness -
EUR € 17,500**

1. NALA DE MALIKEN - A three-year-old filly by Doberman out of Dune de Maliken who is making her debut. Her Dam won twice in 46 starts. Could need this experience

2. NIGHT DES FORGES - A three-year-old fill by Rolling d'Héripuré out of Salsa d'Orgères who is making her debut. Her mother never won after four starts. Could play a minor role

3. NOBLE WOOD - A three-year-old gelding by The Best Madrik out of Boréale des Bois who is making his debut. His mother never won a race after 15 starts Can contest the finish

4. NEWTON MARANCOURT - Disqualified on debut in a class F at Carpentras over 2100m on 3 May. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal

5. NATURE ET BEAUTE - Not disgraced when fifth on debut in a class F at this track over 2050m on 25 April. Can earn some money with improvement expected

6. NAGOYA QUICK - Disqualified in a class F at Carpentras over 2100m on 3 May. Not easy to trust and others are preferred

7. NESMILLE ELEVEN - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 15 April. Hard to trust and others are preferred

8. NANDY COOL - Has improved of late and was a runner-up in a class G at Avignon over 2650m on 18 April. Can go one place better

9. NO LIMIT WELL - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a class F at Carpentras over 2100m on 3 May. Might play a minor role

10. NICE GIRL DU MIDI - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 29 April. Has a place chance in this line-up

11. NEMO DU LEARD - Successful on debut in a class G at Avignon over 2025m on 1 April. Looked good that day and is capable of doubling up

12. NELSON DU DUDY - Has run well in both starts, the latest when third in a class E at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. Should be right there at the finish once again

Summary: NEMO DU LEARD (11) impressed when winning on debut at Avignon last month and could be capable of a follow-up success. NELSON DU DUDY (12) has run well in both his starts so far and should be a real danger this time around. NOBLE WOOD (3) makes his debut but could challenge for top honours. NANDY COOL (8) has shown some improvement of late and would not be a surprise winner over this course and distance.

C2 - PRIX PASINI - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. HADORABLE MEC** - Has needed both runs this year, the latest when 8th in a class F at Nimes over 2750m on 19 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset
- 2. JOLAN BOY** - In good form and was a runner-up in a class F at Nimes over 2750m on 19 April. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
- 3. KAPORAL VISAIS** - Successful in a class E over this track and trip on 6 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of doubling up
- 4. GRANIT PACO** - Battling to find best form and finished 10th in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Needs major improvement to win
- 5. IGGY Fafa** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 3 March. Did better last year and is capable of an upset
- 6. IN THE AIR DELO** - Unreliable but was fourth in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 15 April. Remains barefoot and could make the frame
- 7. INEDIT D'ALEX** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class F at Oraison over 3200m on 26 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 8. IMPACT CASTELETS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 25 March. Remains barefoot but needs to do more to score
- 9. GLADIATOR DE NIMES** - Finished 10th in a class F at Oraison over 3200m on 26 April. On a long losing run and others make more appeal
- 10. KRISTAL DREAM** - Did not show his best when 9th in a class F at Nimes over 2750m on 19 April. Reverts to barefoot and can be a serious challenger for top honours
- 11. INO DE BRION** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 22 April. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 12. IBRA TEJY** - Not reliable but was barefoot and fourth in a class E over this track and trip on 1 May. Remains without shoes and has a place chance
- 13. IBIZA DE BOURGOGNE** - Off form and was unplaced in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Others are much preferred

Summary: KAPORAL VISAIS (3) was a good winner over this course and distance about a month ago and has every chance of doubling up. KRISTAL DREAM (10) starts on the second row but is capable of being a threat, as he is barefoot and ready to strike. JOLAN BOY (2) remains in good form and can contest the finish yet again. IN THE AIR DELO (6) is not reliable but is a possible winner if showing his best form, so must be respected.

C3 - PX DU DOMAINE SAINT JEAN DE LA CAVALERIE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- 1. INSTRUCTOR** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 29 April. Capable making the frame when smart
- 2. ISEO DE LOU** - A winner of a class D at Lyon-Parilly over 1609m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and is quite capable of doubling up
- 3. HIVER D'AUTHISE** - Has struggled this year and finished 7th in a class D at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. Reverts to barefoot but more is needed to be a threat to these rivals
- 4. ILLICO DU JAS** - Disqualified in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 29 April. Unreliable but is capable of an upset on best form
- 5. HEYDAY** - Unplaced in a class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 29 April. Reverts to barefoot and could be competitive
- 6. IRON D'ESPOIR** - Only modest of late and finished 10th in a class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 29 April. Reverts to barefoot and is a threat this time
- 7. GO AWAY BIRD** - Off form and was unplaced in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 18 April. Needs major improvement to score
- 8. IPPON DE MONTCEAU** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 18 April. Remains barefoot and could contest the finish
- 9. HARBOUR D'ORGERES** - Disqualified in a class D at Avignon over 2675m on 1 April. Remains barefoot but has struggled to find form this year
- 10. HAYASTAN DE ROSAN** - Off form and was unplaced in a class E at Cavaillon over 2600m on 29 March. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score

Summary: ISEO DE LOU (2) proved successful over the very short course at Lyon-Parilly. He looks capable of following up over this distance as well. IPPON DE MONTCEAU (8) has only been modest of late but remains a threat for David Békaert. IRON D'ESPOIR (6) will be racing without shoes this time around, so expect an improved performance. HEYDAY (5) is also barefoot for this race and is quite capable of getting into the mix of things.

**C4 - PRIX DU PASINO-HYERES - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness -
EUR € 23,000**

- 1. JAZZ BUROIS** - Disqualified in a class F at Oraison over 2650m on 12 April. Not reliable but is quite capable of scoring when in the right mood
- 2. KAPITANO DREAM** - Did not show his best when unplaced in a class F at Nimes over 2750m on 19 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of getting into the mix of things
- 3. KOOPLES ERA** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class G over this course and distance on 1 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 4. JAMES BOND** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 21 September. Remains barefoot and is capable of scoring returning from a break
- 5. KITKO TEJY** - In very good form and was runner-up in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 17 April. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
- 6. KENAVO DU BOUILLON** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class G over this track and trip on 1 May. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 7. KANEA DE L'ABBAYE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 22 March. Others make more appeal
- 8. JEAN D'HOLLENBOURG** - Successful in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 2400m on 24 April. Remains without shoes and can contest the finish
- 9. KING GIORGIO** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 10. JOLLY LOOK** - In good form and finished fourth in a class G at this track over 2850m on 1 May. Capable of earning some minor money

Summary: A competitive looking race. KITKO TEJY (5) has been disqualified twice at this course before but comes here in good form and gets a narrow vote to score. JAZZ BUROIS (1) faulted last time out at Oraison about a month ago but is capable of contesting the finish when in the right mood. JAMES BOND (4) returns from a break but would not be a surprise winner. KAPITANO DREAM (2) remains barefoot and is another that could get involved in the finish.

C5 - PRIX PROVENCE MEDITERRANEE TOURISME - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LETOILE AMERICAINE** - Unreliable and finished 11th in Class F at Nimes over 2750m on 19 April. Victorious on two occasions this year and has a winning chance
- 2. LIBERIAN GIRL** - Did not show her best when 8th in class F at Nimes over 2750m on 19 April. Some good wins before that and can bounce back to score
- 3. LIBERTE DU RIB** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May when barefoot. Might play a minor role at very best
- 4. LOLITA DES CHAMPS** - Did not show her best when 9th in a claimer at Montlucon over 3025m on 19 April. Victorious earlier in April but this is a tougher race
- 5. LORINA LOULOU** - Has needed both runs this year and was 12th in class E at Feurs over 2100m on 20 April. Barefoot this time and is ready to strike
- 6. LUNA MAG** - Disqualified in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Remains barefoot but is better under the saddle and others make more appeal
- 7. LUTTE DU LOGIS** - Not reliable and was 11th in Class F at Oraison over 3200m on 26 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. L'ILE DU TRIEUX** - Not reliable and was 9th in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 26 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 9. LA FLEUR** - Needed her last run when 6th in class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 3 May. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 10. LECTURE PRIVEE** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class F at Oraison over 3200m on 26 April. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 11. LINEA DE CRENNES** - Victorious in Class G over this track and trip on 25 April. Keeps that shoeing and is capable of following up

Summary: LIBERIAN GIRL (2) is clearly better than what she showed on grass and can bounce back to beat these rivals but she will have to shake off some challengers. LETOILE AMERICAINE (1) is not reliable but has won twice this year already. LORINA LOULOU (5) will strip fitter this time and is barefoot and a lively danger. LINEA DE CRENNES (11) will keep the same shoeing as her course and distance success and is another to consider.

**C6 - PRIX ROLAND JAFFRELOT - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR
€ 19,500**

- 1. MAGIQUE REVAT** - Disqualified on debut in class F at La Gacilly over 2300m on 6 July. Returns from a lengthy break and could need it
- 2. MAZEL DU JAS** - Finished 7th on debut in class G at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Could need this run returning from a break
- 3. MAHATMA** - Only modest so far and was 7th in class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 29 April. Unreliable and needs to fo a bit more to score
- 4. MIMOSA DEVOL** - Not reliable and finished 9th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 3 May. Has yet to score but is barefoot and a lively danger
- 5. MONT VENTOUX** - Showed some improvement when 4th in class G at Nimes over 2750m on 19 April. Remains barefoot and should be a threat if smart
- 6. MODIANO MAY** - Not reliable but was a runner-up in class G at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 1 May. Can go one place better
- 7. MADNESS DOLCE** - Disqualified in his last four starts, the latest in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Has disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 8. MADISON ATALANTE** - Not disgraced when 5th in class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 20 March. Yet to win a race but has claims in this line-up
- 9. MILLENIUM ROC** - In good form and was runner-up in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 3 February. Returns from a short break but is not out of it

Summary: MADISON ATALANTE (8) has yet to taste winning success but does have claims in a very competitive-looking race. MODIANO MAY (6) is not reliable but only found one better on the day earlier this month and is a serious danger. MONT VENTOUX (5) showed some improvement at Nîmes and could have more to offer. MIMOSA DEVOL (4) has yet to score and is unreliable but can also get into the thick of things over this distance.

EUR € 19,500**

- 1. MIRACLE GIRL** - Victorious in Class F at this courseover 2650m on 25 April. Remains in good form and is capable of following up
- 2. MIDYLE D'ALFRAN** - Off form and finished 10th in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Did a lot better last year but others make more appeal
- 3. MILADY D'ALEX** - Did not show her best when 6th in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Is consistent and can make the frame
- 4. MADISON DE NIMES** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and 5th in class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 15 April. Not this time and others are preferred
- 5. MOUNA D'OLIVERIE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. MIA DE MALIKEN** - Needed her only run of the year when 6th in class F at Chartres over 2800m on 26 April. Has a place chance on best form
- 7. MOON TURGOT** - Unreliable but was 3rd in class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 29 April. Not easy to trust but can get involved with the finish
- 8. MEJANES** - Did not show her best when 7th in class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 25 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 9. MAMZELLE CARLESS** - Yet to win but was a runner-up in class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 29 April. Keeps that shoeing and can go one better
- 10. MANDOLINE** - In good shape and finished 4th in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Can be competitive in this line-up

Summary: A very tricky lucky last race. MAMZELLE CARLESS (9) hinted that a winning turn was not far away for her with a solid performance at Marseille-Borély. She can go one better this time. MOON TURGOT (7) is unreliable but also capable of getting involved in the finish. MILADY D'ALEX (3) is often competitive and that consistency could result in a winning turn in a race of this nature. MIRACLE GIRL (1) could follow up on her recent course-and-distance success.
