- 2. MOLLY JACH A winner on debut in Class G at Jullouville-les-Pins over 2700m on 29 May. Tackles tougher but may well be up to it
- **3. MILA DES COUPERIES -** Did all that was asked of her when scoring on debut in Class F at Ecommoy over 2750m on 21 April. Can follow up
- 4. MALICIA Only modest of late and was 5th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 17 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win

- **4. MAZZARINO -** Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 26 May. Did better at this course before that and could earn some minor money
