- **1. HORSE DU HENNEQUIN -** Unplaced in a class F at this track over 2750m on 18 December. Probably will need the run back
- **2. INVICTUS ORADEL -** A runner-up in the latest in a class F at Les Andelys over 2525m on 30 June. In the last two efforts at this track, he has made the frame finishing third on both occasions
- **3. IVORINO D'ECHAL -** Disqualified in a class E at Vire over 2700m on 1 July. Major disqualification issues and is probably best watched for now
- **4. INTELLO D'ERABLE -** Improving and ran well when third in a class E at Caen over 2450m on 10 June. He reverts to barefoot and is in good form of late. Should contest the finish again
- **5. IDEAL DU GOULOT -** Ran well when third in a class E at Montmirail over 3225m on 30 June. Remains barefoot and has a victory, a place in three attempts in this arrangement

- **9. FIDELO BEJI -** Well beaten 9th in a class F at Chartres over 2825m on 30 June. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of surprising
- **10. GOSSE DES MOLLES -** Consistent when fourth in a class F at Dozulé over 2900m on 16 June. Can play a minor role again

- **2. KISS YOU PIYA -** Ran fourth in a class E at Enghien over 2875m on 29 June. He finished off well in the latest start and remains in the same shoeing arrangement. Respect
- **3. KING BABEL -** Well beaten 8th in a class D at Caen over 2450m on 24 June. Two poor efforts this year and others are preferred
- **4. JAG DE ROZEVIC -** Disqualified in the last two, the latest in a class E at Lisieux over 2725m on 7 June. Yoann Lebourgeois partnered him to his last victory and can pop up again
- **5. KING BLACK DANOVER -** Improved effort when third at this track over 2050m on 2 July. If wise can play a minor role
