- **3. DENHAM BLACK -** 2nd over 3500m last time at Nantes in a Class 3 race. More needed to get the win but he can not be discounted
- **4. NUAGE BLEU -** A promising debut run when 2nd over 3700m in a Class 3 hurdle race in late November. Can progress and be involved

- **10. KODENAME MACALO -** Newcomer by Karaktar, from a respected trainer who will have this gelding well schooled. Watch the betting for clues
- **11. BEAUTYSTARS -** Unraced gelding by Storm The Stars, might need this opening run. Monitor the betting for clues
- **12. KAMARAD DE SIVOLA -** 4th on the latest run on the flat over 2350m in early November in a Class 3 race. Makes his hurdling debut and ought to be thereabouts
- **13. PLUME DU NORD -** Unraced gelding by Choeur Du Nord, improvement can be gained from this run. Market support should be noted
- **14. TOUZ THE STARS -** Three runs so far on the level. 4th over 1200m in July two runs back. The trip is an unknown and others make more sense

Summary: DON LOOK COCO (2) has run well on both of his runs over hurdles. His latest effort was a pleasing second at Angers in early November over 3400m. This looks like a good chance for him to get off the mark. The main threat could be NUAGE BLEU (4) who was a promising second in a Class 3 hurdle race in late November on his racecourse debut. He can only improve from that run. KINGPARK (1) is an each-way must. DENHAM BLACK (3) also merits consideration.

FARAH (1) can put a below-par run behind her last time and ought to be involved in this. IL Y A (3) is worth considering after a nice run last time when she was third at Fontainebleau last month.
