### C1 - PRIX DES PARADES DE NOEL D'AMIENS - 2400m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- **1. MOANA DE WALLIS -** Unreliable and finished third in class F at Reims over 2550m on 23 November. Can contest the finish again
- **2. MALOUINE DU BIS** Disqualified in class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 23 November. Won well at Lisieux before that and can bounce back to score
- 3. MALICE DU CHATAULT A winner of a class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 2 November. Fitter this time and is capable of doubling up
- **4. MADOVA DU RILER -** Only modest of late and finished 9th over this course and distance on 26 November. Capable of playing a minor role
- **5. MY QUEEN DELO -** Holding form and finished fourth in class F at Reims over 2550m on 23 November. Can be competitive once again
- **6. MAJESTE DU MENIL -** Not reliable but was fourth in class F over this track and trip on 13 November. Can be in the mix of things again
- **7. MARIBEL MAGNIFIQUE -** Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in a class F at this track over 2400m on 13 November. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **8. MAHRANA DU HAUTY** Only modest of late and finished 6th over this track and trip on 26 November. Needs to do a lot more to win this race
- **9. MAM'ZELLEPAZENAISE -** Did not show her best when 6th in class F at Reims over 2550m on 23 November. Consistent before that and has a place chance
- **10. MELODY DE L'EPINE -** Battling to regain best form and finished 10th in class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 28 November. Needs major improvement to win
- **11. MANON BLONDE -** Disqualified in a Mounted class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 15 October. Capable of playing a minor role if staying on stride
- **12. MIA DE CHENU -** Disqualified in class F at Le Sap over 2625m on 10 August. Hard to trust and could need this run returning from a break
- **13. MA CHOUCHOU -** Unreliable and finished 6th in class F over this course and distance on 13 November. Might play a minor role
- **14. MIA DU BLEQUIN** Much improved last run when runner-up in a class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 23 November. Can go one better

**Summary:** A very open-looking first event. MALOUINE DU BIS (2) faulted last time out at Cherbourg but is better judged on a good win at Lisieux, so gets a narrow vote to score. MALICE DU CHATAULT (3) returned from a break with a good win and can follow up if in the same mood. MOANA DE WALLIS (1) is not reliable but hinted at a winning turn with a good performance at Reims. MY QUEEN DELO (5) is consistent and clearly not out of it.

- **1. LIBERTANGO -** Disqualified in class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 16 November. In good form before that and can bounce back to score
- **2. LUCKY FIX** Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 9 November. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **3. LUCKY DE LINE -** A winner of his last two starts, the latest in class F at Vire over 2800m on 16 November. Can complete his hat-trick
- **4. LOOK D'ALB -** Not reliable and was fifth in class F at Reims over 2550m on 10 November. Tries barefoot and could upset
- **5. LASCAUX DU PERCHE -** Showed some improvement when fourth in a class F ovr this track and trip on 26 November. Needs to do a bit more this time
- **6. LUCKY DELADOU -** Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 9 November. Reverts to barefoot and could be a threat
- **7. LOOPING BEN MAX -** Showed some improvement when fourth in class F at Reims over 2550m on 10 November. Reverts to barefoot and could do better but has disqualification issues

- **9. LOOK DAIRPET -** Not reliable and finished 7th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 30 November. More is needed to win this race
- **10. LEADER TURGOT -** Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in class F at Caen over 2450m on 15 November. Might play a minor role if smart

**Summary:** LUCKY DE LINE (3) has won both his starts for these trainers and sets the standard in the race. LUCKY DELADOU (6) is not easy to trust but is barefoot and could contest the finish. LATINO BELLO (11) faulted last time out but is another that could get involved with the finish.

- **2. KIARA DE LANDEMER -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced in class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 23 November. Reverts to barefoot and could play a minor role
- **3. KEILA DU PERCHE** A winner of a class H at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 2 November. Unexposed, reverts to barefoot and can follow up
- **4. KALLIOPE DU CAIEU -** Not disgraced when fifth in a class F over this course and distance on 26 November. Capable of making the frame
- **5. KALAMATA BEACH -** Has struggled of late and was 8th in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 30 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. KROKEUSE** Unreliable and was unplaced in class F at Reims over 2500m on 10 November. Capable of an upset on best form
- **7. KALIFORNIE -** Holding form and was not disgraced when fifth in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 23 November. Can contest the finish

- **3. IMPERATOR DE CARSI -** A winner of a class G at La Capelle over 2700m on 11 November. Reverts to barefoot and is very consistent. Be right there at the finish
- **4. ITHENA DE GAJUEL** Only modest of late and finished 6th in class F at Saint-Malo over 2850m on 1 November. Might play a minor role a best

- **3. JUNIOR ANGELE -** Battling to regain best form and finished 9th in class E at Graignes over 2725m on 20 November. Reverts to barefoot and could surprise
- **4. JASMIN PHIL** Disqualified in a class E at Graignes over 2725m on 20 November. Remains barefoot and can be a threat on best form
- **5. JIMBO SPORT -** Ultra-consistent and was runner-up in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 19 November. Can go one place better

- **4. NAXOS DIBAH -** Has run well in both starts and was runner-up in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2000m on 21 November. Be right there at the finish
- **5. NAPOLI DU BOUFFEY -** A winner of a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 30 November. Can be competitive over this distance as well
