Stable companion REGULATION has won back-to-back course-and-distance races but completing the hat-trick demands another career-best performance. MAJOR MASTER, ZEITZ and LA PULGA are held by that rival but can get into the picture. OKAVANGO and Highveld raider THE EQUATOR are weighted to be competitive too.

TENANGO finished behind the selection in a 1200m Grade 1 on 27 July and may have to play second fiddle again over this shorter trip, even on 0.5kg better terms. ASIYE PHAMBILI won a course-and-distance Grade 3 last time out but has more to do against male rivals. Last-start winners CONSTELLATION, OUTLAW KING and KINGKUNDEE are at the top of their games so warrant respect.

FIRE ATTACK, COSMIC SPEED, GLADATORIAN and THE REAL PRINCE are proven top-level performers not to be ignored.

Class-droppers POWERANDTHEGLORY, AIR RAID and AVERSATOR ought to fare better in these calmer waters. Watch out for reserve runners DELTA PRIDE.
