C1 - PRIX DE DIEPPE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. LOLITA** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class E at this track over 2850m on 16 November. Returns from a break but has a place chance on best form
- 2. LOVINA PERRINE** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class D at this track over 2850m on 19 January. Needs major improvement to win
- 3. LESDY MAGODA** - In good form and was runner-up in Class D at this track over 2850m on 19 January. Can go one place better
- 4. LAISSEZ FAIRE** - Has won her last three starts, the latest in Class D at this track over 2100m on 14 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 5. LA FORMIDABLE** - Has won two of her last three starts, including last time out at Avenches over 2350m on 7 November. Can earn some more money if fit enough
- 6. LAIKA DES MARES** - In good shape and finished 4th in a Class D at this track over 2100m on 25 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. LADY DE VANDEL** - Clearly needed her come back run when 6th in Class D over this course and distance on 24 January. Remains barefoot and can resume winning ways
- 8. LADY DES ARRIS** - Unreliable and finished 10th in Class D over this track and trip on 24 January. Needs to do more to score
- 9. LA MITIDJA** - Has needed her last two starts, the latest when 6th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 13 January. Can be a threat fitter this time
- 10. LADY DE SAFRAN** - Not disgraced when 4th in a Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 16 January. Might play a minor role at very best
- 11. LA DAME DE COEUR** - Did not show her best when 12th in Class D over this course and distance on 24 January. Barefoot this time and could make the frame
- 12. LEMONADE FIZZ** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class D at this track over 2850m on 4 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 13. LUNA HAUFOR** - Disqualified in her last two starts, the latest at this track on 13 January. Capable of being competitive when staying in stride

Summary: A very competitive opening event. LADY DE VANDEL (7) clearly needed her last run and is sure to do a lot better this time around, so could score. LA MITIDJA (9) finished ahead of that rival when last running without shoes and is clearly a danger. LA DAME DE COEUR (11) is barefoot this time, so it is easy to ignore her last run, and she should be competitive. LUNA HAUFOR (13) has a pair of recent disqualifications but is capable of being successful when staying on the trot.

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**C2 - PRIX DE GUERLESQUIN - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
35,000**

- 1. MONIE DU LOISIR** - Successful in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 25 January. Improving and is clearly not out of it
- 2. MATINA D'ORLY** - Showed improvement and finished 3rd in Class E at this track over 2700m on 1 February. Should contest the finish
- 3. MADEMOISELLE JOLIE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class E at this track over 2175m on 20 January. Has disqualification issues but can contest the finish
- 4. MAISY DU DONJON** - Did not show her best form when 6th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 8 October. Returns from a break but can earn some money if fit enough
- 5. MONANZA CASTEL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track on 20 December. Can be a threat to these rivals if smart this time
- 6. MANZANA** - Consistent and finished 3rd in Class E at this track over 2100m on 30 January. Can be competitive this longer distance as well
- 7. MA DOUCE DE DALINE** - May have just needed the run when fourth in Class E at Angers over 2350m on 28 January. Fitter now and could score
- 8. MELODIE D'AMOUR** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in a Class E at this track over 2700m on 25 December. Can make the frame with improvement expected

Summary: A very tricky race, and it is hard to rule out any of them. MA DOUCE DE DALINE (7) won some nice races last year and could have needed her last two starts, so can score. MADEMOISELLE JOLIE (3) is unreliable and does have disqualification issues, but can be a lively danger when staying in stride. MONANZA CASTEL (5) has faulted twice in a row but does have some ability and can score if smart. MELODIE D'AMOUR (8) is capable of improvement and is another to consider.

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C3 - PRIX DE FALOT - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 33,000

- 1. NEXIT PAS GASSEL** - A three-year-old colt by Exit Money out of Belle Star Gassel who is making his debut. His Dam was unraced. Others are preferred
- 2. NINO D'AMOUR** - A three-year-old gelding by Dragon du Fresne out of Fidji d'Ourville who is making his debut. His mother did not win a race after 66 tries. Others make more appeal
- 3. NORTON KADESH** - Disqualified in all three starts so far, the latest at this track on 30 January. Probably best watched for now
- 4. NORD INTENSE** - Finished 4th on debut in a Class F mounted race at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 February. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 5. NICE DREAM MESLOIS** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a Class C at this track over 2700m on 30 January. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 6. NEWCASH DE PHYT'S** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class D harness race at Angers over 2350m on 15 January. Has mounted race experience and could be a threat
- 7. NEW YORK D'OYSE** - Has some air form and finished 4th in a Class C mounted race at this track over 2700m on 30 January. Can contest the finish
- 8. NEED FOR LOVE** - Successful in a Class F harness race at Machecoul over 2700m on 1 February. Tries a mounted race but might follow up
- 9. NEW LOOK VRIE** - Victorious on debut in a Class F harness race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 31 January. Can follow up trying a mounted race
- 10. NECTAR DE BOMO** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class D mounted over this track and trip on 15 January. Capable of making the frame

Summary: A tricky race, as both recent winners NEW LOOK VRIE (9) and NEED FOR LOVE (8) scored in harness races. NEW LOOK VRIE (9) impressed with a debut victory but now has to prove himself under the saddle. NEED FOR LOVE (8) showed improvement with his second start and could be a threat if as effective in this discipline. NEWCASH DE PHYT'S (6) could be a lively danger, as he already has experience under the saddle. NECTAR DE BOMO (10) has been unreliable but can make the frame.

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**C4 - PRIX DE SELESTAT - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR €
33,000**

- 1. NOTE IMPERIALE** - Finished 3rd on debut in Class F at Nantes over 2275m on 19 January. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. NALA** - Successful on debut in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 25 January. Drops in distance but must be respected for that win
- 3. NALA LEALMANI** - Knocking very loudly and was runner-up in Class D at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 26 January. Should contest the finish once again
- 4. NORMA DU TRIEUX** - Not disgraced when 4th in a Class F at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 1 February. Capable of earning some minor money
- 5. NICE PACE** - Unreliable but was victorious in Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 23 January. Can be a threat to these rivals if smart
- 6. NOGHERA COUNTESS** - Disqualified at this track on 5 February. Did better before that and could play a minor role at very best
- 7. NEW WAVE** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in Class F at Laval over 2050m on 15 November. Returns from a break but has a place chance
- 8. NACARIE PRINCESSE** - Has some fair form and finished third in Class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 14 January. Tougher task in this line-up
- 9. NOOR DU CAMPUS** - Has run well in both starts and finished 3rd in Class D at this track over 2700m on 30 December. Can win this shorter distance
- 10. NORDIC GIRL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the lastest at Rouen-Mauquenchy on 26 January. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 11. NIKITA HONEY** - Showed some promise when 3rd on debut in Class F at Angers over 2425m on 21 January. Could earn some more money

Summary: A very open race. NOOR DU CAMPUS (9) showed improvement second time out and that form could hold up best. NALA LEALMANI (3) has improved with each run and is threatening a first success. NICE PACE (5) showed what she is capable of with a win at Saint-Brieuc and could have more wins in the tank. NALA (2) did all that was asked of her with a victory on debut at Lyon-La Soie, but this shorter distance might test her.

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C5 - PRIX DE JOSSELIN - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

1. **MUSIQUE CLASSIQUE** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 14 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
2. **MANOU DU CHENE** - Disqualified last time out at Caen on 11 October. Has disqualification issues and could need this run returning from a break
3. **MAHIZ DE GUEZ** - Consistent and was runner-up in Class D at this track over 2700m on 19 December. Capable of earning some money
4. **MERRY RIVER** - Consistent and finished 4th at this track over 2850m on 29 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
5. **MESSINA** - Disqualified twice in last three starts including at Enghien on 10 August. Likely to need this run returning from a break
6. **MAMOUNIA SEVEN** - Holding form and finished 4th in Class B over this track and trip on 19 January. Capable of making th frame
7. **MISS BLACK BERRY** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class B at this track over 2700m on 3 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
8. **MAYA GERBEHAYE** - In good shape and finished 4th in Class B over this track and trip on 24 January. Could earn some money
9. **MISSLADY DU VICLAU** - Much improved last run when 3rd in Class B over this course and distance on 19 January. Not easy to trust but is also not out of it
10. **MERIBEL** - Did not show her best when 8th in Class C at this track over 2700m on 30 December. Others make more appeal
11. **MA LIBERTE** - Disqualified at this track on 17 January. Barefoot for the first time and is capable of winning again when staying in stride
12. **MY SAVE QUICK** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class C at this track over 2700m on 30 December. Barefoot for the very first time and can be successful
13. **MAYOLA VEDAQUAISE** - Very consistent anf finished 3rd in Class B at this track over 2700m on 3 February. Looks likely to be competitive once again
14. **MARVINA BELLA** - Showed improvement when 3rd in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Should be right there at the finish
15. **MY HAPPY STORY** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class B at this track over 2700m on 3 February. Needs to do bit more to beat these rivals

Summary: A very competitive-looking race. MY SAVE QUICK (12) has shown ability and will be racing without shoes for the first time, so gets a narrow vote to score. MA LIBERTE (11) is hard to trust with many disqualifications, but she is barefoot and quite capable of victory if staying in stride. MY HAPPY STORY (15) ran a cracker in a Group 3 last time out and must be respected on that form. MAYOLA VEDAQUAISE (13) is very consistent and clearly has claims of scoring.

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C6 - PRIX DE VILLEDIEU - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 36,000

1. **KEIGHT BLESS** - Showed improvement when 5th in a Class D at this track over 2850m on 19 January. Has disqualification issues but that was a good run in a stronger race than this. Big chance if smart
2. **KARAMEL TENDRE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Amiens on 6 September. Returns from a break and is probably best watched for now
3. **KORIOLIS DE ZIETTE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 12 January. Can earn some minor money
4. **KRONOS D'EOLE** - Much improved last run and was runner-up in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Can go one place better
5. **KRALL DE CORDAY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track on 27 January. Can be competitive if staying on the trot
6. **KALOU LA TRIGALE** - Disqualified at Lannemezan on 27 August. Had some fair form before that but is likely to need this run returning from a break
7. **KOBRA JENILOU** - Very consistent and finished 3rd in Class F at Argentan over 2800m on 24 January. Should be right there at the finish yet again
8. **KYMI JACK** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class F at Argentan over 2800m on 24 January. Should be competitive once again
9. **KILLER D'ENFER** - Consistent and finished 3rd in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 February. Has a place chance once again
10. **KUROS PONT VAUTIER** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class E at this track over 2100m on 27 January. Can play a minor role at very best
11. **KEN DE CORDAY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Graignes on 2 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
12. **KSAR UNICK** - A winner last time out in Class F at Argentan over 2800m on 24 January. In good shape and cannot be ruled out
13. **KALISKO** - Victorious in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 18 January. Remains barefoot and can follow up in this line-up
14. **KEL COPAIN** - Off form and finished 11th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 15 December. Needs to do more to score
15. **KATMAI** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Grenade-sur-Garonne on 25 January. Did win when last smart and is capable of an upset
16. **KEVERT** - Disqualified at Le Croisé-Laroche on 15 December. Capable of earning some minor money if staying in stride this time

Summary: A race where the list of possible winners is a lengthy one. KEIGHT BLESS (1) has disqualification issues but did run well in a better race than this, so gets a narrow vote to score. KOBRA JENILOU (7) is usually very competitive and can get involved with the finish once again. KRALL DE CORDAY (5) has had a couple of faults of late but can win a race of this nature. KALISKO (13) remains in good shape and would not be a surprise winner.

C7 - PRIX DE VITRE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- 1. SAM PIERJI (BEL)** - In good shape and was runner-up at Mons over 2840m on 27 January. Tackles stronger but can make the frame
- 2. SECRET OF LAW** - Very consistent and finished 4th at Milan over 1600m on 13 January. Tries further this time but is clearly not out of it
- 3. DUKE OF NEW YORK** - Has improved of late and was victorious at Gelsenkirchen over 1609m on 11 January. Barefoot but has to prove himself over this distance
- 4. FACE WISE AS** - Knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up at Milan over 1600m on 29 January. Can contest the finish this longer distance
- 5. FRISEE KB FONT** - Holding form and finished third at Montegiorgio over 1600m on 8 January. Tougher task in this line-up
- 6. LOUXOR DANICA** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E at this track over 2175m on 29 January. Capable of playing a minor role
- 7. LUCKY DU DONJON** - Has needed both recent runs and finished 8th in a Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 23 January. Barefoot this time and can score
- 8. LOUP SOLITAIRE** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 12 January. Does better when racing without shoes and should fight out the finish

Summary: The key to this race is clearly the distance. A number of the international runners have very good and consistent form, but over shorter trips. LUCKY DU DONJON (7) will strip fitter after two comeback performances, is racing barefoot, and looks ready to strike. LOUP SOLITAIRE (8) is also without shoes and should be competitive over a distance that suits. FACE WISE AS (4) and DUKE OF NEW YORK (3) have both impressed in their home countries over shorter distances and can be lively dangers if as effective over this trip.

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C8 - PRIX DE SENLIS - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 52,000

1. **IDREAMIS** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in Class F at Angers over 3125m on 28 January. Others make more appeal
2. **IRONIE DE CHENU** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 31 January. Can go one better
3. **ZANZA FRANK** - FHas some fair form and finished 3rd in Class E at Nantes over 2275m on 25 January. Has a place chance on best form
4. **SILVER BULLIT(SWE)** - Not reliable but finished 3rd at Gelsenkirchen over 2000m on 1 January. Quite capable of earning some more money
5. **ISLA (GER)** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D over this track and trip on 3 February. A good winner before that and can score again
6. **HELALI DE MONTCEAU** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E over this track and trip on 31 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
7. **HAROLD SAUTONNE** - Off form and finished 13th in Class D over this course and distance on 3 January. Needs major improvement to win
8. **OSCAR VAN HALBEEK** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class E at this track over 2850m on 13 January. Can contest the finish this shorter distance
9. **ROSSI GARLINE** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score
10. **COSMICO POLARE** - Did not show his best when 9th in Class D over this track and tripon 26 December. Better over further but might play a minor role
11. **SIDNEY CELEBER** - Disqualified at this track on 14 December. Unreliable but is better judged on his penultimate start when runner-up. Has claims at winning
12. **LORENZO BOKO** - Disqualified at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 January. Unreliable but might pop up in a minor place

Summary: A very open race. ISLA (GER) (5) is very speedy and won over this course and distance in her penultimate start. That form earns her the selection vote. IRONIE DE CHENU (2) has a good record when barefoot and should challenge for top honours once again. SIDNEY CELEBER (11) is unreliable but does have a chance of winning if at his best. OSCAR VAN HALBEEK (8) is also unreliable but could be competitive over this shorter distance.

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C9 - PRIX DE MACHECOUL - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR € 42,000

1. **DEVIL OP** - Not reliable but finished 3rd in a Class D mounted race this course over 2700m. Has a place chance on best form
2. **PATTON (SWE)** - Has won his last 6 starts, the latest in a Class D harness race at this course over 2850m on 19 January. Tries a mounted race but can score again
3. **JAMES MADRIK** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 February. Needs major improvement to win
4. **DEE GODFATHER** - A winner of three of his last four starts, including last time out in a Class E mounted race at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Clearly not out of it
5. **GLOBAL ENJOY** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a harness race at Eskilstuna over 2140m on 17 January. Capable of an upset back in a mounted race
6. **KWARTZ SIBEY** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in a Class C mounted race at this track over 2700m on 27 January. Races without shoes and could earn some money
7. **KILOU D'YMER** - Very consistent when fully barefoot and finished 3rd in a Class C mounted race at this course over 2700m on 27 January. Not barefoot but might play a minor role
8. **XIA LLOYD** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class D harness race at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 29 January when barefoot. Not this time and others are preferred
9. **EMPIRE AS** - Disqualified last time out at this course. on 14 December. Did well in two mounted races before that and can contest the finish
10. **KADO SHINING** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a Class F mounted race at Angers over 3125m on 28 January. Has disqualification issues but might play a minor role when smart
11. **MANSKENSTOSEN** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class F mounted race at Angers over 3125m on 28 January. Did better over this course and distance before that. Barefoot and is a lively danger
12. **KENTUCKY FIRST** - Continues to shine under the saddle and was victorious in a Class C mounted race at this track over 2700m on 27 January.. Should be right there at the finish

Summary: A very interesting lucky last race. PATTON (SWE) (2) has won his last six starts and should win again if showing that form when trying a mounted race. EMPIRE AS (9) has done well in better races than this and can be competitive yet again. KENTUCKY FIRST (12) is probably better over further but does well under the saddle and is a threat. MANSKENSTOSEN (11) is racing without shoes this time around and is another that can get involved with the finish.
