## R3 TOULOUSE [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX DES AMIDONNIERS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E Amateur Riders  
- Harness - EUR € 21,000**

- 1. KOOPLES DE LARRE** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 29 March. Quite capable of making the frame yet again
- 2. KROONER D'ORION** - Did not show his best when 5th in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2050m on 9 February. Barefoot this time and is clearly not out of it
- 3. KOOL DU PORHOET** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class D at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 2 April. Might need to find a few lengths to score
- 4. KALOU LA TRIGALE** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class F at Castillonnès over 2450m on 8 March. Did win with this shoeing before that and can bounce back to score
- 5. JASMINE DES ETANGS** - A winner of three races last year and finished third last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 27 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 6. KANCAENNAISE** - Unreliable and finished 11th in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Better under the saddle and others make more appeal
- 7. KINAYA DU CHATELET** - Unreliable and finished tenth in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 22 March. A barefoot winner before that and remains without shoes and can strike again
- 8. KANGCHENJUNGA** - Disqualified last time out at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 9. KRISTAL DU PALAIS** - Not disgraced when finishing fifth in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March.. Likes this track and should fight out the finish
- 10. KAMARO DUEM** - Only modest of late and was barefoot and fifth in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 20 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 11. KING CRIMSON** - Victorious last time out in Class F at Castillonnès over 2450m on 6 April. Not reliable but could follow up

**Summary:** A typically open opener where several hold claims. KALOU LA TRIGALE (4) is not the most reliable but scored with this shoeing two starts ago and is capable of bouncing back to winning ways. KING CRIMSON (11) starts from the second row but arrives off a win and could follow up if in the same mood. KANGCHENJUNGA (8) likes this track, while KOOPLES DE LARRE (1) has been holding his form well of late and is another to consider.

## C2 - PRIX DE LA BARRIERE DE PARIS - 2950m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. NASON** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 22 March. Others make more appeal
- 2. NACRE GALAXY** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 14 January. Has a place chance on best form
- 3. NIRVANA PLAYA** - Successful on debut in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 2 April. Tougher task this time but is not out of it
- 4. NARNIA PAN** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class C at Toulouse over 2750m on 3 April. More is needed to beat these wins
- 5. NELLY DES CHARMES** - Chased home a short priced winner when runner-up in Class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Can go one better this time around
- 6. NABUCCO JIJI** - Disqualified in his first two starts but has improved since then and was victorious last time out in Class C at this course over 2150m on 7 February. Can double up this longer distance
- 7. NO RISK FLIGNY** - Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th in Class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Not out of it
- 8. NOT ALONE** - In good form and finished third in Class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Capable of earning some more money
- 9. NATIF DES CAILLONS** - Consistent and finished fourth in Class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 7 March. Can be a threat yet again
- 10. NANO UP STAR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 February. Not easy to trust but is capable of scoring when smart

**Summary:** NELLY DES CHARMES (5) is clearly talented and found only a smart rival too strong last time, setting the standard here. NABUCCO JIJI (6) is on the upgrade and impressed with a solid win at this track, with this longer trip unlikely to pose any issue. NANO UP STAR (10) has been let down by recent faults but remains a danger if staying in stride, while NIRVANA PLAYA (3) steps up in class after a winning debut and commands respect.

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## C3 - PRIX DU FER A CHEVAL - 2950m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 27,000

- 1. LADIVA DE VILLABON** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in a Class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 27 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. LILI** - On a long losing streak but was runner-up in a Class F mounted race over this course and distance on 3 April. Can earn some more money
- 3. LOTUS DES SABLES** - Yet to win a race and finished 6th in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 13 March. Might play a minor role
- 4. LOVE ME DE CERISY** - Disqualified in three of her last four starts, including last time out at Enghien over 2875m on 13 March. Hard to trust but can earn some money when wise
- 5. L'ARTISTE ZEN** - Unreliable but was barefoot and third in a Class F mounted race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2575m on 29 March. Not barefoot this time but might play a minor role
- 6. JADIS PRIOR** - Has needed both his runs this year and was tenth in a Class G harness race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 29 March. Fitter now and back in a mounted race. Can be a threat
- 7. JETHAN DE MONGOCHY** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a Class G harness race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 29 March. Barefoot this time but has struggled twice before in mounted races
- 8. LEGENDE DES ECUS** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class D harness race at Enghien over 2875m on 17 March. Can bounce back to score
- 9. LOUSTIC** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Vincennes over 2200m on 2 April. Capable of a victory when staying in stride
- 10. LATINO BEJI** - Victorious last time out in a Class D mounted race at Lisieux over 2725m on 26 March. At his best under the saddle and may well follow up
- 11. INCUDINE** - Did not show her best when 8th in a Class F mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 25 March. Has a place chance
- 12. KIRCIE DE GUEZ** - Battling to find best form and was tenth in a Class E harness race at Angers over 2350m on 1 April. Capable of being a threat back under the saddle
- 13. HEPICETOU** - Only modest of late and was 8th in a Class F harness race at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 2 April. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals

**Summary:** A competitive contest where several arrive with solid claims. LEGENDE DES ECUS (8) has been disappointing in harness of late but has a strong record under the saddle and looks poised to bounce back. LOUSTIC (9) faulted at Vincennes earlier this month but can go close if keeping his action together. LATINO BEJI (10) thrives in this discipline and could follow up his Lisieux success, while KIRCIE DE GUEZ (12) is another to note back in a mounted race.

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## C4 - PRIX DE CASSELARDIT - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MA BICHE NOA** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a Class E at Caen over 2200m on 19 March. Big chance in this line-up
- 2. MANHATTAN GABINLEA** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class D at this track over 2150m on 9 January. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 3. MADGIK SAUTREUIL** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class C at this track over 2950m on 22 January. More is needed to score
- 4. MILLENIUM GALAXY** - Disqualified at Enghien on 17 March. Has done well with this shoeing and should be a threat for Théo Briand
- 5. MAMBO DE CAHOT** - Succesful in a Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 17 March, Consistent and would not be a surprise winner
- 6. MARQUIS MARANDAIS** - Disqualified at this track on 19 February. Hard to trust but is capabl eof making the frame when staying on the trot
- 7. MAVINA DES ETANGS** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 24 March. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of an upset
- 8. MARC AURELE** - Disqualified at Enghien on 17 March. A good winner before that and remain barefoot and capable of scoring again
- 9. MARCOTTE D'ALBRET** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class E at this track over 2950m on 26 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 10. MIRA D'HAVAROCHE** - In good shape and finished 4th in a Class E at this track over 2750m on 3 April. Might earn some minor money at best
- 11. MIRABEAU** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a Class G at Beaumont-de -Lomagne over 2550m on 5 April. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 12. MAESTRO PYLA** - Returned from a break with a win in a Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 29 March. Looks capable of doubling up
- 13. MAJOR DU PADOUENG** - Disqualified at this track on 26 March. Has struggled this year and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 14. MI SUENO** - Disqualified at this track on 26 September. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run so others are preferred

**Summary:** A very open-looking contest where several bring solid claims. MA BICHE NOA (1) has been improving and could go one better after a pleasing effort at Caen last month. MILLENIUM GALAXY (4) is at his best with this shoeing and, with Théo Briand aboard, should go close. MARC AURELE (8) is capable on his day but lacks consistency, while the reliable MAMBO DE CAHOT (5) can build on a confidence-boosting recent success.

**C5 - PRIX DE NEGRENEYS - 2950m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
24,000**

- 1. L'ETOILE MASCAR** - Yet to win a race but was 3rd in a Class F at Castillonnes over 2450m on 6 April, Capable of contesting the finish
- 2. LILAS METIS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E at Beaumont-de Lomagne over 2550m on 5 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. L'AMIE JOSSELYN** - Disqualified at Beaumont-de Lomagne on 5 April. Has disqualification issues and needs major improvement to score
- 4. LADY BEAUTIFUL** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Enghien over 2875m on 4 August 2024. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
- 5. LUCIOLE DES VENTS** - Disqualified at this track on 20 March. Battling to find best form this year and others make more appeal
- 6. LIBERTINE DE FRECA** - Successful in 3 of her last 5 starts, including last time out in a Class F over this course and distance on 26 March. Should fight out the finish
- 7. LIKELY DU PADOUENG** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class E over this track and trip on 26 March. Can get into the mix of things
- 8. LITTLE CROWN** - Finished 4th in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 16 August. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 9. LA SPEZIA DE LOU** - Finished 3rd in a Class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. Showed improvement returning from a break and could score this time

**Summary:** LA SPEZIA DE LOU (9) showed clear improvement on her return from a break and that effort sets the standard here, with further progress expected. LIBERTINE DE FRECA (6) continues to thrive, winning three of her last five starts, and rates a serious danger. L'ETOILE MASCAR (1) is still a maiden but has enough ability to get involved, while the unreliable LIKELY DU PADOUENG (7) has the means to make the frame.

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## C6 - PRIX DU PONT DES DEMOISELLES - 2950m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. LATCHO DU CHAL** - Has struggled this year and finished 13th in a Class E at Caen over 2450m on 12 March. Needs major improvement to score
- 2. LORD FAFA** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in a Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 5 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 3. LEXO JELOCA** - Disqualified last time out at Beaumont-de-Lomagne on 5 April. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 4. LEOPARDUS** - A barefoot winner in a Class F at Argentan over 2875m on 29 March. Remains without shoes and could follow up
- 5. LYCAON DES VENTS** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a Class D at Montauban over 2400m on 11 October. Returns from a break but could earn some money if fit enough
- 6. LUIGI PAN** - Yet to win a race and finished 10th in a Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 29 March. Need to find a few lengths to be successful
- 7. LEWIS D'EVRON** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 5 April. Barefoot and should contest the finish this time around
- 8. LANCELOT ELLIS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 5 April. More is needed to score
- 9. LEXINGTON DU BOURG** - Disqualified last time out at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 18 November. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 10. LANCELOT DE BEYLEV** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2575m on 29 March. Not barefoot this time and others make more appeal
- 11. LE TRESOR KRAAILO** - Unplaced in a Class G mounted at Enghien over 2875m on 13 March. Capable of bouncing back to beat these rivals
- 12. LEKEVIN DESBOIS** - Holding form well and finished 4th in a Class E at Agen-Le-Passage over 2575m on 22 March. Can make the frame again

**Summary:** LE TRESOR KRAAILO (11) is not the most reliable but can be forgiven his latest under the saddle and has the ability to bounce back in this harness event. LEOPARDUS (4) concedes 25m but impressed when winning barefoot last time and remains unshod, making him a major player. LEWIS D'EVRON (7) is also barefoot and open to improvement, while the consistent LEKEVIN DESBOIS (12) should once again be involved at the finish.

- 1. NELSON GREENWOOD** - Unreliable and finished 13th in a Class A at Vincennes over 2850m on 3 January. Returns from a break but can bounce back to score
- 2. GAVROCHE DU GADE** - Unreliable and finished 13th in a Class E over this course and distance on 26 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 3. JASMIN BLANC** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in a Class E at Caen over 2200m on 9 March. Can go one place better
- 4. HASHTAG DE TAGOR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 25 January. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. IRRATI DUEM** - Disqualified at Marseille-Borely on 20 March. Not easy to trust but is capable of playing a minor role when smart
- 6. JACANA** - In good shape and finished 4th in a Class E at this track over 2950m on 7 February. Has a place chance on best form
- 7. ITALO DUEM** - Much improved last run when 4th in a Class E at Agen-le Passage over 2625m on 22 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 8. LORENZO BOKO** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a Class D at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 25 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 9. I AM EAGLE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class E at Agen-le Passage over 2050m on 3 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 10. GE DU MANOIR** - Unreliable and finished 12th in a Class F at Cazaubon-Barbotan over 2600m on 29 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 11. JOB DES LOUANGES** - Disqualified at Saint-Galmier on 12 March. A winner at this track before that and can be a threat yet again
- 12. HORIZON DU THAY** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E over this track and trip on 15 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 13. INVICTUS DU DOLLAR** - Not easy to trust and was disqualified at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 8 March. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of scoring when smart
- 14. DUNA DI GIRIFALCO** - Successful in a Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2950m on 29 March. Remains in good shape and could follow up

**Summary:** NELSON GREENWOOD (1) returns from a short break but has the benefit of the inside draw and looks well placed to strike in a race of this nature. DUNA DI GIRIFALCO (14) impressed with a solid win at Beaumont-de-Lomagne last month and is capable of following up. JASMIN BLANC (3) has not scored for over a year but has gone close recently, while JOB DES LOUANGES (11) can bounce back from a latest fault and has winning form at this track.

- 1. GAJAC** - Off form and finished 7th in a Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 25 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. INDOCILE** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 3 April. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 3. GAUCHO DE LA NOUE** - Mostly modest form of late and finished 5th in a Class E at Challans over 2900m on 22 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. IRON JET** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 6 March. Remains barefoot and is not out of it
- 5. HINDEN** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class C at Castillonnes over 2450m on 5 April. Barefoot this time but others are preferred
- 6. KINGSLAYER PELLINI** - Disqualified at Agen-le Passage on 3 March. Two good wins before that and can bounce back to beat these rivals
- 7. L.A.BOKO** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 4 April. Capable of doing better and could make the frame
- 8. HAMIGO** - Disqualified at this track on 3 April. Unreliable but is capable of popping up in a place every now and then
- 9. HERODO BELLO** - Finished 5th in a Class D at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 16 September. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 10. FOX PAPA TANGO** - Disqualified at this track on 3 April. Hard to trust and does need to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 11. HERCULE DE LEAU** - Probably needed both runs of the year and finished 9th in a Class D at Caen over 2450m on 9 March. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
- 12. IBIS QUICK** - Has some fair form of late and finished 4th in a claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 17 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 13. JEANNETTE PRIORY** - Showed some improvement and finished 4th in a Class D at Caen over 2450m on 5 March. Could contest the finish
- 14. FAKIR MERITE** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a Group 1 race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1609m on 8 March. Capable of an upset ,dropping in class

**Summary:** An interesting lucky last where a few bring solid credentials. KINGSLAYER PELLINI (6) can be forgiven his latest at Agen-Le Passage and, judged on his two previous wins, looks capable of bouncing back. JEANNETTE PRIORY (13) showed improvement at Caen and may have more to offer. IRON JET (4) remains barefoot and is not out of it on best form, while the unreliable L.A. BOKO (7) has the ability to get involved if in the right mood.
