**C1 - PRIX DU JOURNAL PARIS-TURF - 2850m (a2m) - Class F Race -
Harness - EUR € 17,500**

1. MAMBO PAT - Has struggled so far and was 11th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 30 April. Needs major improvement to win

2. MARION DU CHERISAY - Disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borely on 13 April. Capable of improving on that debut but others are preferred

3. MISS MARGOT - Did not run too badly when 5th on debut in Class G at Carpentras over 2100m on 20 April. Returns from a break and could need this run

4. MY WAY ENJOY - Did not show his best when 8th in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 30 April. Capable of better and could play a minor role

5. MAEVA DES PRES - Disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borely on 4 May. Only modest form before that and others make more appeal

6. MON BEAU MEC - Disappointing last run when 8th in Class G at Carpentras over 2100m on 20 April. Returns from a break and others are preferred

7. MELODIE D'HOULBEC - Disqualified last time out at Lyon-La Soie on 23 February. Did better on debut over 2050m at this track and does have a winning chance

8. MISS TAHITI - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Marseille-Borely on 30 April. Did run well in her penultimate start which was at this track. Not out of it

9. MALAGA DESBOIS - Has been disqualified twice in just four starts, including last time out at Marseille-Borely on 16 April. Probably better this distance and could contest the finish if wise

10. MERLIN DES CHAMPS - Bounced back to form with a good runner-up performance in Class G at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 13 April. Can go one better

11. MAGIC JANEIRO - Disappointing last run when 8th in Class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 16 April. Did better before that and can make the frame

12. MACUMBA DESBOIS - Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at this track on 1 May. Not easy to trust but can surprise if wise

13. MASSIMO - In good shape and finished fourth in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 30 April. Can fight out the finish again

Summary: MERLIN DES CHAMPS (10) bounced back from a disqualification with a good run at Marseille-Borely and can go one better this time. MASSIMO (13) has been more consistent than his stable companion and can be a threat once again. MELODIE D'HOULBEC (7) performed well on her debut, which was at this track, but then fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time out. MISS TAHITI (8) has disqualification issues but can win this race if she keeps her manners this time.

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C2 - PRIX DU CREDIT AGRICOLE PROVENCE COTE D'AZUR - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. FARCEUR DE L'INAM - Has really struggled of late and was 11th in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 16 April. Needs major improvement to win

2. GORLANDO LUDOIS - Has struggled this year and was 8th in Class E over this track and trip on 1 May. Barefoot this time but more is needed to win

3. EXTRA DE LUNOJO - In good form and was third in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 30 April. Can fight out the finish again

4. ILLICO DE CASTELLE - Has been consistent with this shoe arrangement and was victorious last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 12 April. Can double up

5. HOUPETTE ROSE - Has only been fair this year and was 5th in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 16 April. Did better last year and has a winning chance

6. GET UP DE VAUVILLE - On a long losing run but was fourth last time out in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 14 March. Can make the frame

7. IRIS RIVOISE - Showed some improvement when third in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 25 April. Can do even better this time

8. GEORGIO LE FOL - Has struggled of late and was 6th in Class E over this track and trip on 1 May. More is needed to beat these rivals

9. FORMIDABLE VOYAGE - Has struggled in all three starts this year and was 7th in Class E over this track and trip on 21 April. Others make more appeal

Summary: ILLICO DE CASTELLE (4) has improved of late and was an easy winner over this track and trip last month. He should follow up and beat these rivals. IRIS RIVOISE (7) showed some improvement at Marseille-Borély and can get involved in the finish once again. HOUPETTE ROSE (5) is usually not far behind but will need to rediscover her form from last year to win this race. EXTRA DE LUNOJO (3) is in good shape and would not be a surprise winner.

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C3 - PRIX HIPPODROMEDEHYERES.FR - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR € 38,000

1. HOT SUMMER - Very unreliable and was 7th in Clas B at this course over 2850m on 1 May. Capable of an upset this distance

2. HARRY LE BEAU - Finished 7th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 11 April. Capable of better and can fight out the finish

3. FARMER KERYVON - On a very long losing run but was runner-up last time out in Class B at this track over 2850m on 1 May. Can go one better this time

4. GENERAL DU NORD - Probably needed his only run of this year when 7th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 20 April. Capable of improvement but others are preferred

5. GABY DES VALS - Only modest of late and was 6th in Class B at Toulouse over 2325m on 21 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

6. FAVORI DE BRY - Returns from a break but was in good form and finished runner-up in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 16 January. Can contest the finish if fit

7. GIULIANO - Has disqualification issues but did run well when third in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 18 April. Has a winning chance

8. FAMEUX SAX - Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class B at this course over 2850m on 1 May. Barefoot this time but others are preferred

9. GREG DE NIRO - Has struggled this year and was 8th in Class D at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 18 April. Others make more appeal

10. GALOPIN DES CHAMPS - Disappointing last run when 8th in Class E at Cavaillon over 2600m on 26 April. Might play a minor role

11. FASHIONABLE QUICK - Showed vast improvement when fourth in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 30 April. Keeps that shoe arrangement and could play a minor role

Summary: A competitive-looking race. FARMER KERYVON (3) was not beaten far at this track earlier this month and can go one better if in the same mood. HARRY LE BEAU (2) did not show his best last time out but has been in good form all year and has a winning chance in this line-up. FAVORI DE BRY (6) returns from a break but could challenge for top honours again if fit. GIULIANO (7) is hard to trust but does contest the finish when in the right frame of mind.

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C4 - PRIX DU PASINO-HYERES - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. IL PRINCIPINO - Disappointing form of late and finished 8th in Class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 18 April. Might play a minor role

2. JAGUAR ATOUT - Showed some improvement when third in a claimer at Toulouse over 2325m on 25 April. More is needed to win this race

3. JAGUAR DU BOCAGE - Unreliable but was victorious last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 1 May. Can follow up if in the same mood

4. JOLI MEC D'AMOUR - Did not show his best when 8th in Class F at Nimes over 2750m on 5 April. Capable of better and has a place chance

5. IBRAHIC - In good shape and was fourth last time out in a claimer T Toulouse over 2325m on 25 April. Might earn some minor money

6. JAMAIQUE TURGOT - Not disgraced when 5th in Class F over this course and distance on 1 May. Should be involved with the finish again

7. IBRA TEJY - Disqualified last time out at this track on 1 May. Very unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win

8. JEEN LOVER - Returned to form with a Class E barefoot win at Castillonès over 2450m on 21 April. Remains barefoot and is not out of it

9. JEEK D'ACADIE - Disqualified last time out at this track on 1 May. Has disqualification issues but is quite capable of winning a race like this if wise

10. JAZZ BLUE - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class F over this track and trip on 1 May. Others make much more appeal

11. IMPACTDARCHE - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 2400m on 18 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: JAGUAR DU BOCAGE (3) was a good winner earlier this month over this course and distance. That was his first run for Stéphane Guelpa, and he looks likely to follow up. JAMAIQUE TURGOT (6) was fifth behind that rival on the day and can get a lot closer this time around. JEEK D'ACADIE (9) has disqualification issues but also has the ability to contest the finish when in the right mood. JEEN LOVER (8) bounced back with a win last time out, but this may be a tougher assignment.

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C5 - PRIX PROVENCE MEDITERRANEE TOURISME - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. KHALEESI DE KACY - In very good form this year and was victorious in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 14 April. Can follow up

2. KUEEN PEARL - Unreliable but has been runner-up in two of last three starts, with the latest being in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 1 April. Has disqualification issues but can win

3. KRISTINA DU CLOS - Has struggled of late and was 8th in a Mounted race at Angers over 2425m on 22 January. Others make more appeal

4. KAMILLE DU MESNIL - Disqualified at Nimes on 27 April. Is quite capable of being competitive over this course and distance

5. KANDY DU MIDI - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class E at Oraison over 2650m on 6 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win

6. KACY AND GEPE - Disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borely on 16 April. Has major disqualification issues but could play a minor role when wise

7. KLASS DE DOMPIERRE - A winner of three of her last four starts, including when barefoot last time out in Class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 21 April. Remains unshod and can double up

8. KENNY PEARL - Has improved of late and was fourth in Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 20 April. Can get involved with the finish

9. KAREN D'IRAI - Probably needed her only run of the year when 8th in Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 20 April. Barefoot this time and could pop up in a place

Summary: KUEEN PEARL (2) is clearly very hard to trust, but she is racing fully barefoot and is more than capable of winning a race like this, so she gets the vote to score. KHALEESI DE KACY (1) has won two of her last three starts, so it's a bit of a surprise that she is not fully barefoot for this race. KLASS DE DOMPIERRE (7) tackles stronger opposition this time but is in the form of her life and deserves respect. KENNY PEARL (8) is in good form and is another who could shine.

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C6 - PRIX DU JOURNAL VAR MATIN - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 19,500

1. LEGEND YOU - Finished 10th in class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 16 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win

2. LUTECE SMART - Only modest of late and was 6th in class E at this course over 2850m on 1 May. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win

3. LAURE DES FORGES - Not disgraced when 5th in class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 17 January. Victorious back on debut and can score here if fit from a break

4. LOUNA D'AUILLIER - Finished 9th in class H at Carpentras over 2650m on 20 April. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal

5. LEGENDE DE MAI - Finished 7th in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 4 May. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred

6. LIGNEE GEMA - Not disgraced when 5th in class H at Carpentras over 2650m on 20 April. Capable of better and has a winning chance

7. LECTURE PRIVEE - Much improved last run when third in class F at this track over 2850m on 21 April. Can do even better this time

8. LOUNA STAR - Showed some improvement when 5th in class F at Nimes over 2750m on 27 April. Victorious at this venue in March and can contest the finish

9. LOLITA DE RICO - 6th in class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 30 April. Unreliable since victorious in March. Others preferred

10. LOLA DU CHERISAY - Disqualified in class E at this track over 2850m on 1 May. On a long losing streak and others are preferred

11. LHASSA DE VANDEL - Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 25 April. Not easy to trust but is capable of scoring when wise

12. LILIBETH TURGOT - In good form and was runner-up in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 13 April. Big chance in this line-up

Summary: LILIBETH TURGOT (12) is in very good form and found only one too good on the day at Marseille-Borély last month. She can go one better this time. LIGNEE GEMA (6) will strip fitter now and deserves a winning turn after several runner-up performances early in her career. LECTURE PRIVEE (7) showed some improvement last time out but comes with disqualification issues and is hard to rely on. LHASSA DE VANDEL (11) races fully barefoot for the very first time and is another to consider.

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C7 - PRIX ROLAND JAFFRELOT - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 19,500

1. **LUCKY MAJYC** - Finished 6th in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 14 April. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
2. **LIVE UP STAR** - Finished 10th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 3 May. Has yet to win and is best watched for now
3. **LUBERON DE LA CRAU** - Disqualified in class F over this course and distance on 21 April. Unreliable and others are preferred this time
4. **LITCHI TURGOT** - Disqualified in class F at this track over 2650m on 12 April. Victorious in March and can contest the finish if wise
5. **LIDO SHOW** - Finished 8th in class F at this track over 2650m on 12 April. Yet to win a race and others are preferred
6. **LOUSTIC DU MIDI** - Finished 5th in class E over this course and distance on 1 May. Has disqualification issues and needs to do more to beat these rivals
7. **LUCKY ARCTIC** - Disqualified in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 April. Victorious twice before that and can bounce back to score
8. **LEADER DES APRES** - Disqualified in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 27 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of making the frame when smart
9. **LUCKY SKY** - In good form and was runner-up in class F at Nimes over 2750m on 27 April. Capable of getting involved with the finish
10. **L'OR DU MELEUC** - Finished fourth in class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 30 April. Might play a minor role at best
11. **L'AMIRAL D'EURVAD** - Disqualified in class E at Hyeres over 2850m on 1 May. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
12. **LUCKY MAN** - Victorious in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 30 April. Not easy to trust but can follow up if in the right mood
13. **LITTLE KING ELEVEN** - In good form and was fourth in class E over this track and trip on 1 May. Should be involved with the finish again

Summary: LUCKY ARCTIC (7) looked an unlucky loser last time out at Lyon-Parilly. He can make amends and take out this lucky last race. LITCHI TURGOT (4) fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time out but has ability and would not be a surprise winner. LUCKY MAN (12) is a hit-or-miss performer but is quite capable of winning when in the right mood. LITTLE KING ELEVEN (13) has improved of late and also holds a winning chance.
