# C1 - PRIX DE FONTAINEBLEAU - 3800m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Class 3 Race - Steeple Chase - EUR € 26,000

- 1. LEFORT JESSPI 4th last time over 3600m in a Class 4 chase at Cluny on April 26th. Might find a few of these too smart
- **2. LACRIMA -** Three unplaced runs of late, the latter over 3850m in a Class 2 handicap chase at Compiegne on April 2nd. Opposable
- **3. LOUPETSHOW -** Won last time over 3500m in a Class 4 chase at Montlucon on April 20th. Looks like she likes fences and is a live contender
- **4. LUKY DU REPONET -** 5th last time out in a Class 2 hurdle at Angers on February 26th. Capable of a bold show on chase bow
- **5. LYRICAL STAR -** Fair 2nd on chase debut at Haras-Du-Pin on April 13th over 3700m. Others make more appeal
- **6. LALOI -** 5th last time, she won before that over 3400m in a Class 3 hurdle at Angers on February 26th. Chase debut and is one to keep safe
- **7. LA P'TITE HISTOIRE -** Good win last time out over 3600m at Senonnes over hurdles on March 15th. She looks progressive and can win again on chase debut

**Summary:** LA P'TITE HISTOIRE (7) impressed with a strong hurdle win on her second start at Senonnes and is a confident choice despite making her chase debut. LUKY DU REPONET (4) brings consistent Class 2 hurdle form and rates as the main danger if adapting well to fences. LOUPETSHOW (3) has valuable chase experience, having won recently, and should not be underestimated. LALOI (6) makes her fencing debut and is worth a look, especially if strong in the market.

## C2 - PRIX DU JACQUEMART - 3800m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Handicap - Steeple Chase - EUR € 27,000

- **1. OBIDOS -** Two unplaced runs this year, the latter over 3800m in a Class 3 hurdle at Lyon Parilly on April 19th. Back over fences and others preferred
- **2. KAVARATTI -** Fell last time, 2nd before that over 4100m in a Class 2 handicap chase at Lyon Parilly on March 16th. One to pay attention too
- **3. HISO -** 4th on the latest run over 3850m at Fontainebleau on April 16th in a Class 4 chase. Outside place chance if back on song
- **4. JEANNE DE GUYE -** Fair 5th over 4100m in a Class 2 chase at Lyon Parilly on April 19th. Capable of being competitive
- **5. IDEAL D'ALLIER -** Won over 4200m in a Class 2 handicap chase at this track on December 14th. Hard to ignore at this racecourse
- **6. ACTION SPECIALE -** Ran well to be 2nd over 4200m in a class 4 chase at La Roche-Sur-Lyon on April 13th last time. Enters calculations
- **7. KNICK KNACK -** Failed to finish last time out, he was 2nd before that over 3800m in a Class 3 chase at Nancy on March 16th. Hard to overlook
- **8. KOUDOU -** Creditable 2nd over 4000m at Cluny on April 26th in a Class 4 chase. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **9. JEMPIKA -** Placed on the last two runs, 3rd on the latest over 3500m at Montlucon on April 20th in a Class 4 chase. Might find a few of these too smart
- **10. JEU DE PISTE -** Unplaced on the three runs this year, the latter over 3500m at Auteuil on April 20th in a Class 3 handicap chase. Stiff task ahead
- **11. JERICHO D'ALENE** 4th on the last start over 4500m at Lignieres on April 13th in a Class 4 chase. Still looking for that first win

**Summary:** KNICK KNACK (7) looks poised to bounce back after a non-completion last time and can take advantage of a more forgiving race. His earlier second at Nancy was solid. KAVARATTI (2) is the main threat, assuming a clear round—his Class 2 second at Lyon Parilly was strong form. JEANNE DE GUYE (4) has shown enough to warrant each-way support after a fair fifth last time, and IDEAL D'ALLIER (5) is another with claims if improving on recent efforts.

## C3 - PRIX DU MAJESTIC - 3800m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Handicap - Hurdles - EUR € 27,000

- **1. ILTONE** 7th last time in July last year, he won before that over 3600m at Clairefontaine on June 18th in a Class 2 hurdle. Return from a break and is worth consideration
- **2. EDITION ORIGINALE -** Nice effort to be 3rd over 3550m at Fontainebleau on April 16th in a Class 3 hurdle last time. Leading chance
- **3. ROI K'ALIN -** Unplaced last time he won before that over track and trip on March 22nd in a Class 3 handicap hurdle. One to pay close attention to
- **4. JOHNNYSAID -** Two unplaced efforts since a 3rd over 4200m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on January 1st in a Class 4 chase. Each way angle
- **5. GAZ GAZ -** 5th last time out over 3800m in a claiming hurdle at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on April 5th. Can be opposed
- **6. BULIE -** 3rd on the last start over 3800m at Vittel on August 12th in a handicap hurdle. Might need this run after an absence
- **7. KLOVIS BLEUE -** 5th last time over 3600m in a Class 3 handicap hurdle at Senonnes on April 12th. Ought to be on the premises

**Summary:** EDITION ORIGINALE (2) ran well to be third on the latest start in mid-April at Fontainebleau in a Class 3 hurdle. She is the selection ahead of ROI K'ALIN (3), who scored on his penultimate start in late March in a handicap hurdle over track and trip. JOHNNYSAID (4) has a couple of unplaced runs recently, but remains capable of having a say in the finish. ILTONE (1) has an absence to overcome, but if fit, he can be on the premises.

## C4 - PRIX UCELLO II - 3500m (a2m1/4) - TURF - Class 3 Race - Hurdles - EUR € 26,000

- **1. LA LOIRE -** Fair 3rd over fences last time at this track last month, she won before that over track and trip in a Class 4 hurdle on March 9th. Not to be ignored at this track
- **2. NOUBAKA -** Placed on the last two runs 4th on the latest over track and trip in a Class 4 hurdle on April 6th. Might need a few to misfire
- **3. CADELO -** Won by 7.5L on her debut over hurdles at Le Lion D'Angers on April 6th over 3700m in a Class 4 race. She looks like she can improve and play a leading role
- **4. RAFFLES HONOUR -** 7th last time over track and trip in a Class 4 hurdle on April 6th. 3rd last July in a Class 2 hurdle at Cairefontaine and has the ability to be on the premises
- **5. KASTEL D'AIRY -** Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 3800m at this track in a Class 4 hurdle on March 9th. Others seem better equipped
- **6. LENZA CONTI -** Got off the mark over 3500m in a Class 4 hurdle on April 6th at this track last time. More is required but she can improve and be involved
- **7. KAFKAIENNE -** Won on the flat last time over 2450m at Cluny in a conditions race on April 28th. Back over hurdles and warrants respect
- **8. LA VALETTE -** Won on the flat last October, two nice runs over hurdles this year, 3rd on the latest over 3550m in a Class 4 hurdle at Fontainebleau on April 16th. Player
- **9. HOUPS HAS -** Five unplaced runs so far over hurdles, the latter over 3600m in a Class 1 hurdle at Auteuil on April 10th. Hard to fancy

**Summary:** CADELO (3) was a dominant debut winner over hurdles, scoring by a wide margin at Le Lion D'Angers, and looks the one to beat if building on that. LA VALETTE (8), a flat winner, has hinted at ability in this sphere and can get involved. LENZA CONTI (6) is progressing nicely and impressed when winning over this course and distance last month—she rates a solid eachway option and clearly holds repeat claims.

# C5 - PRIX LA FORTAGNE - 2800m (a2m) - TURF - Condition Race - Flat - EUR € 15,500

- **1. KLIFFHANGER -** Won for the first time over 3100m at Montlucon on March 30th. He seems to be improving and is worth considering
- **2. KARNAC -** Two unplaced efforts since a 2nd over 2900m at Senonnes in a conditions race on August 3rd last year. Capable of scoring
- **3. LIBERTY FLY -** Two 2nd placed runs of late, the latter over 3000m at Wissembourg on May 1st in a conditions race. Place contender
- **4. KAMELIA DE CORTON -** 3rd on her last start over 2400m at Lignieres on April 13th in a conditions race. Ought to be thereabouts
- **5. LARMES DE JOIE -** Got off the mark over 2300m at Senonnes on the last run on April 12th in a conditions race. Can keep progressing and be involved
- **6. KAOLIN DU FENOIR -** Three unplaced runs since a 3rd over 3800m at Nancy on March 16th in a Class 3 race. Unlikely to be a live threat

**Summary:** KARNAC (2) is best judged on his second-place run at Sennones three runs back. He can win again on his seasonal return. LARMES DE JOIE (5) could be the main danger. She got off the mark last time at Senonnes in April and seems to be on an upward curve. LUCKY D'AIRY (7) shaped well to be second at Cluny last time and can make her presence felt. KLIFFHANGER (1) won last time at Montlucon and is one to look at each-way.

# C6 - PRIX DE GENNETINES - 1000m (a5f) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 21,000

- **1. ALEM -** Creditable 4th on the one run last year over 1350m in a maiden race at Cholet on October 7th. Ought to be in the shake-up
- **2. PEONE -** Well beaten on the one run over 1200m at Fontainebleau in a claimer on April 20th. Needs vast progress to be involved
- **3. KING RETURN -** 7th last time, 4th before that over 1000m in a maiden race at this track on April 5th. Place chance
- **4. ZELZAL DREAM -** Placed on the last five starts the latter when 4th in a handicap at Parislongchamp on April 24th over 1300m. Key chance
- **5. PENNSYLVANIA -** Ran well to be 4th on debut over 1200m at Chantilly on April 10th. She can make progress and score
- **6. MOLIONEPHY -** 4th on the last start over 1400m at Limoges on May 4th in a maiden race. Hard to recommend

ZELZAL DREAM (4) is more experienced. He looks like the main danger to the selection. ALEM (1) ran well to be fourth on the only run last year at Cholet. She is also dropping in trip and can not be overlooked. GONCHAKOVA (10) has a nice profile and is one to watch in the betting for clues on debut.

# C7 - PRIX D'YZEURE - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Maiden Race - Flat - EUR € 13,000

- **1. GRAND MACHO -** Two unplaced efforts of late, the latter over 1400m in a Class 3 handicap on May 4th at Parislongchamp. Pass over
- **2. RAHIMA** 9th on the last start, 2nd before that, over 2000m in a conditions race at Parislongchamp on debut on May 26th last year. Has the talent to be involved
- **3. KRASHA -** 5th on the last two runs, the latter over 2200m at Lyon Parilly in a maiden on October 18th, 2024. Unlikely to threaten
- **4. SILHAM -** Ran well to be 3rd over 1800m in a maiden at Nort-Sur-Edre on April 20th last time. Capable of being competitive
- **5. ISLAND FANTASY -** Unplaced on the last two runs, the latest over 1600m at Saint-Cloud on April 11th in a Class 3 handicap. Others seem better equipped
- **6. CHIVERE -** Several placed efforts so far, 3rd on the latter over 1400m at Compiegne on April 25th. One to keep onside

**Summary:** In a race that lacks depth. It may pay to side with SILHAM (4), who was a fair third in a maiden last time in late April at Nort-Sur-Edre. She is preferred over the frustrating CHIVERE (6), who has several placed efforts, the latest over 1400m in late April at Compiegne when third. RAHIMA (2) looked like she needed her last run and is best judged on her debut last year at Parislongchamp when she was second. She can not be ignored.

## C8 - PRIX DES LEVEES - 2800m (a2m) - TURF - Condition Race - Flat - EUR € 11,000

- **1. MESSE DE MINUIT -** Ran well to be 3rd over 3200m in a conditions race at Nort-Sur-Edre on April 20th on debut. Can improve and play a lead role
- **2. ANDY'S SPIRIT -** Unraced gelding by Stunning Spirit, the dam won 7 races. Stable runners are well prepared and the betting market can guide
- **3. MON BEAU ROMAN -** 8th on the one run over 2100m at Limoges on May 4th in a maiden race. Others rate higher
- **4. VISTA OF DOVER -** Unraced gelding by Whitecliffsofdover, the dam won 5 races and was placed in a Listed and Group 3 race. From a good stable. He will be well-tuned, and a bold show can be expected
- **5. HAKA -** Unplaced on the one run over 2000m at Strasbourg on October 6th in a maiden race. This might be difficult
- **6. NATAO -** Unplaced on the one run over 1800m at Lyon La Soie on December 9th in a conditions race. Will need to show a good bit more to feature
- **7. MAYDY DE ROMAY -** Four unplaced runs so far, the latter over 2000m at Lignieres on April 13th in a maiden race. Unlikely to trouble some of these

- **9. LUTELLIA -** Unraced filly by Tornibush, the dam was unraced. Should know what is required from a good stable. One to watch in the betting market
- **10. VIVA SOFIA -** Ran with promise when 6th in a maiden at Lyon Parilly on April 23rd on her debut. She can improve and make the top three

**Summary:** VISTA OF DOVER (4) has a nice profile and could be the answer on his debut. His dam won 5 races and was placed in Listed and Group 3 class races. ANDY'S SPIRIT (2) is also making his debut and looks good on paper. He could be the main threat. MESSE DE MINUIT (1) showed promise when third on her debut at Nort-Sur-Edre late last month and can be involved at the finish with progress anticipated. VIVA SOFIA (10) makes up the shortlist.
