However, jockey Muzi Yeni deserts that last-start winner in favour of wide-margin debut scorer GIMME SOME LUCK, suggesting the latter could pose more of a threat to the selection. PRAYERSANDPROMISES (cheek pieces fitted) and stablemate VIKING LASS (sex allowance) can get into the picture too.
