

# FRIDAY, 10/05/24

## C1 - PRIX FERNAND FLORIBERT DUBOIS - 1800m (a1m1/8) - Class F Amateur Riders Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. GOWEN CHALEONNAIS** - On a very long losing run and was 7th last time out in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 3250m on 10 April. Capable of improvement this much shorter distance
- 2. HAXOS DE DIGEON** - Struggling of late and was 8th and barefoot last time out in Class F at this course over 2700m on 28 April. Others are preferred
- 3. GINGIRELLA** - Disappointing of late and was barefoot and 8th last time out in Class F at this course over 2700m. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
- 4. GRANDE MALICE** - Showed some improvement when unshod and third last time out in Class G at Laon 2850m on 1 May. Seems better that longer distance but could earn some minor money
- 5. HIGUAIN DE LOU** - Runner-up in two of last three starts including last time out in Class G at Argentan 2150m on 15 April. Could like this trip and can go close to winning
- 6. HOPE** - Has disqualification issues and that was the case again at Enghien last time out on 7 May. Capable of contesting the finish on best form
- 7. GOPTION MONTAVAL** - On a very long losing streak and was 9th last time out in Class F at Saint-Omer over 3175m on 1 May. Did better at this track before that and could play a minor role
- 8. HAPPY NONANTAIS** - Very consistent this year and was fourth last time out in Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 28 April. Can fight out the finish this much shorter distance
- 9. GROOVY JIEL** - Has really struggled this year and was well beaten last time out in Class F at this course over 2700m on 28 April. Others are much preferred
- 10. HIMALAYA TONIQUE** - Disappointing form this year and was 7th last time out in Class G at Rambouillet over 2800m on 1 May. Did better last year and is capable of making the frame
- 11. GOLD AND GREEN** - Likes this course and was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class F on 28 April. Not out of it

**Summary:** A tricky race as most are really proven over this much shorter distance. HAPPY NONANTAIS (8) is in very good form and should run another decent race. HIGUAIN DE LOU (5) has done well over slightly further recently so should have no problems with this distance. HOPE (6) has disqualification issues but is capable of a top-4 finish when in the mood. GOLD AND GREEN (11) likes this track and deserves respect.

## C2 - PRIX DE SAINT OMER - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

- 1. JALBA DU CHAPT** - Much improved last run when third in a Class F Mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 29 April. Could earn some more money
- 2. JEAN PIERRE** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche on 19 April. Very unreliable but is capable of earning some money
- 3. JOKE DU HOUSSEL** - Battling to regain winning form and as 5th last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 29 April. More is needed to win this race
- 4. JAVOTTE D'ARDENNES** - On a very long losing run and was 6th last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 29 April. Others are preferred
- 5. JOYEUSE DU METZ** - Has yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche on 29 April. Fair form before that and has a place chance
- 6. JUNIOR DU CHATAULT** - Consistent and was a barefoot winner last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 29 April. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- 7. JOKARIA ORIENTALE** - Holding form and was fourth last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Lignièrès over 2825m on 14 April. Not out of it
- 8. JOLICOEUR D'ATHOS** - At the top of his game and is hat-trick-seeking after some nice wins with the last win being in a Class F Mounted race at Lignièrès over 2825m on 14 April. Can win again
- 9. JOBERMAN DU HOME** - In good form of late and was fourth last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Argentan over 2875m on 15 April. Can contest the finish yet again
- 10. JOYEUSE D'OCCAGNES** - Has yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Argentan on 15 April. Capable of earning some money
- 11. JEDEO DES VAUX** - Has disqualification issues and was tenth last time out in a Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 February. Others are preferred
- 12. JIMANY** - Has been struggling for some time now and was 9th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 4 March. Barefoot this time but others are preferred

**Summary:** JOLICOEUR D'ATHOS (8) has won his last two starts nicely enough to think the hat-trick could be completed. JOBERMAN DU HOME (9) remains in good form and should be involved with the finish again. JUNIOR DU CHATAULT (6) won when unshod last time out and is barefoot a real danger. JOKARIA ORIENTALE (7) is holding form and another to consider as a possible winner.

## C3 - PRIX DE L'UPECT - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LISAS** - Did all that was asked of all when winning in Class F over this track and trip on 28 April Can follow up
- 2. LOVELY CHARMES** - Won nicely on her debut in Class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 9 December. Has a winning chance if fit from a break
- 3. LA NUIT JE MENS** - Has shown fair form in three starts and was fourth last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 4 May. Could contest the finish
- 4. L'HAVANA D'ELMA** - Showed some promise on her debut but has struggled since then and was tenth last time out in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 28 April. Others are preferred
- 5. LADY DE GESVRES** - Bounced back to form with a runner-up performance in a Claimer last time out at Gournay-en-Bray 2550m on 27 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. LUNE ROSE D'ALESA** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class F at Chartres over 2800m on 14 April. Can contest the finish again
- 7. LUCIOLE DU VERTAIN** - A bit of a disappointment last time out when 5th last time out in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 25 April. Place chance
- 8. LEDA MESLOISE** - Looked good when winning on debut but was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 22 March. Can bounce back to win
- 9. LITTLE STAR JIEL** - Showed some improvement in her second start when third in Class F at this course over 2750m on 28 April. Might play a minor role
- 10. LA BICHE** - Disqualified on debut at Reims over 255m on 8 April. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 11. LOOK AFTER** - Ran well on debut when runner-up in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 15 April. Can go one better this time
- 12. LAZIE PONT VAUTIER** - Very unreliable and was 6th last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 5 May. More is needed to win this race
- 13. LA LILLOISE** - Disqualified in both her starts, with the latest being at this course on 28 April. Best watched for now
- 14. LA CASTELLE** - Showed improvement in her second start when runner-up in Class F at this course over 2750m on 28 April. Can earn some more money

**Summary:** LEDA MESLOISE (8) fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time out but did look good when winning on debut and can bounce back to score. LISAS (1) was victorious on debut and should fight out the finish again. LOVELY CHARMES (2) returns from a break but did win well on her debut so deserves respect. LUNE ROSE D'ALESA (6) is unreliable but was not disgraced last time out and could make the frame again.

## C4 - PRIX DE BERCK-SUR-MER - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LOVE ME DO** - Won on debut in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 29 February. Can fight out the finish once again
- 2. LORD DE LOIRON** - Victorious on debut in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 14 April. Quite capable of doubling up in this line-up
- 3. LUTIN DE LA FYE** - Has not shown much in three starts and was 7th last time out in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 14 April. Needs to do more to win
- 4. LEADER DU LOISIR** - Seems to prefer the shorter distance and was fourth last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2250m on 8 March. Should contest the finish
- 5. LE CAPORAL** - Showed what he is capable of with a good victory last time out in Class G at Elbeuf over 2750m on 7 April. Deserves respect for that win
- 6. LYS PETTEVINIERE** - Won well on debut in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 26 February. Deserves the utmost respect
- 7. LUCIANO VREDEBEST** - Showed promise on debut but did not repeat it in his second start when tenth last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 28 November. Can surprise returning from a break
- 8. LATINO ELDE** - Won well on his debut but was disqualified last time out at Maure-de-Bretagne on 30 April. Can bounce back to score
- 9. LIEUTENANT COLONEL** - Disqualified in both starts with the latest being at Nancy on 23 March. Best watched until improvement is shown

**Summary:** LOVE ME DO (1) did all that was asked when scoring on debut and gets the vote to double up over a shorter distance. LORD DE LOIRON (2) showed promise when winning on debut and can be a threat again. LYS PETTEVINIERE (6) also won on debut and is clearly not out of it. LATINO ELDE (8) disappointed with a disqualification last time out but did win on his debut.

## C5 - PRIX PIERRE GODET - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. KRIS MARTIN** - In good form of late winning two of last three starts with the latest being at Wolvega over 2600m on 26 April. Tackles stronger but deserves some respect
- 2. KANELLE PLANCHETTE** - Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in Class G at Cherbourg over 2625m on 28 April. Could finish in the money again
- 3. KOQUETTE LIRE** - Holding her form well and was fourth last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 28 April. Can make the frame
- 4. KINTSUGI** - Disqualified on her debut but has won twice since with the latest being in Class G over this track and trip on 10 March. Can complete a hat-trick
- 5. KRACK TER BLEKTE** - Unreliable and was 6th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April. More is needed to win
- 6. KAMBA FRO** - Has struggled this year and was well beaten last time out in Class F at this course over 2700m on 5 May. Others are much preferred
- 7. KALINE ELDE** - Yet to win and was 6th last time out in Class F at its course over 2700m on 5 November. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 8. KRECY PONT VAUTIER** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified again at Amiens on 19 April. Best watched for now
- 9. KHEOPS DES VALOIS** - In fair form this year and was 5th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April. Could play a minor role at best
- 10. KALIF DE CHANJAC** - Has been fair this year and was fourth last time out in Class F at Orléans over 2700m on 21 April. Not out of it
- 11. KERDYNA MATCH** - Consistent so far and was third last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 28 April. Can do even better this time around
- 12. KEEP COOL GLAD** - Mostly moderate form again this year and was 7th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April. Others are preferred
- 13. KINGSTON SAUTREUIL** - Struggling of late and was well beaten last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 14. KUPIDON DU VIVIER** - Yet to win a race and was barefoot and 9th last time out in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 25 April. in good form before that and has a place chance

**Summary:** KINTSUGI (4) has made good progress since being disqualified on her debut. She has won her last two starts and could turn it into a hat-trick. KERDYNA MATCH (11) is consistent and has track and trip experience so could be in the mix of things once again. KRIS MARTIN (1) has done well at Wolvega but this does look a tougher crowd. KALIF DE CHANJAC (10) has been improved of late and could make the frame.

**C6 - PRIX DU TOUQUET - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR  
€ 23,000**

- 1. KRINOLINE DANICA** - Unreliable but did show improvement when runner-up in Class G at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 1 May. Can go one better this time
- 2. KIM SPEED** - Consistent this year and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 16 March. Should fight out the finish yet again
- 3. KING PAPY JOE** - Unreliable and was tenth last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 April. Capable of earning money when in the mood
- 4. KYOTO JIEL** - Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class E at Reims over 255m on 17 April. Place chance
- 5. KING GEORGES ELLIS** - Unreliable and was runner-up last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2824m on 10 November. Has won twice in six starts and is not out of it
- 6. KANDIE D'ARDENNES** - Won three claimers last year and was not disgraced when fourth last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 10 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 7. KRAC BOREAL** - Has done very little wrong so far winning three of four starts with the latest win being in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 1 April. Can make it four straight wins
- 8. KOKIN DE BELLANDE** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 5 May. Capable of an upset on best form
- 9. KAMELIE DU CAMPUS** - Hard to trust but was victorious last time out in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 1 April. Not out of it.
- 10. KHARTOUM DE LA FYE** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 12 April. Capable of earning money when in the mood
- 11. KHALEESI D'ALESA** - Very unreliable and was disqualified last time at Vincennes on 23 April. Capable of running a decent race
- 12. KARA DE PIERREPONT** - Struggling of late and was 7th last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 3 May. Others are preferred

**Summary:** KHARTOUM DE LA FYE (10) is clearly very hard to trust but is capable of winning a race like this when in the mood. It is a tough race to be confident in as KHALEESI D'ALESA (11) is also very unreliable but does have a winning chance. KRAC BOREAL (7) continues to impress and would not be a surprise winner. KAMELIE DU CAMPUS (9) was a winner last time out but is another that is not easy to rely on.

## C7 - PRIX D'ABBEVILLE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **JUDIKATHOR GAME** - Holding form well and was fourth last time out in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 25 April. Can contest the finish again
2. **JIVE BOY** - Has disqualification issues and is coming off two of them with the latest being at Reims on 25 April. Others are preferred
3. **JOVIAL DE ROCK** - In good form of late and as third last time out in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 3 May. Place chance
4. **JOUEUR DU METZ** - On a very long losing run and was 5th last time out in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 25 April. Needs to do a bit more to win this race
5. **JEFFERSON MELOC** - Really struggling of late and was 8th last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 24 February. Others are much preferred
6. **JACKPOT DU LOT** - Showed some improvement when barefoot in Class F over this track and trip on 27 April. Not unshod this time and others are preferred
7. **JOYAU DARLING** - Unreliable and was a disappointment when 8th in Class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 21 April. Capable of better and others are preferred
8. **JEAN D'HOLLENBOURG** - Has major disqualification issues and arrives here after a disqualification at Elbeuf on 1 May. Capable of earning some money when wise
9. **JERIMOW** - In good form this year and was a winner in Class F last time out at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 28 April. Deserves some respect
10. **JURASSIC** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 28 April. Respect
11. **JACKSON HILL** - Yet to win a race after 27 attempts but did run well when runner-up last time out in Class D at Chartres over 2825m on 28 April. Place chance
12. **JUNKO SEPT** - Disappointing last run when well beaten in Class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 1 May. In good form before that and could play a minor role
13. **JOKER DE L'EPINE** - Has really struggled of late and was 11th last time out in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 27 April. Others are much preferred
14. **JASMIN DU NORD** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up again last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 13 April. Can go one better this time

**Summary:** JASMIN DU NORD (14) is in very good form and could turn in a winning performance after some runner-up finishes. JERIMOW (9) has been in good form this year and will not go down easily. JURASSIC (10) is unreliable but was not disgraced over this track and trip last time out; He could have more to offer. JACKSON HILL (11) has yet to taste winning success but can earn some more stake.

- 1. JESSY DU NOYER** - Unreliable since only win and was 8th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April. Could pop up in a minor place
- 2. JUNAKA MELODY** - Ended the 2023 campaign in good form winning in Class F at Laon over 2850m on 1 October. Looks likely to need this run returning from a break
- 3. JOY DU CHATAULT** - Moderate form this year and was 6th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April. More is needed to win
- 4. JUVENTINA DE LOU** - Yet to win a race but was runner-up in her last two starts with the latest being in Class E at this course over 2700m on 18 June. Should need this run
- 5. JOLIE STAR BLONDE** - Proved in need of the last run when 9th last time out in Class F at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 28 April. Might need this run as well
- 6. JAVA MIP** - Proved in need of only run of the year when 9th last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April. Barefoot and can strike back
- 7. JAZIE PONT VAUTIER** - Disappointing recent form and was disqualified last time out at Elbeuf on 1 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 8. JESSAMINA** - On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Châlons-en-Champagne on 28 April. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 9. JAMAIQUE DE HOERDT** - In good form of late and was third last time out in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 25 April. Be right there at the finish once again
- 10. JUSTESS VIKING** - Disappointing form of late and was disqualified last time out at Rambouillet on 1 May. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 11. JEUNESSE ETERNELLE** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 12 April. Capable of better and is not out of it
- 12. JESSIE LAKE** - Mostly disappointing form this year and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 23 April. Big chance dropped in class
- 13. JODLEUSE MAG** - Has major disqualification issues and was 7th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 23 April. Can surprise if wise
- 14. JYLVIE DE GUEUDE** - Has yet to win a race and was barefoot and 8th last time out in Class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 21 April. Capable of playing a minor role
- 15. JOY BLUE** - Returns from a very long break and was 6th last time out in Class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 December 2022. Likely to need this run

**Summary:** JESSIE LAKE (12) takes a drop in class and on best form could take out this lucky last race. JAMAIQUE DE HOERDT (9) is in good form and will contest the finish yet again. JODLEUSE MAG (13) is very hard to trust but is also capable of a surprise when smart. JAVA MIP (6) will be unshod this time so if sure to improve on her only run of this year.
