C1 - PRIX DE BUAIS - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 29,000

- 1. KOPRIORO** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F mounted race at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 9 April. Did win over this course and distance before that and is not out of it
- 2. JULIUS DU THEIL** - Disqualified in a class E harness race at Graignes over 2725m on 22 May. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 3. JUMBO DE LUNESE** - Disqualified in a class F harness race at Saint-Malo over 2850m on 23 May. Reverts to barefoot and can contest the finish back under the saddle
- 4. IRAFARA** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, the latest in a class E harness race at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 May. Others make more appeal
- 5. KRISTALE D'ERABLE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class G mounted race at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 May. Might play a minor role
- 6. KOREA** - In good form and finished third in a class F mounted race at Cherbourg over 2625m on 6 April. Remains barefoot and has claims in this line-up
- 7. KAP ORNE** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in a class F harness race at Granville over 3100m on 24 May. Can be a threat on best form
- 8. KOMEDIE SOMOLLI** - Did not show her best when 6th in a class F mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 3 June. Reverts to barefoot and can be competitive
- 9. KIKO DU VIGNAC** - A winner of a class E mounted race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 17 May. Returned to form and could follow up
- 10. JAFLO GEMA** - Has some fair form and finished third in a class E harness race at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Remains barefoot and could earn some money

Summary: KOREA (6) has been faultless since switching to the mounted code. Consistent, reliable and proven in this code, she sets a high standard and is taken to extend her excellent run of form. The chief threat may come from KIKO DU VIGNAC (9), who makes the trip from the South-West with strong claims. KOPRIORO (1), a course-and-distance winner at the end of the winter, is another who merits serious consideration, having already shown his effectiveness under these conditions. KAP ORNE (7) is returning to a track that suits him particularly well and warrants attention.

C2 - PRIX DE MARIGNY - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. KEIGHT BLESS** - Disqualified in a class D at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of scoring if smart
- 2. KING PRESTIGE** - Finished 7th in a class E over this course and distance on 30 May. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 3. KENAVO TUILERIE** - Did not show his best when 8th in a class F at Vichy over 2950m on 16 May. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of an upset
- 4. KEEPSAKE MOSSA** - Disqualified twice in a row, including last time out in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 11 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 5. KINGSTON DU BOURG** - Finished 9th in a class E over this course and distance on 30 May. Unreliable and needs to do more to score
- 6. KILDARE** - Very consistent of late and finished third in a class E over this track and trip on 30 May. Should be in the final shake-up
- 7. KING OF DAY** - Unreliable but was a runner-up in a class E over this course and distance on 30 May. Can challenge for top honours again
- 8. KUSAERI** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 25 May. Remains barefoot and can go one better
- 9. KANKAN** - Unplaced in a class E at Nantes over 3000m on 1 June. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 10. KAZAAL** - Has only been modest of late and finished fifth in a class E at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 24 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 11. KISS COOL MIJACK** - Usually competitive and was third in a class E at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 24 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 12. KANNABIS JELOCA** - Solid form this year and finished third in a class F at Granville over 3100m on 24 May. Remains barefoot and can make the frame once again
- 13. KIMI DU DOME** - Needed his last run when 9th in a class D at this track over 2200m on 29 May. Fitter this time but others are preferred
- 14. KENOR DESBOIS** - Finished fourth in a class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Probably needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

Summary: Although the least wealthy runner in the field, KEIGHT BLESS (1) possesses the ability to make his mark at this level and should be ideally suited by the right-handed configuration. KUSAERI (8) has shown his best form on flat tracks and looks set to play a major role once again. KING OF DAY (7) and KILDARE (6) both caught the eye with notable recent efforts over this course and appear difficult to leave out of calculations.

C3 - PRIX DE FLEURY SUR ORNE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **KAYA KYDE** - Finished 6th in a class E at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Remains barefoot but will need to find a few lengths to win
2. **KISS ME FIRST** - Consistent of late and finished fifth in a class E over this course and distance on 30 May. Might play a minor role
3. **KELLE BLEUE** - Disqualified in a class F at Durtal over 2825m on 24 May. Remains barefoot but does need to do more to score
4. **KATAVIA PRESS** - Finished third in a class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 24 May. Prefers the grass and others make more appeal
5. **KALI DES LANDIERS** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a class G at Rambouillet over 2825m on 7 June. Capable of scoring when smart
6. **KANELLE D'OUVILLE** - Victorious in a class E over this course and distance on 30 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of following up
7. **KINJAL DE BELLANDE** - At the top of her game and was a runner-up in a class E over this track and trip on 30 May. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
8. **KASTA DU RIB** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a class D at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
9. **KALITY D'ERABLE** - In good shape and finished third in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 25 May. Remains barefoot and can be competitive once again
10. **KRONA VIKING** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class F at Reims over 2550m on 25 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
11. **KAHIRA DES MARES** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a class D at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
12. **KELLY CHARLY ERA** - Successful last time out in a class D at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Has shown improvement of late and is not out of it

Summary: Recent course performers KINJAL DE BELLANDE (7) and KANELLE D'OUVILLE (6), respectively second and first over this track last time, look set to renew rivalry and should once again be at the forefront. The latter arrives with winning momentum, while the former has the consistency to turn the tables. KALITY D'ERABLE (9) is favourably treated by the conditions, making her a leading contender to capitalise should the principals fail to deliver their best. KALI DES LANDIERS (5) is fitted with a lighter shoeing arrangement and could find the improvement needed to score.

C4 - PRIX DE CUVES - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. IKACOU DES CINTY** - Finished 7th in a class E at Les Sables D Olonne over 2775m on 2 June. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. ICONE PLANCHETTE** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class F at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Remains barefoot and others make more appeal
- 3. JURILOVCA** - Showed some improvement and was fifth in a class E at Amiens over 2400m on 23 May. Reverts to barefoot and has claims in this line-up
- 4. JAZZMAN** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class F at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Capable of contesting the finish
- 5. JUNE D'ERABLE** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a class F at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Reverts to barefoot and might play a minor role
- 6. JARDYLAND** - In good shape and finished fourth in a class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 May. Remains barefoot and can be a real threat this time around
- 7. HIGHEST WIND** - Successful in a class F at Vichy over 2150m on 10 May. Remains barefoot and could follow up over a similar distance
- 8. JE VIENS DU SUD** - Victorious in a class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 24 May. Drops in distance but can earn some more money
- 9. JACINTHE DES ULMES** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 3 June. Reverts to barefoot and could surprise
- 10. JAZERANE** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a class F at Durtal over 2825m on 24 May. Reverts to barefoot and could make the frame
- 11. INES DE GLADJESS** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class F at Durtal over 2825m on 24 May. Others are much preferred this time
- 12. IDEAL D'URZY** - Disqualified in a class E at Les Sables- D 'Olonne over 2775m on 2 June. Remains barefoot.
- 13. JOPLIN DES CROUAS** - Disqualified in a class F at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust and others are preferred
- 14. HELLO DU GERS** - Holding form and finished fourth in a class F at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Remains barefoot but more might be needed to beat these rivals

Summary: JURILOVCA (3) appears to have been targeted for this assignment by Sébastien Ernault and looks primed to deliver a big performance. JAZZMAN (4) arrives in good form and has a proven liking for right-handed tracks, making him another leading contender. JARDYLAND (6) also enters calculations after catching the eye with a strong late effort last time, suggesting a return to peak form may be imminent. JAZERANE (10) returns to a track that suits well and could prove a danger if able to reproduce her best form.

C5 - PRIX DE BARBEVILLE - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MANILLE SOMOLLI** - Only modest of late and finished finished 7th in a Class E at Argentan over 2150m on 11 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 2. MIRAGE DE BRAY** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Drops in distance but can be very competitive
- 3. MENEUSE DE HOUELLE** - Unreliable but finished 3rd in a Class E at this track over 2450m on 27 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 4. MELODISYVA** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 26 May, Could play a minor role
- 5. MAMAMIA DES ARRIS** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class E at this track over 2450m on 16 May. Should be right there at the finish
- 6. MIMI CHARMEUSE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 26 May. Can challenge for top honours when in the right mood
- 7. MILLION DREAMS** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class E at Vire over 2700m on 18 May. Probably needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 8. MAESTRO DES SARTS** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Others are much preferred
- 9. MILADY DREAM** - Unreliable and finished 3rd in a Class E at Argentan over 2150m on 11 May. Drops in distance but does have a place chance
- 10. MIRABILIS VRIE** - Off form and finished 10th in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 11. MILWAUKEE LEGEND** - Victorious in a Class F over this track and trip on 30 May. In good form and is quite capable of following up
- 12. MUST PLEIN CHENE** - In good form and finished 4th in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Capable of making some more money
- 13. MYSTIC D'AVE** - Unreliable but finished 3rd in a Class E at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 14. MILLESIME STAR** - Off form and finished 11th in a Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Needs major improvement to win
- 15. MALOU DE DIGEON** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Le Touquet on 24 May. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
- 16. MEDOC PIERJI** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 4 December. Returns from a break and could need this run

Summary: MILWAUKEE LEGEND (11) made a striking impression over this course last time and can follow up if overcoming a tricky draw. A repeat of that latest performance would make him the one to beat . MIRAGE DE BRAY (2) is a talented colt with plenty of ability and looks the main danger. MAMAMIA DES ARRIS (5) caught the eye with a strong late effort on her most recent outing and remains a live contender for the places. MIMI CHARMEUSE (6), a winner over this track earlier in the year, has already proven her effectiveness under these conditions and commands respect.

C6 - PRIX DE THURY HARCOURT - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **KARAT DEFF** - Very consistent and was runner-up in a Class D at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Likely to challenge for top honours once again
2. **KIWI DE CONNEE** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 May. Some good wins before that and can be a threat
3. **KISS ATOUT** - in good form and was runner-up in a Class D at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Can get involved with the finish again
4. **KAISER RIVER** - Successful in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 2 June. Not easy to trust but might play a minor role
5. **KENNEDY STREET** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Jullouville-les -Pins on 17 May. Not easy to trust but might play a minor role
6. **KNOK** - Finished 8th in a Class H at Chalons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 24 May. On a long losing run and others make more appeal
7. **KANCALAIS** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class F at Jullouville-les-Pins over 2700m on 17 May. Capable of doing better and can earn some money
8. **KAPORAL CARISAIE** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 May. Has been good this year and could score again
9. **KESITO D'URVILLE** - Successful in a Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2650m on 17 May. Has been good of late but this looks a tougher race
10. **KAISER** - Victorious in a Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 26 April. A good win that day and would not be a surprise winner
11. **IVRE DE TOI** - Off form and finished 8th in a Class A at Vichy over 3525m on 1 June. Needs to do more to win this race
12. **KNOCKONWOOD** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest at Enghien on 21 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
13. **IVOIRE PRESTANCE** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in a Class D at Laval over 2850m on 29 April. Capable of better but others are preferred
14. **HAPPY DU BOIS** - Successful in a Class E at Challans over 2900m on 23 March 2025. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run
15. **JERZINHO SPORT** - Disqualified at Alencon on 31 May. In good form before that and is capable of an upset if staying in stride
16. **HOLDING GIRL** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
17. **HELIOS SOMOLLI** - Battling of late and finished 14th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 10 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
18. **IDOLE DE MEAT** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 6 May. Battling to find best form and needs major improvement to win this race

Summary: KAPORAL CARISAIE (8) has performed better than recent form figures suggest. Returning to a right-handed track under ideal conditions, he looks well placed to gain compensation and is taken as the selection. KISS ATOUT (3) remains lightly raced for his age after several interruptions to his career and still appears to have plenty in hand. KARAT DEFF (1) has been a model of consistency throughout the year and should once again give a good account. KAISER (10) rates the standout contender from the second row and warrants serious respect. KIWI DE CONNEE (2) is renowned for his toughness and enjoys an excellent partnership with Yoann Lebourgeois.

C7 - PRIX DE CLECY - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 24,000

- 1. MOYA SPORT** - Finished 10th in a Class F harness race at Cherbourg over 2625m on 10 May. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 2. MIRA DES ILES** - Disqualified at Reims on 31 May. Has disqualification issues and is probably best watched until improvement is shown
- 3. MOJITO PLANCHETTE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Bernay on 31 May. Hard to trust but might play a minor role when smart
- 4. MARYLIN SAUTONNE** - Consistent and was runner-up in a Class E over this course and distance on 25 March. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 5. MISS TAVEL** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 27 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. MA PIECE D'OR** - Victorious in a Class E at Vire over 2800m on 18 May. Clearly unreliable but is also capable of scoring again
- 7. MADISON MONNERIE** - Consistent and finished 3rd in a Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 December. Returns from a break but can challenge for top honours if fit enough
- 8. MOJITO DE BANVILLE** - Finished 8th in a Class E harness race at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Ran better than that finish suggests and could be a danger back in a mounted race
- 9. MIST NIGHT QUICK** - Finished 6th in a Class E harness race over this course and distance on 3 May. Capable of earning money back under the saddle
- 10. MISTRAL DU PORET** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class E mounted race at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Can go one place better
- 11. MISS SPEED** - A winner of a Class E mounted race at Ecommoy over 2750m on 11 May. Not reliable but is also not out of it
- 12. MAMMA PAULO** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 10 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 13. MINNEAPOLIS** - Successful in a Class E harness race at Vichy over 2800m on 11 May. Has been disqualified in last two mounted race attempts but is capable of making the frame

Summary: MA PIECE D'OR (6) has already proven her effectiveness under saddle and is expected to play a major role in this company. With solid mounted credentials, she sets a strong standard. MADISON MONNERIE (7) returns from a lay-off but commands respect, particularly as she is set to race barefoot on her comeback, suggesting she is fit and ready. MOJITO DE BANVILLE (8) attracted attention with a promising effort in harness company last time and could make his presence felt back in this discipline. MINNEAPOLIS (13) is an intriguing contender with Mathieu Mottier, the reigning Champion Jockey, taking the ride.

C8 - PRIX DE SAUSSAY - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. NEW QUILLE WINNER** - Disqualified in both starts, the latest at Bihorel-les-Rouen on 14 May. Very hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 2. NEWTON DE MONGOCHY** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a Class D at this track over 2200m on 27 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. NIKOS DE TROIS** - Disqualified twice in three starts, including at this track over 2200m on 27 May. Has ability and can bounce back to score
- 4. NORMA FIRST** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including over this track and trip on 30 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. NARUTO UZUMAKI** - Successful in a Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Improving and does look capable of doubling up
- 6. NUSCH NOVA** - Holding form and finished 3rd in a Class E at Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 25 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. NACOMA RUN** - Victorious in a Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 16 May. Tougher task this time but can make the frame
- 8. NIGHT FASHION** - Has done little wrong so far and was a winner of a Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 24 May. Can be a real threat to these rivals
- 9. NEBELINE LEMAN** - Unreliable and finished 11th in a Class D at this track over 2200m on 30 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 10. NELSON DU CAIEU** - Consistent so far and finished 3rd in a Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 14 May. Might play a minor role at best
- 11. NEW YORKER** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in a Class E at Nantes over 2275m on 14 May. Should fight out the finish once again

Summary: NARUTO UZUMAKI (5) impressed when opening his account at Meslay-du-Maine and looks capable of following up if building on that convincing success. Progressive and seemingly on the upgrade, he earns the vote to come out on top once again. NIKOS DE TROIS (3) represents the powerful Mathieu Mottier stable and rates a major threat. NIGHT FASHION (8) arrives on the back of a strong recent time figure that suggests he is ready to be competitive at this level. NEW YORKER (11) has been knocking on the door and appears close to landing a race of this nature.
