**PREVIEW:** Year after year and season after season trainer Alan Greeff has picked up many of these early juvenile races and it will not be much of a surprise were he to take out this event as well. It is probably worth taking into account he is sending out just the one entrant. CLIFF TOP: a Canford Cliffs colt will have stable jockey Greg Cheyne in the irons. Rival trainer Gavin Smith usually picks up most of the juvenile races Greeff doesn't win but in his case it is more difficult to pick which of his runners is the right one as jockey bookings do not render any help. Apprentice Yuzae Ramzan claims 2.5kg on SAND BANK so could perhaps be preferred to CRUISE CONTROL or THEN IN FOCUS.

NUSSPLY and QUEEN LOUISE both tend to lack a strong finish but are also not out of it. WAR MAN could improve trying the Polytrack for the first time.
