- **1. LA BELLE MIKA -** Unreliable and was unplaced in class E at Nantes over 3025m on 1 December. Might play a minor role at very best
- **2. L'ETOILE DE PAME -** Disappointing last run when unplaced in class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 30 November. Capable of earning some money
- **3. L'AUDACE -** Not reliable but was runner-up in class E at Chartres over 2800m on 25 November. Can be competitive once again
- **4. LIBERATA -** Knocking at the door and was runner-up in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 4 November. Remains barefoot and can go one better
- **5. LEGYPTIA DE GUEZ -** Did not show her best when placed in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 12 November. Capable of a surprise

- **11. LUNA MAG** Disqualified in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 4 December. Hard to trust but is capable of playing a minor role

**Summary:** LIBERATA (4) has been very consistent of late and could have that rewarded with a victory over this course and distance. LAZIZA JASMA (7) was in very good form before disappointing last time out and should be a real threat to these rivals. LA PERLA DE LOU (9) races without shoes and can be competitive this time around. LELLAMIKA (6) was not disgraced at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m and can shine once again.

- **3. INTUITION SOYER -** Disqualified in a class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m on 7 November. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
- **4. INES D'HERMES -** Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 21 November. Might play a minor role at best
