ODE TO THE SEA improved to finish just ahead of SMART CHOICE who showed good pace again last time. Both need to be respected.

BETTER NEVER ENDS was stubborn in his first outing and jumped slowly as well. He could do a lot better this time. Most of the debutants have speedy pedigrees but it will take a decent individual to beat the best of the raced runners.

PREVIEW: THE MASK could get back to winning ways. He needed his last start and prior won with something in hand. Watch out for INDECENT PROPOSAL who caught the eye on the Polytrack last time. He is arguably at his best over this course and distance. But it could get close with YANNAKIS who finished ahead of him the last time they met. In fact, YANNAKIS beat THE MASK the last time he raced over this track and trip and needs to be taken seriously. DEFINITELY YES seems capable of better and should prefer the distance. HAMILTON HERO could make more improvement. He has drawn well.
