R4 LYON LA SOIE [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DU PARC DE LA NARBONNAISE EN MEDITE - 2700m (a1m1/2) -
Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. MY MARCEAUX** - Unreliable and finished 7th in class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 3 November. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 2. MAREVA** - Not reliable and finished fifth in class E at this track over 2050m on 29 January. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 3. MYSTERE DE POULINE** - Consistent and finished third in class E at this track over 2050m on 29 January. Might play a minor role at very best
- 4. MARUDA** - Disqualified in class C at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Unreliable but can earn some money when smart
- 5. MERLIN FAMILY** - A winner of a class E at this track over 2050m on 19 January. Remains barefoot and is clearly not out of it
- 6. MEDEE DU VIVIER** - A runner-up in class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 17 January. Has improved of late and can make the frame
- 7. MILKSHAKE** - Successful in class E at Angers over 2350m on 28 January. Remains barefoot and can challenge for top honours again
- 8. MESTA ATALANTE** - Victorious in class E at this track over 2050m on 29 January. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
- 9. MONTENEGRO** - Disqualified in class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 3 February. Hard to trust but does win races when staying in stride
- 10. MAZEL TOV DAIRPET** - Continues to improve and was a winner of a class E at this track over 2050m on 29 January. Even better this distance and can score again
- 11. MODE VANILLE** - Disqualified in class C at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Tries barefoot and is capable of improvement

Summary: MAZEL TOV DAIRPET (10) has impressed so far with three wins from just five starts. He returned to winning form at this track and is even better over this longer distance, so gets the vote to score. MONTENEGRO (9) has also won three times but has plenty of disqualifications as well. He can be a real threat when staying on the trot. MILKSHAKE (7) remains in good form and should contest the finish. MEDEE DU VIVIER (6) has shown improvement of late and is another to consider.

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C2 - PRIX DU PARC DES MONTS D'ARDECHE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F
- Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. MAG NESS ONE** - A four-year-old gelding by Feeling Cash out of Salvie who is making his debut. His Dam won 11 of her 70 starts. Could need the experience
- 2. MUST DES LOYAUX** - A four-year-old gelding by Excellent out of Câline des Loyaux who is making his debut. His Dam won 5 of her 25 starts. Might play a minor role
- 3. MAXOU DE JEMAX** - Disqualified on debut in class F over this track and trip on 25 January. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 4. MISTER DES LOYAUX** - Finished 9th in class G at Les Sables- D- Olonne over 2650m on 13 August. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 5. MURANO DE MONCHEL** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class G at this track over 2050m on 8 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. MAGIC DU SABLIER** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class F over this course and distance on 25 January.. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. MON LUCERNAIS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class G at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Needs to do more to score
- 8. MY BEAUTIFUL** - Showed some improvement when fifth in class G at this track over 2050m on 8 February. Capable of making the frame if smart
- 9. MOCKINGJAY** - Finished third in class G at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Can get involved with the finish
- 10. MARTEL** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. Unlucky that day and can score if smart
- 11. MONEYTIME DUCAMPUS** - Disqualified in his last three starts, the latest in class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 February. Was looking likely to win that day before faulting. Can make amends
- 12. MOGADOR JEALILY** - Showed improvement when runner-up in class G at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 18 January. Can go one place better

Summary: A very tricky race. Both MARTEL (10) and MONEYTIME DUCAMPUS (11) come here with major disqualification issues. Both, however, could have won their latest starts and were threatening to do so when faulting. MARTEL (10) might be the better of the two. MOGADOR JEALILY (12) put up an improved performance at Saint-Salmier and could be a challenger. MOCKINGJAY (9) is also capable of winning a race of this nature.

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**C3 - PRIX DU PARC DE FORETS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness -
EUR € 17,500**

- 1. MALICE JULRY** - A runner-up on debut in class G at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 30 November. Returns from a break but can go one better
- 2. MAYA DU RADON** - Only moderate so far and finished 6th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 3. MA SOIE ANTIQUE** - A runner-up in a class E mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2700m on 25 January. Better under the saddle but might play a minor role
- 4. MINUTIEUSE** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in class G at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 18 January. Needs major improvement to win
- 5. MOLITA** - Disqualified in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 January. Clearly not easy to trust but can win if staying on the trot
- 6. MERVEILLE DE BOISE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in class F over this track and trip on 25 January. Tries barefoot but others make more appeal
- 7. MAM'ZELLE GEM** - Disqualified in a class F at this track over 2700m on 25 January. Unreliable but is capable of making the frame
- 8. MUSE LIGERIENNE** - Not reliable and was fifth in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 16 November. Tries barefoot but is returning from a break and could need this run
- 9. MAMY BLUE TIT** - Did not show her best when 8th in class F at Aix-les-Bains over 2700m on 9 August. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 10. MADEMOISELLE KEY** - A winner on debut in class G at this track over 2050m on 8 February. Tries further and can double up in this line-up
- 11. MARBELLA DREAM** - Finished 7th in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 30 December. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 12. MANON DE BUSSET** - Unreliable and finished 7th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. Looks capable of making the frame

Summary: MOLITA (5) is best judged on her second last start when she finished a good second at this course in her first run for her new trainer. She can leave behind her last below-par effort. A first start winner at this course last week, MADEMOISELLE KEY (10) should handle the rise in distance without any issue. MALICE JULRY (1) posted a promising debut run at Lyon on 30 November and could be a nice filly on the making. MANON DE BUSSET (12) last run is better than the placing shows.

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C4 - PRIX DE LA SOCIETE DU TROTTEUR FRANCAIS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. ILIADE DU GOUTIER** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in class D at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred
- 2. JOHNNY MIX** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class F over this track and trip on 17 January. Can be a threat when staying in stride
- 3. JASMIN D'ENOGAT** - In good shape and was third in a class G at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 4. ISBA DU DOME** - Not disgraced when fifth in class G at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 1 February. In good shape and can contest the finish
- 5. IOWA DE TOUCHYVON** - Off form and finished tenth in class G at Nimes over 2750m on 16 November.. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. HYPOLIT DE BEL AIR** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in class F at this track over 2050m on 29 January. Needs to do more to score
- 7. IN AMERICA** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 20 December. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 8. JANGA DU BELLAY** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class F at this track over 2050m on 29 January. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of scoring
- 9. INFLUENCE JULRY** - Not disgraced when fifth in class D at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. Might play a minor role
- 10. JEDI DES BROUETS** - Showed some improvement when third in class D over this track and trip on 29 January. Can be competitive once again
- 11. GENERAL D'AMOUR** - Off form and was unplaced in class E over this track and trip on 8 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race
- 12. JERICHO** - Disqualified in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 31 January. Remains barefoot and is better judged on his good penultimate start. Go close to winning
- 13. JURAE VET** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class D at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 18 January. Might play a minor role at very best
- 14. JIGSAW PUZZLE** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 6th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 28 January. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of earning some money
- 15. GUIDO JOSSELYN** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in class E over this course and distance on 19 January. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
- 16. IDEAL DELADOU** - Showed improvement when fifth at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 December. Quite capable of contesting the finish when smart

Summary: JANGA DU BELLAY (8) runs barefoot this time around and should show a totally different figure than last time out. She gets the vote to bounce back and score. JERICHO (12) posted a nice effort despite the sanction at Cagnes sur Mer and should not be taken lightly. IDEAL DELADOU (16) is very well entered and could make his presence felt. JOHNNY MIX (2) can have a say in the outcome if he can keep his stride in check.

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**C5 - PRIX DU PARC DE LA SAINTE-BAUME - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E -
Harness - EUR € 23,000**

- 1. KEL JAC** - Not reliable and finished 5th in class F at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 2. JANOT DE TOUCHYVON** - Finished 5th in class D over this track and trip on 25 January when barefoot. Has shown improvement but others are preferred this time
- 3. KING DE BASSIERE** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. Has a place chance on best form
- 4. KLEOPATRE D'ALFORT** - Unreliable and was 9th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. Victorious back in October and is capable of an upset
- 5. KALIMA DU GOUTIER** - Not reliable and was 4th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February when barefoot. Not this time but could play a minor role
- 6. KAIROS JULRY** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Capable of making the frame
- 7. KA DANSE FOLLE** - Finished 10th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. In good form before that and can earn some minor money
- 8. KENNEDY JAMES** - Disqualified in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 16 November. Unreliable but is capable of getting involved with the finish
- 9. JIFF DES CELLIER** - Off form and finished 9th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 27 October. Needs to do more to score
- 10. KENZA KALOUMA** - Disqualified in class C at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 1 November. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 11. KABOTIN CHENEVIERE** - Victorious in Class F over this track and trip on 17 January. Has shown improvement and can follow up
- 12. KIWI DU LOISIR** - In good form and finished 3rd in class E over this track and trip on 19 January. Can double up in this line-up
- 13. KHEOPS AIREMME** - Has some fair form and was 4th in class E at this course over 2050m on 17 January. Not reliable but might play a minor role
- 14. JINGLE KOP** - Holding form and finished 4th in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Can be competitive once again
- 15. KHAN D'HERIPRE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E over this course and distance on 19 January. More is needed to beat these rivals.
- 16. KRAK DE BUSSIERES** - Only moderate of late and finished 8th in class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2825m on 5 October. Returns from a break and others are preferred

Summary: KABOTIN CHENEVIERE (11) bounced back to winning ways in style on 17 January at this course and in similar form will take a power of beating once again. KIWI DU LOISIR (12) is going through a purple patch and expected to be in the mix too. JINGLE KOP (14) always goes well when fitted with pads on his hind feet and is another one for the shortlist. KENNEDY JAMES (8) is capable of an upset if fit enough after several weeks off.

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**C6 - PRIX DU PARC DU MARAIS POITEVIN - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F -
Harness - EUR € 20,000**

- 1. KEYSTONE OAKS** - In good shape and was 3rd in class F over this track and trip on 29 January. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 2. KAMELIA DE BUSSET** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class F over this track and trip on 17 January. Has a place chance on best form
- 3. KEOPS JUTH** - Successful in Class F at Hyeres over 2850m on 8 February. Unreliable and has disqualification issues but can also double up
- 4. KRYSTAL DE BERAR** - Disqualified in class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 December when barefoot. Unreliable but can play a minor role at very best
- 5. KOUTBOL** - Finished 3rd in a claimer over this course and distance on 25 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. KALINE DU RABUTIN** - Returned to form and was runner-up in class F over this track and trip on 29 January. In decent form and can go one place better
- 7. KAGOUYA OTSUSUKI** - Off form and finished 7th in class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 8 December. Others make much more appeal
- 8. KAPTAIN DE CRISTAL** - Only moderate of late and was 8th in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 18 January. Needs to do more to score
- 9. KEROS DU BAS BOSQ** - Disqualified in a claimer over this course and distance on 25 January when barefoot. Not this time and others are preferred
- 10. KID PADDLE** - Showed some improvement when runne-up in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February when barefoot. Not this time and others are preferred
- 11. KEEP TIME** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. KISS BOY** - Did not show his best when 9th in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
- 13. KUNG FU FAMILY** - Has improved of late and was 3rd in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 14. KINGSLEY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Capable of being a threat when staying on the trot
- 15. KRONOS DE BUSSET** - Victorious in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 29 November when barefoot. Not this time and could need this run returning from a break
- 16. KENDO CASTELETS** - Victorious in Class F over this course and distance on 29 January. Not reliable but is capable of scoring again

Summary: KENDO CASTELETS (16) won ahead of KALINE DU RABUTIN (6) last time out a this course and these two are expected to fight out the finish once more. KEOPS JUTH (3) could however be a serious threat to them if he can stay on the trot as he is a very smart individual. KEYSTONE OAKS (1) was far from disgraced last time in the key race and has a lighter shoeing this time around, which could make him a huge player too.

Harness - EUR € 17,500**

- 1. LORENZO DAIRPET** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 15 December. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. LUAP D'ORTIGE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in class E over this track and trip on 19 January. Needs to do more to score
- 3. LITTLE OAKS** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in class E over this track and trip on 19 January. Remains barefoot and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. LARABELLO STAM** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 13 December. Is barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals
- 5. LESNOIX** - Battling to find best form and was 8th in a claimer at Paray-le-Monial over 2650m on 16 November. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 6. LATINO PASS** - Did not show his best when 6th in class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 20 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- 7. LEJACK DERIG** - Finished 7th in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 4 November. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 8. LASCAR D'ENFER** - Did not show his best when 6th in class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Victorious back in November and is clearly not out of it
- 9. LOOK AT ME** - Did not show his best when 12th in class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 29 January. Capable of making the frame on best form
- 10. LORD OF THE RINGS** - Has been victorious twice in a row, the latest in Class F at Angers over 2425m on 21 January. Can complete a hat-trick
- 11. LOTUS PAULOIS** - Finished 7th in class F at Reims over 2550m on 14 September. Remains barefoot but needs to improve and could need this run returning from a break
- 12. LANCELOT VENESI** - Showed some improvement when 4th in class E over this track and trip on 19 January. Capable of playing a minor role again
- 13. LEMON DE LA VALLEE** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 18 January. Can go one better this time
- 14. LUCCIANO D'OMAHA** - Only modest of late and was 8th in class E over this course and distance on 19 January. Needs to do a more to score
- 15. LOU GEHRIG** - Successful in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 18 January. In good shape and is capable of following up

Summary: LORD OF THE RINGS (10) has now won four of his last five starts and could be hard to stop once again. He gets the vote ahead of LOU GEHRIG (15) who was a sound winner on his comeback run at Saint-Galmier and should strip even fitter this time around. Runner-up to the selection, LEMON DE LA VALLEE (13) will struggle to reverse the form but remains a solid place prospect. LASCAR D'ENFER (8) is better than his last run suggests and is worth another chance.

Harness - EUR € 17,500**

- 1. LONELY JULRY** - Finished fifth in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 November. Barefoot this time and can be a threat if fit enough
- 2. LAIKA SCOTT** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. LOVE ME JULRY** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class E over this track and trip on 19 January. Has shown improvement and could make the frame
- 4. LOVELY DU RABUTIN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 31 January. Victorious back in December and can bounce back
- 5. LA BRIERE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class F over this track and trip on 1 November. Needs to do more to score
- 6. LEYLI DE LA VALLEE** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 24 January. Likely to do even better this time around
- 7. LADY MAGIC** - Unreliable and was 11th in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 30 November when barefoot. Not this time and could need this run returning from a break
- 8. LARNOA** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 16 November. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 9. LAMPEE DES GOUJONS** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in class E at Vichy over 2800m on 20 September. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 10. LAIKA DU LEARD** - Disqualified in class E at Laval over 2850m on 4 February. Not reliable but was unlucky that day and can make amends
- 11. LADY IMPERIALE** - Unreliable and finished 11th in Class E over this course and distance on 19 January. Needs to do more to score
- 12. LIBERTY DE NERET** - Consistent and finished 3rd in class E at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 29 June. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 13. LAIKA D'ESPACE** - Off form and finished 10th in class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 7 December. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
- 14. L'ETOILE DE PAME** - Disqualified in class E at this track over 2050m on 10 December. Not reliable but is capable of winning when smart
- 15. LUNA MAG** - Not reliable but was 5th in class D over this course and distance on 29 January when barefoot. Could play a minor role

Summary: L'ETOILE DE PAME (14) has now run twice since returning from the break and should be in top shape for this assignment. LAIKA DU LEARD (10) blew all her chances at the start at Laval last time and is on a redemption mission here. LOVELY DU RABUTIN (4) is not devoid of ability and can go close if applied. LEYLI DE LA VALLEE (6) showed signs of resurgence at Saint-Galmier and should not be excluded of the equation.
