- **2. MUSETT AF DJUPMYRA -** 9th of 12 in a 2100m Vincennes Class E 2 weeks ago. Not everyone's cup of tea but breaks from the 2-spot and is not to be underestimated
- **3. GOLIATH DE LAIR -** Starts for the first time since coming last of 12 in a 2850m Vincennes claimer on 2 January and has no realistic chance
- **4. MELLBY GUARD -** Unraced since trotting 10th of 14 in a 2575m Agen-Le Passage Class E on 24 March. Is drawn well, races barefoot for the occasion, but still looks out of his depth
- **5. GUESS FOUTEAU -** 7th of 15, at 44/1, in a 2850m Laval Class F 3 weeks ago. Tends to go well for Sébastien Ernault, is well-placed behind the car, and will generate some interest

- **7. HARMONIE DE BREVOL -** Was full of running before encountering traffic problems, finishing 11th of 12 in a 2100m Vincennes Class E a fortnight back, but can redeem herself if Eric Rafffin keeps her out of trouble

- **4. HOLD UP DU DIGEON -** Left a good impression when 4th of 15 in a 2800m Cordemais Gr.3 on 24 April. Won in this configuration here before, adores Caen, and the Eric Raffin-factor cannot be ignored
- **5. HARMONISTA -** Has not been seen out since coming 2nd of 13 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C in early-March. Shoes on and best to wait
- **6. GIVE ME -** Sent for a break after trotting 7th behind HELLO SPORT (8) in a 2850m Vincennes Class D 4 months ago and with shoes on will have little to offer
- **7. IBISCUS MAN -** Runner-up in 2 Gr.3's before faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class C last Saturday and his driver will be loathe to allow the same thing to happen twice. Chance
- **8. HELLO SPORT -** Capable element that came last of 11 on re-entry in a 3200m Fougères Class A 2 weeks ago and, with cobwebs blown away, can get back to doing what he does best. Minor place chance
- **9. GILMOUR -** Not the luckiest when 7th of 13 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C a week ago but, even so, will still have too much to do
- **10. GAZOLINE DU SEUX -** 3rd at Lyon-La Soie before trotting 5th behind GALA DE CRENNES (12) in Fougères race of reference and will struggle to make her presence felt
- **11. DASSERO -** Pleasantly surprised mid-April when 5th of 15 in a 2725m Lisieux amateurs Class E but, in this field, is out of his depth
- **12. GALA DE CRENNES -** Reassuring 3rd in a 3200m on turf in a Class A at Fougères a fortnight back but will have his work cut out this time
- **13. HEDIC GEMA -** Made short work of a 2550m Reims Class D on 17 April. Has earned the right to race in this category and looks main threat to the equally well-entered HEDIC GEMA (13)
- **14. GALANT GALAA -** Good dual-discipline sort but starts for the first time since coming 10th of 12 in a 2850m Vincennes monté Class C on 23 February. Shod for comeback and no danger
- **15. HUBBLE DU VIVIER -** Fine trotter with solid credentials at this level. 4th of 14 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C a month ago and, if he turns, can make this his own
- **16. GREAT OF MADRIK -** Quality element that lost his action last weekend after some misfortune in a 2700m Vincennes Class C, but has the wherewithal to make amends and finish in the mix

Summary: Nicely-engaged here and currently in excellent form, HUBBLE DU VIVIER (15) makes his first right-handed start and will be in a position to win this if he takes to the new conditions. GREAT OF MADRIK (16) had his measure last time out and should again figure prominently, but will first have to see off HEDIC GEMA (13) who flew up at Reims mid-April, and the everimproving IBISCUS MAN (7) whose recent sanction should not be taken too seriously.

- **1. LAURELINA -** Drops back in category after finishing last but one in a 2700m Vincennes Class A 8 days ago but still faces a tough task
- **2. LOVELY TRIP -** Respectable 5th of 8 in a 2700m Vincennes Gr.3 late-March. Will have progressed, comes here fresh, and will justifiably garner significant support
- **3. LARA CROFT -** Sent for a spell mid-February after winning a 2100m Vincennes Class D. Fitted with 4 pads for re-entry though and, from the 3-spot, should not be underestimated
- **4. LAMATTA -** 3rd of 6 finishers in a 2850m Vincennes Class C on 23 April. Franck Nivard has kept the drive and is well-positioned to give this a good go. Minor place chance
- **5. LIBEREE DELIVREE -** Looked rather ordinary when sanctioned in a 2175m Vincennes Class B on 29 March. Has had time to get her house in order though and, on good behaviour, can play a small part
- **6. LOURGA -** Restored some faith when 2nd in a Bihorel-lès-Rouen claimer 2 months ago but has no place in this line-up and can be ruled out
- **7. LIBERTY AVENUE -** 2nd of 8 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D a month ago. Entrusted to Benjamin Rochard this time and will be expected to finish close
- **8. LYNX DU CHATELET -** Facile winner of a 2200m Vincennes Class D on 16 April, confirming his debut success, and will be the one to beat
- **9. LUCKY PIYA -** Acquitted himself well in a 2875m Vincennes Class C 3 weeks ago despite not enjoying the best of runs and will be expected to apply the pressure on LYNX DU CHATELET (8)
- **10. LOCCA DU BELLAY -** Sanctioned in a 2175m Vincennes Class B on 29 March. Is clearly better at a lower level and racing shod will do her no favours
- **11. LOOK AT ME LULU -** Won in Bordeaux before faulting in a 2800m Cholet Class D 12 days ago but can get a look-in if she deigns to stay in stride
- **12. LUNGA DES BROUSSES -** Honest filly but has not been seen out since trotting 5th of 6 in a 2700m Vincennes Class B mid-January. Shoes on and no threat

Summary: Winner of 2 on the trot, both in good order, LYNX DU CHATELET (8) receives another Eric Raffin drive and, even in spite of the draw, still looks up to the task of maintaining his unbeaten status. It is unlikely to be all plane sailing though considering how well LUCKY PIYA (9) acquitted himself at Enghien, and returning to racing right-handed will only enhance his prospects. Better-positioned in front, LOVELY TRIP (2) will have come on for his fine Gr.3 comeback, while LIBERTY AVENUE (7) steps up in category with a decent chance of making the frame.
