# C1 - GRAND PRIX DE LA VILLE DE NICE - 2925m (a2m) - Gr3 Race - Harness - EUR € 69,000

- **1. COOL KRONOS -** Third in a Group 3 at this track over 2925m on 28 July. Barefoot again. In good form and is probably the main danger to GRAND TRIO LUDOIS (8)
- **2. FAMEUX SAX** Fourth in a class C at this track over 2150m on 30 July. Remains barefoot. A consistent sort who is seldom far off them
- **3. FARMER KERYVON -** Third in a class C at this track over 2150m on 30 July. Barefoot again. Unlikely to be too far from the action
- **4. GANGSTER DAVANESS -** Unplaced in a class C at this track over 2150m on 30 July. Reverts barefoot and has not been in this arrangement since 3 March 2023. Can surprise
- **5. FEEL GOOD DESBOIS -** Unplaced in a class C at this track over 2150m on 30 July. Remains barefoot. A runner-up on this track in the penultimate, and deserves some attention
- **6. GIVE ME** Fourth in a class C at this track over 2925m on 21 July. Remains barefoot. Unlikely to be involved in the finish
- **7. HAPPYJO DE LIGNY -** Ran 7th in a class C at this track over 2925m on 26 July. Remains barefoot. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **8. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS -** A winner in a Group 3 at this track over 2925m on 28 July. Remains barefoot. Looking to complete a hat-trick and should make a bold bid
- **9. HEROS DES MOTTES -** A winner in a class B at this track over 2925m on 14 July. Remains barefoot. Unlikely to be too far from the action
- **10. GALA DE CRENNES -** Finished 7th in a class C at this track over 2925m on 26 July. Others are much preferred in this line-up

COOL KRONOS (1) seems back to his best and should contest the finish. HEROS DES MOTTES (9) is not as reliable as those two rivals but can be a threat after a track-and-trip win. FEEL GOOD DESBOIS (5) has not won for some time but is capable of making the frame.

- **2. KALENCIO FLAC -** Fourth in a class B at this track over 2925m on 28 July. Holding form well and can get into the action again
- **3. JOURNEY OF DREAM -** A winner in a class E at this track over 2700m on 9 July. Barefoot again. In form, and is easy to like for a place
- **4. KRACKMANIA -** Finished 6th in a class B at this track over 2925m on 28 July. Others are much preferred in this line-up
- **5. KOMPOSTEL -** Unplaced in a class B at this track over 2925m on 28 July. Remains barefoot. With application can figure prominently
- **6. KENO PETTEVINIERE -** Third in a class B at Enghien over 2875m on 19 July. Remains barefoot. Third run back and can play a minor role
- **7. ISEO DE LOU -** Fifth in a class E at this track over 2150m on 4 August. Remains barefoot. Distance-suited and is capable of contesting the finish again

ISEO DE LOU (7) is usually there or thereabouts and is another to consider.

- **4. JADA MOKO -** A runner-up in a class F at this track over 2925m on 2 August. Remains barefoot. Unlikely to be far from the action
- **5. JOKER DU MIDI -** Fourth in a Mounted class C at this track over 2925m on 23 July. Others are much preferred in this line-up

- **3. LEADER DE CERISY -** Finished 6th in a class E at Amiens over 2400m on 30 July. Reverts to barefoot and is not out of it
- **4. L'AVENIR -** Third in a class D at this track over 2925m on 26 July. Remains barefoot. When applied is competitive, and if keeping the action together should be right there
- **5. LUCKY MAN -** Finished 6th in a class D at this track over 2150m on 2 August. Others are much preferred in this line-up

LATINOS DU NOYER (1) showed improvement when barefoot last time and could do even better this time.

KUEEN PEARL (9) is unreliable but is barefoot and another who can win if staying on the trot.

- **5. MYSTERE DE L'AVRE -** Finished fourth in a class D at this track over 2150m on 4 August. Can play a minor role in the finish
