Both INTIMIDATOR and Highveld raider QUIXOTE have the form and experience to make their presence felt. SHOEFELLA and ASPECT could also stake a claim. Open!

VAN HUNKS caught the eye when last seen and is capable of having a say if building on that effort. However, progressive stablemate PREVALENCE appears the stable elect on riding arrangements and is likely to be involved. Regularly bred NARINA TROGON finished behind stable companion HAMMIES HERO over 1200m but ought to turn the tables on these terms up in trip.

WE'RE JAMMING is unbeaten over this track and trip and could preserve that record with just 52kg to shoulder. FORMAGEAR and SPEED MACHINE could also earn a cheque.

PREVIEW: PACIFIC GREEN swept past her rivals from the rear of the field to win over 1100m at this level last time out and, despite a 3-point penalty, could prove too good again with the extra 100m likely to suit. LIVE MY LIFE, LITTLE MISS PINK and WINTER FURI are weighted to pose more of a threat so ought to be competitive. On the run behind Sonic Burst, DISTINCTION could prove the biggest danger to her stablemate and with improved fitness on her side after a pleasing recent comeback from a break. Highveld raider VIVACIOUS SPIRIT boasts solid form credentials and could make her presence felt too.
