- **1. JORGE ARTHUR -** Showed some improvement when runner-up in a harness claimer at Hyeres over 2850m on 9 November. Remains barefoot and can earn some money
- **2. HYPTIS** Has some fair form and finished 4th in a class G harness race at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **3. HERCULE BRILLOUARD -** Has struggled of late and was 10th in a class G harness race at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. JADORE JULRY -** Showed some improvement when 6th in a class F harness race over this course and distance on 29 October. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- **5. HEROS DE MARZY** Only modest od late and finished 6th in a class F mounted race at Nantes over 3000m on 1 December when barefoot. More is needed to beat these rivals

- **4. MALAGA D'ATOUT -** Unreliable but was runner-up in Class E over this track and trip on 29 November. Can be competitive again
