### C1 - PRIX BEAUMANOIR - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class A Race - Mounted -EUR € 71,000

**1. JEUNESSE ETERNELLE -** Back under the saddle after trotting 5th of 13 in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E last weekend. Has never shown much aptitude for the monté game and can be disregarded

**2. DAMISELA -** Has never disappointed under the saddle, most recently winning a 2850m Class D, with ease, over the short track a fortnight ago. In better company this time and while unlikely to surprise, should still give an honest account

**3. JAMAICA** - Returns to the monté code after being sanctioned early in a 2150m Enghien harness Class C mid-March. Has no references at this level under the saddle and can be passed over

**4. JEROBOAM D'ERABLE -** Impressive 2nd to the good Jean Balthazar in a Gr.2 over track and trip 2 months ago. Returns fresh and even though shod, still looks a player

**5. KIMBO BERRY -** Kicked the season off with Gr.3 success over track and trip before coming in a beaten 5th of 10 finishers in Gr.1 Prix des Centaures. At this level though, is competitive for a place on the podium

**6. JULIANA DE RETZ -** Able mare that came 3rd to JUST FOR BACK (8) in a Class B over course and distance 10 days ago. Steps marginally up in category but still has the wherewithal to pick up a cheque

**7. DARDO ZACK -** Capable on a good day but only 7th of 12 in a 2100m harness Class B on 20 February. Has evident monté potential but with just hind shoes on may be biting off more than he can chew

**8. JUST FOR BACK -** Climbed the class ladder well last season before making short work of a Class B under these conditions 10 days ago. Boasts an excellent record with Eric Raffin and has a realistic claim on the trophy

**9. KATCHINA DE SIMM -** 4th of 14 (to excellent stablemate Kaviarissime) in a harness Gr.3 over course and distance. Sanctioned on lone appearance in the discipline but would not be here if her trainer believed she could not win

**Summary:** Brimming with class and recently 4th in a harness Gr.3, KATCHINA DE SIMM (9) is first-time barefoot under the saddle and, if ability transitions, can return to winning ways. JUST FOR BACK (8), on the other hand, has excellent monté credentials and returned flamboyantly, and successfully, to competition 10 days ago. Gr.3 winner under similar conditions on 20 February, KIMBO BERRY (5) has had time to sharpen up and will not be available at 69/1 this time around. JEROBOAM D'ERABLE (4) showed great courage to finish runner-up to a very good horse in the Gr.2 Prix Paul Bastard mid-February and returns shod to the venue, but with justified ambition.

# C2 - PRIX CLARISSE - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 40,000

**1. KAISER LATAL -** Sanctioned, on return to competition mid-March, in a 2875m Enghien Class E. Is not short of ability though, is confirmed over the main track, sports front pads, and will generate some interest

**2. KAJAGOOGOO** - 2nd of 13 in a 2750m Ecommoy Class E on 1 April. Takes a significant step up in category though and even from the 2-spot will struggle to make his presence felt

**3. KOLOSSE -** Sanctioned, after a 3-months' break, in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 8 March. Has previously won over the main track and will be no pushover if David Thomain keeps him trotting

**4. KRONOS D'EOLE -** Has not been seen out since coming 8th of 9 in a 2550m Bordeaux Class D late-January and is going to need the race

**5. KANAK DU BOCAGE -** 5th of 17, behind KAZACHOK D'ETANG (9), in a 2200m Caen Class E on 18 March. Sports just hind shoes this time and the engagement of the champion driver can make all the difference

**6. KHARTOUM DE LA FYE -** Has returned to competition in excellent shape, latterly close 2nd in a 2150m Cagnes Class E on 2 March. Sanctioned on lone appearance here but is barefoot for the occasion and looks a serious contender

**7. KOQUERY DU BUISSON -** Faithful sort that established his left-handed credentials when 3rd in a 2850m Laval Class E a fortnight ago. In marginally better company on this occasion but is first-time barefoot will not want to be ignored

**8. KELLOU DES BRUMES -** Missed out by little for victory in the Caen race of reference, before being disqualified. Is drawn wide but is a serious horse and merits significant respect

**9. KAZACHOK D'ETANG -** 3rd of 17 in a 2200m Caen Class E on 18 March. 2nd over track and trip mid-February, is barefoot this time and appears eminently capable of making the frame

**10. KENNEDY FRANCE -** Showed improvement at Le Croisé-Laroche on 25 March when 4th, a place behind KING PAPY JOE (13), in a 2700m Class E. Races barefoot for the first time but others still preferred

**11. KAISER DE CESNY** - Has acquitted himself well for the most part this term, latterly 4th in a 2150m Argentan Class E 2 weeks ago. Shoes off for the first time but still not a priority

**12. KEEP TRUST -** Faulted, when well-backed and full of running, in a 2575m Agen-Le Passage Class E a week ago. Gelormini reining this time but the draw will do him no favours

**13. KING PAPY JOE -** Tricky sort that finished a surprise 3rd of 8 finishers in a 2700m Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche late last month but a repeat seems improbable

**14. KING D'HERMES -** Useful type that failed to confirm his early-March success when sanctioned a fortnight back in a 2850m Laval Class E. Faces a stiffer test this time and chances slim

**Summary:** Still somewhat green but a fine future prospect nevertheless, KOLOSSE (3) is wellplaced on the front line and looks marginally better than the reinvigorated, and barefoot, KHARTOUM DE LA FYE (6) who will be dangerous if he stays in stride. KAZACHOK D'ETANG (9) has been handed a tough draw but returns to racing barefoot, is plainly close to his race, and has previously defied a bad draw under these conditions. KANAK DU BOCAGE (5) has not looked dangerous lately but he reverts to a more competitive configuration and being entrusted to Eric Raffin will do his prospects no disservice.

### C3 - PRIX ICLEA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C Amateur Riders Race -Mounted - EUR € 61,000

**1. HOPIUM -** Dependable sort that came 5th to FORAIN JENILOU (7) in a 2250m Enghien Class C late last month. Is better than that though and can begin to make amends

**2. FIRST GEDE -** 8th of 9 in a 3125m Angers Class D 9 days ago and, in this company, has very limited chances

**3. GOLIATH DU CAUX -** Debuts in the monté code after coming 9th of 12 finishers in a similar event here a fortnight ago and is unlikely to spring any surprises

**4. GO OR NOT -** Failed to make it 4-on-the-trot when 6th on return to competition in a 2925m Cagnes Class C a month back. Has had time to come on though, has hind shoes off for the occasion, and should not be too far off the mark

**5. HANNAH -** 10th of 12 finishers when prepping for this in a 2900m harness Gr.3 at Amiens on 6 March. Reverts to a proven formula and should be prominent at the reckoning

**6. EVEIL DU LUPIN -** 12th of 14 in a 2750m Ecommoy Class A on 31 March. Has done nothing noteworthy in either code for some time and can be written off

**7. FORAIN JENILOU -** Won 2 of his last 3, latterly in style in a 2250m Enghien Class C on 26 March, and has a realistic chance of confirming

**8. DJESON D'ARIANE -** Appears to have turned a corner lately, finishing close 3rd to FORAIN JENILOU (7) in the Enghien race of reference. Unlikely to win but, with just front shoes off this time, can prove competitive for a spot in the first 5

**9. DICK DES MALBERAUX** - Has been enjoying something of a return to form recently, latterly 2nd to FORAIN JENILOU (7) in the Enghien race of reference. Not a priority this time but should nevertheless give an honest account

**10. FONZY D'HERIPRE -** Sanctioned on comeback in a similar event here late last month but plainly showed his form and can get a look-in if Thomas Roullier assures his initial strides

**11. HALFA -** Like a horse reborn since December, most recently 2nd when shod in a 2875m Enghien Class C early last month. Shoes off this time and, if all goes to plan, will take some beating

**12. ESPOIR DU RAVARY -** Still going strong aged 10, latterly clear 2nd to an excellent horse, in a 2850m Class B here mid-January. Unseen since and shod again, but still looks a potential spoiler

**13. GEF DE PLAY -** 11th of 12 finishers under these conditions a fortnight ago, on return from a long absence. Shod to preference this time and should logically show improvement

**14. GIROLAMO -** Surprise 5th in a 2925m Cagnes Class C a month ago. Barefoot this time but has little liking for Vincennes and can be passed over

**Summary:** Simply remarkable over the winter, HALFA (11) takes a notable drop in class and with shoes off for the occasion, should be able to wrap this up. That said, she will be pitted against FORAIN JENILOU (7) who was most impressive at Enghien late last month, and HANNAH (5) who came close in her last 2 under the saddle here and who sports a revised configuration this time. ESPOIR DU RAVARY (12) consistently gives his best and will have a lot to offer if race-fit.

### C4 - PRIX ALGENIB - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 49,000

**1. HELLA DE JANA -** Sprang quite the surprise when 2nd of 16, on re-entry, in a 2825m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 25 March. Unlikely to prove dangerous but, with application, should nevertheless acquit herself honourably

**2. INSOLITE EFBE -** Oddly lacklustre 9th, behind ILARIA KILY (6), in a 2450m Caen Class F on 18 March. Is clearly better than that though and can get a look-in

**3. INCREDIBLE STAR -** Came 4th, 2 places behind ILARIA KILY (6), in a 2450m Caen Class F on 18 March. Sports a new configuration and can more than just get around unscathed this time. First-5 prospect

**4. INDES GALANTES -** Back under harness after coming 6th of 16 in a 2450m Caen monté Class F on 18 March. Barefoot for first time since the autumn and, from the front row can give this a good go

**5. IMAYA CHRISTUBERT -** 7th of 9 in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle last Sunday and will need to find significantly more

**6. ILARIA KILY -** Has pleased since the break, latterly trotting 4th of 16 in a 2825m Vire Class F. Unshod-all-4 this time but in more elevated company this time and chances limited

**7. ISBA DU VIVIER -** 5th of 7 finishers in a 2850m monté Class D here 2 weeks ago. Here for a change of scenery and can be disregarded

**8. IZIA DE MONGIVAL -** 9th of 13 finishers, when being conditioned, in a 2750m Ecommoy Class D late last month. Barefoot this time, will be fully-fit, and from the front row can figure prominently at the business end of affairs

**9. ILOUANE DU VIVIER -** Quality mare that finished 8th of 13 finishers, on re-entry, in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F on 1 March. Shod to preference at a track she likes and it would be no surprise to see her get her nose in front

**10. ISIA DU CHENE -** Faulted early, when well-supported, in a 2825m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 1 April. Is not the most dependable, and incurs the penalty, but sports a new configuration and, if applied, can pleasantly surprise

**11. IMAGE D'ATALANTE -** Disappointing on the whole this term, most recently coming 7th of 16 in a Class C over 2850m here a fortnight back, and can be confidently ruled out

**12. ISLA MUJERES -** 5th of 15 in a 2850m Class F over the short track here 10 days ago but still has a lot more to find

**13. ISLAND LOVE -** Won 2 on the trot here before being sanctioned in a 2700m Class C here 3 weeks ago. Races barefoot this time and starts on the back line, but still has the class to win this

**Summary:** Although never far from losing her action, ISLAND LOVE (13) has nonetheless won 2 of her last 3, including over track and trip, and with application, can return to winning ways. ILOUANE DU VIVIER (9) is a veritable steamroller when unshod, has good main-track references, is 25m better off and, competitively-shod, will be a tough nut to crack. IZIA DE MONGIVAL (8) faces her first objective of the new season and, racing barefoot with Eric Raffin in the wagon, will be afforded every chance. INDES GALANTES (4) has proven references when barefoot and looks best of the rest.

# C5 - PRIX HENRIETTA - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 46,000

**1. JERONIMO DU CAUX -** Excellent since returning to competition, most recently meeting no opposition in a 2600m Nancy Class E. Has the inside line but still looks a reasonable place prospect

**2. JOB DU PERSIL -** Simply superb this term, winning 3-on-the-trot, most recently with authority in a 2300m Marseille-Borély Class D mid-March. Is well-placed behind the car and with David Thomain reining must be respected

**3. JUNIOR DU CHERISAY -** Tricky character that faulted early in a 2850m Class C here late-February. Is drawn nicely and will be fresh, but shoes on this time and chances limited

**4. JUPITER TURGOT -** Won 2 in a row before coming 4th of 11 finishers in a 2700m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Has few references over these shorter trips but is in his category and going barefoot from the 4-spot will only enhance his prospects

**5. JACOMO BELLO -** 8th of 11 finishers, behind JUPITER TURGOT (4), in a 2700m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Has never disappointed over 2100m on the main track though and, from the 5-spot, will be in it to win it

**6. JET DES BAUX -** 7th to JUPITER TURGOT (4) in the race of reference, at 85/1, but in this company will have his work cut out

**7. JOUR DE GLOIRE -** Unremarkable trotter that came in a country mile last of 9 in a 2700m Class D here a fortnight ago and has no realistic chance

**8. JACK BARROW -** Unexceptional type making his first start since finishing last of 9 in a 2850m Class C here last September and will have nothing to offer

**9. JACK DES ASS -** Should have won a 2700m Class D here 2 weeks ago but was instead sanctioned. Handed a rough draw but is by some margin the best horse here and, if focused, should be in a position to bring home the bacon

**10. JERICHO** - Back at the top of his game over past 2 months, winning a 2150m Enghien Class E in good order 26 March. Forced to start on 2nd line but this is unlikely to faze Eric Raffin. Claim

**11. JET DE BUSSET -** Failed to confirm his Caen success when sanctioned in the 22 March race of reference. Is not without merit but faces a tougher task this time, is fitted with pads, and others preferred

**12. JACKSON D'ARC -** Modest 6th of 15 in a 2700m Class D here a week ago and can expect to have few takers

**Summary:** A complicated character he may be but there is no question about the potential of JACK DES ASS (9) who can absolutely win this if he stays in stride from one end of the race to the other. Whether the change in fortune JERICHO (10) is enjoying is directly related to Eric Raffin or not, he will be out to win this either way. Although unplaced in his last two, JACOMO BELLO (5) is better-positioned behind the car, has the fastest time in the field under these conditions, and it would be imprudent to ignore his chances. JERONIMO DU CAUX (1) is not out of the picture for the win as he has taken well to racing barefoot and came 2nd on his lone start over 2100m here.

**1. GUERRIER CASTELETS -** 3rd in the race of reference before a disappointing 6th in a 2700m Class D here a week ago. Sports a proven configuration and is not to be underestimated

**2. ELIXIR DE CRENNES -** Unraced since being pulled-up in a 2875m Enghien monté Class D last October and can be totally disregarded

**3. GOAL STAR -** Tough individual that missed out by the smallest of margins in a Class D over track and trip on 22 March and looks main threat to GIMS DU PLESSIS (9)

**4. GINO VIVA -** 8th in the race of reference after having won over 2100m here and, while not a priority, is not to be overlooked when reined by Gabriele Gelormini

**5. EQUEJUELO -** Has ability but sanctioned in all 3 this year, most recently a 2450m Caen Class D, and others easier to trust

**6. DORUN BEAM** - Goes barefoot under harness after faulting, when beaten, in a 2250m Enghien monté Class C on 26 March and, barefoot or not, will have nothing to bring to the party

**7. GIPSY DE CHAMANT** - Showed over the winter she could mix it up with the best of them and will be expected to improve on her 6th place in a Class D over course and distance 3 weeks ago

**8. FLYING BRICKELL -** Unlucky not to finish closer than 6th behind GOAL STAR (3) in the race of reference but can more than make amends if Sébastien Ernault keeps him trotting

**9. GIMS DU PLESSIS -** Classy individual with nothing to prove at this level. Has everything in his favour here and looks set to open his 2024 account

**10. GAULTHERIA** - Drops back to a more reasonable level after coming 11th of 16 in a GNT Gr.3 over 3000m at Marseille-Borély and is not incapable of making the first five

**11. DIRTY LOVING -** Made the frame 3 times before coming 7th in a 2150m Cagnes Class D a month ago and, in this company, will struggle to make his mark

**12. GALON DE VIRE -** Has not been seen out since coming 10th of 13 in a 3000m GNT Gr.3 at Nantes early-November and will need the run

**13. EGINE PRECIEUSE -** Returns to racing barefoot after finishing 9th to FALCO DU DOUET (16) in a 2850m Laval Class D 2 weeks ago, but still has more to find

**14. FOREVER JIEL -** Below-par 7th of 16 in a 2450m Caen Class D a month ago. Has winter form at this level though and will have his supporters

**15. FOXTROT NOBLESS -** Erratic sort making just 2nd start back, finishing last of 15, on return, in a 2825m Cordemais Class D on 1 March and, shod for the occasion, can be confidently passed over

**16. FALCO DU DOUET -** Sprang quite the surprise when 4th, at 52/1 when reined by Raffin, in a 2850m Laval Class D late last month. Deserted by his partner however and unlikely to repeat

**Summary:** Very hard to fault when barefoot, and very much at home at Vincennes, GIMS DU PLESSIS (9) has 2 races under his belt, is barefoot with Eric Raffin back in the sulky, and looks the horse to beat. He will still come under fire from the reinvigorated GOAL STAR (3) who beat a number of these (including the favourite) over course and distance 3 weeks ago, and FLYING BRICKELL (8) who could have finished closer had the not faulted in the final stages. GIPSY DE CHAMANT (7) is better than her recent results would suggest and must be considered a decent place prospect.

# C7 - PRIX D'USSEL - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 41,000

**1. JUST AN ARTIST -** Imposed, for the first time since last May, in a 2750m Ecommoy Class D 12 days ago. Is not about to repeat but should be competitive for a spot in the mix at the finish

**2. JUSTESS VIKING -** Has shown considerably more under the saddle these days, most recently coming 4th of 9 in a 2550m Reims Class E 3 weeks ago, and is not about to spring a surprise

**3. JINA FOUTEAU -** 9th of 12 when prepping shod for this in a 3150m Saint-Brieuc Class E on 26 March. Has previously placed over course and distance and, barefoot this time, looks a player

**4. JADE HAUFOR -** Faulted when full of running in a 2150m Class E across town late last month. Has good 2100m Vincennes credentials and the draw will do her chances no harm

**5. JET SOCIETY -** 5th in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 19 February when associated with Eric Raffin for the first time. Barefoot on this occasion and from the 5-spot will have her chances

**6. JERIKA DE KERYANN -** Sanctioned, for a 5th time in succession, when faulting in a 2550m Reims Class E 3 weeks ago, and can expect to have few takers

**7. JOLIE QUEEN -** 8th behind JAVA DE LANGERON (9) in a 2150m Enghien Class E on 26 March. Unshod-all-4 this time but others still preferred

**8. JALMAROSA -** Won a 2200m Caen Class F, with authority, on 18 March, making it 2 in a row. Starts wide but still looks eminently capable of pulling off the hat-trick

**9. JAVA DE LANGERON -** Quality individual but not the easiest to handle. Reassured when 5th in a 2150m Enghien Class E on 26 March and, with application, can defy the draw and finish in the mix

**10. JALNA DU BUISSON -** Has not been seen out since finishing 8th of 13 in a 2850m Laval Class E on 17 February. Comes here fresh but is unlikely to shake things up

**11. JULIA DE MARZY -** Has improved over recent weeks, most recently coming 3rd of 17 in a 2625m Châtelaillon-La Rochelle Class E on 24 March. Starts on the back line but is competitively-shod for the first time and will be worth retaining

**Summary:** Enjoying something of a renaissance this year, JALMAROSA (8) breaks wide in this small field and should not be too inconvenienced to win a race of this nature. Yoann Lebourgeois will still be wary of the better-placed JINA FOUTEAU (3) who is barefoot following her Saint-Brieuc freshener. The promising JET SOCIETY (5) gets to race barefoot for the first time and Eric Raffin maintaining faith must be viewed as a positive sign. The nicely-positioned JADE HAUFOR (4) appreciates these conditions and, if focused, can put her recent sanction behind her.

**2. DIAPASON (ITY)** - 7th of 14, on return to racing, in a 2100m Class C here last weekend, but bites off more than he can chew on this occasion

**3. DRAGOWSKI -** 13th of 14 in a 2100m Class C here last weekend and expectations appear to be exceeding reality

**4. JUNKIE (SWE)** - Sanctioned last weekend, on first start since the spell, in a 2100m Class C here and, in this company, will struggle to make any impact

**5. DESTINO D.J.** - Won over 2700m here earlier in the year before finishing 5th of 14 in a 2100m Class B next time. Steps up in category but still worth keeping an eye on

**6. JASON GINYU -** Hardy sort making just 2nd start back after coming 8th to WORKING CLASS HERO (8) in a 2450m Caen Class B a month ago. Shoes on and no threat

**7. JOUVENCE DE CAREL -** Has not been seen out since coming 2nd of 11 finishers in a 2700m Class C here 3 months ago. Shod to preference but others preferred this time

**8. WORKING CLASS HERO -** Made short work of a 2450m Caen Class B, on re-entry, a month back. Has nothing to prove at this level, will have progressed for the run and can challenge for the win

**9. JOOST D'OLERON -** Quality individual that finished a very unlucky 6th in 1 March race of reference. Paul Ploquin reining this time and can pick up a cheque if he keeps him trotting

**10. JEDI DES BROUETS -** Delicate sort that reassured with tenacious victory in a 2700m Lyon-La Soie Class F a fortnight ago. Placed at Vincennes over the winter and, on good behaviour, can finish in the mix

**11. JET EXPRESS -** Unraced since coming an unlucky 6th of 9 in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class A late-November. May be a race shy but is unbeaten over course and distance and must be respected

**12. JIBI DU FRUITIER -** Good 3rd of 10 finishers in a Class B over track and trip 3 weeks ago. Appears to have turned a corner and looks competitive for a place on the podium

**13. DUBHE PRAV -** Last seen 2 months ago on his first start since May, finishing 10th, behind JOOST D'OLERON (9), under similar conditions, and has no realistic chance

**14. JE REVE DU BOIS -** 2nd in a 2700m monté Class B here 10 days ago and returns to the harness code in excellent form and with a realistic chance of imposing

**15. JENNY DE JOUDES -** 7th of 8 finishers, behind JE REVE DU BOIS (14), in a 2700m Class B here on 1 March. Has had time to get her house in order and looks set for a return to form

**16. JALIMEDE -** Won a 2850m Feurs Class F on 24 March and, although clearly in form, has no particular love for Vincennes and a minor place chance at best

**Summary:** An excellent dual-discipline trotter, JE REVE DU BOIS (14) returns to the harness code at the top of his game and, barefoot for the occasion, can make this his own. Matthieu Abrivard will still be keeping a keen eye on quality Swedish import WORKING CLASS HERO (8) who was unopposed at Caen a month ago, and JENNY DE JOUDES (15) whose return to victorious ways is just a question of time.
