Summary: ATLANTIC WAYS (6) was an eye-catcher despite finishing unplaced (6th) last time. She ran on well from the tail-end of the field to finish just out of the money over 1400m at Le Mans last time and is good value to land the opener with the step up to this trip expected to unlock improvement. TREMAINE (3) revealed considerable promise as a two-year-old last season and, with scope to improve on his reappearance, could fight for victory. GRETZKY (5), whose form and experience will stand him in good stead, and IBERIA (7), after two much-needed comeback outings, are others worth a mention in this opening event.

- **6. ON Y VA -** Kept to the PSF if late and is hat-trick seeking after some nice wins with the latest being a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 9 April. Could be better on that surface but is not out of it
- **7. KAWARETH -** Very consistent so far and was third last time out in a Conditions race at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 17 April. Can contest the finish back in a handicap
- **8. COGNAC -** Has been unlucky of late and was 15th last time out in a handicap at this course over 2100m on 5 May. Can bounce back to score
- **9. TENNESSEE JOHN -** Returned to best and was a winner of a handicap last time out in a handicap at Compiegne over this distance on 16 April. Carries a penalty but is not out of it
- **10. E VA BIN -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when runner-up last time out in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over this distance on 13 April. Might place
- **11. JOYEUSE SAGE -** Distance suited and was third last time out in a handicap at this course over 2150m on 25 April. Could play a minor role
- **12. BANDASTAR -** Well beaten in both starts this year and was 14th last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 9 April, Best watched for now
- **13. HUTTON** Moderate form this year and was 9th last time out in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over this distance on 13 April. Unlikely to win
- **14. FORZA SEDACA -** Battling to regain best form and was 5th last time out in a Conditions race at La Teste-de-Buch over 2200m on 25 April
- **15. SHAWBAK -** More than a year since last win and was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 26 April. Place chance
- **16. BOWLAND PARK -** Bounced back to best when scoring a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 2000m on 13 April. Not well drawn but is not out of it

Summary: COGNAC (8) was unlucky last time and is a lot better than his finishing that day suggests. He remains more than capable of winning a race of this nature with a bit more luck in running. PRINCE OF DAWN (2) will find firmer ground more to his liking, so could be a threat with improved fitness on his side. BOWLAND PARK (16) won well last time out but is unfavourably drawn in the starting stalls. KAWARETH (7) is consistent and didn't run badly in her only handicap appearance, so deserves respect.

- 1. D DAY MAN In good form this year and was not disgraced when 5th last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 29 April. Won twice before that and can bounce back to score
- **2. JORDAN BAKER -** Runner-up in three of last five starts including last time out in a handicap over this track and trip on 25 April. Big chance
- **3. UN PLUS UNE -** Yet to win after 27 attempts and was 7th last time out in a handicap over this track and trip on 25 April. Might play a minor role
- **4. MALLORCA SUN -** Yet to win a race and was tenth last time out in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 1 May. Place chance
- **5. INVERINATE -** Disappointing form this year and was 6th last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 29 April. More is needed to win this race
- **6. ZANTARIO -** Distance suited and was fourth last time out in a handicap over this track and trip on 25 April. Place chance
- **7. LOVE AFFAIR -** Disappointing of late and was tenth last time out in a handicap at Deauville over 1400m on 10 April. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **8. GIN GEMBRE -** On a very long losing run but has been fair of late and was fourth last time out over this track and trip on 25 April. Not out of it
- **9. PLENTY CITY -** On a very long losing run but was not beaten far when 5th last time out over this course and distance on 25 April. Can contest the finish
- **10. ROYAL VATI -** Disappointing last run when 8th in a handicap at Dax over this distance on 1 May. Capable of better and others are preferred
- **11. VEGA DREAM -** Has not won for some time and was tenth last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 25 April. Capable of better and could contest the finish
- **12. IL RITORNO -** Showed some improvement when 6th in a Conditions race at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 1600m on 22 April. Needs to do much more to win this race
- **13. URI -** Usually gives of his best and was 5th last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 29 April. Always capable of earning some minor money
- **14. SALSA CHIC -** Won this race last year and was third last time out in a handicap over this course and distance on 25 April. Go close
- **15. SHAMASUN -** In good form this year and was runner-up last time out in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over this distance on 19 April. Can contest the finish
- **16. MURRAYFIELD -** On a very long losing run since only was 6th last time out in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over this distance on 19 April. Might place
- 17. ASTURIAS ROAD Disappointing last run when well beaten in a handicap at Fontainebleau over 1200m on 3 May. Others are much preferred

Summary: JORDAN BAKER (2) was ahead of a number of these rivals when runner-up last time and he wouldn't be winning out of turn, having finished 2nd in three of his last five starts. GIN GEMBRE (8) ran well to finish fourth over track and trip recently so may end a long losing run if building on that form/improvement. SALSA CHIC (14) won this race in 2023 and is ideally suited to this course and distance, so cannot be overlooked. PLENTY CITY (9) wasn't beaten far last time and could also get involved.
