# C1 - PRIX DE BUSSET - 2950m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- **1. ISIS DE REYNALD -** Yet to win a race and was 5th last time out in a Mounted race at Carpentras over 2650m on 5 May. More is needed to win this race
- **2. ISIS DE L'AUBE -** Unreliable but did show vast improvement when fourth last time out in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 1 May. Might play a minor role
- **3. IN LOVE METIS -** Disappointing form of late but the last run at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne on 22 April is best ignored. Capable of earning some money when in the mood
- **4. INDIE DE YOR -** Unreliable and was 5th last time out in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 28 March. Needs to do a bit more to win this race
- **5. ISCHIA SAINT CLAIR -** Yet to win after 46 attempts but was third last time out in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 15 April. Capable of making the frame again
- **6. IPSY DU BOCAGE -** Disappointing form of late and was tenth last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 6 May. More is needed to win this race
- **7. IAKA -** In fair form of late and was 5th last time out in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 15 April. Might play a minor role
- **8. ILOMBA DU GUESCLIN -** Has major disqualification issues and is coming off a disqualification at Hyères on 1 May. Won the penultimate start and can not be dismissed from winning
- **9. IMPHY -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this track on 6 May. Best watched for now
- **10. IRA STAR -** Showed some improvement when third last time out in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 22 April. Might play a minor role
- **11. ISA DES GENIEVRES -** Very unreliable again this year and was 11th last time out at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 22 April. Others are preferred
- **12. INES GRIFF -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Lignières on 14 April. Capable of better and can contest the finish
- **13. IMOUSSE LA RAVELLE -** Disappointing last run when 9th in Class F at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 21 April. Barefoot this time and is capable of contesting the finish
- **14. ISIS DU LEARD -** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at La Capelle on 5 May. In good form before that and can bounce back to score
- **15. ILLUSION DE CHENU -** Disqualified in her last three starts with the latest being at Cholet on 1 May. Hard to trust but is capable of winning

**Summary:** ISIS DU LEARD (14) was in good form before being sanctioned last time out and would not be a surprise winner on the previous form. IMOUSSE LA RAVELLE (13) will be barefoot this time so the last modest run is best ignored. ILLUSION DE CHENU (15) is very hard to trust but is capable of winning if wise. ISCHIA SAINT CLAIR (5) is a long-time battler but has been consistent of late and could contest the finish.

# C2 - PRIX DE L'AUBRAC - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- **1. GLAMOUR YOMA** Disappointing last run when 8th in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 29 April. Barefoot this time and should get involved with this finish
- **2. GALOPIN DE BIANCA -** Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in Class F over this track and trip on 6 May. Can contest the finish
- **3. GRISBI DU PERSIL -** Moderate for of late and was 6th last time out at Mons over 2300m on 7 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. HARCANGELO D'AMOUR -** Disappointing last run when 7th in Class E at Cordemais over 2650m on 21 April. Capable of better and could contest the finish
- **5. GALLIANO D'EVA -** In good form this year and was fourth last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 6 May. Can make the frame
- **6. FAXIMA -** Good last run when runner-up in Class F at this course over 2800m on 5 July 2022. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- **7. HUPPERCUT DE JOUX -** Probably best to ignore the last run when 9th at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 1 May. Prepared for this race and runs very well with this shoe arrangement
- **8. FAR WEST DE BUSSET -** Disappointing last run when 9th in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 3250m on 10 April. Barefoot and did better in his penultimate start. Respect
- **9. HORSE LOVE METIS -** Struggling of late and was disqualified last time out at Montluçon Néris-les-Bains on 9 May. Unlikely to win
- **10. FLAG -** Unreliable and was tenth last time out in Class E at Lignières over 2825m on 14 April. Others are preferred
- **11. HELIUM VELCO -** On a very long losing run but is in good form and was third last time out in Class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 7 April. Not out of it
- **12. FIGARO DE BUSSET -** On a very long losing run and was 6th last time out in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 15 April. Barefoot and is capable of earning some minor money
- **13. GLAIEUL DE JOUX -** Has really struggled this year and was 7th last time out in Class F at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 6 May. Others are preferred

**Summary:** HUPPERCUT DE JOUX (7) has had this as a targeted race so expect a big run from him and he may well win it. HARCANGELO D'AMOUR (4) is capable of better than the last run would suggest and could contest the finish. GLAMOUR YOMA (1) is barefoot this time so should be a serious threat. HELIUM VELCO (11) is in good form and could break a long losing run.

- 1. JOUANA GEM Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Lyon-La Soie on 28 March. Best watched for now
- **2. JUNGLE DU CAUX -** Mostly moderate form and was 6th last time out in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 1 May. Others are preferred
- **3. JUNE DE L'ORGUE -** Has struggled this year and was tenth last time out in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Unlikely to win
- **4. JEDHA -** Struggling of late and was 8th last time out in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. JOYCE PIPOL -** Has struggled with disqualifications of late with the latest being at Carpentras on 14 April. Best watched for now
- **6. JULIANA DU LOISIR -** On a very long losing run and was 7th last time out in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 May. Capable of earning some minor money when in the mood
- **7. JENNY LEGEND -** Disappointing form this year and was disqualified last time out at Lyon-Parilly on 3 May. Capable of playing a minor role
- **8. JIRARDIERE MERITE -** Unreliable and was 6th last time out in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 March. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **9. JOUVENCE D'AVRIL -** Disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 4 May. Did better when runner-up in her penultimate start and can bounce back to be a threat
- **10. JOLIE MAJYC -** Unreliable but was barefoot and fourth last time out in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 29 April. Could play a minor role
- **11. JADE MAJOR** Disqualified in her only start of the year at Lyon-La Soie on 12 January. Capable of better but is best watched for now
- **12. JADE HERINIERE -** On a very long losing run but is in good form and was fourth last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 23 April. Can fight out the finish again
- **13. JADE VENESI -** Unreliable but was runner-up last time out in Class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 12 April. Not out of it
- **14. JUST BEAUTIFUL -** A winner of her last three starts with the latest being in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Can extend win streak to 4

**Summary:** JUST BEAUTIFUL (14) has been unstoppable of late reeling in three straight victories and has every chance of winning again. JADE HERINIERE (12) is in good form and looking to break a long losing streak. JADE HERINIERE (12) ran well in the penultimate start but was disqualified last time out. JADE VENESI (13) is unreliable but deserves respect for the recent runner-up performance.

# C4 - PRIX DE SAINT FELIX - 2800m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- **1. KIMCOERE LE FOL -** Disqualified in two of last three starts including last time out at Lyon-Parilly on 3 May. Has ability and can be a threat if smart
- 2. KHEOPS AIREMME Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Feurs over 2850m on 24 March. Not out of it
- **3. KINGLY DREAMS** Very consistent since going barefoot and was fourth last time out in Class F at Lyon-Parilly2000m on 3 May. Be right there at the finish once again
- **4. KEIKO DU CHALET -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class C at Feurs over 2850m on 8 April. Can contest the finish
- **5. KING DE LARRE -** Very unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 27 April. Better this distance and could be capable of an upset
- **6. KARMA DE MONTCIANT -** Has disqualification issues and that was the case again last time out at Lyon-Parilly on 3 May. Capable of contesting the finish when wise
- 7. KING DE PLAY Has major disqualification issues but is in good form and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 29 April. Can go one better this time
- **8. KENJY DE LA VALLEE -** Very consistent last year and was fourth last time out in Class A at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- **9. KAYCAT WARRIOR -** Yet to win a race after 18 attempts but was third last time out in Class F at Chartres over 2800m on 14 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **10. KAMARO DE JOUDES -** Yet to win a race but was third last time out in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 7 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **11. KINGSLEY -** Disqualified in his last three starts with the latest being at Lyon-Parilly on 3 May. Others are much preferred
- **12. KIDAM DE LA VALLEE -** Showed some improvement when barefoot and fourth last time out in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 28 March. Remains barefoot but has more to do this time
- **13. KITUS DE BERTRANGE -** Yet to win but was runner-up last time out in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2600m on 18 March. Place chance

**Summary:** It is hard to put too much faith in KING DE PLAY (7) with his disqualification record but he is in good form of late and he is quite capable of winning this race. KINGLY DREAMS (3) has been consistent since racing unshod and can be right there at the finish yet again. KEIKO DU CHALET (4) is capable of getting involved with the finish. KHEOPS AIREMME (2) has shown ability so far but has yet to win. He is not out of it for a place.

- **1. KIBORA BUISSONAY -** Good third in class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April.Reverts to barefoot and could surprise at good odds
- **2. KALAMITY HENJO -** Disqualified in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 3 May.Remains barefoot and needs to be wise to have a chance
- **3. KELLY DU LYONNAIS -** Disqualified in class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 28 March. The penultimate start was a runner-up. Disappointed with the latest start
- **4. KOURGA DE LOU -** Disappointing when disqualified in class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 1 May. A complicated filly that needs to be wise. If so can be involved in the finish
- **5. KORA DE VINDECY -** Disqualified in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 3 May. Poor recent efforts and others are preferred
- **6. KELLE ALLURE -** Disqualified in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 15 April. Can play a minor role at best
- **7. KAURA DE LA VALLEE -** Disqualified in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 3 May.Remains barefoot and if ignoring the disqualification can get into the mix
- **8. KATE BRIONNAISE -** A winner in class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 28 March. She is looking to make it four in a row. Will find this tougher but will have her supporters
- **9. KATINKA MAUZUN -** A winner in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 2 April. Can double up on the recent victory
- **10. KELLY DE CERISY -** Finished 10th in class C at Feurs over 2850m on 8 April. Not in the best of form and needs to improve
- **11. KALANDA D'ELVIE -** Good winner in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 3 May.Remains barefoot and does well in this arrangement. Can have a say

- **2. JHA -** Finished 6th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. A long losing streak since winning in June last year
- **3. JESSICA TURGOT -** Disqualified in class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 1 May.Unreliable and best watched for now
- **4. JET D'ARJEANC -** Disappointing when disqualified in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 21 April. Tamara Mathias-Maisonnette is in the sulky and if she can get the gelding to be wise, must have a chance
- 5. JAVA D'URZY Fourth in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 May. Can at best play a minor role
- **6. J'Y CROIS -** A winner in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 15 April. Can be involved in the finish. Seldom far off them
- **7. JACKPOT MATH -** A good winner in class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 10 March. Remains barefoot and the last three efforts have been impeccable

JACKPOT MATH (7) has been good of late and should be a lively danger if he can hold his form. JET D'ARJEANC (4) was disqualified last time but she is smart enough and can feature if applied. J'Y CROIS (6) is seldom far from them and is another that won last time out so can be shortlisted too.

- **2. LALMERIA FILO -** Was 8th in class D at this track over 2950m on 6 May. Unplaced to date and will need major improvement
- **3. LEGENDE DE MORGE -** Finished 6th in class E at Chat Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 1 May. First attempt at under the saddle. Might suit
- **4. L'AS DE COEUR -** Finished 7th in a class E at Caen over 2450m on 18 March. Disqualified in both attempts at this discipline
- **5. LABEL DE LARRE -** Third in class G at Elfbeuf over 2750m on 5 May. Improved in the latest and can confirm
- **6. LENOTRE DE HOUELLE -** Fourth in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 7 May. The full brother of Be Mine de Houelle deserves to be respected in this discipline
- **7. LULLY DES IRIS -** Runner up in class F at Lignieres over 2100m on 14 April. Improved effort in this discipline and has sufficient means to fight for victory
- **8. LADY IMPERIALE -** Was 5th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 15 April. She has shown ability in Harness events and this discipline could suit
- **9. LOLA DU VAL -** Disqualified in class R at Marseille-Borely over 2400m on 26 April. Not straightforward but has the ability to get involved in the finish if wise

**Summary:** LENOTRE DE HOUELLE (6) was not disgraced when fourth last time out and could do a lot better in this discipline. LOLA DU VAL (9) is not an easy drive but is quite capable of making her present felt if on a good day. LULLY DES IRIS (7) showed improvement last time out and can fight out the finish. LADY IMPERIALE (8) could improve under the saddle and is another to consider.

- **1. INROAD OAKS -** Disqualified the last four attempts the latest in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 21 January. Major disqualification issues and best watched for now
- **2. HERCULE DU JOUR -** Fourth in class G at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 22 April. Probably needed the last start and can improve
- **3. ILE DE FADA -** Finished 9th in class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 22 April. Last placed at this track in July last year
- **4. ISTRA DU PERCHE -** Fourth in class F at Oraison over 2675m on 21 April. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **5. HASTON ATOUT -** Was 8th at Montluçon Néris-les-Bains over 3025m on 9 May. The penultimate start was a runner-up and could surprise
- **6. HEROS DES LOYAUX -** Disqualified in class E at Nantes over 3000m on 27 February. Unlikely to be the winner
- **7. HOLD MAJYC -** A runner-up in the latest a class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 4 May. The last two have been close up and can go close again
- **8. GRAND RESTAURANT -** Finished 9th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 May. A runner-up in the penultimate start and can bounce back
- **9. IRLANDE DU NORD -** Disqualified in class E at this track over 2800m on 6 May. Ignore the latest where disqualified. Seldom far off them
- **10. FIRST BLACK -** Third in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 5 May. Remains barefoot and improved in the latest effort. Has sufficient means to fight for victory
- **11. HALTESS GRIFF -** Finished 10th in class F at this track over 2150m on 6 May. She has proven herself in this category and can be involved in the finish

**Summary:** HOLD MAJYC (7) is in good shape and could be ready to strike for victory in this lucky last race. FIRST BLACK (10) is improving and should contest the finish again. HALTESS GRIFF (11) is proven in this class of event and clearly better than the last run would suggest. GRAND RESTAURANT (8) ran well in the penultimate start but did not repeat it last time out. He remains hard to rule out of the equation.
